SPIDER NOTES

No. 2 ranked and third-seeded Richmond—winners of 23 of its last 25 games—makes its seventh NCAA Tournament appearance in just 13 seasons and will host its first-ever NCAA Tournament game at Robins Stadium on Saturday night against Duke, ranked No. 13 in polls and unseeded in the NCAA Tournament.

The Spiders currently rank fourth nationally in total attendance, with 21,935 fans passing through the gates at Robins Stadium this season. Richmond is also averaging 2,194 fans per game — the eighth-highest mark in the country. The program’s single-game attendance record at Robins Stadium is 4,249 fans, set on Feb. 8, 2014, during Richmond’s inaugural men’s lacrosse game. Richmond will be a NCAA Quarterfinals host site in 2028.

Led by back-to-back Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year Dan Chemotti, Richmond earned the A-10’s automatic bid and its seventh NCAA Tournament berth last Saturday with an 8–6 victory over Saint Joseph’s in the Atlantic 10 Championship. The title marked the program’s third A-10 crown in the last four years and secured its first back-to-back conference championships since 2022–23.

The Spiders are seeded in the NCAA Tournament for the first time and enter at 14–1, matching the program’s single-season wins record set last year. Richmond also completed an undefeated Atlantic 10 schedule for the second consecutive season and reached the program’s first-ever No. 1 national ranking earlier this year, highlighted by wins over fellow tournament teams Virginia, Cornell, and Georgetown.

The Spiders won their first-ever NCAA Tournament game last year, traveling to Chapel Hill to defeat No. 8 North Carolina, 13–10, before falling to eventual national champion Cornell, 13–12, in Hempstead, N.Y., in the quarterfinals.

Richmond continues to rank among the nation’s elite on both ends of the field, leading the country in scoring margin (+7.40) and winning percentage (93.3%), while ranking second nationally in both scoring offense (15.47) and points per game (24.13). The Spiders also sit among the national leaders in assists per game (8.67, 6th) and shot percentage (34.0%, 6th). The dominance extends defensively, where Richmond ranks third nationally in scoring defense (8.07) and sits fourth in caused turnovers per game (10.53), eighth in clearing percentage (90.9%), eighth in ground balls per game (35.27), and eighth in man-down defense (76.7%).

A Top 25 Tewaaron Award nominee, Aidan O’Neil continues to pace the offense, ranking fifth nationally in both points per game (5.07) and assists per game (2.80). In last Thursday’s semifinal win over UMass, O’Neil’s performance helped push his season total to 42 assists, setting a new program record for assists in a single season and surpassing Dalton Young’s previous mark of 41 set in 2023. Lucas Littlejohn is one of the nation’s most efficient finishers, ranking 22nd nationally in goals per game (2.67). Fellow Top 25 Tewaaron nominee Hunter Smith anchors the defense, ranking 13th nationally in caused turnovers per game (2.08). Freshman faceoff specialist Vincent Gaylord continues to control possession at the X and on the ground, ranking 20th nationally in faceoff win percentage (58.3%) and 15th in ground balls per game (6.57). In goal, Connor Knight has been a steady presence in his first season as Richmond’s full-time starter, ranking fifth nationally in goals-against average (7.96) and ninth in save percentage (56.5%). Gavin Creo adds another efficient scoring option, ranking 24th nationally in shot percentage (41.8%).

RICHMOND CLAIMS FIVE MAJOR A-10 AWARDS, WELL REPRESENTED ACROSS ALL-CONFERENCE TEAMS

Richmond placed 10 players on the Atlantic 10 postseason teams, highlighted by a conference-best seven First Team selections and three on the Second Team, while also earning five of the league's six major awards. Aidan O'Neil was named Offensive Player of the Year for the second straight season, Hunter Smith repeated as Defensive Player of the Year, Joe Sheridan earned Midfielder of the Year honors, Vincent Gaylord was selected as Rookie of the Year, and head coach Dan Chemotti was named Coach of the Year. First Team All-Atlantic 10 honors went to O'Neil, Smith, Sheridan, Gavin Creo, Lucas Littlejohn, Brayden Penafeather-Stevenson, and Jack Pilling, while Gaylord, Michael Farrell, and Connor Knight were named to the Second Team, with Gaylord also earning All-Rookie Team recognition and Creo, Penafeather-Stevenson, and Sheridan receiving All-Academic honors.

