GENERAL INFO

PAYMENT/REGISTRATION A \$200 deposit will confirm registration. Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt. Balance of payment is due by the first day of camp. **Applications received within one month of the camp must be accompanied by the TOTAL registration fee. Per NCAA rules, positions will be filled on a first come, first serve basis.** There is not a registration deadline. However, registration may close earlier if groups are filled. The first skate will be on July 15 2013. Players should check-in 60 minutes prior to their first scheduled skate to get last minute instructions and receive their jersey.

PROGRAM CANCELLATION The number of openings in any Program is limited. Consequently, it is not possible for us to offer an open refund policy. In the event that it is necessary to cancel for medical reasons only, REFUNDS will be issued within six weeks of cancellation minus a 10% administration charge.

HOCKEY CAMP JERSEY & EQUIPMENT
