## What's On Tap . . .

The Spiders welcome Delaware State to Robins Stadium for their final non-conference match-up of the season . . . Both teams are off to an 0-2 start and will vie for their first win of the season Saturday.

## Series History . . .

Saturday's game marks the first-ever meeting between the Spiders and Hornets.

## Tackling Machine . . .

Redshirt senior linebacker Tristan Wheeler is one of the top defensive players in all of NCAA FCS Football and has been a force since he stepped on campus, making 39-straight starts in 42 appearances at linebacker . . . He opened the season with 17 tackles against Morgan State, the second-most in a single game in his career and the most since recording 19 against Virginia in the 2022 season opener . . . He then followed that performance with 13 tackles at Michigan State last Saturday . . . He enters today's game with 396 career tackles, 26.0 tackles for loss, four sacks, and four interceptions . . . Wheeler currently ranks seventh all-time for the Spiders and is on pace to finish his career second all-time in career tackles and is the active leader among all levels of the NCAA (FBS, FCS, DII, DIII) in career tackles.

## Welcome Back, Aidan Murray . . .

Defensive tackle Aidan Murray returned to the starting lineup in the season opener against Morgan State after missing all of 2022 to an Achilles tear . . . The redshirt senior tallied four tackles including a sack on third down in his first game since Nov. 20, 2021 . . . Against Michigan State, he tallied four tackles including a tackle for loss on third down.

## Under Center . . .

Redshirt sophomore Kyle Wickersham has made his first two career starts this season . . . He is 39-of-52 with an interception through two games . . . So far he has thrown for 271 yards and rushed for 47 yards on 32 attempts including a touchdown on his first drive as a starter.

## Spiders Drop Opener To Morgan State . . .

Then-#16/18 Richmond lost its first home opener since 2006 and Morgan State earned a nationally ranked upset and their first season-opening win since 2012 by defeating Richmond at Robins Stadium, 17-10. . . The Spiders were held to 264 yards of offense and the Morgan State defense forced four turnovers and tallied five sacks.

## Spiders Stymied By Spartans . . .

Richmond fell on the road at Michigan State Saturday, 45-14 . . . Michigan State jumped to

38-0 lead headed into the fourth quarter as their defense stymied the Spiders offense all game, holding it to just 193 total yards . . . Richmond's break came in the fourth quarter Marlem Louis forced a fumble and Aaron Banks recovered it and took it 47 yards to the end zone to make it 38-7 . . . Redshirt sophomore Jayden Alsheskie made his Spider debut, knocking in the extra point . . . Michigan State scored their final touchdown of the game to make it 45-17 at the 11:33 mark before redshirt junior Jackson Hardy came in at quarterback and connected with tight end Sean Clarke on a five-yard touchdown pass with 5:16 left in the game . . . Both the touchdown pass and reception came as the first for both Hardy and Clarke, respectively . . . Alsheskie secured his second point of the day with a successful extra point attempt.

## **Oh Captain, My Captain . . .**

The Spiders named three team captains at the end of the spring football camp for the 2022 season . . . Three redshirt seniors were named captains in two-year captain and linebacker Tristan Wheeler, defensive end Marlem Louis and offensive tackle Ryan Coll . . . Wheeler is a four-time All-CAA selection, including three-straight First Team All-CAA honors (2021 spring, 2021 fall, 2022) as well as a four-time All-American . . . he has posted 396 career tackles in his first 42 career games, averaging 9.42 tackles per game in his career . . . He has recorded back-to-back-to-back full seasons over 100 tackles (104 in 2019, 114 in 2021, 110 in 2022) . . . Louis was a First Team All-CAA selection in 2022 . . . He ranked third in the CAA in 2022 with 8.5 sacks and fifth in average tackles for loss per game with 1.27 . . . Helped lead Richmond to the second-fewest opponent points per game in the CAA with 20.1 and yards per game with 333.4 . . . Coll was a First Team All-CAA selection in 2022 . . . He was named a 2022 Second Team AP All-American . . . Named a 2022 Fourth Team FCS All-American by Phil Steele . . . Part of an offensive line that led the Spiders to the third-highest producing offense in the CAA in 2022 . . . Helped the Spiders pick up 5,513 yards of total offense last season.

