What's On Tap ...

Richmond hits the road for its longest trip of the season Saturday afternoon when the Spiders travel to Maine to take on the 18th-ranked and defending Colonial Athletic Association Champion Black Bears ... Kickoff is set for noon at Alford Stadium.

Series History ...

Saturday's game marks the 28th meeting all-time between Richmond and Maine ... The series has been a back-and-forth affair with Maine holding on to a slim 14-13 margin all-time against the Spiders dating back to the first meeting in 1984 ... The teams are 6-6 against each other in Orono and Richmond is 7-8 against the Black Bears at home.

Last year, Maine came to Robins Stadium as 16th-ranked team in the country posting a 28-9 victory over the Spiders ... Neither team was able to run the ball much last year with the Spiders holding Maine to only 57 yards rushing the Black Bears holding Richmond to just 29 yards on the ground ... Maine quarterback Chris Ferguson connected on 20-of-32 through the air for 229 yards and four touchdowns ... Earnest Edwards did most of the damage on the receiving end with six catches for 105 yards and two touchdowns ... Quarterback **Reid Chenault** went 19-of-34 for 224 yards while also rushing for the Spiders' lone touchdown.

Richmond will be making its first trip to Orono since the 2014 season when the Spiders dropped a 33-20 contest to the Black Bears ... Richmond's last win in the Pine Tree State came October 17, 2009 with a 38-21 win.

On This Date In Spider History ...

This season marks the second time in program history that Richmond and Maine have met on the date of October 12 ... The two teams met October 12, 1985 in Orono with the Spiders recording a 37-24 victory ... That game was the second meeting in the series all-time and marked the second-straight victory for Richmond over Maine ... In that game, the Spiders were the No. 1 team in the country in then I-AA football and opened to a 17-0 lead 13 minutes into the game in a wind-swept contest ... Richmond ran for 235 yards on the ground with Danny Holly accounted for 95 yards rushing and two touchdowns ... Leland Melvin scored the game's first touchdown off a 27-yard pass from quarterback Bob Bleier.

CAA Players Of The Week ...

The Spiders posted their first Colonial Athletic Association victory Saturday with a 23-20 win over Albany ... Senior defensive lineman **Maurice Jackson** was named Defensive Player of the Week while freshman kicker **Jake Larson** was named Special Teams Player of the Week in the CAA ... Jackson recorded a career-high 3.0 sacks, 4.0 tackles for loss, six total tackles, forced a fumble and also had an interception ... He returned his interception 27 yards into the red zone, setting up a pivotal touchdown for the Spiders at the end of the first half ... This marks the second time in his career he has earned CAA Defensive Player of the Week honors, picking up the award in the final week of the season last year after the William & Mary victory.

Larson earned his first CAA honor of his burgeoning career after accounting for 11 of the Spiders' 23

points in the win ... The true freshman booted three field goals in the victory and hit both of his extra points ... Larson opened the scoring by hitting a career-long 50-yard field goal in the first half, marking the seventh-longest field goal in Richmond Spider history ... Larson followed that up with a 48-yard field goal in the first half and added a 26-yard field goal for what accounted for the game-winning points.

Spider Defensive Prowess ...

Richmond turned in its top defensive performance of the season Saturday against the Great Danes ... The Spiders held the CAA's third-highest scoring team to 15 points under its season average and a season-low 20 point total for Albany ... The Spiders limited the Great Danes to just 14 total yards rushing in the victory while forcing a pair of interceptions through the air ... Richmond got to the quarterback seven times, including six by the defensive line, in the victory ... Albany had only allowed six sacks against in the first five games of the season ... The seven sacks are the most for a Spider defense since registering eight sacks against Towson November 5, 2005 ... Senior defensive end **Maurice Jackson** recorded a career-high 3.0 sacks in the victory, the most since former Spider Andrew Clyde had three sacks against the Great Danes in 2018 ... The last Spider to record more than three sacks in a game was Lawrence Sidbury when he recorded 4.0 sacks in the national championship game in 2008 against Montana.

