## NCAA TOURNAMENT 3X - WNIT 9X

### SPIDERS THREE WINS IN A ROW

The University of Richmond women's basketball team won their third-straight game in a 72-55 road win at William & Mary. The Spiders outscored the Tribe 19-14 in the first quarter and built a 15-point lead at halftime 40-25. Richmond shot 49.1 percent from the field and was 15-for-18 from the free throw line (83.3 percent).

Three Spiders finished in double-figures with freshman Addie Budnik leading the way with 23 points, four rebounds and three blocks. Juniors Claire Holt and Kate Klimkiewicz each scored 11 points. Sophomore Elaina Chapman finished with 11 rebounds to help Richmond outrebound William & Mary 38-27.

UR shared the basketball against William & Mary with 19 assists, including five by freshman Grace Townsend and four by Elaina Chapman. The Spiders also added six blocks, including three from freshman Addie Budnik.

**ABOUT VCU**

VCU was picked to win the Atlantic 10 Conference in the preseason poll with five senior leaders returning. The Rams have gotten off to a slow start at 2-5 with losses against Arizona State (49-40), Stephen F. Austin (71-66), ODU (81-76 OT), ECU (58-55) and Vanderbilt (90-81). Three of the five losses have come by five points or less. Senior Tera Reed leads the team in scoring at 17.8 points per game and classmate Taya Robinson is second at 13.6 points per game. Freshman Sarah Te-Biasu is third at 12.4 points per game. Senior Sydnei Archie leads the team in rebounding at 6.2 boards per game.

**HISTORY AGAINST VCU**

This will be the 85th meeting all-time between the two teams with VCU leading 44-40 and the Rams have won the last four meetings. In the last meeting, VCU earned a 57-42 win on Feb. 5, 2020 at the Robins Center. A tough 24-7 second quarter proved to be the difference as Taya Robinson led VCU with a double-double of 17 points and 10 rebounds. Claire Holt led the Spiders with 16 points. Richmond's last win against VCU came on Feb. 18, 2018 in a 59-54 win at the Robins Center. Jaide Hinds-Clarke and Micaela Parson each finished with 12 points apiece. The Spiders built a nine-point halftime lead after outscoring VCU, 17-9, in the second quarter.

**SPIDERS BLOCK PARTY**

The Richmond women's basketball team is ranked 34th in the nation in total blocks with 25 as a team through four games played. Only VCU (27) has more blocks in the A-10. The nine blocks against Gardner-Webb was only three away from tying the school record of 12 set against UNCG on Dec. 8, 2012. The Spiders finished with six blocks in the road win at William & Mary.

**BUDNIK SITS 10TH IN THE NATION IN BLOCKS**

Freshman Addie Budnik finished with a career-high five blocks against Gardner-Webb and is 10th in the nation in total blocks with 14 through four games. Budnik's 14 blocks is the most out of all the freshmen in the NCAA leading Texas' DeYona Gaston who has 12 in five games. Budnik is sixth in blocks per game at 3.50. Budnik had three blocks against William & Mary.

**ADDIE BUDNIK NAMED A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

Freshman forward Addie Budnik was named A-10 Rookie of the Week on Dec. 7. Budnik averaged 13.3 points per game, five rebounds, four blocks and shot 71.4 percent from the field. Budnik only missed six total shots on the week and scored a career-high 23 points at William & Mary. It is the first Rookie of the Week honor since Jaide Hinds-Clarke was awarded in the 2016-17 season.

**DISHING OUT DIMES**

UR finished with 19 assists against William & Mary and has 67 in four games, which is fourth in the Atlantic 10 A-10. The Spiders are 101st in the nation in total assists. Three Richmond players have dished out 10 or more assists in Claire Holt (13), Grace Townsend (13) and Elaina Chapman (10). Richmond dished out a career-high 21 as a team in a home win against Gardner-Webb.

**NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP FOR CHAPMAN**

Sophomore forward Elaina Chapman is having a solid sophomore season leading the team in rebounding at 9.0 boards per game. Chapman has pulled down five or more rebounds in every game, including a new career-high 14 rebounds against Navy. Chapman is second on the team with four blocks and third in assists with 10. Chapman finished with 11 rebounds against William & Mary.

**LIGHTS OUT SHOOTING FOR UR**

Richmond shot a season-high 59.6 percent from the field (34-for-57) against Gardner-Webb. It was the highest mark in the Aaron Roussell era and highest since shooting 54.2 percent at VCU on Feb. 26, 2017. The 34 made field goals against Gardner-Webb is the most since making 39 against Savannah State on Nov. 22, 2017. As a team through four games, Richmond is shooting 46.9 percent, which is second in the Atlantic 10 conference behind UMass (47.1). Out of 266 teams in the NCAA, Richmond is sitting 33rd in Field Goal Percentage.

