

What's On Tap ...

Richmond

(1-1)

The Richmond Spiders hit the road for an unexpected trip Thursday night as they travel to Loretto, Pa., for a meeting with Saint Francis ... Game time is set for 5 p.m. at DeGol Field ... The game was moved due to forecasted weather impacts from Hurricane Florence ... The game audio will be available on 99.5 FM/950 AM ESPN Richmond and online at www.richmondspiders. com.

Hurricane Hunters...

This marks the second-straight year that the Richmond football program has been impacted by a hurricane ... Last season, the Spiders were schedule to play at Sam Houston State August 27 but were forced to move their game due to Hurricane Harvey ... The game was postponed until September 1 and was played in Waco on the campus of Baylor University.

Series History ...

Thursday's game marks the first-ever meeting between Richmond and Saint Francis ... The game is just the third game all-time between the Spiders and a member of the Northeast Conference ... Richmond played Duquesne once in 1937 and Wagner College once in 2011, winning against Wagner and falling to the Dukes.

Table For Four . . .

Junior quarterback **Kevin Johnson** accounted for four total touchdowns Saturday night before giving way to his backup early in the second half ... Johnson passed for two second half touchdowns after rushing for two first half touchdowns ... His two rushing touchdowns marks the first Spider quarterback to have two rushing scores in the same game since Kyle Lauletta had a pair against William & Mary December 5, 2015.

Racking Up The Yards . . .

Senior wide receiver **Dejon Brissett** averaged 43.3 yards per catch last weekend against Fordham ... Brissett hauled in four receptions for a career-high 173 yards ... He grabbed a 75-yard touchdown on the first play of the second half to highlight the evening ... Brissett already has 200-yards receiving on the year after finishing last season with 896 yards receiving.

Points On The Board ...

Senior kicker **Griffin Trau** moved into fifth place all-time in Richmond Spider scoring history last weekend, registering 10 points in the win over Fordham ... Trau has now scored 209 points in his career, surpassing Jacobi Green (2012-15) last game at 208 points ... He is just one point shy of fourth place held by Josh Vaughan with 210 points (2005-08).

Pressuring The Quarterback . . .

Last season, Richmond finished second in the CAA with 35.0 sacks ... Through the first two games this year the Spiders are second with 8.0 sacks ... Defensive lineman **Maurice Jackson** leads the way this year with 3.0 sacks in the first two games while fellow defensive lineman **Colby Ritten** is second on the team with 2.0 sacks ... The Spiders return 23.0 sacks from last year's team, including senior defensive lineman **Andrew Clyde's** team-leading 9.0 sacks ... Ritten and linebacker **Dale Matthews Jr.** each added 4.0 sacks apiece while Jackson chipped in 2.5 sacks ... **Justin Rubin, Samari Springs** and **Gershom Ejoni** combined for 3.5 sacks last year.

Spider Takeaways ...

Richmond forced four turnovers last weekend against Fordham, intercepting three passes and forcing one fumble ... The four turnovers forced are the most by Richmond since forcing six turnovers against Towson October 14 of last year ... That game, the Spiders recorded four interceptions and recovered two fumbles ... Last week, Richmond got interceptions from Dionte Austin, Samari Springs and Jordan Payne while Andrew Clyde recovered a fumble forced by Maurice Jackson.

Making Splashes...

The Spiders have had a propensity for the splash play under head coach **Russ Huesman** and this year is no different ... Through the first two games, Richmond has turned in four plays covering over 50-yards ... Against Virginia, quarterback **Kevin Johnson** connected with **Cortrelle Simpson** for a 54-yard gain ... The Spiders had three big plays against Fordham as **Dejon Brissett** had a 55-yard reception and a 75-yard reception from Johnson ... Running back **Deontez Thompson** added a 51-yard run in the second half.

Home Openers . . .

Last Saturday's 52-7 victory over Fordham moved the Spiders to 85-44-6 all-time in home openers and runs Richmond's winning streak in home openers to 13-straight ... The Spiders have not lost a home opener in Robins Stadium history ... Richmond has out-scored opponents by a 569-142 margin in the last 13 home openers, including 120 points scored over the past two years (68 vs. Howard, 52 vs. Fordham).

Home, Sweet Home...

This season marks the ninth year that Robins Stadium is serving as home to Richmond football ... The Spiders are 37-14 all-time at home at the Robins Stadium, good for a .725 winning percentage ... In the last four years, Richmond has gone 21-6 at home, winning at a 77.7 percent clip... The Spiders have won at least five home games in five of the eight years calling Robins Stadium home.

