BY THE NUMBERS

Prior to last Saturday's game against VMI, Richmond had only managed three offensive plays that gained 25 yards or more through the first three games of the season. Against VMI, however, the Spiders recorded **six plays of 25 yards or more**, including three of 40 yards or more, helping the team achieve its highest offensive output of the season (541 yards). Richmond averaged just 3.5 yards per play through the first three games. Last Saturday, the Spiders averaged 8.5 yards per play.

Richmond's defense **ranks seventh** in the country and first in the Patriot League in total defense, holding teams to just 249.3 yards per game. The Spiders secondary has become a 'no fly zone' for opposing offenses, ranking ninth in passing yards allowed, with just 140.3 a game being picked up by opponents. The Spiders have two of the top five pass defenders in the Patriot League, with **Tayshaun Burney** leading the League with 1.25 pass breakups a game, while **CJ Fraser** is fourth with 1.00 a game.

15 Spiders (7 defense, 8 offense) made their first career starts over the last three weeks in **TJ Baldwin (DT)**, **Peyton Seelmann (LB)**, **Tayshaun Burney (LB)**, **Blake Houser (LB)**, **Lee Bruner IV (FS)**, **Devin Geronimi (CB)**, **Bo Fowler (LG)**, **Ronald Anderson (LT)**, **Kade Capristo (C)**, **Kelsey Hundley (RG)**, **Jason Smith (RG)**, **Aidan Steinfeldt (TE)**, **Ryan Campbell (TE)**, **Isaiah Dawson (WR)** and **Jaiden Fair (WR)**. RG Kelsey Hundley, WR Jaiden Fair and LB Tayshaun Burney all earned starts in their first-ever college game at Lehigh to start the season.

The Storyline ...

Richmond looks for two in a row when it hosts Howard during Family Weekend Presented by Sheehy Lexus of Richmond.

Series History ...

Saturday's game is just the third meeting all-time between Richmond and Howard ... The Spiders won the meeting in 2017 by a 68-21 margin at Robins Stadium ... The Spiders set a single-game scoring record against a NCAA Division I opponent with the 68 points scored while former Spider Kyle Lauetta set the single-game record with six passing touchdowns while passing for 321 yards ... The teams met most recently during the 2021 season opener when the Spiders won 38-14 at home.

Applying Pressure ...

Richmond held VMI to just 229 yards including just 34 on the ground ... This was due in part to Richmond's front seven pressuring VMI's quarterback all game and allowing for the secondary to make plays when needed ... The Spiders defense finished with day with two sacks, five quarterback hurries, eight pass breakups and an interception.

Consistency Is Key . . .

Kyle Wickersham was highly efficient under center, completing 10-of-13 passes against VMI for 166 yards and two touchdowns, including a 67-yard strike to Isaiah Dawson . . . He also added 44 rushing yards and an 8-yard touchdown run . . . Wickersham, who led the country in completion percentage in 2023, is currently eighth overall and first in the Patriot League with a 71.4 completion percentage.

Return And Burn . . .

The Spiders have two of the best return men in the Patriot League . . . **Isaiah Dawson** is second in the Patriot League in kickoff return yards, averaging 27.3 a return and ran back a 99-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Lehigh in the season opener, while **Quanye Veney** is first in the Patriot League in punt return yards, averaging 8.0 a return.

Last Time Out . . .

- Richmond posted its most explosive offensive performance of the season, totaling 541 yards — 353 rushing and 188 passing.
- Head Coach Russ Huesman earned his 54th career win at Richmond, moving into second place on the program's all-time coaching wins list.
- The Spiders featured two 100-yard rushers in a game for the first time since 2024.
- Jamaal Brown ran for a career-high 153 yards on 14 carries, including 35- and 43-yard gains.
- Andrew King matched his career high with 100 yards on just seven carries, highlighted by an 83-yard touchdown run, the longest of his career.
- Wide receiver Isaiah Dawson finished with four receptions for 99 yards and two touchdowns, including a career-long 67-yard touchdown catch.
- Aziz Foster-Powell opened the scoring with a 2-yard touchdown run, his first of the season.
- A 3-hour, 19-minute weather delay halted play late in the first quarter, with the game resuming at 5:45 p.m.
- Richmond's defense shut out VMI in the second half and held the Keydets to just 34 rushing yards on 23 attempts.
- Linebacker Peyton Seelmann led the team with seven tackles and two quarterback hurries, while senior linebacker Carter Glassmyer added six tackles, including 1.5 tackles for loss and a sack.
- Sophomore defensive back Lee Bruner IV notched his first career interception, which he returned 29 yards to set up a field goal. He also recorded four tackles.
- The Spiders defense consistently pressured VMI, finishing with two sacks, five quarterback hurries, and eight pass breakups. VMI only picked up two first downs in the second half, both coming on the same drive. One of the first downs picked up in the second half came via an offsides penalty, and VMI did not score on the drive.
- Devin Geromoni recorded four tackles (two solo, two assisted) and a pass breakup, helping the Richmond defense hold VMI to just 229 total yards of offense. Geromoni made his first career start at cornerback last week at UNC after transitioning from safety the week prior.