**A-10 SCHEDULE CHANGES TO 18 GAMES FOR 2020-21**

The Spiders will play 18 Atlantic 10 games in 2020-21 after a 16-game schedule from last season. The league office made the switch to get more games in due to COVID-19 concerns. Richmond will play VCU, UMass, Rhode Island, George Mason and George Washington all twice this season. Road games will adopt the travel partner method this season with A-10 road games being two in one weekend. Richmond will open A-10 play with a home game against VCU on Dec. 20 in the Sonabank P.O.W.E.R Crosstown Showdown at the Robins Center.

**KLIMKIEWICZ CAREER NIGHT AGAINST GARDNER-WEBB**

Junior Kate Klimkiewicz scored a career-high 25 points off 9-for-16 shooting and hit 4-for-10 from downtown to help the Spiders defeat Gardner-Webb 85-73. Klimkiewicz finished with 15 of her 25 points at halftime and grabbed nine rebounds. Klimkiewicz went 3-for-4 from the free throw line and led the team with 31 minutes played.

**MOST POINTS SCORED IN FOUR SEASONS**

The Spiders finished with 85 points scored in a 85-73 win against Gardner-Webb. It was the most points scored since a 100-point game against Savannah State on Nov. 22, 2017. Richmond scored a season-high 26 points in the first quarter to set the table. UR almost scored 20 points in every quarter but finished with just 18 in the fourth quarter.

**LOCAL TALENT ON DISPLAY AT THE ROBINS CENTER**

Richmond has six players from the state of Virginia and four from local high schools in the Richmond area. Senior Alex Parson went to Monacan high school, freshman Grace Townsend went to James River high school, sophomores Elaina Chapman and Angel Burgos went to the Trinity Episcopal school. Kate Klimkiewicz (Oakton, Va.) and Kailyn Fee (Vienna, Va.) are the other two players from Virginia.

**QUEALLY ATHLETICS CENTER**

The Queally Athletics Center is the new home of Spiders basketball.

Opened in October following 18 months of construction, the \$15 million practice facility's centerpiece is the Spiders new practice gym. The gym includes a replica of the Robins Center court plus two additional half-courts and two more retractable baskets on the sidelines of the main court, for a total of six in the facility. Steps from the court is a 20-seat theater that allows for instant review of practice film and diagramming of offensive and defensive schemes.

The Spiders new strength and conditioning area abuts the court's endline, separated only by a pair of see-through retractable overhead doors. A six-table Sports Medicine suite, a hydrotherapy room with two pools, and a nutrition station all border the strength and conditioning area.

Locker rooms and lounges for the men's and women's team are also located on the ground floor, while the second floor includes Spider Hall, the main entrance to the Queally Athletics Center. The space, which serves to engage fans and alumni in celebration of the proud tradition of Richmond Athletics, features a giant video board as well as entrances to Millhiser Gymnasium and the University's new Student Well-Being Center, which are both adjacent to the QAC.

The facility is named for 1986 alumni Paul and Anne-Marie Queally, longtime supporters of the University of Richmond who contributed a \$7.5 million lead gift to launch the fundraising efforts for the new center.

## HEAD COACH AARON ROUSSELL

### Second Season at Richmond - Iowa '01

Aaron Roussell was named Richmond women's basketball head coach on April 2, 2019. Roussell has 16 years of head coaching experience and a career winning percentage of .701 with an overall record of 327-139.

In his first season as a Spider, Roussell led the team to 15 wins, which was a six-win improvement from its previous season and it was the fourth most wins by a first-year coach in school history. Richmond had the highest rated schedule in the A-10 and finished with 11 games against teams in the top-100 RPI. Roussell also helped senior forward Jaide Hinds-Clarke earned A-10 All-Conference honors after leading the team in scoring at 11.8 points per game and hit 23 three-pointers after not hitting any during her previous three seasons.

The Spiders were much improved in year one under Roussell going from 275 in the RPI to 125 last season (+150 increase). That mark was eighth-best nationally and best among first-year coaches. Richmond also had the most improved offense in the Atlantic 10 scoring 6.4 more points per game. The Spiders had three players in the top 11 in three-point shooting, the only A-10 school to do so. Richmond was second in the A-10 in 3-point improvement this past season.

Roussell led Richmond to eight road victories in his first season after only one road win in 2018-19. The Spiders also won a road game in the Atlantic 10 Championship first round at George Washington to secure a postseason win for the first time since the 2017-18 season. Roussell guided sophomore guard Claire Holt to a breakout season after she averaged 10.9 points per game and hit 46 three-pointers last year. Holt averaged 5.2 points per game and hit 21 three-pointers in her freshman season.

Roussell (pronounced ruh-SELL) had seven highly successful seasons at Bucknell, including a 102-30 (.773) mark over the final four years. He led Bucknell to six-straight winning seasons and four-straight years of 22 wins or more. The Bison's 102 wins from 2015-19 are the most in a four-year span in the history of the Patriot League and they also posted a 64-8 (.889) league record in that period.

