### What's On Tap . . .

The Spiders hit the road for two-straight games beginning this Saturday with a trip to Long Island to face off against Stony Brook in a Colonial Athletic Association battle ... The game will be broadcast on FloFootball and air on ESPN Richmond 106.1 FM.

### Series History . . .

Saturday's game marks the seventh meeting all-time between the Spiders and Stony Brook ... The Seawolves are the team in the CAA that Richmond has faced the least in program history with UAlbany be the second fewest at seven times .... The Spiders and Stony Brook have split the first six meetings all-time at three apiece with only one of the games being decided by seven points or less (2017, 27-24 loss) ... The Spiders are 1-2 all-time on the road against the Seawolves, winning 39-31 in 2013 but dropping the last two visits in 2016 (42-14) and 2018 (36-10) ... Richmond evened the series at 3-3 last time the teams met in 2019 when the Spiders defeated the then 20th-ranked Seawolves by a 30-10 margin.

In that game, the Spiders out-scored Stony Brook 20-7 in the second quarter while the defense limited the Seawolves to only 72 yards rushing along with no points in the second half ... Quarterback **Joe Mancuso** accounted for 406 total yards of offense and four touchdowns on the day - two through the air and two on the ground.

### Linebacker Duo . . .

Linebackers **Tyler Dressler** and **Tristan Wheeler** have been a force together on the inside over the past two seasons ... Dressler and Wheeler lead the Spiders with 105 total tackles in the first six games ... Wheeler leads the way with 55 tackles, including a team-high 21 solo tackles, while Dressler is second on the team with 50 tackles ... Wheeler ranks second in the CAA at 9.2 tackles per game while Dressler is eighth at 8.3 tackles per game ... Both rank in the top 50 in the country in tackles per game (Wheeler 26th, Dressler 50th).

Last season, they became the first Spider linebacker duo to each record 100 or more tackles in the same season since 2008 when they each accomplished the feat in 2019 ... Dressler and Wheeler each posted 104 tackles ... Richmond is one of just four teams in NCAA FCS that has two returning 100-tackle members from 2019, joining the likes of Montana, North Dakota State and UAlbany ... Richmond's duo is the only pair that accomplished the feat in the regular season ... Dressler and Wheeler have accounted for 404 career tackles between them heading into Saturday's game ... Dressler has posted 207 career tackles in 40 career games while Wheeler is close behind with 197 tackles coming in just 22 career games ... Dressler is averaging 8.3 tackles per game since the start of 2019 while Wheeler is averaging 8.95 tackles per game during that span.

### Quarterback Questions . . .

The Spiders enter Saturday's game with a question at the quarterback position due to injuries ... Starting quarterback **Joe Mancuso** was injured on the second play from scrimmage against Virginia Tech Sept. 25 and suffered a broken finger ... Mancuso has missed the past three weeks, including games against Elon and James Madison ... Prior to his injury, Mancuso had thrown for 668 yards on 54-of-87 passing with six touchdowns while adding 125 yards rushing on 18 carries ... Backup quarterback **Beau English** came on in relief against Virginia Tech and has started the past two games ... English was injured in last Saturday's game against JMU, suffering a hand injury ... English has thrown for 355 yards on 46-of-84 passing and one touchdown ... Redshirt freshman **Jackson Hardy** saw the most action of his career last week against the Dukes, connected on 4-of-7 passes for 30 yards on a pair of series while English was being treated ... All three quarterbacks are listed as possibilities on the Spiders' depth chart this week.

### Two-Headed Monster . . .

The Spider running back duo of redshirt sophomore **Savon Smith** and red-shirt junior **Aaron Dykes** have combined for 571 yards on the ground this season, averaging a combined 95.7 yards per game ... Smith ranks 14th in the CAA in rushing with 307 yards on 54 carries while Dykes is 18th in rushing with 264 yards on 70 carries ... Smith's 5.7 yards per carry average ranks seventh in the conference ... Quarterback **Joe Mancuso** prior to his injury was third in the conference with a 6.9 yards per carry average.

