CHARLESTON COUGARS (5-4) (RV) RICHMOND SPIDERS (8-1)

- At 8-1, Richmond has its best record through nine games since 1985-86, when the Spiders started 8-1 en route to a 23-7 season and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament.
- Richmond received 3 points in this week's AP Top 25 Poll, it's second straight week Receiving Votes in the AP Top 25. 2019-20 is the first time Richmond has been represented in the AP Top 25 since the final poll of 2011, which was released in mid-March prior to the Spiders run to the Sweet 16. Richmond was also Receiving Votes in that poll (47 points).
- The Spiders are 6-0 at home this season, their longest home win streak since November-December 2015, when they won six straight. After winning their first two home games by a total of three points, Richmond's average margin of victory in its last four home games is 24 points per game.
- Jacob Gilyard is the reigning A-10 Player of the Week after sharing the award with Duguesne's Michael Hughes. Gilyard averaged 16.5 points, 8.5 assists, 6.0 rebounds, and 5.0 steals while shooting 67 percent from the field and committing zero turnovers in UR's wins over Hampton and South Alabama last week. Gilyard and Dayton's Obi Toppin are the only players to win multiple A-10 Player of the Week Awards this season.
- In addition to leading the country in steals per game (3.89), Gilyard is fifth in three-point percentage (53.1), and is up to eighth in assist-turnover ratio (4.07). Since his last turnover with 8:07 left in the 1st half against Boston College, Gilvard has 21 assists.
- Despite being only a junior, Gilyard's 212 career steals are fourth-most in Spiders history. He trails only Kevin Anderson (217), Tony Dobbins (223), and Greg Beckwith (227). Gilyard ranks third among active D-I players in career steals.
- Richmond ranks in the top 10 in the nation in three-point field goal percentage (fifth at 42.1 percent) and three-pointers per game (seventh at 10.7). Last year, Richmond ranked 156th in three-point field goal percentage (34.7) and 188th in three-pointers per game (7.6).
- Over its last seven games, Richmond is holding opponents to 59.1 points per game (25th in D-I over that span) and a field goal percentage of 37.5 (23rd best in D-I over that span). In its first two games, Richmond allowed 95 points per game and opponents shot 49.3 percent from the field.

WITH A WIN ...

- UR would be 9-1, its best record through ten games since 1985-86 (also 9-1).
- The Spiders would lead the all-time series vs Charleston, 3-2.
- Richmond would improve to 19-6 vs current CAA opponents under Chris Mooney (13-3 at home).
- The Spiders would win their first seven home games of a season for the first time since 2012 (7).
- Richmond would have nine wins prior to the start of conference play, its most since 2013-14 (10).
- Richmond would win its fifth straight December game dating back to last season.

UNIVERSITY OF RICHMOND, Va. - Kevin Anderson drilled a pull-up jumper with nine seconds remaining to seal a 74-72 win over the College of Charleston in the CBI Second Round at the Robins Center Monday night. Richmond, which reached 20 wins for the 16th time in school history, advances to the Semifinals Wednesday.

Anderson finished with 21 points and the Second Team All-Atlantic 10 sophomore guard moved into 10th-place on the Spiders' single-season scoring with 920. Anderson was nine-of-17 from the field, grabbed four rebounds, dished five assists with one turnover in 38 minutes on the court.

He reached the 20-point mark for the sixth-straight game and eighth time in the last 11.

Richmond (20-15) will learn is next opponent late Monday night as the bracket's four remaining teams get re-seeded. Stanford has already dispatched Wichita State tonight, 70-56, with Northeastern at UTEP and Vermont at Oregon State set for 10 p.m. ET tipoffs.

David Gonzalvez added 15 points and Ryan Butler scored 10 for the Spiders, while Darrius Garrett played his second big game for Richmond off the bench with six points (on three-of-three shooting), four boards and three blocked shots.