## **Senior Bowl Coll . . .**

Redshirt senior offensive lineman Ryan Coll has been named to the 2024 Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List . . . Last season, Coll and the rest of the offensive line allowed quarterback Reece Udinski to throw for 3,614 yards, becoming just the third UR quarterback to throw for over 3,000 yards in a single season . . . He threw 29 touchdown passes and rushed in four while being protected by Coll and the line . . . Richmond's quick-tempo offense led the CAA in total plays with 990 and was second in total yards with 5,513, averaging 424.1 yards of offense per game in 2022 . . . Richmond was sixth in the CAA in rushing yards with 1,840, while the team's 3,673 passing yards led the conference by over 200 . . . Thanks to Coll and the o-line, Richmond's run game saw 15 touchdowns on the ground and averaged 141.5 yards per game . . . Coll, a team captain, has spent the offseason raking in preseason honors including Bluebloods, Phil Steele and Stats Perform All-America as well as Preseason All-CAA nods . . . Last season Coll earned Phil Steele and AP All-America honors for his contribution to Richmond's best season since 2016 where he played left tackle . . . He was named the No. 13 returning offensive lineman in the FCS by HERO Sports in June . . . The Reese's Senior Bowl is widely regarded as the preeminent college football all-star game and the first stage in the NFL Draft process . . . In each of the past three years, the Reese's Senior Bowl has had 100 or more players drafted and over 40 percent of the entire draft class, which are both record-setting figures for any all-star game.

## **Co-Offensive Coordinators . . .**

Head Coach Russ Huesman announced Offensive Line Coach/Run Game Coordinator Adam Ross and Wide Receivers Coach Winston October have been named the Spiders new Co-Offensive Coordinators in January . . . Ross, October and their position groups played significant roles in the Spiders success in 2022 . . . October's first season on his alma mater's staff saw the Richmond wide receivers room come alive with the trio of Jasiah Williams, Jakob Herres and Leroy Henley Jr . . . All three receivers were consistently at the top of the CAA rankings throughout the season as Richmond boasted the only team in the country with three receivers with 73 or more receptions . . . Williams (82), Herres (77) and Henley (73) led the CAA, while Williams (6.8), Herres (5.9) and Henley (5.6) were first, third and fourth in the conference in receptions per game, respectively . . . Ross and the 2022 offensive line helped Reece Udinski pull off one of the greatest single seasons ever by a Richmond quarterback . . . The offensive line allowed Udinski to throw for 3,614 yards, becoming just the third UR quarterback to throw for over 3,000 yards in a single season . . . He threw 29 touchdown passes and rushed in four while being protected by Ross' offensive line . . . During Richmond's first-ever playoff shutout victory against Davidson, Udinski connected on 29-of-32 pass attempts for his highest completion percentage (90.3%) of the season . . . With his performance, he set the FCS playoffs single-game record for completion percentage . . . Thanks to the offensive line, the Spiders only gave up 26 sacks against in 2022, ranking sixth in the CAA . . . The offense as a whole put up impressive numbers in 2022 . . . Richmond's quick-tempo offense led the CAA in total plays with 990 and was second in total yards with 5,513, averaging 424.1 yards of offense per game . . . Richmond was sixth in the CAA in rushing yards in 2022 with 1,840, while the team's 3,673 passing yards led the conference by over 200.

## **Transfer Tracker . . .**

The Spiders dipped into the transfer portal last spring and brought four new transfers to the program . . . Kicker Will McManus joins from Illinois where he appeared in four games and kicked off 15 times for 848 yards . . . Safety Mikey Jarmolowich comes after a four-year career at Colgate where he appeared in 33 games and tallied 141 career tackles (95 solo, 46 asst.) . . . Quantrill Morris-Walker came to Richmond from Idaho State where he played safety for the previous four seasons, appearing in 31 games . . . in 2022 he tallied 57 tackles as well as a pass breakup and two interceptions . . . he has since switched from safety to outside linebacker . . . Wide Receiver Isaiah Wilson joined the Spiders from East Tennessee State where he played in 26 games and tallied 36+ yards per gameover the last two seasons . . . Offensive lineman Scott Hummel spent the previous two seasons at James Madison where he appeared in three games . . . Four of the five transfers find their name on today's two-deep.