### Punter From Down Under . . .

Sophomore punter **Aaron Trusler** is a native of Melbourne, Australia and is in his first year with the Spiders ... Trusler has taken every punt this season and is averaging 39.8 yards per punt on 36 punts ... He posted a career-high nine punts last time out against James Madison, averaging 41.7 yards per kick ... He has dropped 11 punts inside the 20-yard line this year, ranking third best in the CAA ... Fifteen of his kicks have been fair caught, also ranking third best in the conference ... Last time out against JMU, Trusler booted a career-long punt of 62 yards - the fifth longest punt in the CAA this year.

### Finding The End Zone . . .

Redshirt junior running back **Aaron Dykes** is tied for fourth the Colonial Athletic Association with six total touchdowns in six games ... Dykes is seventh in the league with three rushing touchdowns while also adding a receiving touchdown and one on a kickoff return ... He is the only player in the NCAA FCS to have a rushing, receiving and kickoff return touchdown on their resume this season ... Dykes' three rushing touchdowns have all been from in close ... He has two one-yard rushing scores and a two-yard rushing touchdown ... Dykes has caught receiving touchdowns from both **Joe Mancuso** and **Beau English** ... Additionally, he recorded a 98-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Villanova.

### Strength vs. Strength . . .

Saturday's game sees the Spider defense go head-to-head with one of the top rushing attacks in the Colonial Athletic Association ... Richmond enters Saturday's game third overall in scoring defense at 18.5 points per game and third in the conference in rushing defense allowing just 119.7 yards per game against on the ground ... The Spiders held the CAA's top rushing attack, James Madison, to only 100 yards rushing last week, 98 yards under its season average ... Richmond will again have its hands full this Saturday as Stony Brook enters the game second in the CAA averaging 184.7 yards per game on the ground ... Running back Ty Shon Lawton leads the CAA in rushing at 736 yards in seven games and is coming off a career-high 192 yards rushing last time out against Delaware.

### Turner On A Mission . . .

Defensive lineman **Kobie Turner** had one of his best games of his career last weekend against James Madison ... Turner recorded a career-high 4.5 tackles for loss in the game, including a pair of sacks, which tied his career-high ... He also forced a fumble on a strip sack of JMU's Cole Johnson and finished the game with seven total tackles ... On the year, he has recorded 25 tackles, including 7.0 for loss and forced a pair of fumbles ... Turner has posted 129 tackles, 30 tackles for loss and 14.5 sacks in his Spider career as one of the best defensive tackles in the conference.

### Running It Back . . .

Redshirt junior **Aaron Dykes** has been one of the top kickoff return specialists in the country during his Spider career as well as being the Spiders' starting running back for 20 games in his career ... Dykes returned a kickoff 98 yards for a touchdown against No. 9 Villanova, his third career kickoff return for touchdown ... He returned two kickoffs in the same game against Delaware in 2019 ... His three kickoff returns for scores are tied for the Richmond career lead in program history with Erwin Matthews (1986-88) ... He enters Saturday's game leading the CAA and NCAA FCS in kickoff return, averaging 47.0 yards per return ... The Spiders as a team rank number five in the country in kickoff return average.

### What Can Brown Do For You? . . .

Redshirt junior wide receiver **Isaac Brown** enters Saturday's game tied for the team lead for the Spiders with 17 receptions for 231 yards and two scores

in the first five games ... Brown has posted three or more receptions in the first three games of the year, marking the first time in his career he has done that during a three-game span ... He entered the 2021 season with 42 receptions for 417 yards and three scores in his first three years with the Spiders before turning into one of the top targets this season.

### **Freshman Day ...**

True freshman corner back **Angelo Rankin** made his second career start last weekend against No. 7 James Madison ... Rankin posted a career-high 11 tackles in the loss, leading the team, including a team-best nine solo tackles ... Rankin has moved into the starting role after the injury suffered by starter **Tyrek Funderburk** against Virginia Tech.