Freshman Kicking Sensation ...

Freshman **Jake Larson** has taken over the Spiders' kicking game this season and has excelled in every aspect ... He currently handles all placekicking, punting and kickoff duties for the Spiders ... He is the only kicker in the Colonial Athletic Association to handle all kicking duties for his team ... Larson is the first full-time true freshman kicker for the Spiders since the 2006 season when Andrew Howard was the Spiders' kicker ... Howard would go on to become Richmond's all-time leader in career field goals and extra points made.

Larson has been strong this season kicking, connecting on 9-of-10 field goals and 11-of-11 extra points this season ... He leads the CAA and ranks fifth in the nation averaging 1.8 made field goals per game ... He leads the CAA in field goal percentage at 90 percent after making the first nine attempts of his career ... His field goal percentage ranks eighth in the nation at 90 percent ... His only miss came in the second half against Albany and wasn't a miss but a blocked kick by the Great Danes ... He finished the game against Albany with 11 points scored, hitting three field goals and two extra points ... He connected on a 50 and 48-yard field goal, with both ranking in the top 10 for longest kicks in Richmond Spider history, seventh and 10th, respectively ... Larson opened his collegiate career by scoring eight points against Jacksonville ... He connected on his only field goal, hitting from 31-yards out, while going a perfect 5-of-5 on extra points ... Larson followed that up with a 2-for-2 performance on field goals at Boston College while also converting his lone extra point attempt ... He connected on field goals of 36 and a career-high 45 yards ... Larson scored a career-high 10 points at Fordham, connecting on 3-of-3 field goals and hitting his lone extra point.

On the punting front, Larson is averaging 38.3 yards per kick on 16 punts this season ... He has posted five kicks over 50 yards this year, including a career-long 61 yarder at Fordham.

Turning Over New Leaf ...

Redshirt sophomore defensive lineman **Kobie Turner** has turned up his game over the past two contests ... Turner has posted back-to-back games with a career-high seven tackles against both Fordham and Albany ... He has posted three sacks in the past two games, picking up one against the Rams and a career-high two against the Great Danes.

First Two Of The Year ...

The Spider defense waited a long time this season to record an interception, going without one during the first four games of the year ... Richmond rectified that with two picks against Albany, helping the Spiders win the turnover battle for the first time all season (+2) ... Senior defensive lineman **Maurice Jackson** earned the first interception of the season and the first of his career late in the first half against the Great Danes ... Senior safety **Daniel Jones** added the second interception in the second half for his eighth pick of his career.

You Complete Me ...

Richmond enters Saturday's game ranking second in the Colonial Athletic Association and fifth in the nation in completion percentage at 70.5 percent (86-of-122)

... Redshirt sophomore quarterback **Beau English** leads the way at 70.6 percent, connecting on 48-of-68 through the air this year ... English is second in the CAA in completion percentage ... Additionally, redshirt junior quarterback **Joe Mancuso** has connected on 69.2 percent (36-of-52) through the air, ranking seventh in the nation and third in the CAA.

Covering The Punts . . .

Richmond has been strong on punt return defense this season ... The Spiders rank fifth in the nation in punt return coverage (0.0 yards per return), not allowing a punt return yard so far this season ... Richmond has punted the ball 21 times and only had one punt returned for zero yards ... Fifteen of the Spiders' punts have been downed or out of bounds while five have been fair caught by the opponents.

Racking Up The Tackles . . .

Freshman linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** has been a tackling machine this season and even more over the past two games when he has earned his first two career starts ... Wheeler leads the team with 40 tackles this season, despite coming off the bench in three of the five games ... His 8.0 tackles per game ranks 10th overall in the CAA this season and is the top mark among all league freshmen ... Elon's Tre'Von Jones is second among freshman at 6.4 tackles per game (32 total) while Noah Plack of Delaware is third at 5.4 tackles per game (27 total) ... Wheeler has recorded double digit tackles in three out of his five games to start his career, including leading the team in the past two games ... Against Fordham, he recorded a career-high 13 tackles before following that up with 11 tackles, including his first career sack against Albany.

