Against GW, Wright held their leading scorer to only one goal, while holding VCU's leading scorer without a goal for the first time this season. She also collected two ground balls and a caused turnover against GW and two caused turnovers against VCU. Leading the defense this year, she has helped the Spiders to a Top-20 national ranking of in goals against average, holding opponents to only average nine goals against the Spiders.

GEIERSBACH NAMED TO 2021 TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST

Sam Geiersbach has been named to the 2021 Tewaaraton Award Watch List, college lacrosse's highest honor, the Tewaaraton Foundation announced (March 11). This is Geiersbach second-straight season to be recognized for the honor.

GIANFORTE COLLECTS 600TH CAREER SAVE

With seven saves against George Washington (March 26), goalie Megan Gianforte collected and surpassed 600 career saves as a Spider. Her 606 total saves ranks second among active goalkeepers in Division I.

GEIERSBACH SCORES 150th GOAL IN SPIDER CAREER

With her five goals in the Spiders 19-2 win at Old Dominion (Mar. 14) Sam Geiersbach tallied her 150th career goal becoming one of the fastest Spiders to reach that mark in 53 games. She now sits sixth all time in program history with 155 career goals, fifth in assists with 92, and fifth with 247 total points.

DICENSO SELECTED FOR TEAM USA TRYOUTS

Sophomore midfielder **Sophia DiCenso** was selected to try out for the 2021 Women's National Team, the organization announced Oct. 19. DiCenso was one of 18 midfielders to garner an invitation and one of 50 of the nation's top players to make the tryout. Before starting into her collegiate career, DiCenso won gold as a member of the US Lacrosse Women's U19 Team at the 2019 World Lacrosse Championship. The tryouts were postponed as the World Lacrosse Championships were moved to June 29-July 9, 2022 in Towson, Maryland.

2020 SPIDER RECAP

Richmond's hot start to the 2020 season was abruptly halted on March 12, 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Off to the program's best start at 7-0, including a 13-12 overtime victory at No. 6 Virginia, it has been 345 days since the Spiders have taken the field to compete.

The Spiders finished the shortened season in all three national polls, including No. 10 in Maverik/Inside Lacrosse Media Poll, and No. 13 in the Nike/US Lacrosse Magazine Top-20.

Attacks **Sam Geiersbach** and **Arden Tierney** were named IL Honorable Mention All-America, while Tierney picked up IL All-Rookie Honors. 2020 Tewaaraton Award Watch List honoree Geiersbach paced the squad with 45 points with 22 goals and 23 assists. Tierney led the team with 60 draw controls and was second in the nation among goal-scoring freshmen with a team high 24 goals.

Goalkeeper **Megan Gianforte** finished fourth in the nation with a 7.69 goals-against average, corralled 45 saves while causing seven turnovers and picked up a team-leading 24 ground balls. 2020 Preseason All-Atlantic 10 honoree **Brittney Wright** tallied nine ground balls.

The Spiders' midfielder corps sees the return of **Madison Ostrick**, **Sophia DiCenso**, **Lindsey Frank** and **Marina Miller**. Frank paced the group with 26 draw controls, 14 assists and 10 goals while fellow sophomore DiCenso chipped in 16 draw controls, 13 ground balls and seven goals. Ostrick tallied 13 points with 10 goals and three assists and Miller tallied 11 goals and five assists with nine ground balls.