### **Darius Takes Over ...**

Graduate defensive lineman **Darius Reynolds** has appeared in more caeer games than any other active Spider ... Reynolds has played in 40 games in his career, including 22 career starts heading into Saturday's contest ... He just moved ahead of quarterback **Joe Mancuso** and linebacker **Tyler Dressler** for the most games played for a current Spider (39).

### **Getting That Start ...**

Offensive lineman **Tim Coleman** holds the lead among active Spiders with 32 career starts ... Coleman, who has only missed one game in his career, has started 43 games in his collegiate career after starting 11 games as a freshman at Furman ... Defensive lineman **Colby Ritten** has started 34 games in his career but is out this year with an injury.

### **Everyone Loves a Reese's ...**

Redshirt senior defensive lineman **Kobie Turner** was named to the 2022 Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List ... Turner is one of just 35 members from the NCAA FCS level selected on the Senior Bowl Watch List and one of only three from the Colonial Athletic Association, being joined by Mike Greene from James Madison and Andre Miller from Maine.

The Reese's Senior Bowl is the nation's most prestigious college all-star game, as it annually serves as the first step of the NFL Draft process ...The Reese's Senior Bowl had 106 total players drafted and 36 selected in the first three rounds the 2021 NFL Draft ...The 106 figure represents 41% of the NFL Draft. The 2022 game will be held February 5, 2022 and broadcast on the NFL Network. Practices will be live on ESPN and NFL Network hosts a daily recap show each evening in primetime ... Turner has picked up accolades this offseason in preparation for the 2021 season ... He was named to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List given to the top defensive player in NCAA FCS each year ... He was also named preseason All-CAA Football and preseason All-America by both Stats Perform and HERO FCS ... Turner was the CAA Co-Defensive Player of the Year in the spring.

### **Booting The Ball ...**

Redshirt sophomore placekicker **Jake Larson** has been the Spiders' kicker since he stepped on campus in 2019 ... Saturday's game will be his 22nd career game as a Spider ... Larson has connected on 6-of-9 field goals this season, two coming against No. 9 Villanova, including a season-best 43-yard field goal ... During his career, he has connected on 27-of-35 field goals and has booted a career-best 50-yard kick as a true freshman in 2019 ... Larson ranks sixth all-time in program history with 27 made field goals in his career while his 132 points is seventh all time (27 FG, 51 PAT).

### **Stingy Defense ...**

The Spiders' defense had a strong showing at Virginia Tech, limiting the Hokies to only 14 points offensively and 318 yards of total offense ... Richmond limited Virginia Tech to only 106 yards rushing, its lowest total of the year ... Safety **Aaron Banks** intercepted his first career pass in the game, setting up the Spiders' lone touchdown ... Linebacker **Tyler Dressler** led the way with a game-high 12 tackles while **Aamir Hall** and **Tristan Wheeler** each added eight tackles.

Redshirt senior long snapper **Kevin Laughlin** will be playing in his 34th career game for the Spiders' Saturday ... Laughlin has been the Spiders long snapper for every game since 2018, a string of 32-straight contests for one of the most consistent long snappers in the country.

### First Pick Of Career ...

Redshirt freshman cornerback **Aamir Hall** picked up his first career interception against No. 9 Villanova ... Hall intercepted a pass in the end zone off of Villanova quarterback Daniel Smith ... The pick came in just his seventh career game and his sixth straight start ... Hall became the Spiders' starting cornerback in just his second career game during the shortened spring season.

### Milking The Clock ...

Richmond enters Saturday's game fourth in the Colonial Athletic Association in time of possession, ranking 30th in the NCAA FCS ... The Spiders have held the ball for a 31:19 average in the first six games ... In the season opener, Richmond recorded a time of possession of 36:50 while holding the ball against Lehigh for 33:13 ... In the four-game spring season, the Spiders ranked fourth in the CAA in time of possession at 31:40.

### A New Iron Man ...

Offensive lineman **Tim Coleman** was forced to miss his first career game as a Spider against Lehigh due to a back injury ... The injury snapped Coleman's 28-game starting streak since becoming eligible for the Spiders and is the first game he has missed in his collegiate career due to an injury at either Richmond or Furman ... Center **Clayton McConnell** took over the Spider Iron Man helm, having started 27 straight games entering Saturday's contest ... Defensive lineman **Kobie Turner** is second now at 22-straight starts while linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** is third with 19-straight starts.

