### OPENING TIP

No. 24 Richmond opens the 2025-26 season Tuesday, Nov. 4 at 6 p.m. vs Mount St. Mary's inside the Robins Center. The game airs on ESPN+ with Craig Kocher and Darrell Owens on the call. The Spiders trail the all-time series 4-6, with the first meeting a 66-52 loss on Nov. 20, 1982, and the most recent an 87-44 home win on Nov. 10, 2022. Richmond is 2-3 in its past five season openers and also 2-3 in its past five home openers. Tuesday marks the program's first home season opener since 2021 (L, 63-45 vs Charlotte on Nov. 9, 2021) as the Spiders have only opened the season at home five times in the past 10 seasons.

Richmond enters 2025–26 coming off a historic 28-7 season that featured the program's first NCAA Tournament win and a Second Round appearance. Richmond's 57 wins over the last two seasons are tied for 10th most in D-I. Head coach Aaron Roussell enters his seventh season at the helm with 122 victories at Richmond and was named to the 2026 Kathy Delaney-Smith Coach of the Year watch list after earning the award in 2025.

The Spiders ranked among the nation's best last year: second in field-goal percentage (49.3%), fifth in threepoint percentage (38.3%), and top 20 in assists (17.4 per game) and posted a program-record 17-game win streak. Richmond opens the season ranked No. 24 in the AP Preseason Top 25 and No. 19 in ESPN's Top 25, while being tabbed A-10 preseason favorites for the second straight year.

Senior standouts Maggie Doogan and Rachel Ullstrom lead a veteran core that also includes junior point guard Ally Sweeney. Doogan, the reigning A-10 Player of the Year, averaged 17.0 points and 7.1 rebounds

while shooting 55.5 percent from the floor and 40.6 percent from three. Ullstrom added 15.3 points per game on 42.3 percent three-point shooting and became the 11th Spider to reach 1,000 career points in 2024-25.

Richmond adds graduate transfer Tierra Simon (Saint Louis), who averaged 8.8 points and 8.9 rebounds and appears on the Cheryl Miller Award watch list, and Skylah Travis (Louisiana), a 60-percent shooter and top Sun Belt Conference rebounder. The freshman class features Richmond Times-Dispatch All-Metro POY Rayne Wright, Ava Persichetti, Aneisha Scott, and Shaneka Campbell.

Richmond's non-conference schedule ranks among the most challenging in program history, with three Power Four foes and seven 2025 NCAA Tournament teams. Following the Mount St. Mary's opener, the Spiders visit Texas (Nov. 7), William & Mary (Nov. 12) and Columbia (Nov. 15) before hosting Temple (Nov. 18) and Navy (Nov. 23). They then travel to Mexico for the Cancun Challenge, facing TCU (Nov. 27) and Green Bay (Nov. 28). December includes home matchups with Fairfield (Dec. 7) and Bethune-Cookman (Dec. 16), a trip to Liberty (Dec. 13), and the 4 Tha Culture Holiday Classic in Henrico, meeting Alabama A&M (Dec. 20) and Penn State (Dec. 21).

#### SPIDER BITES

Preseason buzz: No. 24 in the AP Poll and No. 19 in ESPN's Top 25. Picked Atlantic 10 preseason favorites for the second straight year.

Headliners back: Maggie Doogan (17.0 ppg, 7.1 rpg, 3.8 apg, 55.5 FG%, 40.6 3FG%) and Rachel Ullstrom (15.3 ppg, 53.8 FG%, 42.3 3FG%, program-record 11 threes vs Oakland) return to anchor the offense.

Floor general: Ally Sweeney returns after posting 117 assists to 62 turnovers (1.9 A/T) and shooting 44.3 percent from three.

Watch lists: Doogan – Katrina McClain Award and Naismith Trophy; Ullstrom – Ann Meyers-Drysdale Award; Doogan and Ullstrom – Becky Hammon Mid-Major POY; Tierra Simon – Cheryl Miller Top 20.

National nod: ESPN ranked Doogan No. 25 nationally of the top women's college basketball players, the only Non P5 player selected (Oct. 29, 2025).

USA Basketball summer: Ullstrom helped Team USA win the FIBA 3x3 Nations League Americas; Doogan was invited to the USA Women's AmeriCup Trials; head coach Aaron Roussell served as a court coach at USA U19 Trials.

A-10 dominance: The Spiders are 33–3 in conference play over the last two seasons (17–1 in 2024–25; 16–2 in 2023–24).

