SERIES VS. THE FIELD: This is the first ever meeting between Ripon and Hope. The Red Hawks faced DePauw in the 2004-05 season, a 71-59 Tigers' win, but have not played Berea.

BACK IN THE DANCE: This is Ripon's seventh appearance all-time in the NCAA Tournament, second appearance in the last three seasons and third trip in the last five full seasons. Head coach Lauren Busalacchi previously guided the Red Hawks to the Big Dance in 2019 and 2022. Ripon won its first round NCAA matchup in both 2004 and 2005 but has not won in the tournament since.

BEST IN THE LEAGUE: After winning both the Midwest Conference regular season and tournament titles, a host of Red Hawks were honored with postseason awards by the Midwest Conference. Ella Ten Pas was named the league's player of the year, the first Red Hawk to receive the honor since Karalyn Dehn in the 2005-06 season. Lauren Busalacchi and her staff were named the MWC Coaching Staff of the Year for the fifth-straight season. Busalacchi is now the only coach in MWC history to receive five consecutive coach/coaching staff of the year accolades. Additionally, Bonnie Jensen was named a second team All-MWC pick for the fourth consecutive season.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: In her first season as a Red Hawk, Ella Ten Pas has been the best player of the floor just about every night. The junior has tallied 11 double-doubles, six 20+ point games and 12, 10+ rebound games. In the MWC Tournament final, she set the program record for single-season rebounds with her 242nd. She led the league in rebounding (9.3 per game), field goal percentage (55.1%) and defensive rebounds (167). Additionally, she was in the top 15 in a host of categories: scoring (seventh, 13.9 ppg), free throw percentage (fifth, 75.4%), blocks (fifth, 19) and steals (15th, 1.62 spg).

WHAT'S NEXT: The winner of the four-team DePauw regional will advance to the sectional round on March 8-9 at a site to be determined. The Division III Women's Basketball Final Four is scheduled for March 14 and 16 in Columbus, Ohio, at the Capital Center Performance Arena on the campus of Capital University.



Scouting The Opponent: Hope is making its 11th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and 24th overall. The Flying Dutchmen are tied for second in Division III with three national titles: 2022, 2006 and 1990. Hope received an at-large bid to this year's tournament after winning the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association (MIAA) regular-season title and finishing as runner-up in the MIAA Tournament. The Flying Dutchmen, ranked second in the Region VII rankings, are coached by Brian Morehouse, the fastest collegiate coach in NCAA history to reach 700 wins, doing it in 795 games. Hope is sixth in Division III in three-point percentage (36.4) and ninth in made threes per game (8.8).

Players To Watch: Three Flying Dutchmen received postseason All-MIAA honors: Jada Garner (first team, MIAA MVP), Sydney Vis (first team) and Olivia Bellows (second team). Garner started all 27 games, averaging 9.5 ppg and 2.9 rpg while dishing out 60 assists to 23 turnovers. Vis started all 27 games as well, leading Hope in scoring (12.1 ppg) while also averaging 4.3 boards per game. Bellows is also in double figures at 10.2 ppg, shooting 39.1% from deep and 79.5% from the free throw line.

THE BUSALACCHI FILE

ON MAY 13, 2013, RIPON COLLEGE OFFICIALLY ANNOUNCED THE HIRING OF LAUREN (JOHNSON) BUSALACCHI AS THE THIRD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH IN PROGRAM HISTORY.

BUSALACCHI ENTERS THE 2023-24 POSTSEASON WITH A CAREER COACHING RECORD OF 159-100 IN HER 11 SEASONS. THE LAST SEVEN YEARS HAVE BEEN PARTICULARLY IMPRESSIVE, WINNING AT LEAST 17 GAMES IN EACH SEASON (NOT INCLUDING THE COVID-SHORTENED 2020-21 SEASON) AND GOING 133-56 DURING THAT SPAN, INCLUDING 104-14 IN CONFERENCE GAMES, WHILE WINNING THE MWC CHAMPIONSHIP SIX CONSECUTIVE YEARS (2018, 2019, 2020, 2022, 2023, AND 2024), WHICH IS THE LONGEST SUCH STREAK IN PROGRAM HISTORY. THE RED HAWKS HAVE GONE 70-20 AT HOME DURING THE LAST EIGHT YEARS, MAKING WEISKE GYMNASIUM ONE OF THE TOUGHEST PLACES TO PLAY IN THE MWC, WHILE APPEARING IN THE FOUR-TEAM MWC TOURNAMENT IN EACH OF THE LAST EIGHT SEASONS AND HOSTING IT THE LAST SIX (NOT INCLUDING THE COVID-SHORTENED 2020-21 SEASON).

