What's On Tap . . .

The Spiders open the home portion of the 2022 schedule Saturday as they welcome in Saint Francis (Pa.) from the Northeast Conference into Robins Stadium ... Saturday's game marks the lone Spiders home non-conference game this season as they played at Virginia last week and travel to Lehigh next weekend.

Spiders Strong In Home Openers . . .

Richmond has been strong in home openers in program history, posting an 87-44-6 record all-time in such games ... The Spiders have won 16-straight home openers dating back to their last loss in 2005 (UMass) ... During that 16-game winning streak, the Spiders are out-scoring opponents by a 665-189 margin -- an average win of 42-12 ... Last season, the Spiders posted a 38-14 victory over Howard ... Richmond gained 530 yards of total offense with former Spider Joe Mancuso passing for 293 yards and a pair of scores ... The Spiders rushed for 226 yards with four different players going over the 50-yard mark.

In fact, the Spiders' current 16-game winning streak in home openers ranks fifth-best overall in the NCAA FCS level and tops in the Colonial Athletic Association ... North Dakota has won 35-straight home openers to lead the nation while North Dakota State (24), Harvard (20) and Montana (19) round out the top four.

Series History . . .

Saturday's game marks the second meeting all-time between Richmond and Saint Francis ... The teams played in Loretto, Pa., during the 2018 season -- a game that was originally scheduled for Robins Stadium but was moved due to the threat of Hurricane Florence ... The Spiders scored two touchdowns in the final 1.7 seconds of the game to take home a 35-27 victory over Saint Francis ... Kevin Johnson connected with Tyler Wilkins with 1.7 seconds remaining in the game for the go ahead touchdown and a 29-27 lead ... The Spiders scored another touchdown on the game's final play as Maurice Jackson scooped up a loose ball on a lateral and ran it in for the second touchdown in as many seconds on the clock.

Saturday's game also marks only the fourth game in program history against a current member of the Northeast Conference ... Richmond is 2-1 against current members, posting wins over Saint Francis in 2018 and Wagner in 2011 while falling to Duquesne in 1937.

Spiders Opener At Virginia . . .

Richmond opened the 2022 season on the road at Atlantic Coast Conference foe Virginia, falling 34-17 last Saturday ... The Spiders rushed for 170 yards in the loss with redshirt junior running back **Savon Smith** posting a career-high 88 yards, averaging 6.6 yards per carry against the Cavaliers ... Smith scored both of the Spiders' touchdowns in the game, rushing one in from eight yards out and catching a five-yard scored in the second half ... The Spiders' defense was stronger in the second half, limiting the Cavaliers to six points and forcing two turnovers after halftime ... Redshirt senior defensive back **Aaron Banks** notched his second career interception while redshirt senior linebacker **Phil O'Connor** forced a fumble in the third quarter of the contest.

Behind The Web . . .

The season premiere of Behind The Web with head football coach **Russ Huesman** is on tap for this Thursday, September 8, at the show's new home, Glory Days Grill, 10466 Ridgefield Parkway in the Glen-Eagles Shopping Center ... The program airs live from Noon-1pm on 106.1 ESPN, richmondspiders.com and espnrichmond.com ... This week's special player guest is defensive end **Jeremiah Grant** ... In his first career start Saturday at Virginia, the redshirt sophomore recorded career-highs with five tackles and two tackles for loss.

Oh Captain, My Captain . . .

The Spiders named three team captains at the end of the spring football camp for the 2022 season ... Redshirt senior running back **Aaron Dykes**, redshirt junior linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** and redshirt senior defensive lineman **Aidan Murray** were chosen by their teammates as leaders on the team ... Dykes has played in 30 career games for the Spiders, including 26 starts at running back ... He has made 16-straight starts at running back and has been the team's kick-off returner since his redshirt freshman year ... Wheeler has played in 28 games and has made 25-straight starts at linebacker – the most on the team ... Murray has played in 27 games in his career and has made 15-straight starts but will miss the 2022 season after suffering an Achilles tendon injury in early July ... Murray was on track to be named to the preseason All-Colonial Athletic Association team prior to the injury.

The Spiders will name one special teams' captain for each game this season to join Dykes and Wheeler at the coin toss ... Linebacker **Wayne Galloway** was the captain in the first game of the year at Virginia.

Tackling Machine . . .

