What You Need To Know

- Rider closes out a two-game non-conference road trip on Saturday, December 15 with a clash against Bucknell. The Broncs are looking to avenge a five-point setback at home to the Bison to start the 2017-18 campaign. Bucknell is currently ranked No. 9 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25. The Broncs are 0-1 against teams ranked in the poll this year.

- Last time out, the Broncs rallied to defeat Binghamton, 62-57. Rider used a 14-0 run in the second half to knock off the Bearcats on the road. In the win, Stella Johnson had 21 points to go along with nine steals, while Lexi Posset had 19 points and three assists.

- Stella became the 23rd player in program history to score 1,000 points in the game at Binghamton. She is the first junior to accomplish the feat since MyNeshia McKenzie during the 2012-13 season. She set a new single-game program record with nine steals.

- All of Rider's home games this season will be streamed on either ESPN3 or ESPN+. There will be no radio broadcasts during Rider's home games in 2018-19. All of Rider's road contests will be broadcast on 107.7 The Bronc, including Saturday's tilt.

SCOUTING BUCKNELL

The Bison enter Saturday afternoon's contest with a 7-2 mark after an 81-43 thumping of Iona on December 2. The tilt with the Broncs will be the first for Bucknell in nearly two weeks. The Bison are 2-0 at home this year and in the midst of a five-game winning streak. Bucknell is 4-0 against teams from the MAAC this season with all four victories, including a 75-58 beat down of MAAC preseason favorite Quinnipiac, coming by double digits. The Bison have trotted out the same starting five in all nine of their contests this season. It is a balanced attack for Bucknell will all five starters averaging over seven points per tilt, led by Kaitlyn Slagus with over 13 points and nearly eight rebounds per contest. As a team, Bucknell is shooting an impressive 45.8 percent from the field and over 38 percent from three-point range. The Bison have a +1.0 turnover margin and are recording over nine steals per contest. Bucknell is currently ranked No. 10 in the CollegeInsider Mid-Major Top-25.

LAST YEAR VERSUS THE BISON

In the first meeting between the two teams since the 2011-12 campaign, Bucknell used an 8-0 fourth-quarter run to rally to defeat the Broncs, 76-71, in the season opener for both teams. Rider shot just 55 percent (11-of-20) from the foul line in the contest and Bucknell rallied to win despite committing 28 turnovers. In the fourth quarter, Rider shot just 6-of-20 from the field and 1-of-7 from beyond the arc.

SERIES HISTORY

Rider and Bucknell are playing for the 25 time in the series history. The teams are playing for the second year in a row and just the second time since the 2011-12 season. The Bison lead the all-time series, 15-9, with the first meeting coming during the 1980-81 season.

LAST TIME OUT

The Broncs used a 14-0 run from the end of the third quarter through the start of the fourth quarter to rally to defeat Binghamton, 62-57, last Saturday in non-conference in Vestal, New York. In the victory, junior Stella Johnson scored a game-high 21 points to go along with nine steals, while senior point guard Lexi Posset poured in a season-high 19 points. The Broncs forced 28 turnovers in the win and registered 18 steals.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB

Junior Stella Johnson became the 23rd player in Rider women's basketball history to score 1,000 career points. With a three-point play early in the fourth quarter at Binghamton, she became the fourth Bronc in the last three years to reach the milestone. Stella was also the first junior to record her 1,000th career point for Rider since MyNeshia McKenzie did so during the 2012-13 season.

RECORD-BREAKING PERFORMANCE

Stella Johnson set another program record on Saturday at Binghamton. She recorded nine steals to set a new single-game program record. She broke her own record of eight steals in a game which she recorded in her second career game. She had five steals in the first half and her record-breaking theft came as time expired in the contest as she stole the inbounds pass by the Bearcats.

RANK & FILE

Rider currently leads the MAAC in blocks per game with 3.78 swatted shots per contest. The team also ranks second in the league in scoring offense (69.2), field-goal percentage (39.6), turnover margin (+3.2), assist-to-turnover ratio (0.95) and second in assists per game (13.3 APG). The Broncs are third in the conference in both steals per game (9.56) and made three-point field goals per game (6.2).

