Quick Hits

- The Robert Morris University men's basketball team returns to the North Athletic Complex looking to snap a two-game slide and stay perfect at home by welcoming Siena Saturday for a 4:00 p.m. tip.
- The Colonials concluded a two-game road swing in Buffalo, N.Y., with a 68-62 loss @ Canisius (12/5/18). RMU shot just 33.3 percent from the field, tying a season low for field goals with 17. In a game that featured four ties and 11 lead changes, the Golden Griffins grabbed the lead for good with 9:43 to play on a Jordan Henderson jumper.
- Senior guard Josh Williams paced Robert Morris by scoring a game-high 17 points @ Canisius (12/5/18). He finished 8-for-8 at the free-throw line and enters Saturday's game ranked seventh in the Northeast Conference in free throw percentage (.826).
- Sophomore forward Charles Bain contributed 12 points against the Golden Griffins, while junior forward Yannis Mendy tied a career high with nine points on 4-of-5 shooting from the field and a 1-for-2 performance at the free-throw line.
- Robert Morris ranks in the top three in a whopping nine categories in the Northeast Conference entering Saturday's game against Siena. In addition to leading the circuit in turnover ratio (+2.89), the Colonials rank second in scoring defense (70.6), free-throw percentage (.729), field goal percent defense (.435), assists (14.67), steals (8.00) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.08) while sitting third in three-point field goal percent defense (.328) and three-point field goals made per game (8.89).
- Over the last four games, guards Matty McConnell and Jon Williams have combined for 31 assists against 12 turnovers, an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.58. Williams owns 18 assists during that span, while McConnell has recorded 13 dimes.
- The Colonials opened their two-game road swing by dropping an 82-69 decision @ Drexel (12/1/18). Senior guard **Josh Williams** led RMU with **15** points and also added **five** rebounds and a **pair** of assists.
- Senior guard Matty McConnell contributed 14 points, four rebounds and four assists against the Dragons, while Charles Bain also scored 14 points while grabbing three rebounds.
- The Colonials improved to 3-0 at home for the first time since 2012-13 by recording a 76-56 victory over Youngstown State (11/28/18) at the North Athletic Complex. Senior forward Malik Petteway came off the bench to lead five players in double figures with 16 points. He also grabbed six rebounds.
- Senior guards Josh Williams and Matty McConnell, as well as sophomore guard Jon Williams, each scored 12 points in the win over the Penguins, combining to go 7-for-16 from beyond the arc while also compiling nine assists and seven steals. Off the bench, sophomore forward Koby Thomas scored 10 points.

Head Coach Andrew Toole Ninth Season · Penn, 2003 · @AndyToole

Presiding over the golden age of Robert Morris University men's basketball is Andrew Toole, who is in his ninth season as the head coach of the Colonials in 2018-19. Introduced as the eighth head coach in the program's 42-year Division I history at a press conference at the Charles L. Sewall Center May 11, 2010, Toole signed a one-year contract extension at RMU January 19, 2017, and will lead the Colonials through the 2020-21 campaign.

In nine seasons under Toole's tutelage, the Colonials have posted an overall record of 154-128 (.546), including a mark of 91-51 (.641) against Northeast Conference opponents. Toole has overseen the most successful stretch in school history during his 11-year tenure at Robert Morris. Named an assistant coach under former head coach Mike Rice in 2007, Toole was elevated to associate head coach the following season before taking over the reigns as head coach in 2010.

During Toole's seven seasons as head coach at RMU, the Colonials have claimed two NEC regular-season championships (2013, 2014), appeared in four NEC Tournament championship games (2011, 2012, 2014, 2015) and have made four national postseason appearances. Robert Morris played in its first CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) in 2012, earned automatic bids to the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) in both 2013 and 2014 and appeared in the 2015 NCAA Tournament.

Four of RMU's five victories in a national postseason tournament have come under Toole. In 2011-12, his second year as head coach, Toole led the Colonials to an overall record of 26-11 (.703). Robert Morris tied a school record for victories by

advancing to the quarterfinals of the 2012 CIT thanks to road wins over Indiana State and Toledo. In 2012-13, RMU claimed its 10th NEC regular-season championship with a ledger of 14-4 (.778) in conference action and overall finished 24-11 (.686). Robert Morris earned a spot in the 2013 NIT, advancing to the second round thanks to a landmark 59-57 victory over Kentucky in front of 3,444 fans at the Charles L. Sewall Center, the largest crowd in school history.

