**TRENDS:** Ripon has won four of their last five home openers, with the only setback in that time coming last season. The Red Hawks have gained more rushing yards than their opponent in their last 16 games, dating back to the 2016 season, and have recorded at least one sack in 13 of their last 14 contests. Ripon has scored at least 28 points in five of their last six games. Finlandia has allowed more than 30 points in three of their last five games, dating back to last season.

## **SCOUTING THE OPPONENT**

**HEAD COACH** Travis Wiltzius is the interim in his first year as the interim coach at Finlandia. He has been a member of the Lions coaching staff since 2015. A native of Escanaba, Mich., Wiltzius helped Escanaba qualify for the Division 3 state playoffs as a senior. Following graduation, he was a member of the coaching staff at his alma mater where he helped the Eskymos qualify for the Division 3 playoffs twice. In 2010 Wiltzius arrived at Central Michigan and became a student manager for the football team. He worked his way up to offensive intern to offensive quality control and in 2014 offensive graduate assistant coach. The Chippewas played in two bowl games and won the 2012 Little Caesar's Pizza Bowl. Wiltzius helped coached three All-Mid-American Conference first team selections including the 2013 NFL Overall first pick, Eric Fisher. Wiltzius has a B.A. in Sports Management from Central Michigan.

**PLAYER TO WATCH:** Defensive Back Marvin Anthony was all over the field in Finlandia's season-opening 31-3 loss to Concordia (Wis.). The freshman from Miami recorded a team-high 13 tackles in that game, including nine solo, while also intercepting one pass.

## **NEWS AND NOTES FROM AROUND CAMP**

**LAST MEETING VS. FINLANDIA:** This game marks the first-ever meeting on the gridiron between Ripon and Finlandia. The series will continue next season with the two teams playing in Hancock, Mich. in the second game of the 2019. This marks the second week in a row that Ripon is playing a team for the first time in program history, after dropping their season opener 31-28 last weekend at Augsburg University.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last week's game at Augsburg was decided on a 29-yard Field Goal, which gave the Auggies the lead for good with less than six minutes remaining in the fourth quarter. Ripon out-gained Augsburg in rushing yards 293-204, while also achieving 22 first downs, which was one more than the Auggies. Austin Bunders led the way with 103 yards and two touchdowns on the ground, while quarterback Julian Patton recorded 70 rushing yards, while also passing for 74 yards, including a 20 yard touchdown to Cameron Mignone. Tyler VanDeVelde also added a rushing touchdowns for the Red Hawks. Defensively, Ethan Hoffman led Ripon with a game-high 17 tackles, while Dakota Jordan added nine tackles, including two for a loss and one quarterback sack. Freshman Devin Smith recovered one fumble, while also forcing one.

**LOOKING AHEAD:** The Red Hawks will have next weekend, as they'll be enjoying their bye week, before jumping back into action on September 22 against Knox College in what will serve as their annual Homecoming game at Ingalls Field. Ripon has won 18 of their last 19 meetings against the Prairie Fire, and hold a 41-6 advantage in the all-time series.

## **NEWS AND NOTES FROM AROUND CAMP**

**CASTING A WIDE NET:** The Ripon College football team took a different approach to recruiting this year. Whereas last season's team consisted of players from five different states, including four from states other than Illinois and Wisconsin, this year's squad consists of players from 12 different states, with 24 of them coming from states other than Illinois and Wisconsin. This year's team is also made up of the largest recruiting class the program has seen in Head Coach Ron Ernst's 28 years, with 46 freshmen joining the Red Hawks.

**WELCOME BACK!:** On just his second carry since missing all of last season with an injury, Austin Bunders scored on a 29-yard touchdown run. A native of Almond, Wis., Bunders would later add a 40-yard touchdown to tie the score at 28 in the fourth quarter. He would finish his first game back with a team-high 103 yards on just nine carries (11.4 ypc), while also catching two passes for 49 yards, including a long of 33.