Redshirt junior linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** is one of the top defensive players in all of NCAA FCS Football ... Wheeler has been a force since he stepped on to campus, starting 25-straight games at linebacker ... He opened the season with a bang against Virginia, posting a career-high 19 tackles ... He enters Saturday's with 275 career tackles, including back-to-back 100-plus tackle seasons in his past two full seasons of football (2019 & 2021) ... Wheeler ranks seventh in NCAA FCS Football among tacklers with 275 total tackles ... He trails only Robby Hauck (Montana, 373), Brennan Young (Houston Baptist, 327), Ryan Greenhagen (Fordham, 320), Dan Damico (Villanova, 303), Nathan East (Samford, 284) and Jacob Dobbs (Holy Cross, 277).

Parker Produces . . .

Sophomore defensive back **Bryson Parker** had a strong season opener against Virginia ... Parker finished the game second on the team with 11 tackles off the bench, including six solo tackles ... He also led the team with two pass breakups from the safety position ... Parker's 11 tackles surpasses his season total of nine tackles in 11 games last season as a reserve.

QB1 With The Gun . . .

Graduate transfer quarterback **Reece Udinski** has put up impressive numbers in his collegiate career, playing at both VMI and Maryland ... Udinski spent most of his playing career with the Keydets, finishing his career connecting on 783-of-1,268 passing for 7,877 yards and 48 passing touchdowns at VMI ... He finished his VMI career after 39 games as a Keydet as the program's all-time leading passer and ranking sixth all-time in Southern Conference history.

Udinski enters Saturdays game with 8,037 passing yards in NCAA FCS play ranking second among all current quarterbacks in FCS football ... He trails only Tim DeMorat from Forham who has 8,956 in his career ... Udinski has 8,120 total career passing yards, taking into account his time at Maryland.

Udinski's best season came in 2019 when he passed for 3,276 yards on 306-of-479 passing ... He finished the year with 19 touchdowns while only throwing five interceptions all season ... His 3,276 yards passing in the Air Raid offense set a VMI single-season passing record while his completion percentage of 63.9 percent was the best in program history ... He opened the year with an FCS-record 368 consecutive passes without an interception and posted 11 games with 200 yards passing or more ... Udinski also spent the 2021 season as the backup quarterback at Maryland, appearing in four games for the Terrapins, including the Pinstripe Bowl victory over Virginia Tech ... He finished the year 11-of-15 for 100 yards and a touchdown.

Keydet Connection ...

Joining Udinski as a Spider this season is his former VMI teammate and wide receiver **Jakob Herres** ... Herres comes to the Spiders as one of the most decorated wide receivers in NCAA FCS Football ... He has caught 228 receptions for 3,030 yards and 26 touchdowns through the air ... He ranks first in NCAA FCS Football in career receptions, second in career receiving yards and third in receiving touchdowns among active NCAA FCS wide receivers.

Herres' best season came in the spring 2021 season when he helped the Keydets make the NCAA FCS Playoffs ... He was named the SoCon Offensive Player of the Year and was a consensus First Team All-America selection ... He was one of 16 finalists for the Stats Perform Walter Payton Award, given to the national FCS Offensive Player of the Year ... He finished fourth overall in the voting for the Walter Payton Award and was named the Virginia Offensive Player of the Year by the Touchdown Club of Richmond ... Herres led the SoCon with 80 receptions for 978 yards and eight touchdowns in eight games ... He averaged 12.2 yards per catches and 122.2 yards per game, both numbers leading the SoCon.

Coming At You Fast ...

Redshirt senior **Aaron Dykes** is one of the most dangerous kickoff returners in NCAA FCS Football ... Dykes, a two-time First Team All-Colonial Athletic Association selection, enters 2022 second among all returning FCS kick returners with three career kickoff returns for touchdown and ranks fourth among all returners with 1,501 kickoff return yards ... Last season, Dykes averaged 27.3 yards per kickoff return, ranking second all-time in program history in a single season, trailing only Justin Rogers' 30.4 yard average in 2004.

Dykes has returned three kickoffs for touchdowns in his career ... He posted a 98-yard return last fall against Villanova and recorded two returns for touchdowns against Delaware in 2019 – both in the first half of the Spiders' victory.

Walter Payton Award Watch List ...

Graduate quarterback **Reece Udinski** and graduate wide receiver **Jakob Herres** have been named two of the 35 players selected on the pre-season Walter Payton Award Watch List, which Stats Perform presents to the national offensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision ... Udinski and Herres are two of only three CAA Football student-athletes (Juwana Farri, RB, Monmouth) on the initial watch list and the only quarterback and wide receiver from the conference chosen ...