## **New QB1 in Town . . .**

Redshirt sophomore quarterback Kyle Wickersham has been tabbed the Spiders new starting quarterback . . . Wickersham has appeared in just four games but brings with a wealth of knowledge into his first year in a starting job, having backed up Joe Mancuso and Reece Udinski the past two seasons . . . His father, Jeff Wickersham, was a star quarterback in his college days, becoming the first quarterback in Louisiana State program history to pass for over 5,000 career yards as well as the first to throw for over 2,000 yards in three different seasons during his career in the early 80s . . . Wickersham's size along with his arm strength will be a benefit for the Spiders in 2023 . . . The 6-3, 225-pounder threw the first touchdown pass of his college career last season against Stony Brook when he connected on a 12-yard strike to Ja'Vion Griffin . . . The score the

was the first passing and first receiving touchdown in the careers of both Wickersham and Griffin . . . Of the four quarterbacks on the Spiders roster, Jackson Hardy is the only other with playing experience having seen time in three games, all in the fall of 2021 . . . Like Wickersham, Hardy has great a great football pedigree as a fifth-generation player with a lineage that includes All-Americans, professionals and dates back to his great-great grandfathers playing days at Mercer in the 1890s.

### **New Faces on Staff . . .**

Russ Huesman announced the addition of three new coaches to his staff in March . . . Jacob Huesman was named quarterbacks coach, Rob Noel was named defensive line coach and Jameson Zacharias was named cornerbacks coach . . . Huesman comes to the Spiders after previously coaching the tight ends at his alma mater Chattanooga . . . Huesman played for the Mocs from 2011-2015 where he was a three-time SoCon Offensive Player of the Year and holds nearly every offensive program record . . . Noel previously served as the defensive coordinator at CAA foe Stony Brook since 2020 . . . Prior to taking over the Seawolves defense, Noel worked as the defensive line coach since 2014 and became the defense run game coordinator prior to the 2019 season . . . Zacharias comes to Richmond after spending the 2022 season at Georgetown where he was the secondary coach, leading Wedner Cadet to a Second Team All-Patriot League honor as a defensive back in 2022. Prior to his time at Georgetown, Zacharias spent four seasons with Fordham and has had previous coaching stints at IUP, Central Michigan and CAA member Towson . . . Dermot McDonough, a four-year member of the Spiders football team from 2019-2022, joined the staff as a defensive graduate assistant ahead of the 2023 season and primarily works with the linebackers . . . Khaleb Gantt joins as an offensive quality control assistant after serving in the same capacity during a stint at Towson.

### **Buck Buchanan Award Watch List . . .**

Redshirt senior and team captain Tristan Wheeler has been named one of 35 players selected to the preseason Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, announced Thursday by Stats Perform . . . The Buck Buchanan Award is presented by FedEx Ground and honors the national defensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision . . . Wheeler is one of four Coastal Athletic Association players to be named to the watch list . . . Wheeler, a linebacker, was named a Buck Buchanan Award finalist last fall after posting his third consecutive season with 100 tackles or more . . . He was the CAA's second-leading tackler in 2022 with 110 and was named a First Team All-CAA selection as well as a Stats Perform and Phil Steele All-American . . . Richmond's defensive leader and two-year team captain has started 37-consecutive games (the most of any Spider) . . . Following the 2022 season, Wheeler ranked sixth among active leaders in total tackles per game 9.15 and fourth in total tackles with 366.

### **Spiders Ranked In Preseason Polls . . .**

Richmond entered the 2023 season ranked in both national NCAA FCS polls in the preseason, coming in a No. 18 in both the Stats Perform Poll and No. 16 in the AFCA Coaches Poll . . . The Spiders were one of five teams from the Coastal Athletic Association in the preseason polls, joining the likes of William & Mary, New Hampshire, Delaware and Rhode Island . . . The Spiders were nationally ranked in the preseason last year, coming in at No. 24 in both polls . . . Richmond finished the season ranked 11th in the season-ending Stats Perform FCS Media Poll and 12th in the AFCA Coaches Poll in 2022.