SMITH SELECTED 10TH OVERALL BY BOSTON CANNONS IN PLL COLLEGE DRAFT

Chosen with the second pick of the second round, Hunter Smith became just the second active Spider to be drafted to a PLL club, joining fellow defenseman Mitchell Dunham, who was selected in the 2025 College Draft by the Utah Archers. Smith is the highest PLL Draft pick in program history and was the second defenseman taken in the draft.

RICHMOND FEATURES FOUR FIRST TEAM, EIGHT TOTAL INSIDE LACROSSE MIDSEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Eight Spiders were named Inside Lacrosse Midseason All-Americans. Senior captains Aidan O'Neil (A), Joe Sheridan (M), Jack Pilling (SSDM), and Hunter Smith (D) earned First Team honors, while Gavin Creo (M), Vincent Gaylord (FO), Brayden Penafeather-Stevenson (LSM), and Connor Knight (G) received Honorable Mention recognition. Richmond's four First Team selections are the most of any program, while its eight total honorees are tied for second nationally behind Princeton and North Carolina (nine) and tied with Syracuse (eight).

IRON SHARPENS IRON

As they say, "to be the best, you've got to play the best," and the Spiders have never taken the easy way out when it comes to scheduling, having played at least three ranked opponents each season, excluding 2016 when they played two. Richmond is 17-41 all-time against top 20 opponents. Richmond's 17 wins over ranked opponents have come in 2026 (3 times), 2025 (5 times), 2022 (2 times) 2019 (2 times), 2018, 2017 (3 times) and 2016. The highest-ranked opponent Richmond has ever beaten came in 2022 when it knocked off No. 2 Virginia at Robins Stadium. The highest-ranked opponent the Spiders have defeated on the road was Cornell this season, who was ranked No. 5.

ROCKING ROBINS STADIUM

The Spiders ranked among the nation's top 15 programs in both average and cumulative home attendance in 2024 and 2025. Richmond averaged 2,488 fans per game over the last two seasons. The two largest crowds in program history both came against Virginia, led by a record attendance of 4,249 fans on Feb. 8, 2014, for the program's inaugural game. The second-largest crowd followed in 2024 against Virginia, when 4,012 fans packed the stands at Robins Stadium. The Spiders currently rank fourth in the nation in accumulative attendance with 21,935 coming through the gates of Robins Stadium so far this season, and average 2,194 fans a game — the eighth-most in the country.

NEW FACE ON STAFF

Conor Whipple joined the Richmond coaching staff in August of 2025 and will work with the Spiders' offense and man-up units while running the substitution box during games. Whipple brings a high-level

playing pedigree and a proven coaching résumé, most recently helping guide RIT to back-to-back NCAA Division III Final Four appearances, including a trip to the 2024 National Championship. Prior to RIT, he spent five seasons on the coaching staff at Bucknell, serving as the faceoff coordinator before taking on offensive and recruiting coordinator duties, where he helped develop a top-20 extra-man offense. As a player, Whipple enjoyed a Hall of Fame career at the University of Tampa where he played for his father, Rory Whipple, the all-time winningest coach in NCAA Division II men's lacrosse history.

WAY TO REPRESENT

Attackman Lucas Littlejohn (Canada) and two-way midfielder Charlie Packard (U.S.) represented their home countries in the World Lacrosse U20 Championships this past summer in Jeju Island, South Korea. The pair met in the gold medal game where Littlejohn and Team Canada team beat the U.S., 6-5

THINKING INSIDE THE BOX

Lucas Littlejohn had a standout box season over the summer for the Whitby Warriors of the Ontario Junior Lacrosse League. He led the OJLL in both goals (67) and assists (111) en route to winning the The Green Gael Trophy as the league's Most Valuable Player.

