OPENING TIP

- -Richmond has faced William & Mary more than any other opponent in program history dating back to 1920, and the Spiders own the all-time series 92-25. Most recently, Richmond defeated W&M 72-55 on the road back on Dec. 6, 2020.
- -The Spiders are coming off a 98-89 road loss to Ohio last Saturday. Richmond trailed by 16 points in the second quarter and stormed back to take a five-point lead in the fourth quarter before falling to the preseason MAC favorite.
- -William & Mary is coming off a 57-40 loss at Hampton this past Wednesday. Richmond defeated Hampton 96-47 on the road on Nov. 13.
- -Emma Squires posted a career day at Ohio with a career-high 28 points and tied career-high 10 rebounds for her second-career double. She posted 22 points in the second half alone.
- -Grace Townsend posted her first-career double-double at Ohio with 11 points and a career-high 10 assists. She ranks top five in the conference in assists and top 10 in assist-to-turnover ratio.
- -Addie Budnik has scored in double-figures in seven straight games and she currently leads the Spiders and ranks top 10 in the conference with 15.9 points per game. Budnik continues to lead the conference and rank top five nationally in blocks per game.

SCOUTING THE TRIBE

William & Mary is 4-5 this season including 1-4 on the road. The Tribe has suffered losses to Virginia and Hampton, both of which Richmond has beaten this season. W&M is coming off a 57-40 road loss to Hampton this past Wednesday. Sydney Wagner is the Tribe's leading scorer and she is averaging 11.1 points per game. She also leads the team in assists with 25. Kate Sramac is averaging 6.1 rebounds per game alongside 21 total assists.

SERIES HISTORY

Richmond has faced William & Mary more than any other opponent in program history dating back to 1920. The Spiders own the all-time series 92-25 and have taken the last nine of 12 meetings, including the last two straight. Most recently, Richmond defeated W&M 72-55 on the road back on Dec. 6, 2020.

SEEING DOUBLE

A pair of Spiders had career outings with double-doubles against Ohio last weekend. Emma Squires went off for 22 points in the second half and ended the day with a career-high 28 points and a tied career-high 10 rebounds for her second-ever double-double. She shot 9-of-12 from the field including 4-of-5 beyond the arc with three of those treys coming in the third quarter. She was also a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line. Squires is the first Spider to score 25 or more points in a game since Kate Klimkiewicz put up 25 against Gardner-Webb on Dec. 4, 2020.

Grace Townsend posted her first-career double-double with 11 points and a career-high 10 assists. Nine of her assists came in the second half, and she assisted all three of Squires' triples in the third quarter. It was the first time a Spider had 10 or more assists in a game since Kylie Murphree's 11 at VCU on Jan. 28, 2018.

BLOCK PARTY

Richmond set a program record for blocks in a single game with 13 Sunday against UMBC. Going into Friday's game against Long Beach State, the Spiders currently lead the nation in blocks per game with 10.2 and rank second in the NCAA in total blocks (41), behind No. 1 South Carolina (42). Sophomore Addie Budnik leads the NCAA in blocks (23) and blocks per game (5.8) after posting a career-high seven blocks in each of her last two games.

SHARING IS CARING

Out of 28 Richmond buckets against UMBC on Sunday, 24 of them were assisted. Eight different Spiders dished out at least one assist in the game, led by Grace Townsend who tied her career-high of seven. Addie Budnik and Kate Klimkiewicz each had four.

JACK OF ALL TRADES

Addie Budnik is off to a hot start in her sophomore campaign as she currently leads the Spiders in 14 difference statistical categories heading into Friday's game against Long Beach State. In addition to leading the nation and team in blocks (23) and blocks per game (5.8), Budnik leads Richmond in scoring with 59 points and 14.8 points per game after tying her career-high 23 points against UMBC Sunday. She also leads the team on the glass with 7.3 boards per game/29 total, and is tied with Grace Townsend for the team lead in assists with 13 total and 3.3 per game.