LEADER OF THE PACK

Stella Johnson leads the MAAC in five different statistical categories. She ranks top in the conference in points per game (20.6), total points (185), field-goal percentage (47.8%), assists per game (5.0), total assists (45), assist-to-turnover ratio (2.0), steals per game (3.7) and steals (33). She ranks in the top-10 in all of Division I in both steals (she's eighth with 33) and steals per game (she's 10th with 3.7). Stella also ranks 24th in the nation with 20.6 points per game.

TWO-HEADED ATTACK

Stella Johnson and Lexi Posset combined to score 40 points for the Broncs in the victory at Binghamton. The duo combined for 14 steals, seven assists and five rebounds. They also took 10 of the team's 16 shots at the foul line. Johnson and Posset were 5-of-13 from three-point range and the rest of the team shot just 1-of-9.

BUZZER BEATER!!!!

Senior point guard Lexi Posset hit a half-court, buzzer-beating three-pointer to end the third quarter at Binghamton. The shot gave the Broncs a 48-47 edge at the time and Rider would not trail again in the contest. Posset's bucket was featured on ESPNW's Top 10 Plays of the Week (It was play No. 5!) and helped the Broncs end the third frame on a 7-0 run.

WELCOME BACK

Since returning from injury on December 2, point guard Lexi Posset has scored in double figures in back-to-back games. With Posset running the offense, the Broncs have averaged 61 points per game and dished out 13 assists per game. Last time out, she scored a season-high 19 points to go along with three assists and a career-high five steals. Against Binghamton, Posset hit all four of her free-throw attempts and buried 3-of-5 shots from three-point range.

CHARITY STRIPE

Rider took 16 free-throw attempts in the win at Binghamton, hitting 12. The team shot over 70 percent from the foul line for the second straight contest and the third time this season. The team made 12 or more free throws for just the second time this year. Two games ago against NJIT Rider did not attempt a single free throw. That tilt with the Highlanders marked the first time under Head Coach Lynn Milligan that Rider did not attempt a free throw.

DEFENSE (CLAP CLAP) DEFENSE (CLAP CLAP)

Rider forced a season-high 28 turnovers in the win against Binghamton. It marked the most turnovers for the Broncs since forcing 28 in the season opener against Bucknell last season. Rider has forced their opponents to commit over 25 turnovers in two of their last three games. Rider has won both games this season in which they've forced over 20 turnovers. The tilt with Binghamton marked the third time this season that Rider has made less turnovers than their opponent. The Broncs have won all three of those games.

GRAND THEFT AUTO

Rider had a season-high 18 steals in the win against Binghamton. Stella Johnson set a single-game program record with nine steals and Lexi Posset had a career-high five thefts in the triumph. It marked the most steals for Rider since the team had 18 in the regular-season opener last season versus Bucknell. The Broncs have registered 10 or more steals in a game four times this season and the team is 3-1 in those games.

BLOCK PARTY

Rider leads the MAAC with 3.78 blocks per game this season. Against Binghamton, the Broncs recorded four blocks. It marked the fifth time this year that team has registered four or more blocks in a game. The Broncs have blocked over four shots in each of their last three games. Versus Navy, Rider had a season-high seven blocks. The game with Navy marked the most blocks for Rider since the team had nine in the regular-season finale at Manhattan last year.

NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

Rider has a packed non-conference schedule in the early portion of the season. After facing the two-time defending Ivy League champion Princeton Tigers, the Broncs have faced opponents from the A10 (Saint Joseph's) and the ACC (Boston College). Rider still has to face a team from the Big EAST (Georgetown) in December. Rider will face one team that played in last year's NCAA Tournament (Princeton) and four squads that appeared in the WNIT (Saint Joseph's, Navy, Bucknell and Georgetown). The Broncs are 0-1 against NCAA Tournament teams and 1-1 versus teams that appeared in last year's WNIT.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK

Saturday's win at Saint Joseph's marked the first time this year that the Broncs won a game when trailing at halftime. The Broncs opened the third quarter on a 6-0 and outscored the Hawks, 14-10. It marked the fifth straight game in which the Broncs won the third quarter. Rider has outscored its opponents coming out of halftime in five of their six games. Rider has scored 113 points in the quarter this year, while surrendering 97 points.