RMU earned its second straight NEC regular-season crown in 2013-14 with a record of 14-2 (.875) in league play and finished 22-14 (.611) overall. For his efforts, Toole was named the 2014 NEC Jim Phelan Coach of the Year. Led by a career-high 38 points from 2014 NEC Player of the Year Karvel Anderson (2012-14), the Colonials notched a win in the first round of the NIT for the second consecutive year with an 89-78 victory at St. John's.

In the history of the NIT, a No. 8 seed has knocked off a No. 1 seed just four times, with Robert Morris owning two of those victories thanks to its wins over Kentucky and St. John's.

Toole guided Robert Morris to an overall record of 20-15 (.571) in 2014-15, including a mark of 12-6 (.667) in the NEC. The Colonials finished in a tie for second place with Bryant in the league standings and as the No. 2 seed claimed the 2015 NEC Tournament title with a 66-63 win at No. 1 seed St. Francis Brooklyn. The win over the Terriers helped RMU secure its league-high eighth NEC Tournament title and subsequent bid to the NCAA Tournament.

Robert Morris earned its first NCAA Tournament victory since 1983 and second overall in program history by posting an 81-77 victory over North Florida as part of the 2015 NCAA First Four at UD Arena in Dayton, Ohio. Two days later the Colonials fell to eventual 2015 national champion Duke, 85-56, in Charlotte, N.C.

In his first season at the helm in 2010-11, Toole guided RMU to an overall record of 18-14 (.563), including a mark of 12-6 (.667) in the NEC. The Colonials advanced to the championship game of the NEC Tournament, falling three minutes shy of earning their third straight title before falling in overtime at LIU Brooklyn (3/9/11), 85-82.

Prior to joining the Robert Morris staff in 2007, Toole spent the 2006-07 season as an assistant

While an assistant with the Leopards, Toole was responsible for helping recruit student-athletes that helped lead Lafayette to the 2010 Patriot League Tournament championship game against Lehigh. Toole was a four-year starter at the Division I level, playing for Elon University (1998-2000) before transferring to the University of Pennsylvania (2000-03). Over his four-year career at Elon and Penn, Toole averaged 12.3 points per contest, finishing with 1,341 points in 109 games.

Toole and his wife, Brooke, were married June 3, 2011, and the couple resides in Pittsburgh, Pa., with their two sons, Ryan and Colin.

Canisius Tidbits - The Golden Griffins swept the home-and-home series from the Colonials, but RMU still owns a 6-3 (.667) edge in the all-time series ... RMU converted just 33.3 percent (17-of-51) of its attempts from the field, the fourth time in six road games Robert Morris has failed to shoot at least 35 percent ... On the flipside, the Colonials shot a season-high 54.2 percent (26-for-48) from the floor in an 81-72 win @ Stetson (11/19/18) ... RMU went seven minutes without a field goal late in the contest and yet it was still a one-possession contest during five minutes of that stretch ... Senior forward Malik Petteway recorded a team-high eight rebounds ... Senior guard Matty McConnell established a season high with four steals against the Golden Griffins ... McConnell moved into a tie for eighth place all-time at Robert Morris for career starts (94) with Keith Jones (1995-99) and Lucky Jones (2011-15).

Home Cooking - Robert Morris will look to get back in the win column and snap a two-game slide Saturday with some home cooking. The Colonials are 3-0 at the North Athletic Complex and during that stretch have held each of their opponents under 60 points, yielding an average of just 57.3 points per game. Opponents are shooting just 34.8 percent (57-for-164) at the NAC, including 25.8 percent (17-for-66) from beyond the arc. Offensively, senior guard Josh Williams is averaging 24.7 points per game at home and is shooting 55 percent (22-for-40) from deep, while senior forward Malik Petteway has produced averages of 17.0 points and 7.7 rebounds per contest.

2-for-3 - Thanks to a **3-for-8** performance from beyond the arc @ Canisius (12/5/18), senior guard **Josh Williams** became just the **third** student-athlete in program history to hit at least **two three**-pointers in **seven** consecutive games. He joins former guards Scott Shepherd (1988-91) and Karvel Anderson (2012-14) in turning the trick. Shepherd had streaks of seven and eight consecutive games, respectively, during the 1989-90 campaign, while Anderson holds the record of nine straight games during his first season in an RMU uniform in 2012-13. Williams ranks **fourth** in NCAA Division I with an average of **4.33** three-pointers made per game.

