What's On Tap ...

Richmond returns home to Robins Stadium Saturday for its annual Homecoming game, welcome in No. 20 Stony Brook for a 3 p.m. kick-off in a pivotal Colonial Athletic Association contest.

Series History ...

Saturday's game marks the sixth meeting all-time between Richmond and Stony Brook ... The Spiders are 2-3 all-time against the Seawolves ... Richmond won the first two meetings in series history with a 42-0 win in 2007 and a 39-31 win in 2013 on the road ... Stony Brook has won the past three games in the series, posting a 42-14 win in 2016, a 27-24 win at Robins Stadium in 2017 and a 36-10 victory last year over the Spiders ... Last season, the Seawolves rushed for 335 yards against the Spiders and scored a defensive touchdown in the win.

Dykes Sets Records and Earns Multiple Honors ...

Redshirt freshman **Aaron Dykes** had a day to remember last week in the Spiders' 35-25 victory on the road over No. 19 Delaware ... Dykes became the first player in Richmond's 135-year history of football to return two kickoff returns for touchdowns in the same game ... His two kickoff returns for scores ties the NCAA FCS record all-time for returns in a game ... Dykes got things going in the first quarter, recording his first career special teams' touchdown by returning a kick 100-yards for a touchdown ... He broke a pair of tackles around the 25-yard line before breaking free and becoming the fourth Spider in program history to post a return of 100-yards in length ... Dykes followed that up with an 88-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the second quarter that gave the Spiders a 28-10 lead ... He finished with a program-record 226 kickoff return yards, breaking the previous record of 222 yards held by Justin Rogers in 2007 against New Hampshire ... Dykes was named the STATS FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week and the CAA Special Teams Player of the Week for his efforts.

Top 25 Wins ...

Saturday's victory over No. 19 Delaware on the road marked the second win over a nationally ranked opponent this season ... Richmond also defeated No. 18 Maine on the road this year ... This marks the first time since 2017 that the Spiders have won multiple games against nationally ranked opponents ... Richmond posted a 3-4 record against ranked foes that year in 2017, including two on the road at Colgate and Villanova ... Since 1995, the Spiders are 57-67 all-time when facing a nationally ranked opponent, including a 2-1 record this year with the wins over Maine and Delaware along with a loss to No. 25 Elon ... Richmond's game Saturday comes against another ranked opponent as Stony Brook is 20th in the country ... Additionally, Villanova is currently ranked 11th in the nation and James Madison is second in the country.

Fuller On The Move ...

Graduate transfer wide receiver **Keyston Fuller** leads the team with 781 yards receiving this year on 38 catches ... Fuller is averaging 20.6 yards per catch, ranking second in the Colonial Athletic Association behind only Earnest Edwards of Maine (23.9 yards) ... Fuller has posted 11 receptions this year over 25 yards and has six receptions of 60 yards or more this season ... Nine of his 11 receptions over 25 yards have come from the connection with redshirt junior quarterback **Joe Mancuso** ... Additionally, five of his six touchdowns have come on passes of 35 yards or longer.

Three-Straight In CAA ...

The Spiders enter Saturday's game having won three-straight Colonial Athletic Association contest and sit in second place in the league with a 3-1 mark ... Richmond has picked up wins over UAlbany, at Maine and at Delaware during the run ... This marks the first time the Spiders have won three-straight CAA games in a season since 2016 when they won four in a row with wins over Towson, Albany, Villanova and Elon.

Homecoming Games ...

Saturday's game is the 89th Homecoming contest since 1929 ... The Spiders are 46-36-6 all-time in Home-

coming games having won the game in five out of the last seven meetings ... Last year, Richmond dropped the Homecoming game by a 28-9 margin to Villanova ... The Spiders last won their Homecoming game in 2016 with a 22-0 victory over No. 11 Villanova.

Mancuso Maneuvers Offense ...

Redshirt junior quarterback **Joe Mancuso** has made three-straight starts for the Spiders and has accounted for nine touchdowns and just two turnovers ... Over the past three games, Mancuso has thrown for 733 yards and five passing touchdowns while rushing for 240 yards and scoring four touchdowns on the ground ... Last time out, He threw for 280 yards on 21-of-29 passing while rushing for 95 yards on 15 carries against Delaware ... He recorded his first 100-yard rushing performance of his career and the first for a Spider runner this season, rushing for 117 yards on 13 carries against Yale ... Mancuso leads the Spiders on the season rushing for 411 yards on 70 carries ... He has passed for 1,222 yards on 86-of-136 passing this season with eight touchdowns and five interceptions ... His 63.2 completion percentage ranks second in the Colonial Athletic Association and 28th in the country this year.