HOT SHOOTING

As a team, Rider shot a season-best 60.7 percent (34-of-56) from the field in the victory over Mount St. Mary's. It was their first time shooting over 48 percent from the floor this year. Stella Johnson and Amari Johnson combined to hit 24-of-35 shots, including knocking down 10-of-16 from three-point range. It was the highest team field-goal percentage for Rider since the team knocked down 59.6 percent (28-of-47) of their shots in win over NJIT last December.

OFFENSIVE ERUPTION

Rider scored a season-high 85 points versus Mount St. Mary's. It was their first time scoring over 65 points this season. It was just the second time since the start of the 2017-18 campaign that Rider scored 80 or more points in a game. It was their highest point total since pouring in 85 in a win versus Iona in January of 2017.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE!!!

Junior Stella Johnson recorded the second triple-double in program history for the Broncs against Mount St. Mary's. She scored a career-high 35 points to go along with 12 rebounds and 10 assists. She is the first player in program history to record a triple-double with points, rebounds and assists. It marked the first triple-double by a player in the MAAC since January of 2005. It was also the first triple-double by a Bronc since Jessica Beck had 19 points, 18 rebounds and 12 blocks in February of 1995. She is one of eight players in the country to record a triple-double this season.

WHAT A GAME

Stella shot 14-of-19 from the field, including 6-of-8, from three-point range in the win against the Mountaineers. She set new career-highs in points, field-goals made and three-point field-goals made, while tying her career-high in assists. With her 35 points and 10 assists, Stella was directly responsible for 56 of Rider's 85 points.

WEEKLY HONORS

On November 19, Stella Johnson was named the MAAC Player of the Week and the College Sports Madness MAAC Player of the Week for the second time this year. It marked the fourth time she picked up weekly accolades from the MAAC after twice being tabbed as the MAAC Rookie of the Week during her freshman campaign. College Sports Madness also named Stella the National Division I Mid-Major Player of the Week on the 19th as well.

HALFTIME ADJUSTMENTS

Rider has won the third quarter in seven of their nine games this season. The Broncs are outscoring the opposition, 168-144, coming out of halftime this year. Rider outscored the Bearcats, 21-11, in the third quarter last Saturday. The Broncs ended the third quarter on a 7-0 run.

most under Milligan in a season and in program history. The team finished above .500 in conference play for the third time since entering the league and the No. 2 seed is the best for Rider since joining the MAAC as well.

In 2016-17, the women's basketball team saw four players earn All-MAAC honors as announced in early March by the league office. The four players earning All-MAAC honors is a new program record for Rider as the team saw three players receive league-wide distinction in 2012-13, 2001-02 and 1999-2000. The four players honored by the league were the most by any team in the conference this year.

In 2014-15, Milligan's squad posted double-digit wins for the fourth season in a row before being held to eight wins this past season.

In 2013-14, Milligan led the Broncos to 15 wins, tying for fifth in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and Rider advanced to the MAAC semifinals for the first time and the Broncos won their first playoff game since 2004-05.

During that season, Milligan put a player on the All-MAAC First Team for the second season in a row with MyNeshia McKenzie a finalist for Player of the Year honors in the conference. McKenzie graduated as Rider's all-time leading rebounder and third on the all-time scoring list.

Milligan also had a player on the MAAC All-Rookie team with Julia Duggan earning Rider's fifth All-Rookie honor in

In 2017-18, the Broncos went 14-17 overall and 10-8 MAAC play to earn the No. 5 seed in the MAAC Tournament. Rider won a MAAC Tournament game for the second year in a row after topping fourth-seeded Fairfield in the MAAC Quarterfinals. The Broncos advanced to the MAAC Semifinals for the second year in a row and the third time in program history.