During that time, Bucknell advanced to the postseason four-straight years with a pair of NCAA Tournament and WNIT appearances. Roussell guided Bucknell to a program-record 12-game winning streak in 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 and a program-record 29-game home winning streak. His Bison teams posted a 84-20 (.807) record on their home court during his seven-year tenure as head coach.

Roussell, a two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, guided Bucknell to its top season in program history in 2018-19 as the Bison amassed a school-record 28 victories and a 28-6 overall record. The Bison won the Patriot League regular season and tournament titles in 2018-19, advancing to the NCAA Tournament. Bucknell was the No. 12 seed in the Greensboro region and took fifth-seeded Florida State to the wire, seeing two potential game-tying 3-pointers fall off the mark in the closing seconds of the upset bid.

The Bison won the Patriot League title and the top seed in the tournament in 2018-19 after sweeping second-seeded American and third-seeded Lehigh. Bucknell had its best offensive season in program history, setting program single-season records in points scored (2,462), field goals (875), 3-pointers (283) and assists (529).

Bucknell's four-straight postseason appearances is the best run in program history. Roussell led the Bison to a 22-10 record in 2017-18, including a 15-3 mark in league play, finishing second in the standings. Bucknell accepted an invitation to the WNIT and played at West Virginia to cap the season.

Roussell had a banner year in 2016-17 as well for the Bison, leading the team to a 27-6 overall record and a 16-2 mark in Patriot League play. He won the Patriot League regular season and tournament titles in impressive fashion, while earning his second Patriot League Coach of the Year award. The Bison earned the No. 14 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2017, facing off against third-seeded Maryland.

Bucknell's postseason run started in 2015-16 with a then program-record 25-8 overall record and a 17-1 league mark. The Bison tied for the Patriot League regular season crown and he earned his first league Coach of the Year honor. Bucknell was invited to the WNIT and won the program's and the Patriot League's first-ever postseason game with a victory at Akron, before falling to Michigan on the road in the second round.

Roussell turned around the Bucknell program almost immediately upon his arrival in Lewisburg, Pa., for the 2012-13 season. The year prior to his arrival, the Bison only won five games and he improved that mark 10 wins in year one with a 15-15 record – his lone season at Bucknell not over a .500 winning percentage. He finished as a finalist for the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year Award in 2013. He continued to build the program and in year two at the helm, helped the Bison post a winning record at 16-14, Bucknell's first winning season since 2008-09. The Bison earned a bid into the Women's Basketball Invitational postseason tournament for the first time in program history. The rise kept coming in 2014-15 as the Bison finished with an 18-12 record, the most wins for the Bison since 2007.

Much of Roussell's success at Bucknell was a result of his ability to quickly develop talent and meld it with the team's veteran players. Under this guidance, Bucknell earned three Patriot League Rookie of the Year award winners from 2014-16 and one of those student-athletes – Claire DeBoer – went on to earn Patriot League Player of the Year accolades in 2016-17.

Prior to his time at Bucknell, Roussell spent eight years (2004-2012) as the highly successful head coach at the University of Chicago where he compiled a 161-50 (.763) record, including a 52-5 mark with a 43-game regular season winning streak over his last two seasons leading the Maroons.

Roussell logged the most victories and highest winning percentage of any women's basketball coach in Chicago's 48-year history. He guided the Maroons to the only three University Athletic Association outright championships in program history. Two of those came in his last two seasons, both on perfect 14-0 league records. Roussell's Chicago teams made four NCAA Division III Tournament appearances and advanced to three Sweet Sixteen appearances and one Elite Eight showing.

In addition to their success on the hardwood, Roussell's teams at the University of Chicago, one of the most prestigious academic institutions in the nation, have also excelled in the classroom. His 2010-11 team combined for a 3.36 grade-point average and in his last season, Taylor Simpson of Chicago was awarded the Jostens Trophy, given to the most outstanding Division III women's basketball student-athlete based on basketball ability, academic success and community service.

Roussell was the UAA Coach of the Year in 2008, 2011 and 2012, and he was the WBCA Regional Coach of the Year in 2011 and 2012.

Roussell coached six of the 10 1,000-point scorers in program history, he mentored 15 different all-conference performers in eight seasons and had players earn All-America honors in 2005, 2011 and 2012. His teams posted a higher victory total than the previous season in seven of his eight years at Chicago.

Roussell is a 2001 graduate of the University of Iowa, where he double-majored in journalism/mass communications and political science. In 2002 he began a two-year stint as a graduate assistant women's basketball coach at Minnesota State. In addition to his coaching duties, he completed a master's degree in sports administration.

His first coaching experience came at the high school level, where he was the boys' varsity assistant coach and head JV coach at Breck High School in Minneapolis, Minn., in 2001-02.

Roussell and his wife, Molly, have an 10-year-old son, Riley, a six-year old daughter, Kelsey, and a three-year old daughter, Kendall.