A layup by Tony White with 15:03 remaining cut Richmond's lead to just 43-42, but Richmond embarked on a 16-4 run over the next five minutes and built its largest margin of the game at 59-46. Anderson and Gonzalvez each scored five in the

The Bobby Cremins-led Cougars, who finished second to Davidson in the Southern Conference, would not go quietly and trimmed the lead to just two with 42 seconds left thanks to back-to-back baskets from Dustin Scott and a put-back layup from White.

But with the ball in his hands and his team up 72-70, Anderson milked the clock down to the final seconds before driving to the near-side elbow and drilling his patented floater in traffic for the decisive basket with 9.3 on the clock.

Richmond called timeout and Jermaine Johnson tipped in his own miss on the ensuing possession with three seconds left, Charleston called timeout then fouled Anderson. The sophomore missed the front-end of the 1-and-1, leaving the Cougars only a desperation heave at the buzzer that fell short.

Johnson scored 15 to lead four in double-figures for Charleston, which ended its season 27-9.



THE BIG PICTURE

THE SPIDERS SYSTEM

Over his 15 seasons at Richmond, Chris Mooney's offense has evolved into a system that embodies the concept of "basketball without positions." While shorter players will begin most possessions further away from the basket and taller players will begin most possessions on the wing or in the paint, they will rarely end up anywhere near where they started. On each possession, every player on the court is equally as likely to handle the ball, shoot a three, cut back door, or set up on the low block. The Spiders offense places a premium on passing, cutting, and outside shooting, and Richmond's coaches focus on developing those skills in each Spider.

Richmond's offense often results in a high team field goal percentage, a ton of opportunities for assists, and relatively few turnovers. Over the previous five seasons (2014-15 through 2018-19), Richmond ranks 26th in D-I in field goal percentage (46.9), 17th in assists per game (15.6), 10th in fewest turnovers per game (10.2), and sixth in assist-turnover ratio (1.52).

CHANGES ON DEFENSE

According to Mooney's estimation, the Spiders spent between 60 and 70 percent of their court time this offseason working on defense. Specifically, Richmond worked to install a man-to-man defensive scheme after playing primarily a matchup zone in recent years. The process involved reteaching the Spiders the very fundamentals of man-to-man defense, with a focus on plugging gaps, closing out on shooters, and preventing offensive rebounds.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

Jacob Gilyard was named First Team Preseason All-Atlantic 10 and Grant Golden was a Second Team Preseason All-A-10 pick at the conference's media day in October. Gilyard is the fifth different Spider to earn Preseason First Team All-Conference honors under Mooney, while Golden is the fourth Spider under Mooney to land on a Preseason All-Conference team in multiple seasons. Prior to this season, no team had placed a pair of non-seniors on the Preseason All-Atlantic 10 First or Second Teams since 2015, when Rhode Island juniors Hassan Martin and E.C. Matthews both landed on the First Team. (Dayton also has two non-seniors on the Preseason First or Second Teams this season.)

The Spiders landed sixth in the preseason poll, their highest preseason projection since 2016 (also sixth). Richmond received 248 points in the preseason poll, its most since the 2015 season, when the Spiders were also picked to finished sixth and received 262 points in preseason voting.

"THE BEST CLASS THAT RICHMOND'S EVER HAD"

Richmond was led by sophomores Jacob Gilyard, Grant Golden, and Nathan Cayo in 2018-19. Those three players, now juniors, have been joined by Nick Sherod, who received a medical redshirt last season following a torn ACL in November, and Blake Francis, a Wagner transfer who sat out last season, in Richmond's junior class.

Each of Richmond's five scholarship juniors has already proven that they have the ability to produce at an elite level, particularly on the offensive end. While Golden (17.2 PPG) and Gilyard (16.2 PPG) both earned All-Conference honors in 2018-19, Cayo registered the largest scoring increase in the A-10, averaging 12.9 PPG, up from 2.3 in his freshman season. In 2017-18, Sherod scored a team-high 17.6 PPG in conference play and Francis scored a team-high 17.3 PPG in his final season at Wagner. Chris Mooney has said on more than one occasion that

he feels the Golden-Gilyard-Cayo-Sherod-Francis class "will be the best class that Richmond's ever had.