<u>Transfer Impact ...</u>

Junior corner back **Dionte Austin** made his

Richmond Spider debut last week against Fordham ... Austin had an immediate impact, recording five tackles, two pass breakups and an interception against the Rams ... Austin played in 23 games for Wake Forest, including six starts ... He made four starts as a sophomore in 2016 before sitting out a year as a transfer student.

Young Leg...

Freshman punter **Micah Breckenridge** made his collegiate debut against Virginia and through two games, has punted nine times Breckenridge averaged 36.2 yards per kick on four punts against the Cavaliers, with a long of 42-yards ... He followed that up with four punts against Fordham, including a 45-yard punt ... He combined with redshirt freshman long snapper **Kevin McLaughlin** to form a duo of players making their collegiate debuts on the punting team ... Breckenridge is one of two freshmen punters so far this season in the Colonial Athletic Association, joining Villanova's Nathan Fondacaro.

It's Mo Time . . .

Junior defensive end **Maurice Jackson** had a breakout game against Virginia, tying for the team lead with 10 total tackles, including a pair of sacks ... Jackson had 3.5 tackles for loss against the Cavaliers ... He is second in the Colonial Athletic Association for sacks and is first in the league with 4.5 tackles for loss.

Defense Line Pressure...

Junior **Maurice Jackson** and redshirt sophomore **Darius Reynolds** combined for 5.5 tackles for loss in the season-opener at Virginia ... The Spiders kept up the attack against Fordham, combining for 6.5 tackles for loss from the defensive line ... **Gershom Ejoni** led the way with 2.5 tackles for loss while **Colby Ritten** added 2.0 tackles for loss.

Fresh Faces ...

The Spiders had 13 true freshmen or redshirt freshmen make their collegiate debuts in Charlottesville as Clayton McConnell, Noah Nicholson, Aaron Banks, Ben Maffe, Tyrek Funderburk, Augustus Lee, Devon Perry, Grayson Overstreet, Micah Brecken**ridge, Jordan Payne, Kevin Laughlin, Caleb Brooks** and **Kobie Turner** all saw their first action in a regular season game ... McConnell was the only one of the group to notch a start but a large portion played significant roles for the Spiders.

Spiders In The NFL ...

Three former University of Richmond football student-athletes made official 53-man rosters of NFL teams this weekend as **Kyle Lauletta** and **Kerry Wynn** made the New York Giants roster, while **Alex Light** made the Green Bay Packers squad.

Lauletta, the Spiders' starting quarterback the last three years, was drafted by the Giants in the fourth round of the NFL Draft this spring ... He is one of three quarterbacks on the 53-man roster and looks poised to be the backup to future Hall of Fame quarterback Eli Manning ... Lauletta finished his Richmond career as the all-time leading passer and just the fourth quarterback in CAA history to reach the 10,000-yard career mark, finishing with 10,422 yards ... He set the Richmond single-season record for total offense with 3,827 yards and was named the CAA Offensive Player of the Year.

Wynn is in his fifth year with the New York Giants in 2018 ... He has been listed as a backup on the defensive line and has been one of the top special teams performers for the Giants in his career ... Wynn finished his career in Richmond in 2014 as a Third Team All-Colonial Athletic Association selection ... In his senior season, he led all defensive linemen in tackles per game, totaling 56 stops, 5.5 tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks on the year.

Light earned his spot on the Packers' 53-man roster after signing with the club as an undrafted free agent ... He made his way on with a strong preseason camp on the Packers' offensive line ... Light was a key member of last season's offensive success, protecting Lauletta on the line ... He was a Third Team All-America selection as a senior and finished his career making 38 consecutive starts and played two positions for Richmond this year.

Taking It To The House . . .

Senior linebacker **Dale Matthews Jr.** scored the season's first touchdown, intercepting Virginia in the first quarter and returning it 72-yards for a touchdown ... It marked the first interception return for a touchdown by Richmond since David Jones returned one 100-yards in the FCS Playoffs against William & Mary December 5, 2015 ... The interception was just the third of his career with the last two coming in last year's home opening win over Howard.

Buck Buchanan Award...

Senior defensive lineman **Andrew Clyde** was named one of 25 members on the preseason watch list for the STATS FCS Buck Buchanan Award ... Clyde is one of four players from the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) to be named to the watch list, which is given to the nation's top defensive player in the FCS.