BUSALACCHI HAS COACHED 14 ALL-CONFERENCE PLAYERS DURING HER TIME AT RIPON, INCLUDING NINE FIRST TEAM SELECTIONS, WHILE ALSO COACHING ONE ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN, ONE MWC PLAYER OF THE YEAR, ONE MWC NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR, AND ONE CENTRAL REGION ROOKIE OF THE YEAR.

THE 2023-24 SEASON AGAIN HAS BEEN HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL FOR THE RED HAWKS. AHEAD OF THE NCAA TOURNAMENT, RIPON HAS ALREADY TIED THE 2002-03 AND 2018-19 SQUADS FOR THE SEVENTH-MOST SINGLE-SEASON WINS IN PROGRAM HISTORY. ELLA TEN PAS WAS NAMED THE MIDWEST CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE YEAR, ALSO SETTING A PROGRAM RECORD FOR SINGLE-SEASON REBOUNDS WITH HER 242ND ON FEBRUARY 24. BONNIE JENSEN WAS NAMED A SECOND-TEAM ALL-MWC PERFORMER FOR THE FOURTH-STRAIGHT SEASON WHILE THE RED HAWKS WON THE MWC REGULAR-SEASON TITLE BY FOUR FULL GAMES.

A FIVE-TIME MWC COACH OF THE YEAR (2019, 2020, 2022, 2023 AND 2024), BUSALACCHI COACHED RIPON TO THE 2019 NCAA DIVISION-III TOURNAMENT, WHICH WAS THEIR FIRST SUCH APPEARANCE IN 10 YEARS. RIPON FINISHED WITH A 19-9 RECORD THAT SEASON, WHICH IS TIED FOR THE SEVENTH-MOST WINS IN PROGRAM HISTORY, WHILE GOING 16-2 IN THE MWC, SETTING A PROGRAM RECORD FOR MOST CONFERENCE WINS IN A SINGLE SEASON. THE TEAM ALSO SET A SCHOOL RECORD FOR REBOUNDS WITH 1,151, AND FINISHED THE SEASON BY WINNING 16 OF THEIR FINAL 18 CONTESTS, INCLUDING WINNING STREAKS OF NINE AND SEVEN GAMES. THE RED HAWKS WENT 12-1 AT HOME THAT SEASON.

IN 2022-23, THE RED HAWKS WON 20 GAMES FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 2019-20. THE 14-GAME WINNING STREAK FROM JANUARY 3 TO FEBRUARY 25 IS TIED FOR THE LONGEST WINNING STREAK IN SCHOOL HISTORY. ALISON LESLIE WRAPPED UP HER CAREER WITH 214 MADE THREE-POINTERS IN HER CAREER, SETTING A NEW SCHOOL RECORD.

IN 2021-22, BUSALACCHI AGAIN LED RIPON TO THE NCAA DIVISION-III TOURNAMENT WITH AN 18-10 OVERALL RECORD AND A 15-1 MARK IN THE MWC. THE RED HAWKS FINISHED THAT SEASON WINNING 14 OF THEIR FINAL 16 GAMES, INCLUDING A 10-GAME WINNING STREAK, WHICH IS THE THIRD-LONGEST WINNING STREAK IN PROGRAM HISTORY. THAT SEASON, RIPON BROKE THE SCHOOL RECORD FOR 3-POINTERS IN A SEASON WITH 143.

IN HER FIRST SEASON AT THE HELM, BUSALACCHI LED THE RED HAWKS TO A 10-13 RECORD (10-8 MWC), WHICH WAS FOLLOWED BY A 2-21 (2-16 MWC) SEASON IN HER SECOND YEAR. SHE THEN LED RIPON TO THE GREATEST TURNAROUND THE MWC HAD SEEN IN 10 YEARS, AS THE TEAM FINISHED 14-10 (10-8 MWC) IN 2015-16, INCLUDING A BERTH IN THE FOUR-TEAM MWC TOURNAMENT FOR THE FIRST TIME IN SIX YEARS.