### Dressler & Hall Honored ...

Linebacker **Tyler Dressler** was named the CAA Defensive Player of the Week while cornerback **Aamir Hall** was named CAA Rookie of the Week for their performances against Virginia Tech ... Dressler had a homecoming of sorts as the Covington native grew up only 60 miles from the stadium ... He led the way with a game-high 12 tackles, including two for loss and a quarterback sack in the fourth quarter ... His play helped the Spiders limit Virginia Tech to only 106 yards rushing in the game.

Hall picks up his first career weekly honor and becomes the second Spider to earn Rookie of the Week accolades (Jasiah Williams) ... Hall had one of the best games of his career against the Atlantic Coast Conference Hokies, finishing second on the team with eight tackles .... He recorded a career-high three pass breakups on the game and continually guarded the Hokies top wide receiver threats ... On the year, he has posted 20 tackles, four pass breakups and one

### Two Interceptions In One Game . . .

The Spider linebackers picked up a pair of interceptions against Lehigh ... Graduate linebacker **Tyler Dressler** and redshirt junior **Phil O'Connor** each recorded interceptions in the 31-3 victory ... The pick was the second of Dressler's career (Elon in the spring) and the first career interception for O'Connor ... It marked the first time since September 16, 2017 that Spider linebackers have had more than one interception in a game ... In 2017, Dale Matthews Jr. recorded a pair of interceptions against Howard.

### Mancuso Spreads The Wealth . . .

Graduate quarterback **Joe Mancuso** had a strong start to the season ... Mancuso accounted for 347 yards of total offense and three total touchdowns as the Spiders gained 530 yards of total offense against Howard ... Mancuso was efficient, completing 25-of-34 passing for 293 yards and two touchdowns ... He spread the ball around to 10 different Spiders, including seven different Spiders that hauled in multiple catches ... Redshirt freshman **Jasiah Williams** lead the way with eight receptions while red-shirt junior **Isaac Brown** added five receptions, including a touchdown.

### Spiders Win 16th-Straight Opener . . .

Richmond opened the 2021 season with a 38-14 victory over Howard ... The win was the Spiders' 16th-straight home opening victory in program history, dating back to their last loss in 2005 (UMass) ... During that 16-game winning streak, the Spiders are out-scoring opponents by a 665-189 margin -- an average win of 42-12 ... The Spiders' current 16-game winning streak in home openers ranks eighth overall in the NCAA FCS level and second in the Colonial Athletic Association ... North Dakota State has won 24-straight home openers to lead the nation while Wofford (20) and Harvard (19) round out the top three ... James Madison (19), South Dakota (18) are ahead of the Spiders while Montana (16) and McNeese (16) are tied and still to play their home opener this year.

### Captains' Meeting . . .

Head coach **Russ Huesman** announced defensive lineman **Kobie Turner**, offensive lineman **Clayton McConnell**, linebacker **Tyler Dressler** and quarterback **Joe Mancuso** have been selected as team captains for the 2021 fall season by the Spider players and coaches ... Turner, Dressler and Mancuso will be two-time team captains after being selected in the 2021 spring season while McConnell earns the first captaincy of his career.

Turner has played in 31 games in his career, including 21 consecutive starts on the defensive line ... The two-time All-Colonial Athletic Association selection was the CAA Co-Defensive Player of the Year in the spring and is on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List already this fall.

McConnell is the anchor on the Spiders' offensive line, making 30 career starts at center for the Spiders ... He was named First Team All-CAA in the spring season and picked up preseason All-CAA honors this year ... He leads the Spiders' offensive line that returns every snap from the spring season.

Dressler is a two-time All-CAA selection at linebacker and has started 20 games in his career ... He has made 200 career tackles, including a career-high 104 tackles in the 2019 season ... He has played in 39 games as a Spider linebacker heading into Saturday's game.