**DINY PLAYS SMART:** Ripon returns four of its five starting offensive linemen from a year ago. One of those players, Senior Jacob Diny, is a three-time Academic All-Conference performer. He also earned CoSIDA Academic All-District First Team honors at the end of last season, while also being named to the All-Conference Second Team. Diny was one of two Ripon offensive linemen to earn a spot on the 2017 All-Conference Second Team, with Jem Rein being the other.

**CAREER DAY:** Senior linebacker Ethan Hoffman had a day to remember in last weekend's 31-28 loss at Augsburg. A native of Kimberly, Wis., Hoffman finished the game with a career-high 17 tackles, which was the second-highest total by a Midwest Conference player last week. He also finished the game with two of Ripon's five pass break-ups. Hoffman is in his third year as a starter for the Red Hawks.

**GRUENWALD IN THE RECORD BOOKS:** Junior Cameron Gruenwald is one of Ripon's top defensive backs, but he has also excelled on Special Teams. The Iola, Wis. native is currently third in program history for career punting average with a mark of 36.9 yards per punt. After one game this season, Gruenwald ranks sixth in the MWC with a punting average of 38.0. He also led Ripon with five interceptions last season.

# **RED HAWKS GAME RECAPS**

## **Game #1: Sept. 1 at Augsburg University**

**MINNEAPOLIS, Minn.** - Ripon's 2018 season-opening game went down to the wire Saturday afternoon, as an Augsburg field goal with five and a half minutes remaining proved to be the difference, giving the Auggies a 31-28 win. Augsburg out-gained Ripon 469-367 in total offense, while Ripon outgained the Auggies on the ground 293-204.

The game was a track meet early on, as the two teams combined for 28 points in the first 12 minutes of the contest. Augsburg (1-0) got on the board first with a 44 yard touchdown run by quarterback Quinn Frisell on what was just their third play from scrimmage. Ripon would answer on the ensuing possession, which was capped by a 29-yard run from Austin Bunders on what was just his second carry since missing all of last season with an injury. Ripon took their first lead of the game four and a half minutes later when Julian Patton found Cameron Mignone with a 20-yard touchdown pass. Augsburg then tied the score once more on the game's next possession, scoring on a 10-yard run, which capped a four-play, 70-yard drive.

Augsburg took control of the momentum in the second quarter, taking a 21-14 lead with five and a half minutes left in the half on a 25-yard touchdown pass from Frisell to Nick Heenie. Three minutes later, Augsburg was in the end zone again, thanks to another TD pass by Frisell, this time a 33-yard strike to Nate Herber, giving the Auggies the largest lead of the game. On the ensuing possession, Ripon managed to stay in the game by driving 72 yards in five plays, while using just 53 seconds to score on a 26 yard run by Tyler VanDeVelde just before halftime.

The scoring slowed down quite a bit in the second half, with neither team getting on the scoreboard in the third quarter. Just one minute into the fourth period, Ripon tied the score at 28 on a 40-yard Bunders touchdown up the sideline. That tie lasted until about the six minute mark when Tyler Hanson converted a 29-yard field goal for the go-ahead points.

Bunders, who averaged 12.8 yards per carry as a freshman two years ago, finished the game with a game-high 103 yards on nine carries, including the two scores, to go along with two receptions for 49 yards. Patton finished with 70 yards rushing, while also completing 5-of-13 passes for 74 yards.

Defensively, Ethan Hoffman led the way with a career-high 17 tackles, in addition to a pair of pass break-ups. Dakota Jordan added nine tackles, including one sack, while Devin Smith and Shane Strabley each recovered a fumble.

Frisell finished the game 14-for-25 with 239 yards and two touchdowns, in addition to 61 rushing yards and a score on 11 carries. Heenie led all receivers with seven catches for 161 yards and a score.

Ripon will look to rebound in next weekend's home opener against Finlandia University, which will mark the first meeting on the gridiron between those two teams. That game will begin at 1 p.m. at the friendly confines of Ingalls Field in Ripon, and can be seen live, with LiveStats, at <https://portal.stretchinternet.com/ripon/>.
