

SERIES HISTORY VS GARDNER-WEBB

The matchup with the Runnin' Bulldogs marks the second meeting all-time between the two teams. Previously, the Spiders defeated GWU 85-73 on 12/4/20 inside the Robins Center. In the game, Addie Budnik recorded seven points while Grace Townsend recorded 14 and Siobhan Ryan posted 13, all in their freshmen campaigns.

ENTERING THE GAME

The Spiders played host to Delaware State on Sunday and ran away with a dominating 105-44 win over the Hornets inside the Robins Center. The team's 105 points scored was the first 100+ point win inside the Robins Center since Dec. 11, 2022, against Longwood. Following the game, Addie Budnik (1,133 pts) surpassed Jade Clarke (1,130 pts) to become the 17th leading scorer for the Spiders in program history. In addition, Melissa Mwanza and Courtney Swider recorded their first career-points while Ally Sweeney recorded her first three career assists and Siobhan Ryan paced the team with 15 points and ended the game shooting 5 of 8 from the field, 3 of 5 from deep and 2 of 3 from the line. Budnik and Rachel Ullstrom also ended the game in double figures. Grace Townsend was just shy of a double-double with eight rebounds and 11 points. The game also marked the first time the Spiders had five or more players score in double figures since 2/25/23 against St. Bonaventure.

BUDNIK NAMED TO KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LIST

Senior Addie Budnik was selected to the Katrina McClain Award Watch List, featuring 20 of the best power forwards in the country, the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association announced on Thursday.

The senior is coming off a stellar junior season, leading the Spiders to a deep postseason run, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Conference Championship semifinals for the first time since 2008-09, and an appearance in the WNIT, the team's first since 2014-15.

Last season, Budnik was named to VaSID Academic All-State Team, A-10 All-Academic Team, A-10 All-Conference Second Team and A-10 All-Championship Team. In addition, she reached the 1,000-career point mark against St. Bonaventure to become the 27th Spider to reach the milestone. Budnik also paced the team, averaging 14 points per game and led the team with 61 blocks.

SPIDERS NO. 4 IN 2023-24 A-10 PRESEASON POLL

With the highest pick since the 2012-13 season, the University of Richmond Women's Basketball team was selected fourth in the 2023-24 Atlantic 10 Women's Basketball Preseason Poll. In addition, senior Addie Budnik and sophomore Maggie Doogan were named to the Preseason First Team and Second Team, respectively. The conference unveiled the poll and preseason ahead of A-10 Media Day at the Henrico Sports & Event Center.

Budnik, with the Preseason First-Team selection, is coming off a stellar junior campaign in 2022-23 as she was the team's leading scorer, averaging 14 ppg and collecting 5.5 rebounds per game. She became the 27th Spider to eclipse the 1,000-point milestone last season as well as being named to the VaSID Academic All-State Team, A-10 All-Academic Team, A-10 All-Conference Second Team and to the A-10 All-Championship Team. Budnik was also named to the Preseason First-Team in 2022-23 following her sophomore season in 2021-22.

Doogan received Second-Team honors as the sophomore was the second-leading scorer last season, averaging 11.5 ppg and led the team in rebounds averaging six boards per contest. In addition, she ended 2022-23 with A-10 All-Rookie team accolades as well as an A-10 All-Conference Third team selection and was named A-10 Rookie of the Week twice (1/23/23, 1/30/23) during the season.

GRADUATE TRANSFERS LAREN VANARSDALE AND FAYE PARKER

VanArsdale, a Powder Springs, Ga. native, joins the Spiders from Hampton University. The 5'3" guard averaged 13.3 points, 2.5 rebounds and 32.3 minutes over four years with the Lady Pirates. After suffering an injury during the 2020-21 season, she returned to the court and played in 17 games with 11 starts during the 2022-23 season and averaged 8.4

Parker, a Swampscott, Mass. native and a transfer from Penn, played in 20 games in 2022-23 for the Quakers, starting in one, averaged 4.9 minutes per game, totaling 35 rebounds, 15 points, 12 blocks, four assists, and two steals, scored a season-high five points against Princeton (3/3), had a career-high seven rebounds against Richmond (3/16) during first round of WNIT and had a season-high three blocks against Princeton (3/3) and Richmond (3/16).

ANNA CAMDEN TO MISS 2023-24 SEASON DUE TO KNEE INJURY

Graduate transfer Anna Camden will miss the 2023-24 season due to a knee injury suffered during a team workout over the summer, the team announced on June 25, 2023. Camden, a transfer from Penn State, played in 28 games with seven starts in 2022-23 and tallied 32 boards, 18 assists and 15 steals in her senior season with the Nittany Lions. She was also named to the Academic All-Big Ten Team and the College Sports Communicators Academic All-District Team.