Top-25 Action . . .

Saturday's game marks the second of many times this season the Spiders will face off against a team ranked in the top 25 as Maine enters the game ranked No. 18 in the country ... Earlier this year, the Spiders dropped a 42-20 contest to No. 25 Elon at home at Robins Stadium ... Since 2015 though, the Spiders are 12-9 when facing a ranked opponent but have dropped the past six meetings against a top-25 team.

Law Firm Of Fessler & Fuller . . .

Graduate transfer wide receivers Charlie Fessler and Keyston Fuller have come into the program and had an immediate impact on the Spiders ... Fessler leads the team with 26 receptions for 344 yards receiving, ranking sixth and 10th in the CAA respectively ... Fuller leads the team with 435 yards receiving and is second on the team with 24 receptions, ranking fifth and seventh respectively ... Fessler and Fuller have combined for 779 yards receiving this year through five games ... That total ranks fourth in the CAA for a receiving tandem, trailing Rhode Island (Aaron Parker & Isaiah Coulter, 1,187 yards), Albany (Juwan Green & Jerah Reeves, 968) and Maine (Jaquan Blair & Earnest Edwards, 877).

Let's Go Streaking . . .

Redshirt junior defensive lineman **Colby Ritten** has been the Spiders' mainstay in the starting lineup for the past two and a half years ... Ritten has started every game in which he has played, a streak of 27-straight starts to his ledger ... He has the most career starts of any Spider and the most consecutive starts on the team ... Senior safety **Daniel Jones** is second on the team with 23 career starts ... Offensive linemen **Seyoum Settepani** and **Tim Coleman** are second on the team with 16-straight starts each ... Senior linebacker **Billy Coughell** has played in a team-high 43 games in his career while senior **Trent Williams** has played in 38 games and **Maurice Jackson** has played in 76.

Fuller Up . . .

Graduate transfer wide receiver **Keyston Fuller** had a breakout performance in the Spiders loss to No. 25 Elon ... Fuller caught seven passes for a career-high 208 yards and a touchdown against the Phoenix ... The 208 yards receiving are tied for fourth most in a single game in Spider history with Leland Melvin and is the most for a Spider since John Henry recorded 214 yards receiving September 13, 1986 at Massachusetts ... In fact, Fuller is just the seventh Spider in program history to eclipse the 200-yard mark in a single game ... The Richmond receiving record is held by Walker Gillette with 264 yards at Mississippi State in 1969.

Goodall Out For The Season . . .

Redshirt junior running back **Xavier Goodall** suffered a season-ending ACL injury in the Spiders' loss at Boston College last week late in the first half ... Goodall will undergo surgery on his knee for the third time in his playing career after suffering the injury on the same knee as two times before ... He missed all of last season after

injuring his knee in preseason camp ... Goodall has 99 yards on 16 carries this season and has rushed for 945 yards in his career on 169 carries.

Starting With A Win...

Richmond opened the 2019 season with a 38-19 victory over visiting Jacksonville in the first mid-week night game in the 10-year history of Robins Stadium ... The Spiders have won 14-straight home openers dating back to their last loss in 2005 (UMass) ... During that 14-game winning streak, the Spiders are out-scoring opponents by a 607-161 margin -- an average win of 43-11 ... In fact, the Spiders' current 14-game winning streak in home openers ranks ninth overall in the NCAA FCS level and second in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Defensive Scoring...

Redshirt senior defensive lineman **Maurice Jackson** returned a Jacksonville fumble 56-yards for a touchdown for the Spiders' second score of the season ... It marked the second touchdown Jackson has scored in his career as he ran back a fumble in the Spiders win over St. Francis last season ... It also marks the second-straight season that Richmond has scored a defensive touchdown in a season opener as former Spider Dale Matthews Jr. scored one against Virginia last season.

Freshman Debut...