### **Trusler on FCS Punter of the Year Award Preseason Watch List . . .**

Senior Aaron Trusler was one of 17 names selected to the FCS Punter of the Year Award Preseason Watch List, which honors the nation's top collegiate punter in the FCS . . . Last season, Trusler played in all 13 games, punting 53 times for 2,191 yards including a long of 63 yards. He averaged

41.3 yards per punt, stuck 19 inside the 20-yard line and recorded six punts over 50 yards. He was named to last year's FCS Punter of the Year Award Preseason Watch List and was later named a 2022 FCS Punter of the Year finalist.

### **Preseason All-America honors for Wheeler and Coll . . .**

Richmond football captains Tristan Wheeler and Ryan Coll have been named 2023 Stats Perform FCS Preseason All-Americans presented by FedEx Ground . . . Wheeler was named a First Team selection at linebacker, while Coll was tabbed a Third Team offensive lineman . . . Wheeler was named a First Team All-CAA linebacker as well as a Phil Steele and Stats Perform All-American in 2022 . . . The 2023 All-CAA selection and Phil Steele Preseason All-American/First Team All-CAA pick started all 13 games last season and was the team's leading tackler with 110 (54 solo, 56 assisted) including 11 for loss (-29 yards) . . . He recorded two sacks (-9), two interceptions, three pass breakups and seven quarterback hurries on the year . . . His 110 tackles were the second-most in the CAA last season as he eclipsed the 100 tackles mark for the third-straight full season . . . Ahead of the 2023 season, Wheeler ranks sixth among active leaders in career tackles per game with 9.15 and has started 37-straight games— the most of any Spider and was also named to the Athlon Sports FCS Preseason All-America Team . . . Coll was named a Second team AP All-American as well as a Fourth Team FCS All-American by Phil Steele last fall . . . The 2022 First Team All-CAA offensive lineman was part of a unit that led the Spiders to the third-highest producing offense in the CAA in 2022 . . . Coll helped the Spiders rank fourth in the CAA in average scoring with 31.3 points per game and started all 13 games at left tackle, helping the Spiders pick up 5,513 total yards of offense . . . Prior to the start of the 2023 season, he's been named a Phil Steele Preseason All-American and Phil Steele All-CAA First Team selection.

### **Spiders Tabbed Third in Preseason Poll, Six Earn Honors. . .**

Richmond was picked to finish third overall in the Coastal Athletic Association Football preseason poll and six Spiders were honored with preseason All-Conference honors Tuesday morning during the CAA Virtual Media Day, as decided by a vote from the league's head coaches . . . Earning Preseason All-Conference honors for the Spiders were offensive lineman Ryan Coll, defensive linemen Marlem Louis, linebacker Tristan Wheeler and defensive back Aaron Banks . . . Defensive back Bryson Parker and defensive lineman Jeremiah Grant were named honorable mentions.

### **Switchin' it Up. . .**

A major storyline of the 2022 season was defensive tackle Carsen Stocklinski's move from offensive to defensive line . . . Ahead of the 2023 season three other members of the Spiders team have also switched positions . . . Redshirt freshman Jordan Allen and Idaho State transfer Quantraill Morris-Walker have moved from defensive back to linebacker . . . Trae Tomlinson played in 12 games in 2022 at safety and has moved down to cornerback . . . Ethan Calveric has moved from defensive line to offensive line.

### **Sixth-Year Spiders. . .**

Running back Dante Black, defensive back Aaron Banks, running back Milan Howard and defensive tackle Aidan Murray are all veteran leaders of the Spiders team as 2023 comes as their sixth season of college football . . . All but one have played the entirety of their careers at Richmond, with Black playing two seasons at UConn.

