What You Need To Know

- Rider returns to non-conference play Tuesday, when it travels to Delaware.
- Rider has had a brutal early-season schedule, falling at Power 5 schools Virginia, Rutgers, Texas and then-Nationally-ranked No. 2 Houston. The Broncos were also sent on the road to begin MAAC play, falling to Merrimack and two-time-defending MAAC Regular Season Champion Quinnipiac.
- The Broncos earned a win in their home opener Nov. 15 against Division III Eastern University.
- AB Coulibaly broke out for 20 points and nine rebounds at Quinnipiac. Antwan Wilson also contributed 13 points in his first start as a Bronc.
- Caleb Smith has posted two double-doubles - at Rutgers and vs. Coppin State, while coming up a point shy of his third (9 pts, 10 reb) at Merrimack.
- Cole McCabe scored a career-high 12 points to lead six Broncos with at least seven points in a 68-66 setback at Merrimack on Dec. 4.
- Rider and Delaware have played close games in each of the last three seasons, with the Blue Hens winning 2-of-3 and both games in Lawrenceville to take a 34-31 lead in the all-time series.
- Justyn Fernandez leads Delaware at 16.6 ppg., while Christian Bliss (14.8 ppg.), Macon Emory (13.5 ppg.) and Tyler Houser (11.7 ppg.) also average in double figures scoring, with Jameel Brown (9.8 ppg.) just missing the mark. - 14th-year Head Coach Kevin Baggett's teams have posted a 207-210 record. Baggett won MAAC Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2018.
- Only John Carpenter (292) has more head coaching wins at Rider.

HOLD THE O; WE ARE THE BRONCS

Originally nicknamed the Rough Riders by the father of Rider Athletics, Clair Bee, Rider's nickname later changed to the Broncos. What is a Bronc? It's a Bronco. But you can hold the second o. Why do we call ourselves the Broncos, then? The quick answer is a newspaper writer at least 70 years ago likely wanted a shorter word to fit their headline and called us the Broncos. Enough people actually liked it, so it stuck. Bee was not one who enjoyed the change, later saying he "damn near went through the ceiling" when he first read of the change. Still to this day, broadcasters and public address announcers routinely call us the Broncos in error, lighting up our SID's phone with texts, calls, emails and DM's to voice frustration. Your assistance in keeping the Broncos to a single "o" and our SID's phone to "0" messages about the issue is greatly appreciated.

SCOUTING THE DELAWARE BLUE HENS

Justyn Fernandez leads Delaware at 16.6 ppg., while Christian Bliss (14.8 ppg.), Macon Emory (13.5 ppg.) and Tyler Houser (11.7 ppg.) also average in double figures scoring, with Jameel Brown (9.8 ppg.) just missing the mark. AB AND ANTWAN BREAK OUT AT QUINNIPIAC

AB Coulibaly and Antwan Wilson had breakout performances at Quinnipiac on Dec. 7. Coulibaly went for 20 points and nine rebounds in 32 minutes off the bench, easily eclipsing his previous highs of six points, three rebounds and 12 minutes. Wilson, making his first start as a Bronc, contributed 13 points and four rebounds, hitting 5-of-9 from the floor and 3-of-5 from deep. His previous highs were five points and two rebounds.

MOVING FORWARD AT MERRIMACK

Rider made significant strides in several areas in the MAAC opener at Merrimack. The Broncos featured balanced scoring, with six Rider players scoring at least seven points, led by Cole McCabe's 12. The Broncos also dominated the boards, 41-19, led by Caleb Smith's 10.

CRUZ'IN HIGH, SMITH SOLID

Zion Cruz scored a season-high 18 points and Caleb Smith added his and the Broncos' second double-double (10 points, season-high 11 rebounds) of the year, but Rider fell to Coppin State, 68-65, on Nov. 25.

HOUSTON WAS A PROBLEM

Nationally-ranked No. 2 Houston didn't do much wrong in defeating the Broncos, 91-45, Nov. 20 in Texas. The Cougars shot 56.1 percent (37-66) from the floor and never trailed in the game. Caleb Smith scored a team-high 13 points for the Broncos, including his second-straight game with 6-for-6 shooting from the free-throw line.

NON-CONFERENCE GAUNTLET

The Broncos played Power 5 competition in each of their first four games against Division I opponents this season. Rider opened the year at Virginia on Nov. 3, before making the short trip to intrastate foe Rutgers (Nov. 5). Following a Nov. 15 meeting with Division III Eastern University, the Broncos traveled to Texas to take on the University of Texas (Nov. 18) and 2025 National Runner-Up Houston (Nov. 20). Among MAAC programs, only Mount St. Mary's plays as many as four Power 5 games this season, while Quinnipiac plays three. None of the other 10 teams in the league are scheduled to play more than two Power 5 programs.