Dig In - Yannis Mendy seems to be getting comfortable in his role as a starting forward for the Colonials. The junior tied a career high with **nine** points @ Canisius (12/5/18) and enters Saturday's game against Siena averaging **8.7** points over his last **three** games while shooting **63.2** percent (**12-for-19**) from the field. In his first **six** games of the year, Mendy scored a total of 11 points on 40 percent (6-for-15) shooting.

Toe The Line - Senior guard Josh Williams and his younger brother, Jon Williams, have each gotten off to a solid start in their first season playing together at the college level in converting at the free-throw line. Josh Williams finished a perfect 8-for-8 at the chalk @ Canisius (12/5/18) and ranks seventh in the Northeast Conference in free-throw percentage (.826) entering Saturday's game against Siena. Jon Williams, meanwhile, opened the year by converting each of his first 11 attempts at the stripe and is 15-for-16 (93.8%) on the season. Combined, the duo are 34-for-39 (87.2%) at the free-throw line this season.

A Sense Of Calm - Head coach Andrew Toole appointed the same five student-athletes as starters in each of RMU's first nine games of the season, as Matty McConnell, Jon Williams and Josh Williams have been penciled in at guard, while Charles Bain and Yannis Mendy have started at forward. It's the longest stretch to start a season under Toole with the same starting lineup since 2011-12, when the same starting five got the nod in RMU's first 10 contests of the season.

The Steel City - Robert Morris has consistently been at the top of the Northeast Conference leaderboard in steals throughout head coach Andrew Toole's tenure, as the Colonials have led the league in steals in each of the last three years as well as six times overall. Individually, RMU returned the top picket in the league from last year in senior guard Matty McConnell. So far in 2018-19, McConnell ranks second in the NEC in thefts with an average of 2.33 per contest thanks to 21 steals in nine games. As a team, Robert Morris is tied for second with LIU Brooklyn, posting an average of 8.00 pilfers per contest.

Grand Theft Auto - Senior guard **Matty McConnell** is just **four** steals shy of becoming the **eighth** player in school history to eclipse **200** career thefts. He would be the **fifth** student-athlete to accomplish the feat that has been coached by **Andrew Toole**, a list that also includes Tony Lee (2004-08), Jeremy Chappell (2005-09), Velton Jones (2008-13) and Kavon Stewart (2013-17).



The Leader - RMU head coach Andrew Toole picked up career victory No. 150 thanks to a 60-56 win @ Mount St. Mary's (2/28/18) in the quarterfinals of the 2018 Northeast Conference Tournament. Toole is in his ninth season at the helm leading the Colonials in 2018-19 and has posted an overall record of 154-128 (.546), including a mark of 91-51 (.641) against league foes. Toole is just four victories shy of becoming the all-time leader for coaching wins at Robert Morris. Former head coach Jarrett Durham posted an overall record of 157-183 (.462) from 1984 to 1996.

Close and Late - A common theme in the nine years that head coach Andrew Toole has been at the helm at Robert Morris has been playing close games late. During Toole's tenure, the Colonials have posted a record of 55-32 (.632) in games decided by five points or less, including a mark of 8-6 (.571) in games decided by just a single point.

Defense Wins Championships - The numbers bear out that following in the footsteps of defending is victories. Despite a 68-62 setback @ Canisius (12/5/18), Robert Morris has compiled a record of 170-49 (.776) when holding their opponent to under 70 points since the beginning of the 2007-08 season. Under ninth-year head coach **Andrew Toole**, RMU owns a mark of 117-41 (.741) when turning the trick. Overall the last 12 years, Robert Morris has held its opponent to under 70 points 56.7 percent (219-of-386) of the time.

Historical Home Debut

Robert Morris has played a total of **1,603** games across the junior college and NCAA Division I levels since joining the college basketball ranks in 1963. In just **three** of those contests has a member of the Colonials eclipsed the **40**-point plateau. Senior guard **Josh Williams** became the latest in a 104-57 win over Mount Aloysius (11/14/18) in RMU's 2018-19 home opener. Williams, who was playing his first home for RMU against Mount Aloysius in the program's first home game at the North Athletic Complex, broke the single-game record of 42 points, which came in a 99-85 setback @ Eastern Michigan (11/26/02) by former guard Maurice Carter (2001-05). It had been **519** games since Carter's feat against the Eagles and the performance by Williams. The record for most points by a Robert Morris student-athlete, however, had stood for over **53** years until Williams shattered the mark in the win over the Mounties.