Freshman linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** had a debut to remember in his first collegiate game of his career ... Wheeler led all Spiders with 12 tackles in the victory, ranking third in the Colonial Athletic Association in week one of action ... The 12 tackles are the most since **Daniel Jones** recorded 14 tackles last season against Elon ... It is also the most tackles in a season opener since Reggie Burnette and Aaron Roane each recorded 12 tackles against Virginia in 2012.

Infusion Of Transfer Talent...

Richmond dipped its foot into the transfer market this offseason, bringing in five NCAA FBS transfers, including four of the graduate transfer variety, along with a junior college transfer ... Joining the Spiders this season include quarterback **Beau English** (Air Force), cornerback **Brandon Feamster** (Duke), wide receiver **Charlie Fessler** (Northwestern), wide receiver **Keyston Fuller** (Duke), linebacker **Jimmy Marchese** (Illinois) and cornerback **Roland Williams** (Ellsworth CC) ... All six transfers are expected to compete for playing time and fill immediate needs for the Spiders heading into the 2019 season ... Richmond had big holes to fill due to departures at quarterback, wide receiver, defensive back and linebacker.

Feamster is arguably the most accomplished transfer to join the team after earning three letters at Duke ... He played in all 13 games last year for the Blue Devils and started the final seven games at corner back ... He posted an interception in his Duke finale at the Independence Bowl ... Fessler joins the Spiders from Northwestern where he posted 10 receptions last year, including three in the Big Ten Championship game against Ohio State.

Leading The CAA...

Since the 2007 season, the Spiders have produced

five seasons with 10 or more wins, led by the 2008 National Championship campaign when they posted a program-record 13 wins ... Over the past 12 seasons, the Spiders' five seasons of double digit wins leads the entire Colonial Athletic Association, with New Hampshire second with four and James Madison and Delaware tied for third with three each.

Youth Movement...

The Spiders made a concerted effort to get young in year three of the **Russ Huesman** era ... Richmond enters the 2019 season with only 10 seniors or redshirt seniors on the roster and four of this are NCAA FBS graduate transfers ... The Spiders' seniors and graduate seniors include **Dionte Austin, Trent Williams, Daniel Jones, Maurice Jackson, Brandon Feamster, Keyston Fuller, Charlie Fessler, Jimmy Marchese, Billy Caughell** and **Gershom Ejoni**.

The Spiders will have a young flair for this years team as they have 41 on the roster that are listed as true freshmen or redshirt freshmen ... This year's team accounts for 23 true freshmen and 18 redshirt freshmen ... Richmond took advantage of the new NCAA rule last year that allowed true freshmen to play in four games before deciding to redshirt and not lose a year of eligibility.

On the depth chart for this Saturday's game against Boston College, Richmond has six different true freshmen listed in the two-deep -- **Cameron Cloud, Cade Salyers, Tom Elia, Ryan Coll, Tristan Wheeler** and **Jake Larson** ... Additionally, Richmond has 14 different redshirt freshmen in the two deep -- **Isaac Brown, Justin Jasper, Foster Singleton, James Snavelly, Joe More, Aaron Dykes, Milan Howard, Ray Eldridge, Aidan Murray, Nile Harris, Aaron Banks, Tyrek Funderburk, Duncan Trau** and **Talon James**.

Experience Defense...

The Spiders entered the 2019 season with eight returning starters from last year's team, having only lost three starters -- two linebackers and defensive tackle ... Richmond returns three of its four defensive linemen this season in **Maurice Jackson, Colby Ritten** and **Darius Reynolds** ... The three helped the Spiders defensive line lead the Colonial Athletic Association with 23.5 sacks last year, five more than their closest competitor -- James Madison ... Richmond's lone loss on the line was a valuable one in All-CAA selection Andrew Clyde ... The Spiders moved to a 4-3 defense during the season in 2018 and return only redshirt senior linebacker **Billy Caughell** while losing the likes of Justin Rubin and Dale Matthews Jr. ... Caughell finished second on the team with 74 tackles on the year.