INSIDE AND ON THE BREAK

Texas defeated the Broncos, 99-65, on Nov. 18, taking scoring advantages of 42-8 in the paint and 34-4 on fast breaks. Foul trouble played a role on the interior, with the Broncos' starting frontcourt of Mohamad Diallo and Cole McCabe fouling out with 12:05 and 9:27 remaining in regulation, respectively. Flash Burton as a bright spot offensively with a team-high 16 points.

EFFECTIVE PLAYERS ONLY HALFTIME TEAM MEETING

Tied at 36-36 at the half against Division III Eastern University on Nov. 15, Rider team captains Zion Cruz and Flash Burton asked the coaching staff to step outside the locker room and let them handle the halftime messaging. The result was a 30-3 run to begin the second half and the game never got closer than 22 points the rest of the way. Burton led the Broncos with 21 points in the game, while Cruz added 16. Mohamad Diallo (12) and Caleb Smith (10) also reached double figures.

20 PRETTY DECENT, 20 TO FORGET

Rider hung with Virginia in the first half on Nov. 3, outshooting the Cavaliers, 41.7 percent to 40.0 percent, while trailing, 42-32, after 20 minutes. But things unraveled in the second, with Virginia scoring 28 of the first 31 points to begin the second half. Flash Burton scored 15 of his team-high 17 points in the first half.

SCRAPPY SMITH

Caleb Smith was a bright spot for the Broncos in their first two games. After scoring six points and grabbing a team-high eight rebounds at Virginia (Nov. 3), Smith posted a double-double of 12 points and 10 rebounds at Rutgers (Nov. 5). Smith grabbed eight of his 18 boards on the offensive glass in the two games and got to the free-throw line consistently, where he made 12-of-18 attempts, including 8-of-10 at Rutgers.

RETURNING CAST

The Broncos are led by returning starters Zion Cruz and Flash Burton. Cruz was named to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team after starting 24 of 30 games played a year ago and finishing third on the team at 10.1 ppg. He shot 35.6 percent from beyond the three-point arc, best on the team among those with more than 1.0 three-point field goal made per game and 15th in the MAAC. He scored in double figures 16 times. Burton started 12 of 33 games played, including the final 10 games of the season, averaged 7.6 points, 2.3 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game, posting a 1.4 assist-to-turnover ratio (15th-MAAC). Cole McCabe also returns after playing in 26 games, including one start, as a true freshman.

PORTAL PRODUCTIONS

The Broncs will look to get contributions from seven transfers in 2025-26. Five of the seven transfers enter with prior Division I experience - Davis Bynum (Cal State Fullerton), Shemani Fuller (Western Michigan), Daniel Helterhoff (USC Upstate), Devean Williams (Canisius/Bryant) and Antwan Wilson (UMES). Mo-hamad Diallo (Florida Memorial, Clayton State, Morehouse) brings a variety of NAIA and Division II experience, while Caleb Smith (Pratt C.C./Garden City C.C.) arrives from the JUCO ranks.

FRESH FACES

Rider also welcomed three scholarship freshmen. 6-foot freshman guards Kristupas Kepezinskas (Kaunas, Lithuania) and Jamir McNeil (Cape May Courthouse, NJ) and 6-foot-5 wing AB Coulibaly (Philadelphia, PA) will look to make contributions for the Broncs this season.

BAGGETT SECOND ALL-TIME AT RIDER

14th-year Rider Head Coach Kevin Baggett tied Thomas Leyden (1940-42, 1946-60) for second all-time at Rider with his 187th win on Feb. 18, 2024, at Manhattan and passed him with his 188th win on Feb. 23, 2024, vs. Iona. Entering the season with 206 wins, only John Carpenter's program-record 292 wins outpace him.

200 WINS FOR BAGGETT

Rider Head Coach Kevin Baggett earned his 200th win as Broncs Head Coach on Jan. 31, 2025 vs. Saint Peter's. Only three other coaches in the 45-year history of the MAAC have compiled 200 wins as head coach at league institutions - Joe Mihalich (265, all at Niagara), John Dunne (256, 153 at Saint Peter's, 103 at Marist) and Jimmy Patsos (222, 145 at Loyola, 77 at Siena). Baggett's 139 wins in league play rank third all-time behind Mihalich (166) and Dunne (157). Both Baggett's 100th (Jan. 26, 2018) and 200th wins came against Saint Peter's in late January.