Home-court edge: Richmond is 26–2 at the Robins Center over the past two years, including 12–2 last season.

Back-to-back NCAA runs: The Spiders earned consecutive NCAA Tournament bids for the first time since 1990–91, highlighted by the program's first NCAA win in 2025.

Historic efficiency: Ranked No. 2 nationally in FG% (49.3), No. 5 in 3FG% (38.4), No. 9 in 3PM per game (9.4) and No. 18 in assists (17.5) last season.

Doogan milestones: Became just the fourth Spider in program history to reach 1,000 career points and 500 rebounds in three seasons, joining Karen Elsner, Laurie Governor and Kate Flavin.

New faces: Graduate transfers Tierra Simon (Saint Louis; 8.8 ppg, 8.9 rpg, Cheryl Miller watch list) and Skylah Travis (Louisiana; 5.6 ppg, 6.6 rpg, >60 FG%) bolster the frontcourt. Departures: Addie Budnik, Katie Hill, Alyssa Jimenez, Anna Camden, Faith Alston, Courtney Swider, Steph Ouderkirk.

Freshman class: Features Richmond Times-Dispatch All-Metro Player of the Year Rayne Wright alongside Ava Persichetti, Aneisha Scott and Shaneka Campbell.

Facility boost: The Robins Center debuts new videoboards, synced scoreboards and an upgraded audio system for the 2025–26 season.

#### DOOGAN LANDS ON MCCLAIN AND NAISMITH WATCH LISTS

Senior forward Maggie Doogan earned spots on both the Katrina McClain Award Top 20 and the Naismith Trophy Watch List after a 17.0-point, 7.1-rebound junior season. She posted 12 games of 20-plus points and powered Richmond's first NCAA win with 30 and 15 vs Georgia Tech.

#### ESPN TABS DOOGAN NO. 25; ONLY NON P5 PLAYER (OCT. 29. 2025)

Doogan checked in at No. 25 on ESPN's Top 25 list, the only Non P5 player selected. She shot 55.5 percent from the field and 40.6 percent from three while leading Richmond's NCAA run.

#### SIMON EARNS CHERYL MILLER AWARD TOP 20 NOD

Graduate forward Tierra Simon, a Saint Louis transfer, was named to the Cheryl Miller Top 20 after averaging 8.8 points and 8.9 rebounds with seven double-doubles last season.

#### ROUSSELL RETURNS TO NATIONAL COACH WATCH

Head coach Aaron Roussell appears on the 2026 Kathy Delaney-Smith Coach of the Year list after a 28-7 season and 17-game win streak that included Richmond's first NCAA Tournament win.

#### ULLSTROM NAMED TO ANN MEYERS-DRYSDALE TOP 20

Senior guard Rachel Ullstrom earned a spot on the shooting-guard watch list after averaging 15.3 points and shooting 42.3 percent from three. She broke the program record with 11 threes in a 35-point outing vs Oakland.

#### SPIDERS RECEIVE VOTES IN USA TODAY SPORTS COACHES POLL

Richmond garnered 67 points in the preseason poll, joining its No. 24 AP ranking for the program's highest preseason standing ever.

#### DOOGAN. ULLSTROM NAMED TO BECKY HAMMON PRESEASON LIST

Doogan and Ullstrom are among 25 on the Her Hoop Stats Becky Hammon Player of the Year Watch List, recognizing the nation's top Non P5 players.

#### AP PRESEASON NO. 24. FIRST IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Richmond enters the year ranked for the first time in school history at No. 24 in the AP Poll. Doogan and Ullstrom headline a roster built for another postseason run.

#### ESPN PRESEASON NO. 19 WITH MARQUEE TESTS AHEAD

ESPN placed Richmond at No. 19 nationwide, highlighting a schedule that includes matchups with Texas, TCU, and Columbia plus the Cancun Challenge and 4 Tha Culture Classic.

#### A-10 FAVORITES AGAIN: FOUR SPIDERS EARN PRESEASON HONORS

Richmond earned nine first-place votes to lead the A-10 poll ahead of the 2025-26 season. Doogan and Ullstrom landed on the First Team, Sweeney was placed on the Second, and Simon was highlighted on the Third.

#### ROBINS CENTER GAME DAY GETS AN UPGRADE

New corner videoboards, synced end-wall scoreboards and a revamped audio system highlight major arena enhancements for 2025–26.

