Saint Louis is on a five-game losing streak after starting the season with three-straight wins. The Billikens lost back-to-back games to Miami (Ohio) before dropping contests to Davidson (3-1), Appalachian State (3-2 OT) and VCU (4-0). Demi Sahuleka leads the SLU offense with six goals and one assist for 13 points, including three game winning goals. Kendyl Underwood has made eight starts in goal for SLU, tallying 40 saves while allowing 14 goals.

About The Spiders

Richmond moved into the win column with a 1-0 road victory over Davidson. Sophomore Sutton Orndorff scored the game winner 55 seconds into the third quarter after driving past the Wildcat defense. Sophomore goalkeeper Erika Latta tallied a career-high five saves to collect her first career victory and shutout. UR held the upper hand in corners (8-4), while Davidson had the advantage in shots (10-9) and shots on goal (5-3).