BUSALACCHI CAME TO RIPON AFTER SPENDING ONE YEAR AS AN ASSISTANT COACH AT COE COLLEGE IN CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA, WHERE HER DUTIES INCLUDED RECRUITING, ACADEMIC COORDINATOR, FILM COORDINATOR, FUNDRAISING COORDINATOR, WHILE ALSO SERVING AS AN INSTRUCTOR OF EXERCISE PHYSIOLOGY AND THE DIRECTOR OF INTRAMURALS. PRIOR TO HER TIME AT COE, BUSALACCHI SPENT THREE YEARS AS AN ASSISTANT COACH AT LORAS COLLEGE IN DUBUQUE, IOWA AND ONE YEAR AS AN ASSISTANT AT EAST TEXAS BAPTIST UNIVERSITY IN MARSHALL, TEXAS.

A NATIVE OF BLACK RIVER FALLS, WIS., BUSALACCHI EARNED HER B.S. IN ATHLETIC TRAINING FROM CLARKE COLLEGE IN 2008, BEFORE GOING ON TO EARN A DOCTOR OF PHYSICAL THERAPY IN 2010. AS A MEMBER OF THE CRUSADER'S WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM, JOHNSON WAS NAMED HONORABLE MENTION ALL-CONFERENCE IN 2006. AS A JUNIOR DURING THE 2006-07 SEASON, JOHNSON EARNED A SPOT ON THE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM AT THE RIPON COLLEGE TOURNAMENT. AS A TEAM CAPTAIN THAT YEAR, BUSALACCHI WAS NAMED TEAM MVP, WHILE ALSO WINNING THE LEADERSHIP AWARD. SHE FINISHED HER CAREER AT CLARKE RANKING IN THE SCHOOL'S TOP 10 FOR SCORING, STEALS, ASSISTS, 3-POINT FIELD GOALS, FREE THROW PERCENTAGE AND MINUTES PLAYED.

BUSALACCHI AND HER HUSBAND MARK CURRENTLY RESIDE IN HARTFORD. THEY HAVE TWO DAUGHTERS, SHEA AND SOPHIE.

Scouting DePauw:

Standing at 21-7 overall and 11-3 in the North Coast Athletic Conference (NCAC), DePauw is the top-ranked team in Region VII. The Tigers won both the NCAC regular season and tournament titles and have not played a game away from home since February 10. DePauw is making its 23rd NCAA Tournament appearance this season and its first since 2021-22. The Tigers are looking for their first NCAA Tournament win since 2020 and are coached by Kris Huffman in her 31st season. Ava Hassel leads DePauw, scoring 11.8 points per game while shooting 37.1% from deep (41-132). She also averages 2.9 assists per game and pulls down 2.8 boards per game. Riley Mont is also in double figures at 10.4 points per game; she is shooting 41.6% from the field (111-267) and averages 4.1 rebounds per game. Both were named to the All-NCAC team ~ Hassel was a first-team selection for the second-straight year, while Mont was a second-team choice after being named the NCAC Newcomer of the Year and a third-team selection last season.

Scouting Berea:

With an overall record of 24-3 and a 15-1 mark in Collegiate Conference of the South play, Berea is making its second consecutive appearance in the NCAA Tournament after back-to-back CCS tournament titles, claiming a coveted Pool "B" bid to the Big Dance. The Mountaineers have enjoyed sustained success the last decade, riding seven consecutive seasons of 20+ wins. Berea is coached by Trent Milby in his 10th season, the newly minted 2023-24 CCS Coach of the Year. LynKaylah James was named the CCS Player of the Year after averaging 15.6 points per game and 11.1 rebounds per game heading into the NCAA Tournament. She is shooting 55.7% from the floor while collecting 31 total blocks. Two other Mountaineers are averaging in double figures: Drea Satori (11.1 ppg) and Jayden Merriweather (10.8 ppg).