Mancuso is a two-time team captain after earning the honor in the spring season ... He has played in 39 games in his career at quarterback, making 21 starts ... He ranks seventh all-time in program history with 6,038 yards of total offense, passing for 4,687 yards and rushing for 1,351 yards in his career.

### Opening With Two Wins . . .

The Spiders have opened the season with back-to-back wins over Howard and Lehigh at home at Robins Stadium ... This marks the first time

since 2016 the Spiders have opened the year 2-0 in a fall campaign ... That year, Richmond started 2-0 and finished the year with a 10-4 record and a NCAA Playoff Quarterfinal appearance ... During the shortened spring season, the Spiders won their first three games making them 5-2 in this last seven contests.

## **Veteran Spiders . . .**

Richmond enters the 2021 fall returning all 22 starters on offense and defense as well as all specialists on the two-deep from the spring campaign ... The Spiders benefited from the extra year of COVID-19 eligibility as they have five players in their sixth year of eligibility in **Joe Mancuso, Darius Reynolds, Tim Coleman, Seyoum Settepani** and **Tazle Sumpter**.

## **Spiders Picked Fourth In CAA Poll . . .**

The Spiders were picked to finish fourth in the Colonial Athletic Association preseason poll as voted on by the league's head coaches and media relations personnel ... Richmond, which posted a 3-1 record in the shortened spring season and finished the year ranked No. 14 nationally, earned 169 total points in the preseason poll, including a pair of first place votes ... The Spiders were one of just three teams in the CAA to earn a first place tally. James Madison was picked first overall with 231 points and 15 first place votes while Delaware was second at 222 points and seven first place votes .... Villanova was just in front of the Spiders with 194 points while New Hampshire was behind Richmond in fifth place with 135 points. Rhode Island (121), Towson (115), UAlbany (114), Maine (99), Stony Brook (73), William & Mary (61) and Elon (50) round out the 12-team prediction.

## **Richmond Places Six On CAA Team . . .**

The Spiders had six members honored with preseason All-CAA honors this summer in defensive lineman **Kobie Turner**, linebacker **Tristan Wheeler**, linebacker **Tyler Dressler**, tight end **John Fitzgerald**, offensive lineman **Clayton McConnell** and kickoff return specialist **Aaron Dykes**, who earned Honorable Mention All-CAA.

Turner headlines the selections after being named All-America by the Associated Press and STATS Perform last spring ... He was the CAA Co-Defensive Player of the Year in the spring, becoming just the fifth Spider in program history to earn CAA Defensive Player of the Year accolades and the first since 2010 when Eric McBride was Co-Defensive Player of the Year ... Turner was the first interior defensive lineman in the CAA to earn the award since 2011 (Ronnie Cameron, ODU).

The Spiders picked up two of the four linebacker slots on the preseason All-CAA team in Wheeler and Dressler ... Wheeler finished 14th in the voting for the Buck Buchanan Award during the spring, given to the top defensive player in all of NCAA FCS Football ... He was named All-America by STATS Perform in the spring after leading the Spiders and the entire CAA averaging 9.5 tackles per game ... He ranked 21st in the country in tackles per game, finishing the Spiders' four-game season with a team-high 38 tackles.

Dressler is a two-time First Team All-Colonial Athletic Association selection at the linebacker position ... He combined with Wheeler to become the first linebacker duo for the Spiders to earn First Team honors in the same year since 2009 (Eric McBride & Collin McConaghy) ... In his last full season in 2019, Dressler was tied for the team lead with 104 tackles and led the CAA at 9.5 tackles per game.

Fitzgerald picks up his first career preseason honor from the CAA after bursting onto the scene as a transfer tight end last spring ... He picked up First Team All-Conference honors after leading all tight ends in the conference with 14 receptions and leading the position with 131 yards receiving.

McConnell also records his first career preseason honor after being named First Team All-Conference in the spring ... That honor was the first of his career and he became the Spiders' first offensive lineman to earn First Team All-CAA honors since Alex Light in 2017.