Running Quarterbacks ...

Redshirt junior quarterback **Joe Mancuso** has been the top rushing quarterback in the Colonial Athletic Association this season ... Mancuso leads the Spiders on the ground with 411 yards rushing on 70 carries, averaging 5.9 yards per rush ... He has done most of his damage despite not playing at quarterback for two of the Spiders' eight games this year (Fordham and UAlbany) ... Mancuso's 411 yards rushing leads the CAA among all quarterbacks on the ground ... Hollis Mathis of William & Mary is second with 321 yards rushing on 76 carries followed by Tom Flacco of Towson (297 yards/79 carries), Ben DiNucci of James Madison (290/65) and Tyquell Fields of Stony Brook (265/61).

Music To Our Ears ...

Redshirt freshman defensive lineman **Kobie Turner** -- a music major at Richmond -- has been making some music of his own on the field this season ... Turner is coming off a career-high 2.0 sack performance last week against No. 19 Delaware ... He is second on the team this season with 5.5 sacks, ranking fifth in the Colonial Athletic Association ... This is Turner's first season as a full-time starter and he has accounted for 44 tackles ... He is tied for the team lead with senior **Maurice Jackson** with 11.5 tackles for loss this year.

Racking Up The Tackles ...

Freshman linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** has been a tackling machine this season, moving into the starting lineup in the fourth game of the year ... Wheeler is second on the team with 69 tackles this season, despite coming off the bench in the first three games ... His 8.6 tackles per game ranks seventh overall in the CAA this season and is the top mark among all league freshmen ... Elon's Tre'Von Jones is 32nd overall at 5.6 tackles per game (41 total) while Noah Plack of Delaware are third among freshmen at 5.6 tackles per game (45 total) ... He currently leads all of NCAA FCS among freshmen in tackles at 8.6 per game, with Tra Tluellen of Houston Baptist in second averaging 8.5 tackles per game ... He ranks 44th in the nation in tackles per game among all players ... Wheeler has recorded double digit tackles in four out of his first eight games to start his career ... He opened his career with 12 tackles against Jacksonville ... Against Fordham, he recorded a career-high 13 tackles before following that up with 11 tackles, including his first career sack against Albany ... Last week, he led the Spiders with 11 tackles in the win over No. 19 Delaware.

Dressler Dominates ...

Despite missing last week's game, junior linebacker **Tyler Dressler** leads the Colonial Athletic Association in tackles this season with 71 tackles in seven games, averaging 10.1 tackles per game ... Dressler ranks 13th in the country in total tackles and has racked up 35 tackles in his past two games ... He had a game for the ages in the Spiders' win over No. 18 Maine ... Dressler recorded a career-high 20 tackles in the victory, earning himself Colonial Athletic Association Defensive Player of the Week honors ... His 20 tackles are the most by any player in the NCAA FCS this season and the most by a player in the CAA since 2017 (Nate Hatalsky, UAlbany 21) ... Dressler's 20 tackles are the most for a Richmond Spider in a single game since Darius McMillan recorded 20 tackles against William & Mary in 2011 ... The 20 tackles are the most in the NCAA FCS since October 6, 2018 when BJ Blunt of McNeese State also had 20 tackles ... Dressler's play helped the Spiders post their second-straight CAA victory and their first win over a nationally ranked opponent since November 4, 2017 when Richmond shutout then 20th-ranked Villanova 22-0 on the road ... Dressler followed that up with a team-high 15 tackles against Yale.

Jackson Heating Up The Sack Train ...

