



PITT FIELD

The process to elevate Pitt Field has already begun — a beautiful new field was installed in 2015. We will now surround that new playing surface with a Collegiate Gothic stadium that reflects the architecture that makes Richmond so special. The renovated baseball complex will include expanded grandstands, a press box, restrooms, concessions, indoor batting cages, outfield seating, and a new right field entrance that mirrors Robins Stadium. The new Pitt Field will complement a new South Entrance to the Robins Center and the overall Athletics Village.



CRENSHAW FIELD

Historic Crenshaw Field will be elevated with new berm seating made of Richmond Brick, a press box with restrooms, and decorative fencing that connects the look and feel of Crenshaw Field to Robins Stadium, the rest of our Athletics Village facilities, and the campus as a whole.



WESTHAMPTON TENNIS COURTS

A complete renovation will elevate the Westhampton Tennis Complex, creating new courts, new seating, and the potential for several courts to be temporarily enclosed. The overhaul will also result in architecture that reflects our campus, new scoreboards, and a new entrance that matches the Robins Center, Robins Stadium, and the rest of our Athletics Village facilities.



ROBINS STADIUM

Robins Stadium provides a competitive home to more Spider Athletics teams than any other venue. We will further elevate Robins Stadium with new hospitality spaces and offices for coaches. We will create additional suites to provide amenities for our fans and more spaces for large group outings. Below the press box, on the second floor, we will create a home for our men's and women's lacrosse programs, including offices that overlook the field.

ROBINS CENTER

The Robins Center arena embodies the concept of elevation. It is a physical manifestation of our success and our commitment to our athletics programs. Now, we will carry that energy through the rest of our flagship facility.

A dramatic new South Entrance, with a towering glass façade, will welcome fans into a fully renovated interior and immerse them in a showcase of Spider sports featuring a new Hall of Fame. The new South Entrance will complement the renovated Pitt Field and the adjacent Weinstein Center. The West Entrance of the Robins Center will feature a new entryway that will showcase the history and tradition of


Spider Athletics. A new West Entrance plaza will announce that you are entering a place of distinction and tradition.