Half & Half - The performance for Josh Williams in the win over the Mounties helped him become the first student-athlete ever in school history to score 20 points in each half of a game. In the first 20 minutes, Williams scored 23 points, going 8-for-13 from the floor, including 7-for-12 from deep. In the second stanza, Williams scored 26 points, tying the mark for most points in a half by an RMU student-athlete. Former Colonials A.J. Jackson (2003-08) and Karvel Anderson (2012-14) also scored 26 points in the second half of victories @ Marshall (11/17/06) and vs. LIU Brooklyn (2/20/14), respectively.

Consider This ... Thanks to the performance by senior guard **Josh Williams** in a 104-57 win over Mount Aloysius (11/14/18), the Colonials established a new team singlegame record for three-pointers with **22**. The old record of 16 in a game had been accomplished five times previously, with the most recent performance in an 89-78 win @ St. John's (3/18/14) in the first round of the 2014 NIT. Since head coach **Andrew Toole** joined the staff in 2007 as an assistant coach with the Colonials, RMU has accomplished five of its top six performances in school history in regard to three-point field goals.

Dropping 100 - For the first time in nine seasons under head coach **Andrew Toole**, Robert Morris eclipsed the **100**-point plateau in a 104-57 win over Mount Aloysius (11/14/18). It marked RMU's first **100**-point performance since a 107-76 win over Alcorn State (11/21/09) in Albany, N.Y., as part of the 2K Sports Classic. It also marked the **16th** time in RMU's NCAA Division I history the Colonials have scored at least **100** points. In those games Robert Morris owns a record of **14-2** (.875).

Economical Margins

The defensive pressure that Robert Morris has employed over the last 12 seasons has allowed the program to post each of its top four totals for largest margin of victory against a Northeast Conference opponent in school history. The Colonials earned a 91-38 victory over Bryant (2/3/11) at the Charles L. Sewall Center to not only establish a new school record in an NEC game but also tie the league mark. The record was originally set when Wagner defeated Sacred Heart, 116-63, on February 22, 2000. In fact, only four games in league annals have been decided by 50 or more points, and RMU owns two of them. Robert Morris posted a 95-45 victory over Fairleigh Dickinson (2/7/08) at the Sewall Center, while LIU Brooklyn defeated Wagner, 127-77, Feb. 11, 1998. A look at the largest margins of victory for Robert Morris against NEC foes since the league was created in1981 ...

Series Notes

- Saturday's game between RMU and Siena concludes a home-and-home series and is the **sixth** meeting between the two programs, with the Saints holding a **3-2** (.600) edge in the all-time series.
- Siena posted a 76-74 victory over RMU in last year's meeting at the Times Union Center (12/1/17) in Albany, N.Y. The Saints opened up a 48-32 lead in the second half, but a 12-0 run helped the Colonials close to within 48-44. Siena stemmed the tide, as Nico Clareth hit three-pointers on consecutive possesions to get the lead back to double digits, 54-44.
- Robert Morris was led by guard Dachon Burke (2015-17), who finished with 26 points and seven rebounds. Guard **Jon Williams** scored a career-high 15 points and also dished out five assists.
- Off the bench in last year's meeting against Siena, forward **Malik Pet-teway** recorded his third career double-double with 11 points and a game-high 12 rebounds.
- The **home** team has won each of the previous **five** meetings between the Colonials and Saints. The last time Robert Morris hosted Siena was at John Jay Gymnasium Jan. 26, 1984, a 71-53 victory for the Colonials. The win marked the **26th** consecutive home victory for RMU, with Tom Underman leading the way with 17 points.

Did You Know?

Robert Morris has paced the Northeast Conference in steals against league foes in **nine** of the last 11 years, including each of the last **three** seasons. The Colonials led the circuit in thefts in 2017-18 with an average of **7.61** per contest. Junior guard **Matty McConnell** paced the league individually with an average of **2.18** steals per game.

Defensively Speaking - Robert Morris has won 11 consecutive games when holding opponents to less than 60 points dating back to the 2016-17 season after a 76-56 victory over Youngstown State (11/28/18) that improved the Colonials to 3-0 at home at the North Athletic Complex. In **nine** years under head coach **Andrew Toole**, the Colonials are **58-7** (**.892**) when turning the trick. The last loss for RMU when yielding under 60 points was a 48-47 setback @ Mount St. Mary's (1/26/17).