BEST HELD UNDER 72

Rider was 10-3 last season when holding the opposition to fewer than 72 points, with the exceptions coming in three games in February. The Broncs had won the first seven times they held an opponent under 72 before falling, 66-64, to Merrimack on Feb. 2. The Broncs also fell consecutively, 66-65 at Saint Peter's on Feb. 16 and 69-49 vs. Fairfield on Feb. 21. Rider has defeated San Diego (68-67), Coppin State (64-53), Bucknell (57-53), Niagara (68-65), Mount St. Mary's (66-60), Marist (64-57), Saint Peter's (67-64), Siena (61-59), Iona (74-71) and Canisius (78-50) while allowing 71 points or fewer. The lone wins while allowing more than 71 came at Navy (90-79) and Merrimack (83-78) and vs. Niagara (77-76) and Siena (78-76). On four occasions, the Broncs fell when allowing 72 points (Villanova, Delaware, Quinnipiac, Stony Brook).

HOME IS WHERE YOU HOLD YOUR BREATH

Eight of Rider's 10 conference home games were decided by six points or less in 2024-25. All of Rider's first seven conference games at home had been decided by six points or less, including four by three points or less prior to a 69-49 loss to Fairfield on Feb. 21. Following a 78-50 win over Canisius on Mar. 6, the Broncs used a Flash Burton three-pointer with 4.3 seconds left to defeat Niagara, 77-76. All told, eight of 10 Rider MAAC home games were decided by six points or less and the Broncs were 5-5 in conference home games in 2024-25.

ROAD TOUGH

Rider played 19 of its first 29 games on the road in 2024-25, posting an 8-11 record. The fourth road win, coming Nov. 23 at Bucknell, stood as the most in NCAA Division I until UC Irvine won its fifth road game on Dec. 30. Rider's first four road wins came at San Diego, Coppin State, Navy and Bucknell. Rider had never in program history won more than two true road games in November.

Two-time MAAC Coach of the Year Kevin Baggett returns for his 14th season as the Rider University head basketball coach in 2025-26. The 2025-26 season is the 20th for Baggett as a member of the Rider staff, serving two as an assistant coach and four as an associate head coach. In the last 19 years, Rider has compiled 317 wins, second-most in the MAAC behind only Iona (355). Baggett has coached on the Division I level for 29 years and has been on the Rider staff since the 2006-07 season.

'Baggs' is a two-time MAAC Coach of the Year (2015 and 2018) and has been a finalist for three different National Coach of the Year Awards - the Ben Jobe Award, the Joe B. Hall Award and the Hugh Durham Award.

As Head Coach at Rider, Baggett has led his players to 27 All-MAAC honors and two MAAC Sixth Player of the Year awards. The total increases to 37 including six seasons as an assistant coach, with mentorship of 2008 NBA Lottery Pick Jason Thompson, the 2008 MAAC Player of the Year and two-time MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, to his credit. In addition, he's coached six MAAC All-Rookie Team honorees.

In his first season at Rider, Baggett took a team with just two returning starters and six total letterwinners that was picked to finish seventh in the 10-team Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference in 2013 and finished in second place. With an emphasis on defense, Baggett's Broncs led the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage defense in 2012-13 and was second in overall field goal percentage defense, third in blocks and fourth in points allowed.

He guided the 2012-13 Broncs to a 19-win season, the most by a Rider rookie head coach since Bob Greenwood led Rider to a 20-win season in 1962-63. The only other Rider basketball coach to compile 19 wins in his rookie campaign was the legendary Clair Bee. Included in the 19 wins was Rider's first-ever Division I national postseason tournament victory, a road win at Hartford in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT). The last time Rider had won a game in a national postseason tournament came in 1957, when the Roughriders won a pair of games in the NCAA College Division Championships (now NCAA Division II).

In 2013-14, Coach Baggett took a young team and produced two All-MAAC performers along with a MAAC All-Rookie team selection. His 2013-14 squad was ranked eighth in the nation in three-point field goal percentage and was 51st in Division I in three-point field goals made.

In 2014-15, Baggett took a squad that was picked seventh in the MAAC and guided the team to a 21-win season and a second place finish in the conference, earning MAAC Coach of the Year honors as Rider was selected to play in the College Basketball Invitational tournament. Bag-

gett was a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coaching Award for the second time in three years and he was named the UPS All-District 1 Coach of the Year.

The Broncs had another very successful campaign in 2016-17, winning 18 games and advancing to the MAAC Championship Quarterfinals. Rider was offered the chance to play in multiple national postseason tournaments, but declined. Seniors Jimmie Taylor and Kahlil Thomas were each named to the All-MAAC Third Team. Rider finished first in the league in rebounds per game (40.3), with three Broncs - Thomas, Norville Carey and Taylor - finishing in the top 20 individually.