ROUSSELL NAMES ARIEL STEPHENSON AS ASSISTANT WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH

Ariel Stephenson (Wake Forest, 19) joins the Spiders following a twoyear stint with Davidson, where she spent the 2021-22 season as the Wildcat's Director of Player Development and was promoted to Director of Basketball Operations ahead of the 2022-23 season. In her first year as a Wildcat, she helped the team go 18-15 in addition to a trip to the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) while in 2022-23, the Wildcats went 14-16 and picked up a first-round win in the Atlantic 10 Championship.

ROUSSELL NAMES ALEX LOUIN AS ASSISTANT WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH

Alex Louin (Villanova, '18) brings a wealth of playing and coaching experience to the staff. Most recently, Louin finished a year-long stint as the assistant basketball coach at the University of North Carolina-Wilmington. Prior to her time in North Carolina, she spent one season with the Fordham Men's Basketball program as a player development coach. She has experience playing professionally with Luxemborg's BBX Grengewald Hueschert and in the Finnish leagues with Torpan Pojat (ToPo). In Luxembourg, Louin was a first-team All-Total League Champion and capped off her time with a deep buzzer-beating three to win the league championship in 2018. With ToPo, Louin led the country in scoring at 28 ppg, was named first-team All-League and Foreign Player of the Year, being the only American player on the team.

HEAD COACH AARON ROUSSELL

FIFTH SEASON AT RICHMOND (IOWA '01)
Roussell enters his fifth season at the helm of the Spiders in 2023-24. He was named head coach on April 2, 2019 and has 19 years of head coaching experience to match a career winning percentage of .686 with an overall record of 377-173.

In 2022-23, Roussell led the Spiders to a record-breaking season, including a record-breaking victory over Longwood on Dec. 11, 2022, where the Spiders saw a 119-55 score line. The 119-point output marked a new women's basketball program record of points scored at the Robins Center, eclipsing the 115-point total against American, scored on Jan. 28, 2000. In addition, Rousell led the team to its highest seed in the Atlantic 10 Championship since the 2014-15 season. As the No. 5 seed, the Spiders defeated No. 12 Dayton and No. 4 Fordham enroute to the team's first appearance in the A-10 Championship semifinal game since 2008-09 where the Spiders ultimately fell to No. 1 UMass. The Spider appearance in the A-10 semifinals marked the first appearance for the Spiders since the 2008-09 season. the 2008-09 season.

Richmond also accepted a bid into the WNIT, marking the team's first appearance in the tournament since the 2014-15 season. The team opened the tournament with a 75-52 victory over Penn inside the Robins Center before falling to Rhode Island in the WNIT second round. Roussell coached Addie Budnik to All-Conference Second Team Honors, All-Championship team honors and All-Academic team honors while Maggie Doogan was named to the All-Conference Third team and the All-Rookie team. Richmond finished the season second in the A-10 in field-goal percentage (44.1%), defensive rebounds per game (28.6), three-point percentage (34.9%) and three-pointers per game (8.2).

In year three with the Spiders, Roussell saw his best statistical season offensively at Richmond. The team ranked first in the Atlantic 10 in field goal percentage, effective field goal percentage and two-point percentage while ranking second in three-point percentage and points per game and third in assists.

The Spiders finished the 2021-22 season 16-14 overall featuring an eight-game win streak that saw a 2-0 mark in the Florida Atlantic Pre-Christmas Tournament and a buzzer-beating win at A-10 opponent George Washington. The season was also highlighted by a Power 5 win as the Spiders defeated Virginia, 74-65, at the Cavalier Classic.

Additionally in 2021-22, Roussell coached Emma Squires to A-10 Sixth Woman of the Year honors while Addie Budnik was named All-Conference Second Team.

During year two, Roussell finished the season with a 13-9 record, advancing to the A-10 Quarterfinals for the second-straight season. Roussell led the Spiders to another postseason win against 11th-seeded George Washington, winning 58-54 in overtime. In two seasons at Richmond, Roussell has dramatically improved the offensive numbers for the Spiders having moved up 160 spots nationally in offensive rating, 171 spots in field goal percentage and 203 spots in assists per game.

He helped coach Addie Budnik to becoming the school's first-ever Atlantic 10 Freshman of the Year and was a finalist for Freshman of the Year by World Exposure Report. Roussell also helped Kate Klimkiewicz lead the A-10 in three-pointers made (49) and was named A-10 All-Conference Second Team and earned CoSIDA Academic All-District 3 honors. He also started 5-0 in A-10 play on the road for the first time in school history and continued to win at the Robins Center, going 6-2 at home in 2020-21. Through two seasons, Richmond was 13-7 (.650) in home games at the Robins Center.

In his first season as a Spider, Roussell led the team to 15 wins, which was a six-win improvement from its previous season and it was the fourth most wins by a first-year coach in school history. Richmond had the highest rated schedule in the A-10 and finished with 11 games against teams in the top-100 RPI. Roussell also helped senior forward Jaide Hinds-Clarke earn A-10 All-Conference honors after leading the team in scoring at 11.8 points per game and hit 23 three-pointers after not hitting any during her previous three seasons.

