About The Hawks

Saint Joseph's offense is paced by Stephanie Kelly's 43 goals with 38 assists for 81 points, 11 of 15 in free position attempts. Lauren Figura is second with 42 goals with seven assists for 49 points, while Sam McGee chipped in 32 goals and 13 assists for 45 point during the regular season. Julia Pash leads the Hawks with 77 draw controls, 32 ground balls and 20 caused turnovers as Melissa Semkiw picked up 25 ground balls, while corraling 109 saves for a .519 save percentage and allowing 101 goals for a 10.38 GAA.

About The Spiders

Richmond was named Atlantic 10 Conference Regular Season Co-Champions, sharing the title with UMass after both teams went undefeated in league play. The Spiders won the tiebreaker to be the No. 1 seed in the Championship. The Spiders are led offensively by Lindsey Frank, who ranks second in the league in goals per game with 3.09 and Sam Geiersbach who is third in the league in assists (2.11 per game) and points (4.33 per game). Arden Tierney leads the Spiders with 57 draw controls, 22 goals and 16 assists for 49 points. Goalkeeper Megan Gianforte allows 9.87 goals per game, which ranks third in the A-10 while Sarah Roycroft is eighth in the league with 13 caused turnovers.

ZIEMBA BREAKS ASSISTS SINGLE-GAME PROGRAM RECORD

In the Spiders win over George Mason (April 25), senior **Rachel Ziemba** dished out a new single-game program record eight assists, with seven in the first half. She broke Emily Doyle's 2012 record set against Temple.

FRANK, QUINN COLLECT FINAL A-10 WEEKLY HONORS OF SEASON

Sophomore **Lindsey Frank**, A-10 Player of the Week (April 26), led the team with eight goals on 11 shots on goal of 14 shot attempts. She also picked up a team-leading 14 draw controls. Her five goals and eight draw controls against George Mason matched both matched career highs from earlier this season.

Freshman **Marymargaret Quinn**, A-10 Rookie of the Week, scored three goals in UR's victories, two against Davidson and one against George Mason. Quinn's goals against Davidson came in huge moments, with her first to tie the game at 8-all at 24:38 in the second half. Her second goal against Davidson then put the Spiders up one at 11-10 at the 13:09 mark.

TIERNEY COLLECTS 100TH CAREER DRAW CONTROL

Sophomore **Arden Tierney** picked up seven draw controls against VCU (April 17) to tally 102 career draw controls in 15 games, the fastest Spider to reach that mark.

KWOLEK COLLECTS 100TH CAREER COACHING VICTORY

Head Coach **Allison Kwolek** picked up her 100th career victory against Davidson (April 23) to move to a 100-51 record in her ninth season at the helm of the Spiders Women's Lacrosse Program. She has guided the Spiders to six Atlantic 10 Championship finals appearances, two A-10 Tournament titles and two NCAA Tournament appearances.

GEIERSBACH, ROYCROFT COLLECT A-10 WEEKLY HONORS

Sam Geiersbach was named A-10 Offensive Player of the Week, while **Sarah Roycroft** collected A-10 Rookie of the Week. In the Spiders victories at VCU and at GMU, Geiersbach had seven goals and four assists for 11 points and one ground ball. The attacker also had 12 of her 15 shots on goal and went 2-for-3 for the weekend in free position goals. She led the UR offense with four goals, including the game winner, and three assists in the Spiders 19-13 win at VCU. She was second with three goals and one assist for four points and had one ground ball against Mason.

In two starts this week, Roycroft tallied a game-high three caused turnovers and three ground balls against Mason. The midfielder from Westwood, Mass., helped the UR defense to hold Mason to nine shots in the first half and only five on goal, and 13 shots (8 SOG) in the second half.

WRIGHT COLLECTS A-10 DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR

Brittney Wright was named Atlantic 10 Defensive Player of the Week March 30. Against GW, Wright held their leading scorer to only one goal, while holding VCU's leading scorer without a goal for the first time this season. She also collected two ground balls and a caused turnover against GW and two caused turnovers against VCU. Leading the defense this year, she has helped the Spiders to a Top-20 national ranking of in goals against average, holding opponents to only average nine goals against the Spiders.

GEIERSBACH NAMED TO 2021 TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST

Sam Geiersbach has been named to the 2021 Tewaaron Award Watch List, college lacrosse's highest honor, the Tewaaron Foundation announced (March 11). This is Geiersbach second-straight season to be recognized for the honor.

GIANFORTE COLLECTS 600TH CAREER SAVE

With seven saves against George Washington (March 26), goalie **Megan Gianforte** collected and surpassed 600 career saves as a Spider. Her 643 total saves ranks second among active goalkeepers in Division I. She is also second in the nation with 201 career ground balls.

GEIERSBACH SCORES 150TH GOAL IN SPIDER CAREER

With her five goals in the Spiders 19-2 win at Old Dominion (Mar. 14) **Sam Geiersbach** tallied her 150th career goal becoming one of the fastest Spiders to reach that mark in 53 games. She now sits sixth all time in program history with 158 career goals, fifth in assists with 93, and fifth with 251 total points.

TIERNEY BREAKS DRAW CONTROLS SINGLE-GAME PROGRAM RECORD

Sophomore attack **Arden Tierney** collected 13 draw controls in the Spiders' 19-10 victory over Radford, breaking Caroline Queally's 2018 record of 12 draws against LaSalle. She heads into the GW game with 90 career draw controls.