The Spiders are one of just five programs in the country that has multiple members on the preseason watch list, joining the likes of South Dakota State (3), Montana State (2), UIW (2) and Stephen F. Austin (2).

Buck Buchanan Award Watch List . . .

Redshirt junior linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** has been named one of the 35 players selected on the preseason Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, which Stats Perform presents to the national defensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision ... Wheeler is one of four players from the Colonial Athletic Association honored on the watch list and the only CAA linebacker on the list ... Wheeler was a Buck Buchanan Award Watch List honoree last fall and has posted back-to-back full seasons with over 100 tackles ... He was a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award during the shortened spring season in 2021 after posting 38 tackles in four games.

Preseason All-America . . .

The Spiders placed two members on the preseason Stats Perform All-America team this fall ... Redshirt junior linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** and graduate wide receiver **Jakob Herres** both picked up the honors ... Wheeler and Herres are the only linebacker and wide receiver on any of the three teams representing CAA Football.

Transfer Tracker . . .

Richmond dipped into the transfer portal this offseason, bringing in five transfers to the program, four of which came on the offensive side ... Graduate quarterback **Reece Udinski** joined the program from VMI/Maryland while graduate wide receiver **Jakob Herres** came in from VMI ... Redshirt junior offensive tackler **Derek Ferraro** came in from Rice, redshirt sophomore wide receiver **Nick DeGennaro** moved over from Maryland and redshirt freshman defensive tackle **Matei Fitz** transferred in from James Madison ... All five of the transfers are listed in the two-deep for Saturday's game.

Young Guys In Back . . .

Last year, the Spiders started at least one true freshmen or redshirt freshmen in every game last season and six times had both positions starting with first or second year players. Redshirt sophomore **Aamir Hall** started all 11 games last season leading the team with 12 pass breakups, the most by any non-upperclassman in the Colonial Athletic Association ... Hall has played in 16 career games with 15-straight starts at the

boundary corner ... Sophomore **Angelo Rankin** started six games at field corner last fall, making his first career interception at Stony Brook ... Rankin played in 10 games total last season ... Sophomore **Bryson Parker** also played in 11 games last season in the defensive backfield at corner before moving over to the safety position this offseason.

The Spiders aren't all young in the defensive backfield though as redshirt senior cornerback **Tyrek Funderbuk** has appeared in 28 games with 11 starts at corner ... Redshirt senior safety **Aaron Banks** has played in 28 games with 14 starts, including eight-straight, while redshirt junior safety **Gio Seigler** has appeared in 15 games.

New Look Offense . . .

Head coach **Russ Huesman** made a big change in his coaching staff in the offseason, making a change at offensive coordinator and bringing in **Billy Cosh** to take over an offense that ranked sixth in the Colonial Athletic Association in scoring in 2021 ... Cosh comes to Richmond after spending four seasons at VMI, including the past two as offensive coordinator ... Cosh's offense, dubbed the Air Raid Offense, finished in the top 20 in the country in numerous categories and top two in the SoCon in seven offensive marks ... The Keydets ranked 20th in the nation in scoring offense (29.2), 18th in passing efficiency (144.77), 17th in total offense (427.6 yards), ninth in passing offense (309.4 yards) and fifth in total first downs (201).

Replacing Defensive Line . . .

The Spiders had one of the top defensive lines in Colonial Athletic Association Football last season with two All-Conference selections and a third that was in line for preseason All-Conference accolades this season ... Richmond will have to replace all three of those performers this season though ... All-Conference selection Darius Reynolds led the team with 9.5 sacks and 13.0 tackles for loss in his final year of eligibility ... All-Conference defensive tackle Kobie Turner added 3.0 sacks and 10.5 tackles for loss before transferring to Wake Forest for his final year of eligibility ... Captain **Aidan Murray** added 5.0 sacks and 7.5 tackles for loss and was in line for the leading role this year before suffering a season-ending Achilles injury in the summer ... Defensive ends **Jeremiah Grant** and **Marlem Louis** lead the returning healthy players with 4.5 and 4.0 tackles for loss last season, respectively ... Defensive tackles **Carsen Stocklinski** and **Matei Fitz** made their collegiate debuts last weekend against Virginia.

Familiar #BossHawgs . . .

The Spider offensive line has two long-time starters to replace in Tim Coleman and Clayton McConnell but bring a wealth of experience back to the team with 60 career starts for the Spiders ... Redshirt senior tackle **Joe More** has played in 31 games with 27 starts, including 18-straight ... Redshirt junior guard **Cade Salyers** is second on the offensive line with 27 career games played and 17 starts, including 16-straight starts ... Redshirt junior tackle **Ryan Coll** has played in 25 career games with 19 career starts, making 12-straight with most of his career games at offensive line being played next to Salyers ... Redshirt junior center **Tom Elia** has played in 16 career games, making his first career start last weekend at Virginia.