Clyde was named to three preseason All-America teams, including the STATS FCS team ... He was named All-America and All-CAA last fall after leading the CAA in sacks, totaling 9.0 on the season ... He led a defense that set a school-record with 3.2 sacks per game (35 on the year) ... He recorded 41 total tackles, 11 of which were for a loss, while leading the team with seven QB hurries.

Year Two Of Huesman Era ...

Head coach **Russ Huesman** is in his second year at the helm of the Richmond football program ... This is Huesman's 10th season overall as a collegiate head coach and his second stint with the Spiders after spending five seasons (2004-08) as an assistant coach, and was part of the 2008 National Championship team.

Huesman returned to Richmond last season and guided the Spiders to a 6-5 record ... The Spiders had 11 different players earn All-CAA honors, led by the Offensive Player of the Year Kyle Lauletta ...He became the first Richmond player to win Offensive Player of the Year since Greg Lilly in 1992 ... Lauletta led the CAA with 3,737 yards, 28 passing TDs and 3,827 yards of total offense and was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award.

Offensive Line Help...

The Spiders entered the 2018 season with a revamped offensive line with All-Conference member **John Yarbrough** as the only returning starter ... Yarbrough, who played center last year, started the season at right tackle but will play both positions at some point during the year ... Yarbrough has made 19-straight starts for the Spiders ... Joining him on the line this year is Furman transfer **Tim Coleman** at left tackle ... Coleman sat out last season due to transfer rules but was a Freshman All-America recipient in 2016 with the Paladins ... Redshirt freshman center **Clayton McConnell** started in the middle at Virginia, making his first career start ... At the two guard positions, the Spiders will look to three players in **Seyoum Settapani, Tazle Sumpter** and **Kolby Williams** ... Settapani started the last game of the year in 2017 while Sumpter was the opening day starter last season before suffering a season-ending injury against Sam Houston State.

Got Your Back ...

Richmond employs a 4-2-5 defense and returns both of its linebackers this season in seniors **Justin Rubin** and **Dale Matthews Jr.** ... The two combined for 159 total tackles last season, including 14.5 tackles for loss ... Rubin led the team with 92 tackles from his Mike linebacker position, including 6.5 tackles for loss ... Matthews recorded 67 tackles on the year, ranking third in the league, while recording 8.0 tackles for loss at the Sam linebacker.

Best Foot Forward...

The Spiders have two completely different kickers handling duties this season, in terms of experience ... Redshirt senior **Griffin Trau** will handle





the kicking duties while true freshman **Micah Breckenridge** will handle the punting duties ... Trau has scored 209 points in his career, ranking fifth all-time in Richmond scoring history ... He has converted 38-of-45 field goals in his career (84.4%) and is third all-time in career field goals made trailing Andrew Howard (55) and Rob Courter (41) ... Breckenridge will handle all of the Spiders' punting duties this season as a true freshman ... He was a two-time All-Conference player at White Station High School in Memphis and has the unique capability of punting with either foot.

Team Captains...

University of Richmond head football coach Russ Huesman announced the Spiders' team captains for the 2018 season in seniors **Dale Matthews Jr.**, **John Yarbrough**, **Justin Rubin**, **Andrew Clyde** and **Tyler Wilkins** ... The players were chosen as captains after a vote by the players on the team ... The five-man captain crew have combined to play in 173 career games for Richmond during their careers heading into the 2018 season.

Rubin and Clyde have played in the most games in their careers with 39 games each ... Rubin was a Third Team All-Colonial Athletic Association selection at linebacker last season after leading the team with 92 tackles ... Clyde was a First Team All-CAA selection and is a preseason All-America selection this year ... He led the CAA with nine sacks last season and finished with 41 tackles.

Wilkins earned Second Team All-CAA honors last year and has played in 38 games in his career ... He caught 62 passes for 876 yards and seven touchdowns last season ... Matthews finished with 67 tackles, including four sacks, while also notching a pair of interceptions last season ... He has played in 29 career games while Yarbrough has played in 28 games ... Yarbrough was an All-CAA selection last fall and is a preseason All-CAA pick this year.

Preseason All-America . . .

Senior defensive lineman **Andrew Clyde** and senior wide receiver **Dejon Brissett** were named preseason FCS All-America by STATS ... The Spiders are one of four teams from the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) with multiple members on the preseason team (James Madison 5, Villanova 2, Delaware 2).