On the back end, Richmond returns all four starters in seniors **Daniel Jones** and **Trent Williams** along with junior **Markus Vinson** and redshirt sophomore **Noah Nicholson**.

Offensive Line Experience...

Last season, the Spiders were ravaged by injuries on the offensive line, including games where they only dressed six linemen for a game and one contest where they lined up a tight end for a couple

of series on the offensive line due to injuries ... The bright spot for those injuries though was it allowed for great experience for some of the Spiders' young offensive linemen ... Richmond enters the year with no offensive lineman that is a senior or redshirt senior ... They also return 37 starts from the offensive line last year, including three who started almost every game on the line ... Redshirt juniors **Tim Coleman** and **Seyoum Settepani** started all 11 games last year next to each other on the left side of the line at tackle and guard, respectively ... Redshirt sophomore center **Clayton McConnell** played in 10 games and made nine starts at center last season ... Redshirt junior **Taz Sumpter** played in the first five games of the year and made three starts before suffering a season-ending injury ... Redshirt freshmen **Foster Singleton** and **Joe More** each played in four games under the new NCAA redshirt rule with Singleton getting three starts under his belt on his redshirt year ... The Spiders will look to replace two departing seniors in All-Colonial Athletic Association selection John Yarbrough and Kobie Williams.

New Look At Wide Receiver ...

The Spiders entered the 2018 season with one of the top wide receiving groups in the country and one of the most seasoned groups in all of the Colonial Athletic Association ... Now that that group has moved on, the Spiders will have an entirely new group of pass catchers for 2019 ... Richmond lost its top seven receivers from last year, accounting for 179 receptions and 2,582 yards receiving ... Leading the way last year was All-CAA selection and current Tampa Bay Buccaneer Cortrelle Simpson who finishes the year with 651 yards receiving on 36 receptions ... Former Spiders Tyler Wilkins, Caleb Drake and Jarmal Bevels all graduated and combined for 98 receptions last year.

This year, the Spiders brought in two NCAA FBS graduate transfers into the receiving room to go along with a talented group of young wide receivers ... **Charlie Fessler** from Northwestern and **Keyston Fuller** from Duke joined the Spiders this year as transfers and bring big-game experience to the group ... **Ben Maffe** is the top returning wide receiver from last year's team, but only caught four balls ... Redshirt junior tight end **Andrew Tsangeos** is the leading receiver returning overall with eight receptions for 90 yards last year ... In addition, **Isaac Brown** and **Justin Jasper** saw time as true freshmen, each playing in four games before earning their redshirt.

Spiders Winning CAA Titles ...

Since the 2007 season, Richmond is tied for the most Colonial Athletic Association regular season titles with four -- joining James Madison at the top ... The Spiders won the titles in 2007, 2009, 2012 and 2015.

Jackson Tabbed Defensive POY ...

Senior defensive lineman **Maurice Jackson** has been named the Colonial Athletic Association's Preseason Defensive Player of the Year ... This marks the second time in the last four years a Spider has earned the honor (David Jones, 2016) and the third Spider since 2009 to earn the preseason accolade (Eric McBride, 2009) ... Jackson earned First Team All-CAA honors last fall in his first year as a full-time starter on the defensive line ... The Third Team All-American, Jackson moved to defensive end in 2018 and made the most of his opportunity, leading the CAA in sacks with 1.0 per game, finishing the regular season with 10 sacks in 10 games.

Jackson finished the year ranked eighth overall in the nation in sacks per game (1.0) and enters 2019 sixth in the nation among the top sack getters from last year ... Additionally, only one other returning defensive lineman in the country averaged more sacks per game last season than Jackson ... He led the CAA in tackles for loss at 15.0 and forced fumbles at 4.0 ... He finished his year with a stellar showing in the Spiders' Capital Cup victory over William & Mary, posting 2.5 sacks and forcing two fumbles against the Tribe ... Even more impressive, Jackson accomplished all of this in his first season as a defensive end ... He was originally recruited as a linebacker and moved to defensive tackle his sophomore season before shifting out to the edge last fall.