Entering the season, 12 of the 15 Spiders, including Tomas Verbinskis, who ultimately transferred out of the program in December, were returnees from last season. Freshmen Tyler Burton and Gabe Arizin and sophomore transfer Connor Crabtree were the only newcomers on the roster.

Seniors Julius Johnson (3.4 PPG) and Keith Oddo (0.3 PPG) and graduate student Noah Yates (3.8 PPG) all graduated in the spring, although Oddo is playing at Louisville while this season while pursuing a graduate

Richmond returned 90 percent of its scoring from last season -- the second-highest rate in the A-10 behind Davidson's 94 percent -- and much of its other production.

NO SENIOR MOMENTS

2019-20 is Richmond's first season since 1999-00 without a senior on the team. Richmond is one of six D-I programs without a senior or grad transfer on its roster this season, joining CSU-Bakersfield, Mount St. Mary's, Santa Clara, Stony Brook, and USC-Upstate.

NATIONAL EXPOSURE

At least 10 of the Spiders 31 regular-season games this season will be broadcast on national television: four on NBC Sports Network, two on CBS Sports Network, one on the SEC Network, and three on the ESPN family of networks.

Of the 16 game scheduled for the Robins Center this season, three will be broadcast nationally (Boston College, Charleston, and VCU) while 12 more will be shown on regional television on either MASN or the NBC Sports Washington networks.

VOICE OF THE SPIDERS

For the 37th straight season, Bob Black will handle play-by-play duties for Spider men's basketball broadcasts. Black, who also hosts a morning show on ESPN Richmond, the Spiders radio rights-holder, underwent surgery to remove a vocal polyp in June. Following the successful procedure, Black has said that he is "more fired up to get going than I have been in a long time." Black will be teamed with analyst Greg Beckwith, a member of the Richmond Athletics Hall of Fame who is still the program's career leader in assists and steals. Black and Beckwith will do all away games and national TV home games on ESPN Richmond radio. They will anchor the SpiderTV broadcast for all of Richmond's home games on regional TV. Those broadcasts will be produced and directed by Blake Ellett.

WEIGHTY MATTERS

Redshirt junior Grant Golden will play the 2019-20 season close to 255 lbs, down about 20 lbs from his playing weight in 2018-19. Golden focused on cutting weight this offseason after he said he felt his legs were heavy at the ends of games last season.

On the other hand, sophomore Souleymane Koureissi has bulked up to 215 lbs this offseason. That's up 25 lbs from what he weighed when he came to Richmond in the summer of 2018.

WILD START

Richmond opened its season with a pair of wild games at the Robin's Center, becoming the first team since Southern Miss in 2012-13 to start a season with two straight overtime wins.

Richmond trailed Saint Francis (PA) by 10 with 100 seconds remaining in regulation in its season opener on November 8 before a 12-2 run, keyed by a full-court press that led to three Red Flash turnovers in a 32-second span, tied the game at 90 and forced overtime. Richmond prevailed 100-98 in the extra period, the Spiders most points scored in a season opener since 1980.

In their next game, the Spiders were tied with Vanderbilt at 80 at the end of regulation. With 25 seconds left in OT, Jacob Gilyard tied the game with a reverse layup. With four seconds left, Gilyard intercepted a Vanderbilt pass and flipped the ball ahead to a streaking Andre Gustavson, who was fouled on his dunk attempt with 0.6 seconds left and went on to make the game-winning free throw in a 93-92 Spiders win.

Richmond was the first team to start a season with back-to-back wins by no more than two points since UNLV in 2014-15.

URBAN LEGENDS

Richmond competed in the Romand Legends Classic at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y. during Thanks-giving Week. Richmond defeated Wisconsin 62-52 in the semifinals behind 16 first-half points from Blake Francis. It was Richmond's third straight win over a power-conference opponent dating back to last season.