SENIOR TRIO SECURES POSTGRAD PLANS

A trio of Spider seniors have secured plans after basketball as Kate Klimkiewicz and Madelyn Neff each accepted full-time jobs while Molly Mraz has been accepted into PA school. Klimkiewicz completed an internship in the assurance department at PricewaterhouseCoopers over the summer and was then offered a full-time job with the company. She will begin her accounting career with the PwC upon graduating and completing the CPA exam. Neff accepted a position with DS+B, an accounting firm in Minneapolis, Minn., where she will be working as an accountant in the Business Services department. Mraz was accepted into the PA program at Rutgers and has accepted the school's offer.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

The Spiders have three new faces this season, including guards Sydney Boone and Katie Hill along with forward Cayla Williams. Boone, a Richmond native, attended Highland Springs High School and is the second Spider on the current roster to be named All-Metro Player of the Year joining Elaina Chapman. All three freshman were recognized as McDonald's All-American nominees.

KLIMKIEWICZ NAMED PRESEASON SECOND-TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE

Senior Kate Klimkiewicz was named to the Atlantic 10 Preseason All-Conference Second-Team by the league's coaches. She earned a spot on last year's All-Conference Second Team after leading the Spiders in scoring and rebounding. She averaged 14.3 points per game, which ranked in the top-10 in the conference, and hauled in 151 total rebounds. Klimkiewicz started all 22 games and scored in double-figures in 19 of those appearances. She posted a careerhigh 25 points against Gardner-Webb, going 9-for-16 from the field in the game. Klimkiewicz also led the Spiders in steals with 43, including eight against Saint Louis in the A-10 Championship quarterfinal, which was third-most in a single-game in school history.

RICHMOND PICKED SEVENTH IN A-10 PRESEASON POLL

The Spiders were picked to finish seventh in the Atlantic 10 preseason coaches'poll, the squad's highest preseason ranking since 2016. Richmond received 104 points to rank ahead of La Salle (100), Duquesne (83), and Saint Joseph's (68) in the top 10. Dayton was picked as the favorite with 193 points and 11 first place votes. Rhode Island (174), Fordham (163), Saint Louis/VCU (144), and UMass (140) all ranked ahead of Richmond. Head coach Aaron Roussell is entering his third year at the helm of the program, and during his tenure, the Spiders have ranked higher in each preseason poll than the previous season. The Spiders return 14 out of 16 players from last season's team, including reigning A-10 Rookie of the Year Addie Budnik. Richmond finished last year with a 13-9 record that included its second-straight trip to the A-10 Championship Quarterfinals.

HEAD COACH AARON ROUSSELL THIRD SEASON AT RICHMOND (IOWA '01)

Aaron Roussell was named Richmond women's basketball head coach on April 2, 2019. Roussell (pronounced ruh-SELL) has 17 years of head coaching experience and a career winning percentage of .700 with an overall record of 340-148.

During year two, Roussell finished the season with a 13-9 record, advancing to the A-10 Quarterfinals for the second-straight season. Roussell led the Spiders to another postseason win against 11th-seeded George Washington, winning 58-54 in overtime. In two seasons at Richmond, Roussell has dramatically improved the offensive numbers for the Spiders having moved up 160 spots nationally in offensive rating, 171 spots in field goal percentage and 203 spots in assists per game. He helped coach Addie Budnik to becoming the school's first-ever Atlantic 10 Freshman of the Year and was a finalist for Freshman of the Year by World Exposure Report. Also Roussell helped Kate Klimkiewicz lead the A-10 in three-pointers made (49) and was named A-10 All-Conference Second Team and earned CoSIDA Academic All-District 3 honors. Roussell also started 5-0 in A-10 play on the road for the first time in school history and continues to win at the Robins Center going 6-2 at home in 2020-21. In two seasons with Roussell, Richmond is 13-7 (.650) in home games at the Robins Center.

In his first season as a Spider, Roussell led the team to 15 wins, which was a six-win improvement from its previous season and it was the fourth most wins by a first-year coach in school history. Richmond had the highest rated schedule in the A-10 and finished with 11 games against teams in the top-100 RPI. Roussell also helped senior forward Jaide Hinds-Clarke earn A-10 All-Conference honors after leading the team in scoring at 11.8 points per game and hit 23 three-pointers after not hitting any during her previous three seasons.