Offensive Line Dancing . . .

Richmond found it's rhythm on offense, especially in the run game last Saturday against VMI thanks to another new-look offensive line . . . The Spiders have used three iterations of its offensive line lineup through the first four games of the season.

Another Punter From Down Under . . .

Richmond has found recent success with Australian punters . . . Following the departure of All-American punter Aaron Trusler (2021–24), the Spiders have identified their next Aussie talent in left-footed freshman **Ned Gray** . . . Like Trusler, Gray comes from an Australian rules football background . . . The 2025 season marks his first experience with American football, and the 21-year-old from Melbourne has made an immediate impact playing in his first ever football games over the past three weeks . . . In his collegiate debut at Lehigh, Gray punted six times for 210 yards . . . He followed that performance with eight punts for a total of 312 yards (39.0-yard average), including a long of 46 yards at Wofford . . . He placed three of those punts inside the 20-yard line—one of which pinned Wofford inside the 10 and led to a three-and-out, setting up Richmond's game-winning drive . . . He also recorded one touchback . . . Notably, Wofford did not return any of Gray's eight punts, and Lehigh managed just one return for four yards . . . Gray had a quiet day punting at North Carolina, kicking four times, with just one being returned . . . his average of 41.0 yards a punt at North Carolina came as his season and career-high.

2024 At A Glance . . .

Richmond posted a 10–3 overall record, went undefeated in conference play, and claimed a share of a conference title for the second straight year. The Spiders also reached the FCS Playoffs for a third consecutive season and delivered the program's first 10-win regular season since 2009, matching the school's all-time best. The perfect 8–0 run in conference play was only the second in Richmond history—and the first since 1968—making the Spiders just the seventh team in CAA history to finish league play unbeaten.

Transfer Portal Giveth, Transfer Portal Taketh . . .

When the transfer portal opened last year on December 9, Richmond found itself without 10 starters—half of whom were All-Conference honorees . . . In addition to the starters lost, the Spiders lost another eight players due to graduation and/or exhaustion of eligibility . . . The team also lost two key specialists to graduation . . . Of the 51 players on Richmond's depth chart for its final game of the 2024 season, just 29 returned . . . Of the 11 All-CAA honorees in 2024, only two returned for the 2025 season in linebacker **Carter Glassmyer** and defensive end **Camden Byrd**.

Under Center . . .

In 2023, **quarterback Kyle Wickersham** led all FCS quarterbacks with a .726 completion percentage, threw for nearly 1,400 yards, rushed for 401 yards, scored four rushing touchdowns, and was named Capital Cup MVP in Richmond's win over William & Mary . . . In 2024, he started the first three games of the season before missing time due to injury.

PLAYERS TO WATCH



19 LEE BRUNER IV

Sophomore free safety Lee Bruner IV recorded his first collegiate interception in Richmond's win over VMI, returning it 29 yards to set up a Richmond field goal. Bruner IV ranks fourth on the team with 16 total tackles and is one of three Spiders (alongside Jordan Allen and CJ Fraser) with interceptions this season. He made an immediate impact with six solo tackles in his first career start at Lehigh.

A native of Washington, D.C., Bruner IV comes from a family with strong ties to Howard University, where both of his parents attended.



7 JAMAAL BROWN

Jr. • RB • Pittsburgh, Pa. • Upper St. Clair

Jamaal Brown, who has missed time due to injury during his career, has emerged as Richmond's top rusher in 2025. He posted a career-best performance last week against VMI, rushing for 153 yards on 14 carries, including long runs of 35 and 43 yards — marking his first-ever 100-yard game. Prior to Saturday, Brown's career-long run was just 12 yards, and he had totaled only 92 yards on 35 carries over his first two seasons at Richmond.

Brown started the first three games this season and is currently tied with quarterback Kyle Wickersham as Richmond's leading rusher with 127 yards. He's averaging 31.8 yards per game and just over six yards per carry.

New Season, New Coaches . . .

Wide receivers coach Jerry Taylor, a Richmond native and former Spider graduate assistant (2011–12), returns to the program after a decade of coaching experience . . . He most recently served as Assistant Head Coach, Offensive Coordinator, and Quarterbacks Coach at Bluefield State in 2024 . . . His résumé includes stints at Columbia, William & Mary, Dartmouth, Virginia State, Saint Francis, and the Buffalo Bills . . . **Co-Offensive Coordinator and offensive line coach Mike Cummings** joined Richmond after two seasons as the offensive line coach at Appalachian State (2023–24), where he helped lead a unit that allowed just 15 sacks in 2024 and blocked for a 1,000-yard rusher . . . He brings over 30 years of coaching experience, including roles at Cincinnati, Central Michigan, and UConn, and held offensive coordinator roles at Central Michigan (2010-13) and UConn (2014-16) and coached under Nick Saban at Michigan State (1998) . . . Cummings will share offensive coordinator duties with Jacob Huesman, who will continue to lead the quarterbacks in his third season on staff.