In the championship game, the Spiders fell to #18 Auburn 79-65. Richmond led 35-34 at halftime but was unable to answer a 15-4 run by the Tigers to start the second half and finished the game 2-18 from threepoint range.

After the game, Grant Golden and Jacob Gilyard were named to the Legends Classic All-Tournament Team.

IN A CLASS BY HIMSELF

While the Spiders are scheduled to return their entire roster in 2020-21, Richmond currently has two open scholarships. One of those spots will be filled by Isaiah Wilson next season, the only member of Richmond's Class of 2020 signing class. Wilson, a point guard from Pittsburgh, Pa., is a Top-200 national recruit who is rated as the fourth-best Class of 2020 recruit in Pennsylvania by 247sports.com as well as 31st best 2020 point guard in the nation.

FAMILY BUSINESS

Several Spiders have family members who participated in college athletics.

Jake Wojcik's father Dave was head coach at San Jose State from 2013-17 and has 19 seasons of college coaching experience. He played collegiately at Loyola (Md.). Wojcik's uncle Doug is a former head coach of both Tulsa (2005-12) and College of Charleston (2012-14) and played at Navy, where he was an All-CAA performer and teammate of Basketball Hall-of-Famer David Robinson.

Junior Nick Sherod is the son of E.J. Sherod who played basketball at ODU. Nick's grandfather, Edmund, was a Hall-of-Famer at VCU before playing for the New York Knicks.

Jacob Gilyard's father Rodney is a member of Ottawa University's Athletics Hall of Fame and graduated as the school's all-time leader in assists and steals in 1992.

Freshman Tyler Burton's father Quinton played at Providence and helped the Friars to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances in 1989 and 1990. He scored

Grant Golden's father played at Fairfield University and he had two grandfathers that played collegiate football. Grant's brother Bryce is a sophomore on Butler's team this season.

Sophomore Jordan Gaitley is the son of Stephanie Gaitley, currently the head coach of the women's basketball team at Fordham University and the head coach of Richmond's women's team from 1985-91, when she amassed a 116-63 record over six seasons at the Robins Center. Gaitley also has two older brothers who played collegiately. His oldest brother Dutch is currently an assistant coach for the Charlotte Hornets.

Freshman Gabe Arizin is the grandson of Basketball Hall-of-Famer Paul Arizin, a 10-time NBA All-Star who twice led the league in scoring. He attended Villanova and led the nation in scoring as a senior in 1950. His No. 11 jersey has been retired by the school. He was inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame in 2006. Gabe's father Mike played at William & Mary and La Salle. He earned All Southern-Conference honors following his freshman and sophomore seasons at W&M.

Junior Blake Francis' father Carl attended Virginia Union University and played linebacker for four seasons. He is currently the Director of Communications for the NFL Player's Association. Also in Francis' family:

- Brother Branden played football at Liberty from 2010-13
- Cousin Tyler Thornton played basketball at Duke from 2010-14
- Cousin Marques Hagans started at QB for Virginia from 2004-05 and played in 10 NFL games after being picked in the 2006 NFL Draft.

Grant Golden spent multiple weeks at the end of July and the beginning of August working out in Houston with former NBA All-Star and current Houston Rockets Player Development Coach John Lucas.

HOME OF THE SPIDERS

ROBINS CENTER

Built in 1972 through the generosity of the E. Claiborne Robins family, the Robins Center underwent a \$17 million renovation in 2013 that transformed it into the one of the premier college basketball arenas in the nation

Last season, the Spiders averaged 5,730 fans per game, fifth in the Atlantic 10. In 2017-18, Richmond averaged 6,492 fans per game, its most since the 1992-93 season when capacity at the arena was over 9,000. Today, the arena has a capacity of 7,201.

The Robins Center complex houses the University's athletic squads and serves as the showplace for University of Richmond basketball. Renovations to the lower level of the building in 2018 resulted in the creation of the Blandford-Everett Student-Athlete Performance Center, which provides Richmond's student-athletes with the latest strength and conditioning equipment, access to a nutrition fueling center, and a state-of-the-art sports medicine facility.