Senior defensive end **Maurice Jackson** was named the CAA preseason Defensive Player of the Year over the summer after leading the league in sacks last year with 10.0 ... Jackson has started to heat up his game recently, moving into second in the CAA on the year with 7.0 sacks this season -- all solo sacks ... He has recorded 5.0 sacks

in two games along - recording 3.0 against Albany and 2.0 against Maine ... Jackson has also moved into ninth place all-time in Richmond Spider history for career sacks with 19.5, despite only playing defensive end the past two seasons ... He is tied with Jonathan Wilfong for ninth place overall and is just a half sack away from fifth place all-time at 20.0 sacks held by four players -- Lawrence Sidbury, Sherman Logan, Shawn Barber and Justin Oravetz ... Fourth place is currently held by Tom Coles (24.5) and second place is held by Andrew Clyde and Steve Quander (25.0) ... Marc Megna holds the career record with 32.0 sacks total.

Protecting The Ball ...

Richmond was one of the worst teams protecting the ball last season and had ball security as a priority in the offseason ... The Spiders have started to take heed and the past three games committing just two turnovers in four games, including two games without a turnover ... By no coincidence, the two games without turnovers resulted in CAA wins for the Spiders against Albany and Maine ... The Spiders are 6-0 all-time under head coach **Russ Huesman** when they do not commit a turnover and are 8-1 when they win the turnover battle in the past three seasons ... In fact, over the past five years, the Spiders are 12-2 when committing zero turnovers and are 22-3 when winning the turnover battle.

Leg Of Larson ...

Freshman **Jake Larson** has taken over the Spiders' kicking game this season and has excelled in every aspect ... He currently handles all placekicking, punting and kickoff duties for the Spiders ... He is the only kicker in the Colonial Athletic Association to handle all kicking duties for his team ... Larson is the first full-time true freshman kicker for the Spiders since the 2006 season when Andrew Howard was the Spiders' kicker ... Howard would go on to become Richmond's all-time leader in career field goals and extra points made.

Larson has been strong this season kicking, connecting on 12-of-15 field goals and 22-of-22 extra points this season ... He ranks third in the CAA and 10th in the nation averaging 1.5 made field goals per game ... He ranks second in field goal percentage at 80 percent after making the first nine attempts of his career ... His field goal percentage ranks 23rd in the nation despite missing two field goals in a game for the first time in his career against Yale ... He scored a career-high 11 points against Albany, hitting three field goals and two extra points ... He connected on a 50 and 48-yard field goal, with both ranking in the top 10 for longest kicks in Richmond Spider history, seventh and 10th, respectively ... Larson opened his collegiate career by scoring eight points against Jacksonville ... He connected on his only field goal, hitting from 31-yards out, while going a perfect 5-of-5 on extra points ... Larson followed that up with a 2-for-2 performance on field goals at Boston College while also converting his lone extra point attempt ... He connected on field goals of 36 and a career-high 45 yards ... Larson scored a career-high 10 points at Fordham, connecting on 3-of-3 field goals and hitting his lone extra point.

On the punting front, Larson is averaging 38.6 yards per kick on 27 punts this season ... He has posted five kicks over 50 yards this year, including a career-long 68 yarder at No. 18 Maine.

Spider Defensive Prowess ...

Richmond turned in its top defensive performance of the season against Albany ... The Spiders held the CAA's third-highest scoring team to 15 points under its season average and a season-low 20 point total for Albany ... The Spiders limited the Great Danes to just 14 total yards rushing in the victory while forcing a pair of interceptions through the air ... Richmond got to the quarterback seven times, including six by the defensive line, in the victory ... Albany had only allowed six sacks against in the first five games of the season ... The seven sacks are the most for a Spider defense since registering eight sacks against Towson November 5, 2005 ... Senior defensive end **Maurice Jackson** recorded a career-high 3.0 sacks in the victory, the most since former Spider Andrew Clyde had three sacks against the Great Danes in 2018 ... The last Spider to record more than three sacks in a game was Lawrence Sidbury when he recorded 4.0 sacks in the national championship game in 2008 against Montana.

A Game With No Penalties ...

Another big reason the Spiders posted their 24-17 victory over No. 18 Maine was Richmond was not called for a penalty all game long while the Black Bears were whistled for six penalties, accounting for 64 yards This marks the first time that Richmond has not been called for a penalty in a game since September 28, 2013, ironically also against Maine.

Feamster Steps Up ...

Graduate transfer defensive back **Brandon Feamster** had his best game as a Spider in the win over No. 18 Maine ... Feamster posted a career-high 12 tackles in the victo-

ry ... He also recorded the first sacks of his Richmond career, registering 1.5 sacks of the Black Bears ... His sacks marked the first this season for a Spider defensive back and just the second non-defensive lineman to have a sack for the Spiders this year (**Tristan Wheeler**).