The Spiders were much improved in year one under Roussell going from 275 in the RPI to 125 last season (+150 increase). That mark was eighth-best nationally and best among first-year coaches. Richmond also had the most improved offense in the Atlantic 10 scoring 6.4 more points per game. The Spiders had three players in the top 11 in three-point shooting, the only A-10 school to do so. Richmond was second in the A-10 in 3-point improvement this past season.

Roussell led Richmond to eight road victories in his first season after only one road win in 2018-19. The Spiders also won a road game in the Atlantic 10 Championship first round at George Washington to secure a postseason win for the first time since the 2017-18 season. Roussell guided sophomore guard Claire Holt to a breakout season after she averaged 10.9 points per game and hit 46 three-pointers last year. Holt averaged 5.2 points per game and hit 21 three-pointers in her freshman season.

Roussell had seven highly successful seasons at Bucknell, including a 102-30 (.773) mark over the final four years. He led Bucknell to six-straight winning seasons and four-straight years of 22 wins or more. The Bison's 102 wins from 2015-19 are the most in a four-year span in the history of the Patriot League and they also posted a 64-8 (.889) league record in that period.

During that time, Bucknell advanced to the postseason four-straight years with a pair of NCAA Tournament and WNIT appearances. Roussell guided Bucknell to a program-record 12-game winning streak in 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 and a program-record 29-game home winning streak.

Roussell, a two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, guided Bucknell to its top season in program history in 2018-19 as the Bison amassed a school-record 28 victories and a 28-6 overall record. The Bison won the Patriot League regular season and tournament titles in 2018-19, advancing to the NCAA Tournament.

The Bison won the Patriot League title and the top seed in the tournament in 2018-19 after sweeping second-seeded American and third-seeded Lehigh. Bucknell had its best offensive season in program history, setting program single-season records in points scored (2,462), field goals (875), 3-pointers (283) and assists (529).

Bucknell's four-straight postseason appearances is the best run in program history. Roussell led the Bison to a 22-10 record in 2017-18, including a 15-3 mark in league play, finishing second in the standings. Bucknell accepted an invitation to the WNIT and played at West Virginia to cap the season.

Roussell turned around the Bucknell program almost immediately upon his arrival in Lewisburg, Pa., for the 2012-13 season. The year prior to his arrival, the Bison only won five games and he improved that mark 10 wins in year one with a 15-15 record – his lone season at Bucknell not over a .500 winning percentage. He finished as a finalist for the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year Award in 2013. He continued to build the program and in year two at the helm, helped the Bison post a winning record at 16-14, Bucknell's first winning season since 2008-09. The Bison earned a bid into the Women's Basketball Invitational postseason tournament for the first time in program history. The rise kept coming in 2014-15 as the Bison finished with an 18-12 record, the most wins for the Bison since 2007.

Much of Roussell's success at Bucknell was a result of his ability to quickly develop talent and meld it with the team's veteran players. Under this guidance, Bucknell earned three Patriot League Rookie of the Year award winners from 2014-16 and one of those student-athletes – Claire DeBoer – went on to earn Patriot League Player of the Year accolades in 2016-17.

Prior to his time at Bucknell, Roussell spent eight years (2004-2012) as the highly successful head coach at the University of Chicago where he compiled a 161-50 (.763) record, including a 52-5 mark with a 43-game regular season winning streak over his last two seasons leading the Maroons.

Roussell is a 2001 graduate of the University of Iowa, where he double-majored in journalism/mass communications and political science. In 2002 he began a two-year stint as a graduate assistant women's basketball coach at Minnesota State. In addition to his coaching duties, he completed a master's degree in sports administration.

Roussell and hi<mark>s w</mark>ife, Molly, have an 11-year-old son, Riley, a seven-year-old daughter, Kelsey, and a four-year-old daughter, Kendall.