The Spiders were much improved in year one under Roussell going from 275 in the RPI to 125 last season (+150 increase). That mark was eighth-best nationally and best among first-year coaches. Richmond also had the most improved offense in the Atlantic 10 scoring 6.4 more points per game. The Spiders had three players in the top 11 in three-point shooting, the only A-10 school to do so. Richmond was second in the A-10 in 3-point improvement this past season.

Roussell led Richmond to eight road victories in his first season after only one road win in 2018-19. The Spiders also won a road game in the Atlantic 10 Championship first round at George Washington to secure a postseason win for the first time since the 2017-18 season. Roussell guided sophomore guard Claire Holt to a breakout season after she averaged 10.9 points per game and hit 46 three-pointers last year. Holt averaged 5.2 points per game and hit 21 three-pointers in her freshman season.

Roussell had seven highly successful seasons at Bucknell, including a 102-30 (.773) mark over the final four years. He led Bucknell to six-straight winning seasons and four-straight years of 22 wins or more. The Bison's 102 wins from 2015-19 are the most in a four-year span in the history of the Patriot League and they also posted a 64-8 (.889) league record in that period.

During that time, Bucknell advanced to the postseason four-straight years with a pair of NCAA Tournament and WNIT appearances. Roussell guided Bucknell to a program-record 12-game winning streak in 2016-17, 2017-18 2018-19 and a program-record 29-game home winning streak. His Bison teams posted a 84-20 (.807) record on their home court during his seven-year tenure as head coach.

The Bison won the Patriot League title and the top seed in the tournament in 2018-19 after sweeping second-seed-ed American and third-seeded Lehigh. Bucknell had its best offensive season in program history, setting program single-season records in points scored (2,462), field goals (875), 3-pointers (283) and assists (529).

Bucknell's four-straight postseason appearances is the best run in program history. Roussell led the Bison to a 22-10 record in 2017-18, including a 15-3 mark in league play, finishing second in the standings. Bucknell accepted an invitation to the WNIT and played at West Virginia to cap the season.

Roussell had a banner year in 2016-17 as well for the Bison, leading the team to a 27-6 overall record and a 16-2 mark in Patriot League play. He won the Patriot League regular season and tournament titles in impressive fashion, while earning his second Patriot League Coach of the Year award. The Bison earned the No. 14 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2017, facing off against third-seeded Maryland.

Bucknell's postseason run started in 2015-16 with a then program-record 25-8 overall record and a 17-1 league mark. The Bison tied for the Patriot League regular season crown and he earned his first league Coach of the Year honor. Bucknell was invited to the WNIT and won the program's and the Patriot League's first-ever postseason game with a victory at Akron, before falling to Michigan on the road in the second round.

Much of Roussell's success at Bucknell was a result of his ability to quickly develop talent and meld it with the team's veteran players. Under this guidance, Bucknell earned three Patriot League Rookie of the Year award winners from 2014-16 and one of those student-athletes – Claire DeBoer – went on to earn Patriot League Player of the Year accolades in 2016-17.

Prior to his time at Bucknell, Roussell spent eight years (2004-2012) as the highly successful head coach at the University of Chicago where he compiled a 161-50 (.763) record, including a 52-5 mark with a 43-game regular season winning streak over his last two seasons leading the Maroons.

In addition to their success on the hardwood, Roussell's teams at the University of Chicago, one of the most prestigious academic institutions in the nation, have also excelled in the classroom. His 2010-11 team combined for a 3.36 grade-point average and in his last season, Taylor Simpson of Chicago was awarded the Jostens Trophy, given to the most outstanding Division III women's basketball student-athlete based on basketball ability, academic success and community

Prior to Roussell's arrival at Chicago in September 2004, the Maroons had never appeared in the national rankings. But they were listed in the ESPN/WBCA and D3hoops.com top-25 polls in each of the last seven years under his tutelage. The program was ranked No. 1 in the nation in the ESPN/WBCA Coaches' Poll in 2006-07, and his 2011-12 team was ranked No. 2 for most of the campaign. Roussell was the UAA Coach of the Year in 2008, 2011 and 2012, and he was the WBCA Regional Coach of the Year in 2011 and 2012.

Roussell coached six of the 10 1,000-point scorers in program history, he mentored 15 different all-conference performers in eight seasons and had players earn All-America honors in 2005, 2011 and 2012. His teams posted a higher victory total than the previous season in seven of his eight years at Chicago.

Roussell is a 2001 graduate of the University of Iowa, where he double-majored in journalism/mass communications and political science. In 2002 he began a two-year stint as a graduate assistant women's basketball coach at Minnesota State. In addition to his coaching duties, he completed a master's degree in sports administration.

His first coaching experience came at the high school level, where he was the boys' varsity assistant coach and head JV coach at Breck High School in Minneapolis, Minn., in 2001-02.