In addition to sporting and recreational activities, the Robins Center annually serves as the site or Richmond's commencement exercises and also provides a forum for countless other educational and cultural events.

The eyes of the world were focused on the Robins Center in 1992, when one of that year's Presidential debates was held in the Center's main arena. In 2011, President Obama delivered an economic address to a capacity crowd.

QUEALLY ATHLETICS CENTER

The Queally Athletics Center is the future home of Spiders basketball.

Sports medicine and nutritional facilities, along with an athletic training room with hydrotherapy, will ensure the health and well-being of student-athletes. Strength and conditioning areas, including a full-sized practice gym, coaches offices and team locker rooms will help athletes compete at maximum performance levels. A new Academic Support Center will be located in the renovated Millhiser Gymnasium to ensure that student-athletes have access to the resources they need to maintain progress toward their educational goals. A Spider Hall will engage fans and alumni in celebration of the proud tradition of University of Richmond athletics.

The facility is named for 1986 alumni Paul and Anne-Marie Queally, longtime supporters of the University of Richmond who contributed a \$7.5 million lead gift to launch the fundraising efforts for the new center, which is expected to open in the fall of 2020.

The site will also be home to Richmond's new student Well-Being Center, which will house all campus health care services in addition to providing facilities for wellness education and nutrition services.

Made to weigh in on other hot-button issues, the Richmond roster chose ketchup (67 percent) as its top condiment, easily outdistancing barbeque sauce (20 percent), and picked LeBron James (58 percent) over Michael Jordan (25 percent) - with Giannis Antetokounmpo and Jimmy Butler each getting one write-in vote. Befitting basketball players, the Spiders would prefer to have the ability to fly (67 percent) over the ability to be invisible (33 percent).

COLOR WHEE

Perhaps no issues splits the Spiders as much as uniform color. 40 percent of Richmond's roster prefers the Spiders red jersey, 40 percent like the blue jersey best, and 20 percent chose the white jersey.

DUSTY IN HERE

While some Spiders claim to have never cried at a movie, a 2018 film led to damp eyes for at least four players. Grant Golden, Matt Grace, Nick Sherod, and Jordan Gaitley all said that the last movie they cried at is Lady Gaga's A Star is Born.

THE PLACES YOU'LL GO

A third of the Spiders roster (Grace, Sullivan Kulju, Tyler Burton, Gabe Arizin, Connor Crabtree) says their favorite television show as a kid was Spongebob Squarepants. Blake Francis chose Drake & Josh, but says his favorite book ever is still a children's book: The Dr. Seuss Collection.

FACE YOUR FEARS

Tyler Burton and Connor Crabtree were both heavily recruited before signing with Richmond this offseason. The duo decided to come to Richmond despite both admitting that the thing they are most afraid of is spiders.

CHRIS MOONEY HEAD COACH 15th SEASON PRINCETON, 1994

Chris Mooney is the winningest coach in Richmond basketball's storied history, a distinction he earned with a win over Wake Forest on December 1, 2018 for his record-setting 240th victory on the Spiders sidelines. Now in his 15th season with the Spiders, Mooney has led Richmond to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and a pair of NIT Quarterfinals.

Hired by Richmond prior to the 2005-06 season, Mooney is the second longest-tenured coach in the Atlantic 10, trailing only Bob McKillop (Davidson). Mooney ranks fifth all-time in conference history in both A-10 wins by a head coach (124) and overall wins by an A-10 head coach (250).

Mooney has led the Spiders to seven total postseason appearances - all in the last 12 seasons. Under Mooney, the Spiders made trips to the NCAA tournament in 2010 and 2011 and trips to the NIT Quarterfinals in 2015 and 2017. In the spring of 2011, Mooney's Spiders made national headlines en route to the NCAA Sweet 16, knocking off five-seed Vanderbilt and Morehead State in the process. Richmond finished both the 2010 and 2011 seasons ranked in the top 25.