Redshirt junior offensive lineman **Gavin Lamp** was penciled in as the starting left tackle this season but Lamp suffered a season-ending ACL injury last week leading up to the Virginia game.

Redshirt freshman **Carsen Stocklinski** spent the 2021 season in the offensive line room, learning behind a very deep squad in his first year in college ... During this past offseason with the Spiders becoming thin at defensive line after the injury to **Aidan Murry** in July, the coaching staff approached Stocklinski about switching sides of the ball ... He eagerly accepted after playing both offensive and defensive line in high school and seeing an opportunity in front of him this year on the defensive line ... Stocklinski has worked hard in the transition and finds himself in the two-deep heading into the season opener at Virginia ... He earned All-Conference and All-County honors on both sides of the football in high school at Oconoe County in Georgia.

Phil-Er-Up . . .

Redshirt senior linebacker **Phil O'Connor** has patiently waited for his time to come, sitting behind a pair of All-Conference linebackers in **Tristan Wheeler** and recently graduated Tyler Dressler ... O'Connor makes his way into starting lineup this year and has played in 19 games in his career ... He started the final five games of the year last season with the Spiders went 4-1 and played a vital role in all five games ... He posted a career-high 11 tackles in his first career start at Stony Brook ... In the final four games of the year, all he did was post three sacks, force two fumbles and record 18 tackles ... O'Connor was strong in the season opener against Virginia, notching seven tackles and forcing a second half fumble.

Iron Spiders . . .

Entering Saturday's game, redshirt senior offensive lineman **Joe More** leads the team with 31 career games played, including 27 starts ... Both those numbers lead the current Spiders while redshirt senior running back **Aaron Dykes** is second on the team with 30 games played in his career and 26 starts ... Redshirt junior linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** leads the team with 25-straight starts in his career ... More is second on the team with 18-straight starters while Dykes is third at 16 ... Redshirt sophomore cornerback **Aamir Hall** has started 15-straight games.

Returning Pass Catchers . . .

While Richmond has brought in some transfer wide receivers this offseason, the Spiders return five out of their top six pass catchers from last year's team ... Redshirt sophomore **Jasiah Williams** led the team last season

with 42 receptions for 448 yards ... Williams averaged 4.7 receptions per game last year ... Graduate wide receiver **Leroy Henley** led the team with 459 yards receiving on 35 catches and three touchdowns ... Redshirt senior running back **Aaron Dykes** added 25 catches for 309 yards and a team-high four receiving touchdowns ... Redshirt junior running back **Savon Smith** added 18 catches for 125 yards while redshirt sophomore tight end **Connor Deveney** chipped in 16 catches for 159 yards and two scores.

Leg From Baltimore . . .

Redshirt junior placekicker **Jake Larson** has been the Spiders' kicker since he stepped on campus in 2019 ... Larson has appeared in 27 games in his career, connecting on 33-of-44 field goals in his career ... His 33 career made field goals is tied for seventh overall among returning NCAA FCS placekickers, including a career-best 17 made field goals as a freshman in 2019 ... He has connected on 70-of-73 of his career extra point attempts.

Punter From Down Under . . .

Junior punter **Aaron Trusler** is one of 22 names selected to the FCS Punter of the Year Award Preseason Watch List, which honors the nation's top collegiate punter in the FCS ... The Augusta Sports Council, also home to the Ray Guy Award (awarded to the best collegiate punter in the FBS), created the FCS Punter of the Year Award in 2019 to honor the best collegiate punter playing in the FCS ... Last season, Trusler averaged 40.2 yards per punt with four coming in at over 50 yards ... In 57 attempts in 2021, the junior covered 2,289 yards and stuck 19 inside the opposing team's 20-yard line ... His career-long came against James Madison last year when he recorded a 62-yarder.

Spiders Close Year On Winning Streak . . .

Richmond closed out the 2021 season winning four-straight games to finish the year with a winning record at 6-5 ... The Spiders posted wins at New Hampshire, against Towson, Delaware and at William & Mary ... The four-game winning streak was the longest winning streak for the Spiders since winning five in a row in the 2016 season ... The victory also secured the Spiders first winning season since 2017 and gave them momentum heading into the offseason.

New Faces On The Sideline . . .