Comeback Kids - Robert Morris has made a habit of climbing out of double-digit deficits under Andrew Toole, and for the first time in 2018-19 the Colonials turned the trick @ Canisius (12/5/18). RMU fell behind, 29-19, with 4:11 to go in the first half against the Golden Griffins but charged back to grab the lead in the second half. It was part of a contest that featured four ties and 11 lead changes. It marked the 27th time under Toole the Colonials have erased a double-digit deficit in his eight seasons as head coach. On 24 of those occasions Robert Morris has earned a victory.

Board Games - Part of following the formula in regard to being successful for RMU over the last 11 seasons has been the program's ability to crash the boards. Since the beginning of the 2007-08 campaign, Robert Morris owns a record of **150-39** (.794) when the Colonials are even or better in rebounding in a game, including a **141-33** (.810) mark when outrebounding their opponent.

Free Is For Me - Getting to the free-throw line at least 30 times in a game is a good sign for the Colonials. RMU owns a record of 31-12 (.721) under head coach Andrew Toole when visiting the chalk at least 30 times in a contest. Robert Morris visited the chalk a season-high 31 times @ Canisius (12/5/18), knocking down 22, a success rate of 71 percent, in suffering a 68-62 setback. Senior guard Josh Williams (8-for-8) and sophomore forward Charles Bain (6-for-6) finished perfect at the free-throw line against the Golden Griffins.

Did You Know? In nine seasons under head coach **Andrew Toole**, Robert Morris has compiled a record of **93-35** (.727) when scoring at least **70** points in a game. Included in that record is a mark of **36-5** (.878) when eclipsing the **80**-point plateau.

The Anatomy Of Overtime - Robert Morris has been to overtime 11 times under head coach Andrew Toole in his nine years leading the Colonials. Under Toole, Robert Morris is 7-4 (.636) in overtime, including 3-4 (.429) on the road. All-time in program history RMU has posted a record of 29-26 (.527) in overtime contests.

In The Clutch - You certainly could say that Robert Morris has a flair for the dramatic. In an 80-79 overtime win over St. Francis Brooklyn (1/4/18) at the A.J. Palumbo Center, junior guard **Matty McConnell** became the latest member of the Colonials to hit a buzzer beater for RMU. McConnell converted a layup and then completed the and-one with a free throw to lift the Colonials to the win over the Terriers. A look at the last 10 Colonials to hit a game-winning shot in the final 15 seconds to give RMU a victory:

The RMU Ring of Honor

Devised in the summer of 2013, the Robert Morris Ring of Honor was created to honor the very best of the program in its Division I history. In order to be eligible for the Robert Morris Ring of Honor, a former student-athlete who played basketball with the Colonials must meet at least four of the following five criteria ...

- RMU Athletic Hall of Fame member
- RMU career statistical leader in any category (minimum 5 years)
- Named conference player of the year at least once
- Earned all-conference first team honors at least once
- Member of conference regular season or tournament championship team that advanced to a national postseason tournament

The first member to join the Robert Morris Ring of Honor is Chipper Harris, who played guard for the Colonials from 1980 to 1984 and had his banner raised in the rafters at the Charles L. Sewall Center Saturday, Feb. 15, 2014.

A 1995 inductee into the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame and a native of New Kensington, Pa., Harris served as the program's all-time leading scorer from the conclusion of his career in 1984 until 1994 with 1,940 points and currently ranks second all-time. Harris averaged 16.4 points per game over his career, shooting 51.4 percent (821-for-1,598) from the field and 78.9 percent (300-for-380) at the free-throw line. RMU's all-time leader in career steals with 450, he also compiled career totals of 405 rebounds, 436 assists and 21 blocks.

In a surprise ceremony Saturday, Jan. 21, 2017, at the Sewall Center, former guard Myron Walker (1990-94) joined the RMU Ring of Honor. The program's all-time leading scorer with 1,965 points, Walker concluded his career by averaging 18.7 points per game, also a school mark. A 1999 inductee into the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame and a native of Aliquippa, Pa., Walker scored at least 20 points in a game 47 times, the most in school history.

Robert Morris Historical Tidbits

In The Beginning - Robert Morris was the first institution to jump directly from the junior college ranks to NCAA Division I. RMU played basketball at the junior college level for 13 seasons from 1963 to 1976, posting a record of 287-58 (.832) under head coach Gus Krop. Krop led the Colonials to a record of 30-1 (.968) in 1968-69 in its sixth season as a junior college program, with its only loss a 79-76 setback to Paducah (Ky.) in the national title game. In his time leading Robert Morris, Krop coached nine All-Americans and also recruited Earl Cureton, a native of Detroit, Mich., who played one season with the Colonials when it was a junior college program (1975-76) as well as the first season of Division I basketball in 1976-77.