### **Backfield Bullies . . .**

Corner Angelo Rankin Jr. aims to build upon his strong 2022 performance . . . He was a constant presence in every game, accumulating 47 tackles, including three for loss, and breaking up eight passes . . . Rankin Jr. burst onto the scene as a freshman in 2021, making an immediate impact and playing in 10 games . . . Bryson Parker and Aaron Banks stand as the seasoned leaders within the safeties . . . Parker showcased his impact from the moment he arrived on campus . . . A contributor in all 24 possible games of his career, Parker has racked up 72 tackles, two tackles for loss, seven pass breakups, and a pair of interceptions in his two seasons with the program . . . Banks, a sixth-year veteran of the team, returns after securing Second Team All-CAA honors last season . . . Last year he finished the season with 53 tackles, four interceptions and a pick-six . . . He picked up a season-high 10 tackles during the NCAA FCS Second Round Playoff game at No. 2 Sacramento State and recorded six pass breakups on the year . . . He finished the season 10th in the CAA in passes defended (six breakups, four interceptions) and second in defensive touchdowns.

### **In the Trenches . . .**

The strength of the 2023 Richmond roster lies in its offensive and defensive lines . . . The Spiders return veteran talent in four-of-five possible offensive line positions in Ryan Coll, Keith Gouveia, Tom Elia and Cade Salyers . . . The defensive line brings back three-of-four starters in Marlem Louis, Carsen

Stocklinski and Jeremiah Grant . . . While both sides of the ball lose a starter from a year ago, they're replaced with a starter who missed the 2022 season to injury . . . Aidan Murray (defensive tackle) and Gavin Lamp (offensive line) are back in the lineup and projected starters for Saturday's game.

## **Taking on a new role . . .**

Last year, Richmond stood alone in the FCS with a quartet of receivers boasting 50 or more receptions, with the fourth being Nick DeGennaro . . . DeGennaro was the fourth wide receiver on the Spiders depth chart at the end of last season and with the injury of Jasiah Williams during spring practices, has rose to the occasion as the team's top receiver . . . DeGennaro hauled in 51 catches in 2022 and picked up 522 receiving yards and one touchdown.

## **2022 at a Glance . . .**

The 2022 team won five of its final six regular season games to finish 6-2 in the CAA, tied for third in the final conference standings . . . # RUSS HUESMAN

**HEAD COACH  
SEVENTH SEASON  
CHATTANOOGA, 1983**

2023 marks Russ Huesman's seventh season as head coach of the University of Richmond football program and his 15th season overall as a collegiate head coach. This is Huesman's second stint with the Spiders after spending five seasons (2004-08) as an assistant coach, including part of the 2008 National Championship team.

In his 30-plus years of coaching, Huesman has coached 50 All-Americans and 22 NFL Draft Picks, while being a part of nine conference championships and the 2008 National Championship with the Spiders. He has spent 24 years coaching in the Colonial Athletic Association, bringing a wealth of experience to the Spiders.

Huesman's 2022 team won five of its final six regular season games to finish 6-2 in the CAA, tied for third in the final conference standings. Richmond knocked off three top 25 opponents in 2022 en route to its best finish since 2016. The Spiders earned a berth in the FCS Playoffs, where they defeated Davidson 41-0 in the First Round, posting the first postseason shutout in program history. In the Second Round, Richmond pushed unbeaten No. 2 seed Sacramento State to the limit, taking a leading into the fourth quarter before falling 38-31. Richmond placed 11th in the season-ending Stats Perform FCS Media Poll and 12th in the AFCA Coaches Poll. Quarterback Reece Udinski won the Dudley Award as the top college football player in Richmond and linebacker Tristan Wheeler was given the CAA's prestigious Chuck Boone Leadership Award for his athletic and academic accomplishments. In total, the Spiders took home 11 All-CAA selections and named two All-Americans in Tristan Wheeler and Ryan Coll in 2022.

In 2021, the Spiders closed out the year winning four-straight games to finish the season with a 6-5 overall record. Richmond posted wins down the stretch over New Hampshire, Towson, Delaware and rival William & Mary. The win over UNH on the road marked the first victory for the Spiders in Durham since 2000 while the win over William & Mary gave the Spiders the lead in the all-time series 64-63-5. The Spiders placed seven on the Colonial Athletic Association All-Conference teams, including five First Team All-CAA honors in Tristan Wheeler, Tyler Dressler, Kobie Turner, Clayton McConnell and Aaron Dykes.

