BY THE NUMBERS

Punter Ned Gray leads the nation with 1,067 punting yards through three games. His 24 punts rank second nationally, while his 44.5-yard average ranks third. Gray has six punts of 50-plus yards and six downed inside the 20 so far this season.

Defensive end Camden Byrd ranks second nationally and leads the Patriot League with 1.33 sacks per game. Byrd has four sacks and four tackles for loss through three games and now owns 21.5 career sacks, tying his former teammate Jeremiah Grant for fifth all-time at Richmond.

Defensive tackle TJ Baldwin ranks fifth nationally and second in the Patriot League with 1.0 sack per game. Baldwin has already matched his 2025 sack total with three through three games so far this season.

Richmond has recorded 11 sacks through three games. Byrd and Baldwin have combined for seven, with Daniel Sellers adding two and Blake Houser and freshman Jefferson Serkfem recording one apiece.

Blake Houser leads Richmond with 25 tackles, including a team-high 16 solo stops. He also has two tackles for loss, a sack, a pass breakup, two quarterback hurries and a forced fumble.

The Storyline . . .

Richmond returns to Robins Stadium Saturday for its second Patriot League game of the season, hosting Georgetown at 3:30 p.m. The Spiders enter the week 2-1 overall and 1-0 in league play after opening the season with a conference win over Bucknell before playing their next two games on the road. Richmond has recorded 11 sacks through three games, led by Camden Byrd with four and TJ Baldwin with three. Punter Ned Gray has also emerged among the nation's leaders, totaling an FCS-best 1,067 punting yards through three games. Offensively, freshman Bryce Allen leads Richmond with 165 receiving yards, while Aziz Foster-Powell has rushed for a team-high 141 yards and three touchdowns.

Series History . . .

Richmond is 4-5 all-time against Georgetown. The teams first met in 1894, with Georgetown outscoring Richmond 180-0 over the first four meetings (1894, 1900, 1909, 1911). Richmond has outscored the Hoyas 128-34 in the three most recent match-

ups (2008, 2009, 2025).

Last Time vs. Georgetown . . .

Richmond rallied from an 11-point second-half deficit to defeat Georgetown, 31-24, at Cooper Field on Nov. 8, 2025, earning the 600th victory in program history. The Spiders trailed 21-10 early in the third quarter before Ashten Snelsire came off the bench and helped lead three second-half touchdown drives. Snelsire scored on a one-yard run, connected with Ja'Vion Griffin for a 45-yard touchdown and later found Andrew King for the 15-yard game-winning score with 2:43 remaining. Aziz Foster-Powell led Richmond with 64 rushing yards and a touchdown, while Griffin finished with 106 receiving yards and a score. Richmond's defense recorded eight sacks and 12 tackles for loss, with Donovan Hoilette totaling 3.5 sacks and 4.5 tackles for loss. Braxton Lassiter recovered a Georgetown fumble at the Hoyas' six-yard line to set up Richmond's deciding touchdown.

No Fly Zone . . .

Richmond's pass defense has been effective against FCS competition this season, holding Bucknell and Howard to a combined 25-of-57 passing for 264 yards. FCS opponents have completed just 43.9% of their passes while averaging 132.0 passing yards per game. The Spiders also recorded 14 pass breakups and nine sacks in those two games while allowing just 3.5 yards per play overall.

No Room to Run . . .

Richmond has limited its two FCS opponents to 157 rushing yards on 65 carries this season, an average of 78.5 yards per game and 2.4 yards per attempt. Bucknell and Howard combined for only eight rushing first downs and one rushing touchdown. The Spiders opened the season by holding Bucknell to 32 yards on 29 carries before allowing 125 rushing yards at Howard.

THINGS TO KNOW

- **GRAY AMONG THE NATION'S BEST** — Ned Gray leads the nation with 1,067 punting yards, ranks second with 24 punts and third with a 44.5-yard average. Gray put together a career-best performance in the season opener against Bucknell, averaging 44.9 yards per punt and matching his career-long with a 57-yard punt before adding another career-best performance against Howard where he averaged 47.10 yards per punt. He recorded a career-high nine punts against NC State, averaging 42.00 yards a kick.
- **GETTING TO THE QUARTERBACK** — Richmond ranks second nationally and first in the Patriot League with 3.67 sacks per game through three games. The Spiders have a nation-best 11 sacks overall, including nine in two games against FCS opponents, an average of 4.5 per game. Camden Byrd has four sacks, while TJ Baldwin has three. Byrd ranks second nationally and leads the Patriot League at 1.33 sacks per game, while Baldwin ranks fifth nationally and second in the League at 1.0.
- **HOUSER IN THE MIDDLE OF EVERYTHING** — Junior linebacker Blake Houser continues to pace Richmond in tackles with 25 through three games, including 16 solo stops. Houser has added two tackles for loss, a sack, one pass breakup, two quarterback hurries and a forced fumble.
- **STRONG AGAINST FCS COMPETITION** — Richmond's defense has been effective in its two games against FCS opponents this season. The Spiders allowed Bucknell and Howard an average of just 210.5 yards and 17.5 points per game while surrendering only 3.5 yards per play. Those opponents averaged 132.0 passing yards and 78.5 rushing yards per game and converted just seven of 31 third downs (22.6%). Richmond also recorded nine sacks and 14 pass breakups in those two games.
- **SPECIAL TEAMS STAND OUT** — Richmond enters the week ranked among the national leaders in multiple special teams categories. The Spiders rank 14th nationally and second in the Patriot League in net punting and 11th nationally and first in the League in average punt returns (20.50 yards). Punter Ned Gray leads the nation with 1,067 punting yards, ranks second with 24 punts and third with a 44.5-yard average.