2017-18 was a banner year for Baggett and the Broncs. Picked to finish seventh in the MAAC after losing four starters to graduation, the Broncs won 22 games, a share of the MAAC Regular Season Championship and advanced to the NIT for the second time in program history. Baggett was named MAAC Coach of the Year for the second time in six years, took NABC All-District 1 Coach and was also a finalist for the Hugh Durham and Ben Jobe Awards. Baggett guided four players to All-MAAC honors, including First Teamer Dimencio Vaughn, Second Teamer Stevie Jordan and Third Team honorees Jordan Allen and Frederick Scott. Scott was named MAAC 6th Player of the Year, while

Allen earned All-Rookie Team honors. Vaughn was also selected to the NABC All-District Second Team and earned Second Team All-Met. As a team, Rider led the MAAC in field-goal percentage (.465), offensive rebounds per game (13.2), rebound margin (+2.6), steals per game (7.5), rebounds per game (39.2), turnover margin (+2.2) and turnovers forced per game (15.4). Jordan led the league in assists (5.9) for the second-straight year and was 26th in the nation. Allen's 2.88 three-point field goals made per game ranked 50th in the country, while Vaughn's 1.83 steals per game were 55th. Baggett earned his 100th career win on Jan. 26, 2018, against Saint Peter's.

Stevie Jordan and Frederick Scott repeated as All-MAAC Second and Third Team selections, respectively, in 2018-19, as the Broncs finished tied for second in the MAAC Regular Season Standings. Jordan recorded his 1,000th career point, becoming the 37th player in Rider history to reach the plateau.

In 2019-20, Tyere Marshall joined the ranks of All-MAAC selections, earning Third Team recognition. Dimencio Vaughn returned to All-MAAC First Team form, while Scott earned his third-straight Third Team honor. Vaughn, Scott and Marshall became the 38th, 39th, and 40th Broncs to score their 1,000th points in the cranberry and white. The Broncs compiled an 18-12 overall record and a 12-8 mark in league play. Baggett's Broncs earned the No. 3 seed in the MAAC Championships and were riding a three-game winning streak when the tournament was halted due to COVID-19.

Rider once again won a MAAC Tournament game in 2020-21 under Baggett, taking an opening-round contest against sixth-seeded Canisius. Dwight Murray, Jr. earned All-MAAC Second Team and NABC All-District 1 Second Team honors.

While 2021-22 had its up's and down's, the year ended on a high note, as Baggett led the Broncs to a pair of MAAC Tournament wins, including an upset of top-seeded Iona in the quarterfinals. Dimencio Vaughn earned All-MAAC Second Team honors and Dwight Murray, Jr. was named to the MAAC All-Championship Team after hitting the game-winning shot against Iona with six seconds remaining in regulation.

Baggett led the Broncs to a second-place finish in the MAAC regular season standings in 2022-23, including a win at eventual champion Iona, snapping the Gaels' 21-game home winning streak. Rider ranked among the best rebounding teams in the nation with a +4.6 rebounding margin, good for 37th in Division I. Murray earned his second All-MAAC honor, being named to the First Team, while Mervin James was selected to the Second Team.

The Broncs again finished in the upper tier of the MAAC in 2023-24, with Baggett guiding Rider to a 15-17 mark, including a 12-8 record in league play. The Broncs finished the league slate with a seven-game winning streak to clinch a first-round bye in the MAAC Championships. During the win streak, Baggett moved past Thomas Leyden (187 wins) into second place all-time at Rider with his 188th victory at the school. James was a unanimous First Team All-MAAC honoree, while Allen Powell was selected to the Third Team.

Rider finished 14-19 (9-11 MAAC) in 2024-25, earning the No. 8 seed in the MAAC Tournament and earning a dramatic opening-round win over ninth-seeded Siena. Baggett earned his 200th career victory on Jan. 31, 2025, against Saint Peter's. T.J. Weeks Jr. was named to the All-MAAC Second Team.

Baggett was named the Rider men's basketball head coach at a standing room only press conference on May 24, 2012.

"This was a popular decision," Rider Director of Athletics Don Harnum said at that time. "It was also a convenient decision, but let me make it very clear, this was not a hire of convenience. This was a hire because I firmly believe and am very confident that Kevin is the right person to lead this program in the future."

Baggett hails from Burlington, NJ and was a 2006 inductee into the South Jersey Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Saint Joseph's 1985-86 basketball team that compiled a 26-6 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He received his bachelor's degree in marketing from Saint Joseph's in June, 1989.

Baggett came to Rider from the University of Maryland Baltimore County, where he served as assistant coach from 2004-06. At UMBC Baggett recruited an America East All-Rookie Team member who went on to earn First Team All-Conference honors three times, as well as a pair of transfers from the Colonial Athletic Association who went on to earn All-America East honors.

Baggett has also served as an assistant coach at James Madison, Howard, Western Kentucky and Coastal Carolina.