During the unconventional spring 2021 season, the Spiders posted a 3-1 record in the shortened CAA season that saw Richmond nationally ranked for most of the season. The Spiders finished the year No. 14 in the country and were third in the CAA standings with a 3-1 record. Defensive lineman Kobie Turner was named the CAA Co-Defensive Player of the Year while eight Spiders earned All-Conference accolades. Richmond also won the CAA Team Academic Award for the first time in program history, despite battling the COVID-19 pandemic.

In 2019, the Spiders finished the year 5-7 overall and 4-4 in Colonial Athletic Association play. Richmond picked up three victories last year against nationally ranked opponents, including a pair of them coming on the road. The Spiders defeated No. 18 Maine and No. 19 Delaware on the road while knocking off No. 20 Stony Brook at home at Robins Stadium. Freshman linebacker Tristan Wheeler was named the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year and was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award, given annually to the top freshman in all of NCAA FCS. Wheeler was joined by Aaron Dykes as Freshmen All-America selections in 2019 while the Spiders placed eight on the postseason All-CAA teams.

Huesman led the Spiders in 2018 through a tough, injury-riddled season. Richmond's defensive line was the top unit in the Colonial Athletic Conference last season, leading the league with 23.5 sacks. Junior Maurice Jackson led the CAA in sacks and earned All-America honors for his play. Senior Andrew Clyde earned All-Conference honors for his third-straight year, becoming the first Spider to start every game of his collegiate career.

Huesman returned to Richmond in 2017 and guided the Spiders to a 6-5 record. The Spiders had 11 different players earn All-CAA honors, led by the Offensive Player of the Year Kyle Lauletta. He became the first Richmond player to win Offensive Player of the Year since Greg Lilly in 1992. Lauletta led the CAA with 3,737 yards, 28 passing TDs and 3,827 yards of total offense and was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award.

Joining Lauletta on the All-CAA First Team were Alex Light (OL), Garrett Hudson (TE), Dejon Brissett (WR), Griffin Trau (PK) and Andrew Clyde (DL). The All-CAA Second Team included Tyler Wilkins (WR) and Cortrelle Simpson (WR), while Brandon Waller (DL), Justin Rubin (LB) and John Yarbrough (OL) were all named to the All-CAA Third Team.

Prior to returning to Richmond, Huesman spent eight tremendously successful seasons at Chattanooga. He was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year three times (2009, 2013, 2014) and was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year three times.

In his eight seasons at Chattanooga, Huesman helped guide the Mocs to a 59-37 record, including a 36-16 mark in his last four seasons (2013-16), which featured three Southern Conference regular season championships. Chattanooga was one of only 10 programs in the country to reach the FCS Playoffs each year from 2014-16. The Mocs were also just one of four programs in the country to post a playoff win during that time.

In his eight seasons, the Mocs had at least seven players named to the All-SoCon team every year, including a school-record 17 honorees in 2014. Prior to Huesman's arrival, the Mocs had not boasted seven members of any All-SoCon team since 1979.

Chattanooga had 17 All-America honorees and three NFL draft picks with DB Buster Skrine (Cleveland – 2011), QB B.J. Coleman (Green Bay – 2012) and LB Davis Tull (New Orleans – 2015) over eight-year period.

Huesman's first stop at Richmond came from 2004-08 as defensive coordinator molding the Spiders' defensive unit into one of the best in the country. In his final year at Richmond, the national championship season, the Spiders led the country in interceptions and finished in the top-10 in four other defensive categories.

Under Huesman's guidance, the Spiders had 23 All-Conference selections, including former NFL standouts Lawrence Sidbury, Jr. and Justin Rogers. During his five-year period as an assistant coach, the Spiders posted a 42-23 (.646) record and played in the FCS Playoffs three times with a quarterfinal appearance in 2005, a semifinal appearance in 2007 and the National Championship in 2008.