You Complete Me ...

Richmond enters Saturday's game ranking second in the Colonial Athletic Association and 11th in the nation in completion percentage at 66.2 percent (137-of-207) ... Redshirt junior quarterback **Joe Mancuso** has connected on 63.2 percent (86-of-136) through the air, ranking fourth in the CAA ... Redshirt sophomore quarterback **Beau English** leads the CAA at 70.6 percent, connecting on 48-of-68 through five games.

Law Firm Of Fessler & Fuller ...

Graduate transfer wide receivers Charlie Fessler and Keyston Fuller have come into the program and had an immediate impact on the Spiders ... Fessler leads the team with 40 receptions for 495 yards receiving, ranking seventh in the CAA in catches ... Fuller leads the team with 793 yards receiving and is second on the team with 38 receptions, ranking third and eighth respectively ... Fessler and Fuller have combined for 1,276 yards receiving this year through seven games ... That total ranks third in the CAA for a receiving tandem, trailing Rhode Island (Aaron Parker & Isaiah Coulter, 1,630 yards) and Albany (Juwana Green & Jerah Reeves, 1,374).

Let's Go Streaking ...

Redshirt junior defensive lineman **Colby Ritten** has been the Spiders' mainstay in the starting lineup for the past two and a half years ... Ritten has started every game in which he has played, a streak of 30-straight starts to his ledger ... He has the most career starts of any Spider and the most consecutive starts on the team ... Senior safety **Daniel Jones** is second on the team with 26 career starts ... Offensive linemen **Seyoum Settepani** and **Tim Coleman** are second on the team with 19-straight starts each ... Senior linebacker **Billy Caughell** has played in a team-high 46 games in his career while senior **Trent Williams** has played in 41 games and **Maurice Jackson** has played in 39.

Fuller Up ...

Graduate transfer wide receiver **Keyston Fuller** had a breakout performance in the Spiders loss to No. 25 Elon ... Fuller caught seven passes for a career-high 208 yards and a touchdown against the Phoenix ... The 208 yards receiving are tied for fourth most in a single game in Spider history with Leland Melvin and is the most for a Spider since John Henry recorded 214 yards receiving September 13, 1986 at Massachusetts ... In fact, Fuller is just the seventh Spider in program history to eclipse the 200-yard mark in a single game ... The Richmond receiving record is held by Walker Gillette with 264 yards at Mississippi State in 1969.

CAA Weekly Awards ...

The Spiders posted their first Colonial Athletic Association victory with a 23-20 win over Albany ... Senior defensive lineman **Maurice Jackson** was named Defensive Player of the Week while freshman kicker **Jake Larson** was named Special Teams Player of the Week in the CAA ... Jackson recorded a career-high 3.0 sacks, 4.0 tackles for loss, six total tackles, forced a fumble and also had an interception ... He returned

his interception 27 yards into the red zone, setting up a pivotal touchdown for the Spiders at the end of the first half ... This marks the second time in his career he has earned CAA Defensive Player of the Week honors, picking up the award in the final week of the season last year after the William & Mary victory.

Larson earned his first CAA honor of his burgeoning career after accounting for 11 of the Spiders' 23 points in the win ... The true freshman booted three field goals in the victory and hit both of his extra points ... Larson opened the scoring by hitting a career-long 50-yard field goal in the first half, marking the seventh-longest field goal in Richmond Spider history ... Larson followed that up with a 48-yard field goal in the first half and added a 26-yard field goal for what accounted for the game-winning points.

Starting With A Win ...

Richmond opened the 2019 season with a 38-19 victory over visiting Jacksonville in the first midweek night game in the 10-year history of Robins Stadium ... The Spiders have won 14-straight home openers dating back to their last loss in 2005 (UMass) ... During that 14-game winning streak, the Spiders are out-scoring opponents by a 607-161 margin -- an average win of 43-11 ... In fact, the Spiders' current 14-game winning streak in home openers ranks ninth overall in the NCAA FCS level and second in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Defensive Scoring ...