Dykes was named Honorable Mention Preseason All-CAA as one of just two kickoff returners on the entire preseason team ... He was named First Team Freshman All-America by Phil Steele in 2019 and was a Third Team All-CAA selection that year for his work as a kickoff returner ... He finished the year second in the CAA and eighth in the country averaging 27.1 yards per kickoff return, leading all freshmen in the country with that average.

## **Richmond - VMI Renew Rivalry . . .**

The Spiders and Keydets of VMI announced a three-game series that will include two contests at Robins Stadium and one game at VMI's Foster Stadium ... The series will begin September 20, 2025 at Robins Stadium before heading to Lexington September 9, 2028 ... The three-game set will conclude back at Robins Stadium September 1, 2029.

The Spiders and Keydets have met 90 times in program history, making the Keydets the second-most played opponent in program history, trailing only the Capital Cup series against William & Mary ... Richmond is 45-40-5 all-time against VMI. The series saw the teams play every season for 60 straight years at one point from 1926-1986 ... The first ever meeting in the series came November 10, 1893 in Lexington and the last meeting was September 19, 2015 with the Spiders' 42-10 victory ... The Spiders have won the past 12 meetings against the Keydets and have won 22 out of the last 24 contests since 1983 ... Richmond is 33-21-3 all-time at home against the Keydets, including a perfect 3-0 all-time at Robins Stadium ... The Spiders last visited Lexington in 2012, posting a 46-7 victory over VMI.

The Spiders' non-conference schedules for the 2022, 2023 and 2024 seasons are already set making the 2025 season the first available date to renew the rivalry ... Richmond is slated to play Virginia, Saint Francis and Lehigh in 2022; Morgan State, Michigan State and Delaware State in 2023; Virginia, Wofford, Charleston Southern and Delaware State in 2024.

# RUSS HUESMAN

**HEAD COACH**

Fifth Season  
Chattanooga, 1983

Russ Huesman is in his fifth season as head coach of the University of Richmond football program and his 13th season overall as a collegiate head coach in the fall of 2021. This is Huesman's second stint with the Spiders after spending five seasons (2004-08) as an assistant coach, including part of the 2008 National Championship team.

In his 30-plus years of coaching, Huesman has coached 46 All-Americans and 21 NFL Draft Picks, while being a part of nine conference championships and the 2008 National Championship with the Spiders. He has spent 22 years coaching in the Colonial Athletic Association, bringing a wealth of experience to the Spiders.

Last spring, the Spiders posted a 3-1 record in the shortened CAA season that saw Richmond nationally ranked for most of the season. The Spiders finished the year No. 14 in the country and were third in the CAA standings with a 3-1 record. Defensive lineman Kobie Turner was named the CAA Co-Defensive Player of the Year while eight Spiders earned All-Conference accolades. Richmond also won the CAA Team Academic Award for the first time in program history, despite battling the COVID-19 pandemic.

In 2019, the Spiders finished the year 5-7 overall and 4-4 in Colonial Athletic Association play. Richmond picked up three victories last year against nationally ranked opponents, including a pair of them coming on the road. The Spiders defeated No. 18 Maine and No. 19 Delaware on the road while knocking off No. 20 Stony Brook at home at Robins Stadium. Freshman linebacker Tristan Wheeler was named the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year and was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award, given annually to the top freshman in all of NCAA FCS. Wheeler was joined by Aaron Dykes as Freshmen All-America selections in 2019 while the Spiders placed eight on the postseason All-CAA teams.

Huesman led the Spiders in 2018 through a tough, injury-riddled season. Richmond's defensive line was the top unit in the Colonial Athletic Conference last season, leading the league with 23.5 sacks. Junior Maurice Jackson led the CAA in sacks and earned All-America honors for his play. Senior Andrew Clyde earned All-Conference honors for his third-straight year, becoming the first Spider to start every game of his collegiate career.