Quarterback Ashten Snelsire has thrown for 536 yards and six touchdowns through Richmond's first three games, including 460 yards and six scores in two games against FCS opponents. The senior has completed 44-of-86 passes this season and has started all three games. Snelsire also played a key role in last year's win at Georgetown, coming off the bench to throw for 114 yards and two touchdowns while adding a rushing score in Richmond's 31-24 comeback victory.

Jackson Thorne moved into the starting lineup after Richmond's anticipated Week 1 starter at SAM linebacker was injured on the opening kickoff against Bucknell. Thorne has started all three games this season, recording 19 tackles, 2.5 tackles for loss and a pass breakup. He posted a season-high eight tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss at NC State.

Sellers Is A Freak . . .

Defensive end Daniel Sellers was named to Bruce Feldman's 2026 college football "Freaks List," ranking No. 98 among the 101 most physically gifted players in the country. The 6-3, 254-pound Sellers recorded 4.5 tackles for loss, three sacks and two forced fumbles as a sophomore in 2025. Sellers continued his development during the offseason, earning Richmond's Gus Lee Winter Warrior Award as the player who made the biggest strides during winter workouts. Sellers can squat 600 pounds, bench more than 455 pounds and power clean approximately 365 pounds.

The Power of 10 . . .

The Patriot League enters a new era in 2026 with 10 football members following the additions of Villanova and William & Mary. Bucknell, Colgate, Fordham, Georgetown, Holy Cross, Lafayette, Lehigh, Richmond, Villanova and William & Mary now comprise one of the nation's deepest FCS conferences. The League's "Power of 10" campaign highlights both the strength of the expanded membership and its collective tradition of success. The 10 programs have combined for two FCS national championships, 12 national semifinal appearances, 22 quarterfinal appearances and 42 FCS postseason victories.

2025 At A Glance . . .

Richmond navigated its first season in the Patriot League to a 7–5 overall record and 3–4 conference mark in 2025, extending the program's run of winning seasons to six. Eleven Spiders earned the program's first-ever Patriot League All-League honors, while head coach Russ Huesman became the second-winningest coach in program history with his 54th Richmond victory, a 38–14 win over VMI. The season ended with a memorable 14-point comeback against William & Mary, as the Spiders erased a 14–0 halftime deficit to win the Capital Cup and improve to 67–64–4 in the all-time series.

Richmond's defense ranked sixth nationally and second in the Patriot League in total defense, allowing just 290.3 yards per game. The Spiders led the league in passing defense at 155.3 yards per game, ranked second in scoring defense at 22.7 points per game and finished third with 11 interceptions. Offensively, Richmond ranked third in the Patriot League in rush-

ing at 147.7 yards per game, while the offensive line surrendered just 14 sacks (1.17 per game), third-best in the league and 14th nationally. Quarterback Kyle Wickersham also led the Patriot League with a 64.6 completion percentage.

The second-winningest and second-longest-serving coach in University of Richmond football history, Russ Huesman enters his 10th season as the Spiders' head coach in 2026, marking his 18th season overall as a collegiate head coach. This marks Huesman's second stint with the program after previously serving five seasons (2004-08) as an assistant coach, including his role as defensive coordinator for Richmond's 2008 FCS National Championship team.

Under Huesman's leadership, Richmond has established itself as one of the most consistent programs in the FCS. With Huesman at the helm, Richmond has won two conference championships (2023, 2024) and made three straight FCS Playoff appearances (2022, 2023, 2024).

In more than 40 years of coaching, Huesman has guided 53 All-Americans and 23 NFL Draft selections while being part of 11 conference championships and Richmond's 2008 National Championship.

In 2025, Huesman guided the Spiders through a transition to the Patriot League while continuing to build on the program's championship culture. Richmond finished 7-5 overall, earned 11 All-Patriot League selections and saw Huesman become the second-winningest coach in program history following a 38-14 victory over VMI. The season was highlighted by a dramatic comeback win over William & Mary in the Capital Cup, extending Richmond's advantage in the historic rivalry. Under Huesman's guidance, the Spiders featured one of the nation's top defenses, ranking first in the Patriot League and fourth nationally in passing defense while finishing sixth nationally in total defense. Richmond also showcased balance offensively, ranking third in the league in rushing and featuring an offensive line that allowed just 14 sacks, one of the top marks in the FCS.