Head coach **Russ Huesman** has a bunch of new faces on the sideline on his coaching staff this season ... **Billy Cosh** has been brought in as the new offensive coordinator

while Richmond alum **Winston October** is the new wide receivers coach ... **Chris Ellis** is the new defensive ends coach while **Justin Poindexter** is the new running backs coach ... **Dave Legg** has come on as the recruiting coordinator ... **Cody Gray** has returned as a defensive assistant while **Will Ahrens** and **Sam Karn** are defensive and offensive graduate assistant coaches, respectively.

Preseason CAA Poll . . .

The Spiders were picked to finish fourth in the preseason Colonial Athletic Association poll by the league head coaches ... Defending conference co-champion Villanova was picked to finish first overall in the preseason poll with 270 points and 16 out of 26 votes ... Delaware was picked second with 235 points (7 first place) while Rhode Island was third at 224 points ... Richmond came in fourth at 219 points, followed by William & Mary (206), Elon (191), Stony Brook (151), Maine (134), New Hampshire (117), Monmouth (105), Towson (81), UAlbany (64) and Hampton (31) ... This marks the first year in the CAA for both Monmouth and Hampton.

Two Honored on Preseason Team . . .

The Spiders placed two on the preseason All-Colonial Athletic Association Team ... Earning preseason All-Conference honors for the Spiders were redshirt senior kick returner **Aaron Dykes** and redshirt junior linebacker **Tristan Wheeler** ... Both Dykes and Wheeler are two of the Spiders' three team captains this season.

Dykes is a two-time All-CAA selection as a kick returner, earning First Team All-CAA honors last fall ... He enters 2022 second among all returning FCS kick returners with three career kickoff returns for touchdown and ranks fourth among all returners with 1,501 kickoff return yards ... Last season, Dykes averaged 27.3 yards per kickoff return, ranking second all-time in program history in a single season, trailing only Justin Rogers' 30.4 yard average in 2004.

Wheeler is a three-time All-CAA selection, including back-to-back First Team All-Conference accolades ... He was named Second Team All-America by Stats Perform last fall and was a First Team Sophomore All-America honoree by HERO Sports ... He led the team and the CAA in total tackles in the regular season with 114. He ranked eighth in the nation in total tackles and tackles per game (10.4) ... He enters the season with 256 total tackles in 27 career games.

SIXTH SEASON
CHATTANOOGA, 1983**

Russ Huesman is in his sixth season as head coach of the University of Richmond football program and his 14th season overall as a collegiate head coach in the fall of 2022. This is Huesman's second stint with the Spiders after spending five seasons (2004-08) as an assistant coach, including the 2008 National Championship team.

In his 30-plus years of coaching, Huesman has coached 48 All-Americans and 21 NFL Draft Picks, while being a part of nine conference championships and the 2008 National Championship with the Spiders. He has spent 23 years coaching in the Colo-

nia Athletic Association, bringing a wealth of experience to the Spiders.

Last fall, the Spiders closed out the year winning four-straight games to finish the season with a 6-5 overall record. Richmond posted wins down the stretch over New Hampshire, Towson, Delaware and rival William & Mary. The win over UNH on the road marked the first victory for the Spiders in Durham since 2000 while the win over William & Mary gave the Spiders the lead in the all-time series 64-63-5. The Spiders placed seven on the Colonial Athletic Association All-Conference teams, including five First Team All-CAA honors in Tristan Wheeler, Tyler Dressler, Kobie Turner, Clayton McConnell and Aaron Dykes.

During the unconventional spring 2021 season, the Spiders posted a 3-1 record in the shortened CAA season that saw Richmond nationally ranked for most of the season. The Spiders finished the year No. 14 in the country and were third in the CAA standings with a 3-1 record. Defensive lineman Kobie Turner was named the CAA Co-Defensive Player of the Year while eight Spiders earned All-Conference accolades. Richmond also won the CAA Team Academic Award for the first time in program history, despite battling the COVID-19 pandemic.

In 2019, the Spiders finished the year 5-7 overall and 4-4 in Colonial Athletic Association play. Richmond picked up three victories against nationally ranked opponents, including a pair of them coming on the road. The Spiders defeated No. 18 Maine and No. 19 Delaware on the road while knocking off No. 20 Stony Brook at home at Robins Stadium. Freshman linebacker Tristan Wheeler was named the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year and was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award, given annually to the top freshman in all of NCAA FCS. Wheeler was joined by Aaron Dykes as Freshmen All-America selections in 2019 while the Spiders placed eight on the postseason All-CAA teams.