Redshirt senior defensive lineman **Maurice Jackson** returned a Jacksonville fumble 56-yards for a touchdown for the Spiders' second score of the season ... It marked the second touchdown Jackson has scored in his career as he ran back a fumble in the Spiders win over St. Francis last season ... It also marks the second-straight season that Richmond has scored a defensive touchdown in a season opener as former Spider Dale Matthews Jr. scored one against Virginia last season.

Infusion Of Transfer Talent ...

Richmond dipped its foot into the transfer market this offseason, bringing in five NCAA FBS transfers, including four of the graduate transfer variety, along with a junior college transfer ... Joining the Spiders this season include quarterback **Beau English** (Air Force), cornerback **Brandon Feamster** (Duke), wide receiver **Charlie Fessler** (Northwestern), wide receiver **Keyston Fuller** (Duke), linebacker **Jimmy Marchese** (Illinois) and cornerback **Roland Williams** (Ellsworth CC) ... All six transfers are expected to compete for playing time and fill immediate needs for the Spiders heading into the 2019 season ... Feamster is arguably the most accomplished transfer to join the team after earning three letters at Duke ... He played in all 13 games last year for the Blue Devils and started the final seven games at corner back ... He posted an interception in his Duke finale at the Independence Bowl ... Fessler joins the Spiders from Northwestern where he posted 10 receptions last year, including three in the Big Ten Championship game against Ohio State.

Leading The CAA ...

Since the 2007 season, the Spiders have produced five seasons with 10 or more wins, led by the 2008 National Championship campaign when they posted

Youth Movement ...

The Spiders made a concerted effort to get younger in year three of the **Russ Huesman** era ... Richmond enters the 2019 season with only 10 seniors or redshirt seniors on the roster and four of these are NCAA FBS graduate transfers ... The Spiders' seniors and graduate seniors include **Dionte Austin, Trent Williams, Daniel Jones, Maurice Jackson, Brandon Feamster, Keyston Fuller, Charlie Fessler, Jimmy Marchese, Billy Caughell** and **Gershon Ejoni**.

The Spiders will have a young flair for this years team as they have 41 on the roster that are listed as true freshmen or redshirt freshmen ... This year's team accounts for 23 true freshmen and 18 redshirt freshmen ... Richmond took advantage of the new NCAA rule last year that allowed true freshmen to play in four games before deciding to redshirt and not lose a year of eligibility.

On the depth chart for this Saturday's game against Boston College, Richmond has six different true freshmen listed in the two-deep -- **Cameron Cloud, Cade Salyers, Tom Elia, Ryan Coll, Tristan Wheeler** and **Jake Larson** ... Additionally, Richmond has 14 different redshirt freshmen in the two deep -- **Isaac Brown, Justin Jasper, Foster Singleton, James Snavelly, Joe More, Aaron Dykes, Milan Howard, Ray Eldridge, Aidan Murray, Nile Harris, Aaron Banks, Tyrek Funderburk, Duncan Trau** and **Talon James**.

Experience Defense ...

The Spiders entered the 2019 season with eight returning starters from last year's team, having only lost three starters -- two linebackers and defensive tackle ... Richmond returns three of its four defensive lineman this season in **Maurice Jackson, Colby Ritten** and **Darius Reynolds** ... The three helped the Spiders defensive line lead the Colonial Athletic Association with 23.5 sacks last year, five more than their closest competitor -- James Madison ... Richmond's lone loss on the line was a valuable one in All-CAA selection **Andrew Clyde** ... The Spiders moved to a 4-3 defense during the season in 2018 and return only redshirt senior linebacker **Billy Caughell** while losing the likes of **Justin Rubin** and **Dale Matthews Jr.** ... **Caughell** finished second on the team with 74 tackles on the year.

On the back end, Richmond returns all four starters in seniors **Daniel Jones** and **Trent Williams** along with junior **Markus Vinson** and redshirt sophomore **Noah Nicholson**.

New Look At Wide Receiver ...

The Spiders entered the 2018 season with one of the top wide receiving groups in the country and one of the most seasoned groups in all of the Colonial Athletic Association ... Now that that group has moved on, the Spiders will have an entirely new group of pass catchers for 2019 ... Richmond lost its top seven receivers from last year, accounting for 179 receptions and 2,582 yards receiving ... Leading the way last year was All-CAA selection and current Tampa Bay Buccaneer **Cortrelle Simpson** who finishes the year with 651 yards receiving on 36 receptions ... Former Spiders **Tyler Wilkins, Caleb Drake** and **Jarmal Bevels** all graduated and combined for 98 receptions last year.