Spiders Place Two On Preseason All-CAA Team ...

selections in senior defensive end **Maurice Jackson** and senior safety **Daniel Jones** ... Jackson earned preseason CAA Defensive Player of the Year accolades as well (see above) ... Jones earns his first-ever CAA accolade by being named Honorable Mention All-CAA preseason ... He started all 11 games for the Spiders, leading the team with 86 tackles, including 51 solo ... He has recorded seven interceptions over the past two seasons, including a team-high three picks in 2018 ... Over the past two seasons, he has appeared in 20 games, including 16 starts and has recorded 154 tackles.

Spiders Picked 10th ...

The Richmond Spiders were picked to finish 10th overall in the Colonial Athletic Association preseason poll after finishing last season 10th as well with a 4-7 overall record and a 2-6 mark in league play ... The Spiders return 13 starters on offense and defense, including eight on the defensive side of the ball ... Richmond picked up 62 total votes in the poll ... James Madison was picked to win the regular season title with 20 first place votes and 238 total points ... Towson was second with 217 votes (3 first place) and defending champion Maine was third with 201 votes (1 first place) ... Elon was fourth with 164 points, followed by Delaware (162), Stony Brook (151), New Hampshire (109), Rhode Island (104) and Villanova (84) ... The two teams below the Spiders in the poll is William & Mary in 11th (58 votes) and Albany in 12th with 34 votes ... Both the Tribe and Great Danes accounted for the two Spiders' CAA wins last year.

New Faces On Staff ...

The offseason was one of transition for head coach **Russ Huesman** as he brought in five new assistant coaches and revamped his entire staff ... Offensive coordinator **Jeff Durden** will now also coach the Spider quarterbacks while **Rod West** will now coach the cornerbacks and be the defensive pass game coordinator ... **Justin Wood** will be the defensive run game coordinator as well as coach the linebackers.

New to the staff this year is **Wesley Satterfield** who joins the Spiders from Austin Peay ... Satterfield is coaching the wide receivers and will be working with Huesman for the second time in his career ... **Brandon Lacy** joins Richmond after spending the past 10 seasons at Southeastern Louisiana ... Lacy will be in charge of the defensive line ... **Johnson Richardson** joins the Spiders from Charlotte the past seven seasons and will be in charge of the tight end group ... **Julius McNair** will oversee the Spider running backs after spending the past year at Hampton ... **Bobby Maffei** rounds out the new members of the coaching staff, coming to Richmond from Baylor ... Maffei is the special teams coordinator and will be a defensive assistant coach.

Year Three Of Huesman Era ...

Richmond enters the 2019 season under third-year head coach **Russ Huesman** and is coming off its first sub-.500 season since 2011 ... It marked just the second time in Huesman's 10-year head coaching career that he finished under .500 on the season.

Russ Huesman is in his third season as head coach of the University of Richmond football program and his 11th season overall as a collegiate head coach. This is Huesman's second stint with the Spiders after spending five seasons (2004-08) as an assistant coach, including part of the 2008 National Championship team.

In his 30-plus years of coaching, Huesman has coached 43 All-Americans and 21 NFL Draft Picks, while being a part of nine conference championships and the 2008 National Championship with the Spiders. He has spent 20 years coaching in the Colonial Athletic Association, bringing a wealth of experience to the Spiders.

Huesman led the Spiders last season through a tough, injury-riddled season. Richmond's defensive line was the top unit in the Colonial Athletic Conference last season, leading the league with 23.5 sacks. Junior Maurice Jackson led the CAA in sacks and earned All-America honors for his play. Senior Andrew Clyde earned All-Conference honors for his third-straight year, becoming the first Spider to start every game of his collegiate career.

Huesman returned to Richmond in 2017 and guided the Spiders to a 6-5 record. The Spiders had 11 different players earn All-CAA honors, led by the Offensive Player of the Year Kyle Lauletta. He became the first Richmond player to win Offensive Player of the Year since Greg Lilly in 1992. Lauletta led the CAA with 3,737 yards, 28 passing TDs and 3,827 yards of total offense and was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award.