#### ROSTER FINALIZED WITH VETERAN CORE AND SIX NEWCOMERS

The Spiders finalized their 2025–26 roster with a strong mix of experience and new



talent, returning eight letterwinners from last year's NCAA Tournament squad and adding six newcomers. Head coach Aaron Roussell, entering his seventh season, brings back an accomplished core led by Atlantic 10 Player of the Year Maggie Doogan, All-Conference First Team guard Rachel Ullstrom and junior point guard Ally Sweeney, a trio that combined for 40 points per game last season.

ATLANTIC 10 STANDINGS

Doogan headlines the

returners after averaging 17.0 points, 7.1 rebounds and 3.8 assists per game while shooting 55.5 percent from the field and 40.6 percent from three. The Broomall, Pa. native became one of just four Spiders ever to reach 1,000 career points and 500 rebounds in three seasons and capped her year with 30 points and 15 rebounds in the NCAA win vs Georgia Tech. Ullstrom, from Auburn, Mass., added 15.3 points per game on 42.3-percent three-point shooting and broke the program's single-game record with 11 triples in a 35-point performance vs Oakland. Sweeney, a steady floor general from New Jersey, started all 34 games, ranking among league leaders in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.9) and three-point percentage (44.3).

Depth returns in key rotational contributors Sam Dewey, Alicia Newell, Payton Richard, Jada Green and Annika Manthy, all of whom played supporting roles during Richmond's postseason run. Dewey and Richard provided reliable perimeter defense and spacing off the bench, while Green and Newell bring athleticism and rebounding to the frontcourt. Manthy, a redshirt freshman, enters her second year in the program.

The newcomers include two experienced graduate transfers and four freshmen expected to make immediate impacts. Graduate forward Tierra Simon arrives from Saint Louis, where she averaged 8.8 points, 8.9 rebounds and one block per game while starting all 32 contests. The Houston, Texas native posted seven double-doubles last season, ranked fifth in the Atlantic 10 in rebounding and earned a spot on the Cheryl Miller Award preseason watch list. Graduate forward Skylah Travis joins the program after a season at Louisiana and previous stops at Missouri and Old Dominion, bringing size and interior scoring to the Spider frontcourt. She averaged 5.6 points and 6.6 rebounds while shooting over 60 percent from the floor for the Ragin' Cajuns.

Richmond's freshman class features Richmond Times-Dispatch All-Metro Player of the Year Rayne Wright (Manchester HS), a local standout who led her team to a VHSL Class 6A state title; Ava Persichetti (Pa.), a three-time Pennsylvania First Team All-State guard; Aneisha Scott (Minn.), the 2023–24 Tri-Metro Player of the Year; and Shaneka Campbell (N.Y.), a 2022–23 PSAL champion from New York City.

Richmond's roster now features balance across every position group, boasting five players with all-conference honors and four standing 6-2 or taller. The 14-player unit blends scoring, shooting and defensive depth as the Spiders chase a third straight NCAA appearance and defend their Atlantic 10 crown.

Departures from last year's 28-win team include Addie Budnik, Katie Hill, Alyssa Jimenez, Anna Camden, Faith Alston, Courtney Swider and Steph Ouderkirk.

#### ULLSTROM HELPS USA WIN FIBA 3X3 NATIONS LEAGUE AMERICAS (JULY 27. 2025)

Senior guard Rachel Ullstrom capped her summer with international success, helping the United States capture the FIBA 3x3 Women's Nations League Americas title in Punta Arenas, Chile. The U.S. squad dominated throughout the week, defeating Argentina 21-5 to open Stop 5 before rolling past the host nation Chile 21-5 in the final to secure its fourth straight Stop Final victory. The Americans finished unbeaten across the final four stops of the event, earning qualification for the 2025 FIBA 3x3 U23 World Cup in Xiong An, China. The win marked Ullstrom's first international championship appearance as part of the USA Basketball 3x3 program, continuing a breakout summer that also saw her named to the Ann Meyers-Drysdale Award watch list and the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year preseason list.