This year, the Spiders brought in two NCAA FBS graduate transfers into the receiving room to go along with a talented group of young wide receivers ... **Charlie Fessler** from Northwestern and **Keyston Fuller** from Duke joined the Spiders this year as transfers and bring big-game experience to the group ... **Ben Maffe** is the top returning wide receiver from last year's team, but only caught four balls ... Redshirt junior tight end **Andrew Tsangeos** is the leading receiver returning overall with eight receptions for 90 yards last year ... In addition, **Isaac Brown** and **Justin Jasper** saw time as true freshmen, each playing in four games before earning their redshirt.

Spiders Winning CAA Titles ...

Since the 2007 season, Richmond is tied for the most Colonial Athletic Association regular season titles with four -- joining James Madison at the top ... The Spiders won the titles in 2007, 2009, 2012 and 2015.

Athletic Association's Preseason Defensive Player of the Year ... This marks the second time in the last four years a Spider has earned the honor (David Jones, 2016) and the third Spider since 2009 to earn the preseason accolade (Eric McBride, 2009) ... Jackson earned First Team All-CAA honors last fall in his first year as a full-time starter on the defensive line ... The Third Team All-American, Jackson moved to defensive end in 2018 and made the most of his opportunity, leading the CAA in sacks with 1.0 per game, finishing the regular season with 10 sacks in 10 games.

Jackson finished the year ranked eighth overall in the nation in sacks per game (1.0) and enters 2019 sixth in the nation among the top sack getters from last year ... Additionally, only one other returning defensive lineman in the country averaged more sacks per game last season than Jackson ... He led the CAA in tackles for loss at 15.0 and forced fumbles at 4.0 ... He finished his year with a stellar showing in the Spiders' Capital Cup victory over William & Mary, posting 2.5 sacks and forcing two fumbles against the Tribe ... Even more impressive, Jackson accomplished all of this in his first season as a defensive end ... He was originally recruited as a linebacker and moved to defensive tackle his sophomore season before shifting out to the edge last fall.

New Faces On Staff . . .

The offseason was one of transition for head coach **Russ Huesman** as he brought in five new assistant coaches and revamped his entire staff ... Offensive coordinator **Jeff Durden** will now also coach the Spider quarterbacks while **Rod West** will now coach the cornerbacks and be the defensive pass game coordinator ... **Justin Wood** will be the defensive run game coordinator as well as coach the linebackers.

New to the staff this year is **Wesley Satterfield** who joins the Spiders from Austin Peay ... Satterfield is coaching the wide receivers and will be working with Huesman for the second time in his career ... **Brandon Lacy** joins Richmond after spending the past 10 seasons at Southeastern Louisiana ... Lacy will be in charge of the defensive line ... **Johnson Richardson** joins the Spiders from Charlotte the past seven seasons and will be in charge of the tight end group ... **Julius McNair** will oversee the Spider running backs after spending the past year at Hampton ... **Bobby Maffei** rounds out the new members of the coaching staff, coming to Richmond from Baylor ... Maffei is the special teams coordinator and will be a defensive assistant coach.

Year Three Of Huesman Era . . .

Richmond enters the 2019 season under third-year head coach **Russ Huesman** and is coming off its first sub-.500 season since 2011 ... It marked just the second time in Huesman's 10-year head coaching career that he finished under .500 on the season.

Russ Huesman is in his third season as head coach of the University of Richmond football program and his 11th season overall as a collegiate head coach. This is Huesman's second stint with the Spiders after spending five seasons (2004-08) as an assistant coach, including part of the 2008 National Championship team.

In his 30-plus years of coaching, Huesman has coached 43 All-Americans and 21 NFL Draft Picks, while being a part of nine conference championships and the 2008 National Championship with the Spiders. He has spent 20 years coaching in the Colonial Athletic Association, bringing a wealth of experience to the Spiders.

Huesman led the Spiders last season through a tough, injury-riddled season. Richmond's defensive line was the top unit in the Colonial Athletic Conference last season, leading the league with 23.5 sacks. Junior Maurice Jackson led the CAA in sacks and earned All-America honors for his play. Senior Andrew Clyde earned All-Conference honors for his third-straight year, becoming the first Spider to start every game of his collegiate career.