Joining Lauletta on the All-CAA First Team were Alex Light (OL), Garrett Hudson (TE), Dejon Brissett (WR), Griffin Trau (PK) and Andrew Clyde (DL). The All-CAA Second Team included Tyler Wilkins (WR) and Cortelle Simpson (WR), while Brandon Waller (DL), Justin Rubin (LB) and John Yarbrough (OL) were all named to the All-CAA Third Team.

Prior to returning to Richmond, Huesman spent eight tremendously successful seasons at Chattanooga. He was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year three times (2009, 2013, 2014) and was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year three times.

In his eight seasons at Chattanooga, Huesman helped guide the Mocs to a 59-37 record, including a 36-16 mark in his last four seasons (2013-16), which featured three Southern Conference regular season championships. Chattanooga was one of only 10 programs in the country to reach the FCS Playoffs each year from 2014-16. The Mocs were also just one of four programs in the country to post a playoff win during that time.

In his eight seasons, the Mocs had at least seven players named to the All-SoCon team every year, including a school-record 17 honorees in 2014. Prior to Huesman's arrival, the Mocs had not boasted seven members of any All-SoCon team since 1979.

Chattanooga had 17 All-America honorees and three NFL draft picks with DB Buster Skrine (Cleveland – 2011), QB B.J. Coleman (Green Bay – 2012) and LB Davis Tull (New Orleans – 2015) over eight-year period.

Huesman's first stop at Richmond came from 2004-08 as defensive coordinator molding the Spiders' defensive unit into one of the best in the country. In his final year at Richmond, the national championship season, the Spiders led the country in interceptions and finished in the top-10 in four other defensive categories.

Under Huesman's guidance, the Spiders had 23 All-Conference selections, including former NFL standouts Lawrence Sidbury, Jr. and Justin Rogers. During his five-year period as an assistant coach, the Spiders posted a 42-23 (.646) record and played in the FCS Playoffs three times with a quarterfinal appearance in 2005, a semifinal appearance in 2007 and the National Championship in 2008.

Prior to his time with the Spiders, Huesman spent six years at the University of Memphis (1998-03), where he held several positions, serving as the recruiting coordinator and offensive line coach. He also coached the outside linebackers, tight ends and running backs. As recruiting coordinator, Huesman brought in a Top 50 recruiting class, ranked No. 1 in Conference USA, in 2002. It was the first recruiting class ranked in the Top 50 at Memphis.

Huesman also coached for 13 years at William & Mary (1985-97), both with the defense and special teams. During his time in Williamsburg, Huesman coached Steve Christie, a 15-year NFL place kicker with Tampa Bay, Buffalo, San Diego and the New York Giants. His coaching family tree also includes Mike Tomlin, head coach of the Pittsburgh Steelers, Sean McDermott, the head coach of the Buffalo Bills and Alan Williams, the former defensive backs coach of the Detroit Lions. All three played for Huesman at William & Mary.

Huesman's success on the gridiron is not limited to just coaching as he was a standout player at perennial power Moeller High School in his native town of Cincinnati, Ohio. He helped Moeller's team compile a record of 43-0-1 and win a pair of Ohio state championships.

An all-city selection in football as a senior, Huesman signed a football scholarship with Chattanooga, where he started all four years as a defensive back (1978-81) and was a two-sport athlete. During his playing career with the Mocs, he helped UTC to a 31-11-2 mark and two Southern Conference championships. Huesman also patrolled center-field on the baseball diamond for the Mocs during his freshman and junior seasons.

Huesman was on the Mocs' sidelines for the 1982 season as a student coach, earning his degree in business education in 1983. He followed that up with a move to the University of South Carolina as a graduate assistant under the late Joe Morrison.

Huesman and his wife Amy have two daughters, Natalie (21) and Emily (18) and two sons, Jacob (25) and Levi (15).