Clyde was named preseason Second Team All-America ... This marks the third preseason All-America selection for Clyde and he was named preseason All-CAA ... He earned Third Team All-America honors last season by STATS FCS and was a First Team All-CAA selection last year ... He led the CAA in sacks, totaling

9.0 on the season ... He led a defense that set a school-record with 3.2 sacks per game (35 on the year) ... He recorded 41 total tackles, 11 of which were for a loss, while leading the team with seven QB hurries.

Brissett was named preseason Third Team All-America and was also named to the preseason All-CAA team ... Last year, he finished first on the team with 63 receptions and was second on the team with 896 yards ... He tied for the team lead with seven touchdowns, ranking 37th in the nation in that category ... He recorded four 100-yard games and was 25th in the nation with 5.7 receptions per game.

Spiders Picked Seventh ...

The Richmond Spiders have been picked to finish seventh overall in the highly competitive Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) by the league's coaches and media ... Seven different teams have already been ranked in the top-25 in various preseason polls this season, showing the depth of the league ... Richmond has been ranked in the top three in the preseason poll in three out of the last five years ... The last time the Spiders were ranked as low as seventh in the preseason poll was the 2012 season when Richmond was picked to finish ninth ... The Spiders proved the poll wrong, finishing the year as co-champions in the CAA and ended the year ranked No. 18 in the country.

Preseason Accolades . . .

Richmond had four players tabbed on the preseason All-CAA Team, the third most by any school trailing only James Madison (6) and Delaware (5) ... Senior defensive lineman **Andrew Clyde** highlights the Spider defense while senior wide receiver **Dejon Brissett** and senior center **John Yarbrough** were chosen on offense ... Senior kicker **Griffin Trau** rounded out the Spiders' All-Conference selections on special teams.

Clyde was also named preseason All-America by multiple publications this season ... He earned Third Team All-America honors last season by STATS FCS and was a First Team All-CAA selection ... He led the CAA in sacks, total-

ing 9.0 on the season ... He led a defense that set a school-record with 3.2 sacks per game (36 on the year) ... He recorded 41 total tackles, 11 of which were for a loss, while leading the team with seven QB hurries.

Brissett finished first on the team with 63 receptions and was second on the team with 896 yards ... He tied for the team lead with seven touchdowns, ranking 37th in the nation in that category ... He recorded four 100-yard games and was 25th in the nation with 5.7 receptions per game.

Yarbrough earned Third Team All-CAA honors last season ... He has made 18-straight starts for the Spiders and anchored a line last year that allowed just 23.0 sacks, fourth best in the CAA.

Trau was a First Team All-CAA selection last season and has earned All-America honors as a sophomore ... Last year, he finished first in the CAA and 15th in the nation converting 80 percent of his field goal attempts (12-of-15) ... For his career, Trau is 38-of-45 (.844), scoring 209 points.

Top Receiving Trio . . .

Last season, Richmond had one of the top receiving trios in the nation ... **Dejon Brissett** was named First Team All-CAA while **Tyler Wilkins** and **Cortrelle Simpson** earned Second Team All-CAA honors ... The three combined for 2,791 receiving yards and 20 touchdowns ... Brissett (896 yds, 7 TDs), Wilkins (876 yds, 7 TDs) and Simpson (1,019 yds, 6 TDs) all ranked in the top-four in the CAA in yards last year. ... Richmond was the only school in the FCS to finish the regular season with three receivers over 800 yards on the year.

The trio is the top returning receiving trio in the nation entering the 2018 season ... The three combined for 253.7 yards per game, the highest per-game total of any receiving trio at the FCS level ... Princeton is second with 216.2 yards per game returning while Sam Houston State is third at 203.8 yards returning (two receivers).

Richmond CAA Success ...

Since joining the league in 2007, no CAA football program has captured more conference titles than Richmond ... The Spiders have taken home four trophies ('07, '09, '12 and '15), one more than any other school during that span (James Madison) ... Richmond has posted an overall record of 93-48 (.660) since joining the CAA and has gone 54-34 (.614) in league play since 2007.

Replacing Lauletta ...

RUSS HUESMAN

HEAD COACH

Second Season Chattanooga, 1983

Russ Huesman enters his second season as head coach of the University of Richmond football program and his 10th season overall as a collegiate head coach. This is Huesman's second stint with the Spiders after spending five seasons (2004-08) as an assistant coach and was part of the 2008 National Championship team.