Mooney has earned many honors during his Spiders career. He was tabbed the Sporting News Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year in 2010, while also being selected as a finalist for the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award. That same year, he won Richmond's Voice of the University Award, given to a faculty or staff member for being a voice that represents the University of Richmond in a positive manner to the wider community. Later in 2010, Richmond Style Weekly tabbed him for the 40 Under 40 list, spotlighting UR's community involvement with the homeless, Special Olympics, Arthritis Foundation, Friends of Jaclyn Foundation and the ASK Foundation for Childhood Cancer Research.

21 of Mooney's former players have gone on to play professionally in either the NBA, the G League, or overseas, including at least one from 12 of the last 14 graduating classes.

In 2018-19, the Spiders became the first team in four years to place a pair of sophomores on the Atlantic 10's All-Conference teams, as Jacob Gilyard earned Second Team honors and Grant Golden was named to the Third Team. Gilyard and Golden were forced into bigger roles after junior Nick Sherod, the Spiders most experienced starter, suffered a season-ending knee injury in late November. With Sherod out, the Spiders were one of the 25 youngest teams in Division I, relying on freshmen and sophomores for 87 percent of their points. The Spiders youth often showed up at the end of games, as Richmond lost seven games despite leading with five minutes left in regulation. The Spiders finished 13-20, and held a lead of eight or more points in half of their losses

In 2017-18, Mooney oversaw the development of one of the nation's youngest teams, starting a junior, two sophomores, and two freshmen. Facing one of the 25 most difficult out-of-conference schedules in Division I, the Spiders entered A-10 play with a 2-10 record. But Richmond exceeded expectations in the league, finishing tied for fifth with a 9-9 record that included a pair of wins against crosstown rival VCU and a 2-0 mark against eventual league champion Davidson.

In 2016-17, the Spiders swept the two major Atlantic 10 awards, with senior T.J. Cline winning A-10 Player of the Year and freshman De'Monte Buckingham earning Rookie of the Year honors. UR rebounded from a 6-6 start to finish third in A-10 play and earn an NIT bid where the Spiders won games at Alabama and home vs Oakland.

In 2014-15, Richmond finished the regular season on a six-game winning streak, and was one of the "Last Four Out" of the NCAA Tournament at-large field, thereby securing the No. 1 seed and home-court advantage in the NIT, where they would reach the tournament's quarterfinals.

2009-10 and 2010-11 are remembered as two of the top seasons in Mooney's coaching career and in Spider basketball history. In the spring of 2010, Richmond earned its first NCAA at-large bid since 2004, garnering a seven seed before falling in the first round of the tournament. Mooney was named the 2010 Sporting News Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year, and was a finalist for the 2010 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. The Spiders finished the season ranked no. 24 in the final top-25 rankings.

In 2011, Richmond defeated Dayton in the A-10 championship game to earn Mooney's first conference championship, the Spiders first and only league title since Richmond joined the Atlantic 10 in 2001.

The 2010-11 Spiders would go on to the second Sweet 16 in program history by downing Vanderbilt and Morehead State in the NCAA Denver Subregional. The Spiders run came to an end at the hands of Kansas in San Antonio. Richmond finished 29-8, set a school record for wins, and finished no. 21 in the coaches poll.

Mooney previously coached at Air Force for five seasons: three as an assistant, one as an associate head coach and his final season as head coach. In 2004-05, Mooney led the Falcons to an 18-12 record and votes in the national polls. His 18 victories were the most by a first-year head coach at Air Force.

Mooney began coaching at the high school level, taking a job at Lansdale Catholic High School in Lansdale, Pa., in 1994. His first college coaching experience came at Division III Beaver College, now known as Arcadia University. He spent two seasons there from 1998-2000. While at Beaver College, Mooney only coached part-time, spending much of his time as an event coordinator. He helped plan weddings and events while also serving as the team manager.

Mooney is married to the former Lia Chomat, a Princeton graduate who also has a doctorate in psychology from Penn. The couple has two sons, Danny and Ryan.