Huesman returned to Richmond in 2017 and guided the Spiders to a 6-5 record. The Spiders had 11 different players earn All-CAA honors, led by the Offensive Player of the Year Kyle Lauletta. He became the first Richmond player to win Offensive Player of the Year since Greg Lilly in 1992. Lauletta led the CAA with 3,737 yards, 28 passing TDs and 3,827 yards of total offense and was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award.

Joining Lauletta on the All-CAA First Team were Alex Light (OL), Garrett Hudson (TE), Dejon Brissett (WR), Griffin Trau (PK) and Andrew Clyde (DL). The All-CAA Second Team included Tyler Wilkins (WR) and Cortelle Simpson (WR), while Brandon Waller (DL), Justin Rubin (LB) and John Yarbrough (OL) were all named to the All-CAA Third Team.

Prior to returning to Richmond, Huesman spent eight tremendously successful seasons at Chattanooga. He was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year three times (2009, 2013, 2014) and was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year three times.

In his eight seasons at Chattanooga, Huesman helped guide the Mocs to a 59-37 record, including a 36-16 mark in his last four seasons (2013-16), which featured three Southern Conference regular season championships. Chattanooga was one of only 10 programs in the country to reach the FCS Playoffs each year from 2014-16. The Mocs were also just one of four programs in the country to post a playoff win during that time.

In his eight seasons, the Mocs had at least seven players named to the All-SoCon team every year, including a school-record 17 honorees in 2014. Prior to Huesman's arrival, the Mocs had not boasted seven members of any All-SoCon team since 1979.

Chattanooga had 17 All-America honorees and three NFL draft picks with DB Buster Skrine (Cleveland – 2011), QB B.J. Coleman (Green Bay – 2012) and LB Davis Tull (New Orleans – 2015) over eight-year period.

Huesman's first stop at Richmond came from 2004-08 as defensive coordinator molding the Spiders' defensive unit into one of the best in the country. In his final year at Richmond, the national championship season, the Spiders led the country in interceptions and finished in the top-10 in four other defensive categories.

Under Huesman's guidance, the Spiders had 23 All-Conference selections, including former NFL standouts Lawrence Sidbury, Jr. and Justin Rogers. During his five-year period as an assistant coach, the Spiders posted a 42-23 (.646) record and played in the FCS Playoffs three times with a quarterfinal appearance in 2005, a semifinal appearance in 2007 and the National Championship in 2008.

Prior to his time with the Spiders, Huesman spent six years at the University of Memphis (1998-03), where he held several positions, serving as the recruiting coordinator and offensive line coach. He also coached the outside linebackers, tight ends and running backs. As recruiting coordinator, Huesman brought in a Top 50 recruiting class, ranked No. 1 in Conference USA, in 2002. It was the first recruiting class ranked in the Top 50 at Memphis.

Huesman also coached for 13 years at William & Mary (1985-97), both with the defense and special teams. During his time in Williamsburg, Huesman coached Steve Christie, a 15-year NFL place kicker with Tampa Bay, Buffalo, San Diego and the New York Giants. His coaching family tree also includes Mike Tomlin, head coach of the Pittsburgh Steelers, Sean McDermott, the head coach of the Buffalo Bills and Alan Williams, the former defensive backs coach of the Detroit Lions. All three played for Huesman at William & Mary.

Huesman's success on the gridiron is not limited to just coaching as he was a standout player at perennial power Moeller High School in his native town of Cincinnati, Ohio. He helped Moeller's team compile a record of 43-0-1 and win a pair of Ohio state championships.

An all-city selection in football as a senior, Huesman signed a football scholarship with Chattanooga, where he started all four years as a defensive back (1978-81) and was a two-sport athlete. During his playing career with the Mocs, he helped UTC to a 31-11-2 mark and two Southern Conference championships. Huesman also patrolled center-field on the baseball diamond for the Mocs during his freshman and junior seasons.

Huesman was on the Mocs' sidelines for the 1982 season as a student coach, earning his degree in business education in 1983. He followed that up with a move to the University of South Carolina as a graduate assistant under the late Joe Morrison.

Huesman and his wife Amy have two daughters, Natalie (21) and Emily (18) and two sons, Jacob (25) and Levi (15).