In his 30-plus years of coaching, Huesman has coached 42

All-Americans and 21 NFL Draft Picks, while being a part of nine conference championships and the 2008 National Championship with the Spiders. He has spent 20 years coaching in the Colonial Athletic Association, bringing a wealth of experience to the Spiders.

Huesman returned to Richmond last season and guided the Spiders to a 6-5 record. The Spiders had 11 different players earn All-CAA honors, led by the Offensive Player of the Year Kyle Lauletta. He became the first Richmond player to win Offensive Player of the Year since Greg Lilly in 1992. Lauletta led the CAA with 3,737 yards, 28 passing TDs and 3,827 yards of total offense and was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award.

Joining Lauletta on the All-CAA First Team were Alex Light (OL), Garrett Hudson (TE), Dejon Brissett (WR), Griffin

Trau (PK) and Andrew Clyde (DL). The All-CAA Second Team included Tyler Wilkins (WR) and Cortrelle Simpson (WR), while Brandon Waller (DL), Justin Rubin (LB) and John Yarbrough (OL) were all named to the All-CAA Third Team.

Prior to returning to Richmond, Huesman spent eight tremendously successful seasons at Chattanooga. He was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year three times (2009, 2013, 2014) and was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year three times.

In his eight seasons at Chattanooga, Huesman helped guide the Mocs to a 59-37 record, including a 36-16 mark in his last four seasons (2013-16), which featured three Southern Conference regular season championships. Chattanooga was one of only 10 programs in the country to reach the FCS Playoffs each year from 2014-16. The Mocs were also just one of four programs in the country to post a playoff win during that time.

In his eight seasons, the Mocs had at least seven players named to the All-SoCon team every year, including a school-record 17 honorees in 2014. Prior to Huesman's arrival, the Mocs had not boasted seven members of any All-SoCon team since 1979.

Chattanooga had 17 All-America honorees and three NFL draft picks with DB Buster Skrine (Cleveland – 2011), QB B.J. Coleman (Green Bay – 2012) and LB Davis Tull (New Orleans – 2015) over the eight-year period.

Huesman's first stop at Richmond came from 2004-08 as defensive coordinator molding the Spiders' defensive unit into one of the best in the country. In his final year at Richmond, the national championship season,

the Spiders led the country in interceptions and finished in the top-10 in four other defensive categories.

Under Huesman's guidance, the Spiders had 23 All-Conference selections, including former NFL standouts Lawrence Sidbury, Jr. and Justin Rogers. During his five-year period as an assistant coach, the Spiders posted a 42-23 (.646) record and played in the FCS Playoffs three times with a quarterfinal appearance in 2005, a semifinal appearance in 2007 and the National Championship in 2008.

Prior to his time with the Spiders, Huesman spent six years at the University of Memphis (1998-03), where he held several positions, serving as the recruiting coordinator and offensive line coach. He also coached the outside linebackers, tight ends and running backs. As recruiting coordinator, Huesman brought in a Top 50 recruiting class, ranked No. 1 in Conference USA, in 2002. It was the first recruiting class ranked in the Top 50 at Memphis.

Huesman also coached for 14 years at William & Mary (1984-97), both with the defense and special teams. During his time in Williamsburg, Huesman coached Steve Christie, a 15-year NFL place kicker with Tampa Bay, Buffalo, San Diego and the New York Giants. His coaching family tree also includes Mike Tomlin, head coach of the Pittsburgh Steelers, Sean McDermott, the head coach of the Buffalo Bills and Alan Williams, the former defensive backs coach of the Detroit Lions. All three played for Huesman at William & Mary.

Huesman's success on the gridiron is not limited to just coaching as he was a standout player at perennial power Moeller High School in his native town of Cincinnati, Ohio. He helped Moeller's team compile a record of 43-0-1 and win a pair of Ohio state championships.

An all-city selection in football as a senior, Huesman signed a football scholarship with Chattanooga, where he started all four years as a defensive back (1978-81) and was a two-sport athlete. During his playing career with the Mocs, he helped UTC to a 31-11-2 mark and two Southern Conference championships. Huesman also patrolled centerfield on the baseball diamond for the Mocs during his freshman and junior seasons.

Huesman was on the Mocs' sidelines for the 1982 season as a student coach, earning his degree in business education in 1983. He followed that up with a move to the University of South Carolina as a graduate assistant under the late Joe Morrison.

Huesman and his wife Amy have two daughters, Natalie (21) and Emily (18) and two sons, Jacob (25) and Levi (15).