Huesman returned to Richmond in 2017 and guided the Spiders to a 6-5 record. The Spiders had 11 different players earn All-CAA honors, led by the Offensive Player of the Year Kyle Lauletta. He became the first Richmond player to win Offensive Player of the Year since Greg Lilly in 1992. Lauletta led the CAA with 3,737 yards, 28 passing TDs and 3,827 yards of total offense and was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award.

Joining Lauletta on the All-CAA First Team were Alex Light (OL), Garrett Hudson (TE), Dejon Brissett (WR), Griffin Trau (PK) and Andrew Clyde (DL). The All-CAA Second Team included Tyler Wilkins (WR) and Cortrelle Simpson (WR), while Brandon Waller (DL), Justin Rubin (LB) and John Yarbrough (OL) were all named to the All-CAA Third Team.

Prior to returning to Richmond, Huesman spent eight tremendously successful seasons at Chattanooga. He was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year three times (2009, 2013, 2014) and was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year three times.

In his eight seasons at Chattanooga, Huesman helped guide the Mocs to a 59-37 record, including a 36-16 mark in his last four seasons (2013-16), which featured

three Southern Conference regular season championships. Chattanooga was one of only 10 programs in the country to reach the FCS Playoffs each year from 2014-16. The Mocs were also just one of four programs in the country to post a playoff win during that time.

In his eight seasons, the Mocs had at least seven players named to the All-SoCon team every year, including a school-record 17 honorees in 2014. Prior to Huesman's arrival, the Mocs had not boasted seven members of any All-SoCon team since 1979.

Chattanooga had 17 All-America honorees and three NFL draft picks with DB Buster Skrine (Cleveland – 2011), QB B.J. Coleman (Green Bay – 2012) and LB Davis Tull (New Orleans – 2015) over eight-year period.

Huesman's first stop at Richmond came from 2004-08 as defensive coordinator molding the Spiders' defensive unit into one of the best in the country. In his final year at Richmond, the national championship season, the Spiders led the country in interceptions and finished in the top-10 in four other defensive categories.

Under Huesman's guidance, the Spiders had 23 All-Conference selections, including former NFL standouts Lawrence Sidbury, Jr. and Justin Rogers. During his five-year period as an assistant coach, the Spiders posted a 42-23 (.646) record and played in the FCS Playoffs three times with a quarterfinal appearance in 2005, a semifinal appearance in 2007 and the National Championship in 2008.

Prior to his time with the Spiders, Huesman spent six years at the University of Memphis (1998-03), where he held several positions, serving as the recruiting coordinator and offensive line coach. He also coached the outside linebackers, tight ends and running backs. As recruiting coordinator, Huesman brought in a Top 50 recruiting class, ranked No. 1 in Conference USA, in 2002. It was the first recruiting class ranked in the Top 50 at Memphis.

Huesman also coached for 13 years at William & Mary (1985-97), both with the defense and special teams. During his time in Williamsburg, Huesman coached Steve Christie, a 15-year NFL place kicker with Tampa Bay, Buffalo, San Diego and the New York Giants. His coaching family tree also includes Mike Tomlin, head coach of the Pittsburgh Steelers, Sean McDermott, the head coach of the Buffalo Bills and Alan Williams, the former defensive backs coach of the Detroit Lions. All three played for Huesman at William & Mary.

Huesman's success on the gridiron is not limited to just coaching as he was a standout player at perennial power Moeller High School in his native town of Cincinnati, Ohio. He helped Moeller's team compile a record of 43-0-1 and win a pair of Ohio state championships.

An all-city selection in football as a senior, Huesman signed a football scholarship with Chattanooga, where he started all four years as a defensive back (1978-81) and was a two-sport athlete. During his playing career with the Mocs, he helped UTC to a 31-11-2 mark and two Southern Conference championships. Huesman also patrolled centerfield on the baseball diamond for the Mocs during his freshman and junior seasons.

Huesman was on the Mocs' sidelines for the 1982 season as a student coach, earning his degree in business education in 1983. He followed that up with a move to the University of South Carolina as a graduate assistant under the late Joe Morrison.

Huesman and his wife Amy have two daughters, Natalie and Emily and two sons, Jacob and Levi.