### DOOGAN INVITED TO USA WOMEN'S AMERICUP TRIALS (JUNE 17. 2025)

Reigning Atlantic 10 Player of the Year Maggie Doogan was one of just 21 athletes nationwide invited to the USA Basketball Women's AmeriCup Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo. The event, held at the U.S. Olympic & Paralympic Training Center, featured top collegiate players competing for roster spots ahead of the 2025 FIBA Women's AmeriCup in Santiago, Chile. Doogan, one of only seven invitees making their USA Basketball debut, earned the selection following a 596-point, 250-rebound, 133-assist junior campaign that helped lead Richmond to its first NCAA Tournament win. Head coach Aaron Roussell also received a USA Basketball assignment this summer, serving as a court coach for the Women's U19 National Team Trials. The dual invitations marked a milestone moment for Spider Women's Basketball, showcasing Richmond's growing national presence on the collegiate and international stage.

#### 2024-25 CURTAIN CALL

The Spiders will unveil their 2024-25 Championship banner at the home opener on Nov. 4. Richmond closed a historic 2024–25 season in the NCAA Tournament Second Round, falling 84-67 to No. 1 UCLA inside Pauley Pavilion to finish the year at 28-7 overall and 17-1 in the Atlantic 10. The Spiders led early and battled the nation's top-ranked team throughout before the Bruins pulled away late in the third quarter. Maggie Doogan paced Richmond with 27 points, seven assists and two blocks, while Rachel Ullstrom added 18 points and seven rebounds. Addie Budnik finished with 10 points and four assists in her final game in a Spider uniform. Richmond shot 51 percent from the floor, 42.1 percent from three and 70 percent from the free-throw line while matching UCLA in paint scoring (34–36). The appearance marked the program's first trip to the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament and capped a season that included the first NCAA win in school history (W, 74-49 vs No. 9 Georgia Tech) after earning an at-large bid, a 17-game winning streak and the team's second straight A-10 regular-season title.

# HEAD COACH AARON ROUSSELL SEVENTH SEASON AT RICHMOND (IOWA '01)

Aaron Roussell is in his seventh season leading the University of Richmond women's basketball program and has established the Spiders as one of the Atlantic 10's premier teams. Since taking over in April 2019, Roussell has transformed Richmond into a consistent contender, guiding the Spiders to consecutive 25-win seasons, back-to-back Atlantic 10 regular-season titles, the 2024 A-10 Championship crown, and the program's first NCAA Tournament win in 2025. A two-time Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year, Roussell also earned national honors in 2025 as the Kathy Delaney-Smith Coach of the Year and ECAC Coach of the Year.

Under Roussell, Richmond has posted five straight winning seasons, its longest streak since the early 1990s, and ranks among the nation's most improved programs over the last half decade. The Spiders have recorded a 57-13 mark across the past two years, including a 33-3 record in conference play and a 26-2 mark at home. During that span, Richmond earned top-25 national rankings in field-goal percentage, three-point percentage, assists, and scoring offense while finishing in the top 75 of the NET each season. The Spiders' rise has been highlighted by their first-ever NCAA Tournament victory, a first-round win over Georgia Tech in 2025, and the program's 1,000th all-time win, both achieved under Roussell's tenure.

Player development has been a hallmark of Roussell's teams. He has coached multiple Atlantic 10 major award winners, including 2025 Player of the Year Maggie Doogan, 2024 Defensive Player of the Year Addie Budnik, and 2024 Sixth Woman of the Year Rachel Ullstrom. His Richmond players have also combined for eight All-Conference honors over the past two seasons, with Doogan, Ullstrom, and Grace Townsend earning First Team recognition. Roussell's teams are known for their offensive efficiency, disciplined defense and elite assist-to-turnover ratios, consistently ranking among the A-10's best in ball movement and team defense.

Prior to his time at Richmond, Roussell engineered winning traditions at Bucknell and the University of Chicago. At Bucknell (2012–19), he compiled a 161-85 record with two Patriot League titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, and two Patriot League Coach of the Year honors while producing three Patriot League Rookies of the Year and the 2017 Patriot League Player of the Year. His Bison teams posted six straight winning seasons, including four 22-win campaigns and a program-best 28-win season in 2018-19, setting school records for points, field goals and assists.

Before Bucknell, Roussell turned the University of Chicago into a Division III powerhouse from 2004–12, posting a 161-50 (.763) record to become the winningest coach in program history. His teams captured three UAA titles, made four NCAA Tournament appearances, and reached three Sweet 16s and one Elite Eight while achieving a No. 1 national ranking in 2007.

A Plymouth, Minn., native, Roussell earned his bachelor's degree in journalism and mass communications and political science from the University of Iowa in 2001 and a master's in sports administration from Minnesota State in 2004. He and his wife, Molly, have a son, Riley, and two daughters, Kelsey and Kendall.