WORLD TRAVELERS

Shortly after the conclusion of the 2025 season, the Spiders traveled to Portugal and Spain for a team trip. The program immersed itself in local culture while kayaking, zip-lining, taking a cooking lesson, learning to surf and competing in two exhibition games against Scotland's national team. The trip marked the first time Head Coach Dan Chemotti led one of his teams

on an international tour. Under NCAA regulations, programs are permitted to take an international summer trip once every four years

2025 AT A GLANCE

Dan Chemotti was named 2025 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year after leading Richmond to the most successful season in program history. Richmond finished 14-3 overall and went a perfect 5-0 in Atlantic 10 play to win its first-ever A-10 regular-season title and captured its second A-10 tournament championship in three years.

Richmond earned its first NCAA Tournament victory with a 13-10 upset of No. 8 North Carolina in Chapel Hill.

The Spiders climbed as high as No. 5 in the national polls, the highest ranking in program history.

Richmond was one of only two NCAA Tournament teams ranked in the top 10 nationally in both scoring offense and scoring defense, alongside Notre Dame.

The Spiders set a program record with a nine-game winning streak and defeated a program-best four nationally ranked opponents. Those ranked wins included No. 7 Virginia, No. 13 Georgetown, No. 19 UMass, and No. 17 Saint Joseph's.

The Spiders' only loss by more than one goal came in the season opener at Maryland (12-7).

The Spiders finished second nationally in scoring margin, third in scoring defense,

and fourth in caused turnovers per game. Richmond also ranked eighth in clearing percentage, ninth in scoring offense, and 11th in points per game.

Eight Richmond players earned All-America honors and the Spiders claimed five of the six Atlantic 10 postseason major awards, including Aidan O'Neil (Offensive Player of the Year), Max Merklinger (Midfielder of the Year), Zach Vigue (Goalie of the Year), and Hunter Smith (Co-Defensive Player of the Year). Richmond placed 10 players on All-Atlantic 10 teams

DAN CHEMOTTI

HEAD COACH | 13TH SEASON | DUKE '02 | 132-68 (.767)

Dan Chemotti enters his 13th season as head coach of the University of Richmond men's lacrosse program in 2026, continuing a tenure that has defined the program since its inception. Hired in 2012, Chemotti is the program's first and only head coach and has overseen its development from a first-year Division I team into a nationally recognized contender.

Chemotti has guided Richmond to six NCAA Tournament appearances (2014, 2018, 2019, 2022, 2023, 2025) within the program's first 12 seasons, including conference tournament championships in three different leagues (Atlantic Sun, Southern Conference, Atlantic 10). Under his leadership, the Spiders have won five regular-season conference titles and reached the conference championship game in every season of program existence and has produced 17 All-Americans during his tenure.

Entering 2026, Chemotti has compiled a 118-67 (.637) career record at Richmond, including nine seasons with double-digit wins. The Spiders have won more than 80 percent of their conference games all-time (54-12) and earned the program's 100th victory on March 30, 2024.

The 2025 season marked the most successful campaign in program history. Richmond finished 14-3 overall and went a perfect 5-0 in Atlantic 10 play to secure its first A-10 regular-season title and a second conference tournament championship in three years. The Spiders earned their first NCAA Tournament victory with a 13-10 upset of No. 8 North Carolina on the road and reached a program-high national ranking of No. 5. Richmond finished the season ranked in the top 10 nationally in both scoring offense and scoring defense, joining Notre Dame as the only NCAA Tournament teams to do so in 2025.

Richmond defeated four nationally ranked opponents during the season, set a program record with a nine-game winning streak, and ranked among the national leaders in scoring margin, scoring defense, caused turnovers, clearing percentage, scoring offense, and points per game. Eight Spiders earned All-America honors, and the team claimed five of six Atlantic 10 major postseason awards, including Chemotti's first Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honor. Close defenseman Mitchell Dunham became the first active Spider selected in the PLL College Draft when he was chosen 21st overall by the Utah Archers.

Prior to Richmond, Chemotti served as offensive coordinator at Loyola University Maryland, where he helped lead the Greyhounds to the 2012 NCAA National Championship. During his time at Loyola, the program earned four NCAA Tournament berths, produced 12 All-Americans, and led the nation in several offensive categories. Earlier coaching stops included Dartmouth and St. John's.

A 2002 graduate of Duke, Chemotti was a four-year starter and team captain for the Blue Devils, helping lead the program to four NCAA Tournament appearances and back-to-back ACC Championships. He later played professionally in Major League Lacrosse and the National Lacrosse League.