Huesman led the Spiders in 2018 through a tough, injury-riddled season. Richmond's defensive line was the top unit in the Colonial Athletic Conference, leading the league with 23.5 sacks. Junior Maurice Jackson led the CAA in sacks and earned All-America honors for his play. Senior Andrew Clyde earned All-Conference honors for his third-straight year, becoming the first Spider to start every game of his collegiate career.

Huesman returned to Richmond in 2017 and guided the Spiders to a 6-5 record. The Spiders had 11 different players earn All-CAA honors, led by the Offensive Player of the Year Kyle Lauletta. He became the first Richmond player to win Offensive Player of the Year since Greg Lilly in 1992. Lauletta led the CAA with 3,737 yards, 28 passing TDs and 3,827 yards of total offense and was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award.

Joining Lauletta on the All-CAA First Team were Alex Light (OL), Garrett Hudson (TE), Dejon Brissett (WR), Griffin Trau (PK) and Andrew Clyde (DL). The All-CAA Second Team included Tyler Wilkins (WR) and Cortrelle Simpson (WR), while Brandon Waller (DL), Justin Rubin (LB) and John Yarbrough (OL) were all named to the All-CAA Third Team.

Prior to returning to Richmond, Huesman spent eight tremendously successful

seasons at Chattanooga. He was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year three times (2009, 2013, 2014) and was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year three times.

In his eight seasons at Chattanooga, Huesman helped guide the Mocs to a 59-37 record, including a 36-16 mark in his last four seasons (2013-16), which featured three Southern Conference regular season championships. Chattanooga was one of only 10 programs in the country to reach the FCS Playoffs each year from 2014-16. The Mocs were also just one of four programs in the country to post a playoff win during that time.

In his eight seasons, the Mocs had at least seven players named to the All-SoCon team every year, including a school-record 17 honorees in 2014. Prior to Huesman's arrival, the Mocs had not boasted seven members of any All-SoCon team since 1979.

Chattanooga had 17 All-America honorees and three NFL draft picks with DB Buster Skrine (Cleveland – 2011), QB B.J. Coleman (Green Bay – 2012) and LB Davis Tull (New Orleans – 2015) over eight-year period.

Huesman's first stop at Richmond came from 2004-08 as defensive coordinator molding the Spiders' defensive unit into one of the best in the country. In his final year at Richmond, the national championship season, the Spiders led the country in interceptions and finished in the top-10 in four other defensive categories.

Under Huesman's guidance, the Spiders had 23 All-Conference selections, including former NFL standouts Lawrence Sidbury, Jr. and Justin Rogers. During his five-year period as an assistant coach, the Spiders posted a 42-23 (.646) record and played in the FCS Playoffs three times with a quarterfinal appearance in 2005, a semifinal appearance in 2007 and the National Championship in 2008.

Prior to his time with the Spiders, Huesman spent six years at the University of Memphis (1998-03), where he held several positions, serving as the recruiting coordinator and offensive line coach. He also coached the outside linebackers, tight ends and running backs. As recruiting coordinator, Huesman brought in a Top 50 recruiting class, ranked No. 1 in Conference USA, in 2002. It was the first recruiting class ranked in the Top 50 at Memphis.

Huesman also coached for 13 years at William & Mary (1985-97), both with the defense and special teams. During his time in Williamsburg, Huesman coached Steve Christie, a 15-year NFL place kicker with Tampa Bay, Buffalo, San Diego and the New York Giants. His coaching family tree also includes Mike Tomlin, head coach of the Pittsburgh Steelers, Sean McDermott, the head coach of the Buffalo Bills and Alan Williams, the former defensive backs coach of the Detroit Lions. All three played for Huesman at William & Mary.

Huesman's success on the gridiron is not limited to just coaching as he was a standout player at perennial power Moeller High School in his native town of Cincinnati, Ohio. He helped Moeller's team compile a record of 43-0-1 and win a pair of Ohio state championships.

An all-city selection in football as a senior, Huesman signed a football scholarship with Chattanooga, where he started all four years as a defensive back (1978-81) and was a two-sport athlete. During his playing career with the Mocs, he helped UTC to a 31-11-2 mark and two Southern Conference championships. Huesman also patrolled center field on the baseball diamond for the Mocs during his freshman and junior seasons.

Huesman was on the Mocs' sidelines for the 1982 season as a student coach, earning his degree in business education in 1983. He followed that up with a move to the University of South Carolina as a graduate assistant under the late Joe Morrison.