During the year, four Broncos earned weekly awards from either the MAAC or College Sports Madness. At the conclusion of the regular season, three Rider players garnered All-MAAC recognition. In 2017-18, Kamila Hoskova became the 22nd player in program history to score 1,000 career points. She ended her stellar tenure with the Broncos eighth all-time in scoring with 1,255 points.

The team had a record-breaking in 2016-17, finishing 24-9 and earning the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) automatic bid to the WNIT thanks to a second-place finish during the regular season. The post-season berth was the first for the Broncos at the Division I level.

Milligan picked up her 100th career win as the Head Coach of the Broncos during the 2016-17 season and she now ranks second all-time in program history in wins.

She was named both the MAAC Coach of the Year in a vote of her peers and the Maggie Dixon Division I Coach of the Year by the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association. Milligan was the first Rider Head Coach to earn both distinctions.

Milligan guided the Broncos to arguably the most successful season in program history in 2016-17, racking up 24 wins and earning the No. 2 seed in the MAAC Tournament. Picked to finish 10th in the preseason poll, Rider posted an 8-2 mark both on the road and at home in conference play. The team swept eight MAAC opponents during the regular season and was ranked for four weeks in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top-25 Poll.

The 24 wins are the most victories by the Broncos under Milligan and the most for the program since the team won 26 games during the 1981-82 season. The 24 wins against Division I opponents is the most in a single season in program history as well. The 16 MAAC wins are also the

Milligan's first seven seasons.

With 15 wins in 2012-13, Rider had its best season since the Broncs went 16-12 in 1994-95.

The 15 wins were the fifth most in the then 74-year history of the program and Rider tied its best MAAC record (10-8), finishing fourth in the conference.

Rider made the MAAC quarterfinals and McKenzie earned First Team All-MAAC and Second Team All-MET honors with senior Caitlin Bopp earning Third Team All-MAAC honors with freshman Mikal Johnson named to the MAAC All-Rookie team.

Rider got off to its best start in almost 30 years when the Broncs opened 2011-12 with eight wins in the first 11 games, matching the 8-3 start by the 1982-83 squad. The Broncs were led by McKenzie who was recognized with Third Team All-MAAC honors.

In Milligan's first season, Rider tripled its win total in the MAAC and the excitement that Milligan brought to the program boosted attendance in Alumni Gym to almost 600 fans per game.

Milligan returned to her alma mater to become the new head coach of the Rider University women's basketball team, on April 24, 2007.

"Returning to Rider has been a dream come true," said Milligan, who was a two-sport stand-out for the Broncs. "I was thrilled to come home to a place that is so special to me and have the opportunity to lead the women's basketball program into the future."

Milligan returned to Rider from Saint Joseph's University in Philadelphia, Pa., where she served as an assistant coach for six years, the last two as the top assistant. Saint Joseph's earned a berth in the WNIT five times during her last six seasons.

At Saint Joseph's, Milligan was directly responsible for recruiting and guard play for a program that compiled 111 wins during her last six seasons with the team. Three of her last five recruiting classes were nationally ranked. She assisted with all aspects of the Hawks' program, including on-court instruction, scouting, game-plan preparation, academic support and fundraising.

Prior to joining Saint Joseph's, Milligan spent six years as the top assistant coach at Drexel University. In her final season, she helped guide Drexel to a 19-10 record overall and a 13-5 mark in the America East Conference, tying for second place and advancing to the semifinal round of the league tournament. Milligan arrived in Philadelphia following a one-year stint as an assistant coach at Central Connecticut State.

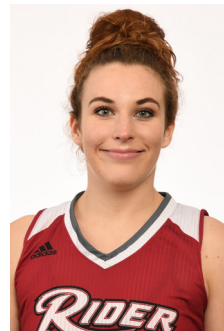