New Play Caller . . .

Jacob Huesman enters his third season on the Richmond coaching staff in 2025, now serving as Co-Offensive Coordinator, Play Caller and Quarterbacks Coach . . . After joining the staff in 2023, he helped guide the Spiders to back-to-back CAA championships . . . Under his leadership, quarterback Camden Coleman (now at James Madison) went 13-1 as a starter over two seasons . . . Huesman previously coached at Chattanooga—his alma mater—where he was a record-setting All-America quarterback and coached tight ends from 2019 to 2023 . . . Huesman, 33, carries nearly every major offensive program record at Chattanooga and is one of only four FCS players to record at least 40 rushing touchdowns (43) and 40 passing touchdowns (64) in a career and is one of only two FCS players to rush for over 4,000 yards (4,051) and pass for over 8,000 yards (8,197) in a career . . . He was a three-time Southern Conference Offensive Player of the Year and an All-America selection in 2015.

Upward Momentum . . .

The 2021 season saw Richmond battle through injuries and a 2-5 start before finishing with four straight wins. Since that turnaround, the Spiders are 35-12 overall, with an impressive 25-4 record in conference games.

Defense Dominates . . .

Under the leadership of Assistant Head Coach and Defensive Coordinator **Justin Wood**, the Spiders defense has continued to flourish . . . Between the 2021 and 2024 seasons, Richmond ranked in the top 20 in nearly every defensive category and ranked in the top three in the CAA.

Preseason Honors . . .

Ahead of Richmond's inaugural season in the Patriot League, **five Spiders** earned Preseason All-League honors, and the team was picked to finish second in the eight-team conference behind Lehigh . . . **Offensive linemen and team captains Gabriel Carbajal and Scott Hummel, along with tight end Sean Clarke, were selected to the All-League Offense. On defense, linebacker and captain Carter Glassmyer and defensive end Camden Byrd were named All-League.**

- **Carbajal and Hummel** anchored an offensive line that started every game in 2024 and helped Richmond average 27.15 points and 380.4 total yards per game, while allowing just 16 sacks. The unit ranked second in the CAA in rushing yards (2,527) and fourth in total offense (4,945).
- **Clarke** appeared in 12 games with six starts, contributing as both a blocker and receiver. He recorded five catches for 38 yards, including a touchdown in the FCS Playoffs First Round against Lehigh.
- **Glassmyer**, a Second Team Stats Perform FCS Preseason All-American, returns as Richmond's leading tackler. He totaled 87 tackles (53 solo), 7.0 TFLs, three sacks, two fumble recoveries, a forced fumble, and three pass breakups in 2024, earning Second Team All-CAA honors.
- **Byrd** started 11 games at defensive end and was also named Second Team All-CAA. He recorded 45 tackles, including 8.5 for loss and seven sacks, along with a forced fumble, a fumble recovery, five quarterback hurries, and a pass breakup.

From an academic standpoint, the Patriot League is unmatched in its performance metrics. In the most recent NCAA data, the League posted a 96% graduation success rate (GSR) and the nation's highest federal graduation rate (FGR) at 87%— 19 points above the national average. In football specifically, Patriot League programs led the nation with a GSR of 96 and an FGR of 91, outperforming all FCS and FBS conferences. Richmond's arrival

Russ Huesman, entering his ninth season as head coach at the University of Richmond in 2025, brings over 40 years of coaching experience and is in his 17th season as a collegiate head coach. His career has been defined by championship-level success, player development, and the ability to build strong, competitive programs. Huesman previously served as Richmond's defensive coordinator from 2004 to 2008, playing a key role in the Spiders 2008 FCS National Championship.

Since returning as head coach in 2017, he has led Richmond to three consecutive FCS Playoff appearances (2022–2024) and two conference championships. The 2024 team was particularly historic, finishing 10-3 overall with an undefeated 8-0 record in conference play—just the second perfect league record in program history and one of only seven in CAA history.

A finalist for the 2024 Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year and winner of the Touchdown Club of Richmond's Coach of the Year award, Huesman has coached 53 All-Americans and 23 NFL Draft picks during his career.

Prior to his time at Richmond, Huesman led Chattanooga from 2009 to 2016, compiling a 59-37 record, capturing three Southern Conference championships, and earning SoCon Coach of the Year honors three times. His teams made three straight FCS Playoff appearances from 2014 to 2016, and he oversaw the development of numerous All-Americans and future NFL players.

Earlier in his career, Huesman served on staffs at Memphis and William & Mary, where he coached future NFL head coaches Mike Tomlin and Sean McDermott. As a player, Huesman was a four-year starter at defensive back at Chattanooga from 1978 to 1981, helping lead the Mocs to two Southern Conference titles. He also played baseball during his time at UTC.

Known for his defensive acumen and program-building vision, Huesman has built a lasting legacy as one of the most respected coaches in FCS football.