The Entire History - The 2018-19 campaign marks the 56th season of intercollegiate basketball at Robert Morris. The Colonials compiled an overall record of 287-58 (.832) in 13 years as a junior college program from 1963 to 1976 and since moving to Division I with the 1976-77 campaign have posted an overall record of 615-643 (.489). Combined, Robert Morris posted a record of 816-610 (.572) over its first 50 years as an intercollegiate program from 1963 to 2013. In honor of 50 years of intercollegiate basketball, Robert Morris enshrined the 1981-82 Colonials, the first squad to qualify for the NCAA Tournament, into the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame Feb. 15, 2014.

The First Superstar - Don Mackey (1963-65) was the only player in junior college history to score over 1,000 points in his two seasons with the program. A native of Homestead, Pa., Mackey finished his two years with the Colonials by scoring 1,034 points, and his 43 points in a 125-111 win over Walsh Jan. 30, 1965, stood for over 53 years as the most points scored in a game by a player in a Robert Morris uniform. He went on to finish his collegiate career at Gannon University and was inducted into the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame Oct. 9, 2010. Mackey is one of nine members of the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame from the junior college ranks, which also includes former All-Americans Perry Johnson (1969), Cleveland Edwards (1969) and Ron Hightower (1971 and 1972).

The Twirl - Arguably the best basketball player in school history, in his one season at the Division I level in a Robert Morris uniform Earl "The Twirl" Cureton (1975-77) averaged 17.2 points and 10.5 rebounds per game in 1976-77. Cureton still owns Robert Morris single-season records for rebounds (274) and rebounding average and is the only player in the program's Division I history to average a double-double. He transferred to the University of Detroit to continue his Division I career and was drafted by the Philadelphia 76ers in the third round of the 1979 NBA Draft. He went on to play 12 seasons in the NBA, earning a pair of championship rings, one with the 76ers in 1983 and the other with the Houston Rockets in 1994.

Charter Member - Robert Morris played independently as a Division I program for five seasons before becoming a charter member of the ECAC Metro Conference in 1981, which changed its name to the Northeast Conference in 1988. The Colonials have won eight NEC Tournament titles, the most in league history, and have also appeared in the NCAA Tournament eight times. Robert Morris has won back-to-back NEC Tournament titles on three occasions, including the first two championships in 1981 and 1982. RMU also claimed back-to-back NEC Tournament titles in 1989 and 1990 and again in 2009 and 2010.

Dynamic Duo - Led by guards Chipper Harris (1980-84) and Forest "Bay" Grant (1980-84), Robert Morris claimed the first two ECAC Metro Conference Tournament championships in 1981 and 1982. In four seasons, Harris and Grant combined for career totals of 3,434 points, 869 rebounds, 991 assists and 782 steals. Harris scored 1,940 points and still owns the Robert Morris career record for steals (450), while Grant is the program's all-time leader in assists (555) and scored 1,494 points. The pair helped the ECAC Metro Conference garner its first victory in the NCAA Tournament, as the Colonials upended Georgia Southern, 64-54, in a play-in game at the University of Dayton in Dayton, Ohio, in the 1983 NCAA Tournament.

Walk On The Ocean - Former guard Myron Walker (1990-94) continued RMU's lineage of stellar guards when he arrived on the scene in the fall of 1990 and was a key part of a 1991-92 squad that claimed the program's fifth NEC Tournament championship and berth in the NCAA Tournament. In his second year with the program, Walker scored 614 points en route to being named the 1992 NEC Player of the Year, the first sophomore in league history to earn the honor. Walker went on to become the program's all-time leading scorer with 1,965 points and also owns the single-season record for scoring average (20.1 ppg as a senior in 1993-94) and career marks for 20-point scoring games (47) and scoring average (18.7 ppg).



Robert Morris closed out an eight-game road trip to open its 2017-18 season @ Siena (12/2/17), and the Times Union Center became the 15th arena that the Colonials have played in that has also featured a concert by Pearl Jam since the band's formation in 1990. Also included is John Paul Jones Arena (Charlottesville, Va.), PPG Paints Arena (Pittsburgh, Pa.), the Pan American Center (Las Cruces, N.M.), Time Warner Cable Arena (Charlotte, N.C.), The L.A. Sports Arena (Los Angeles, Calif.), the Verizon Center (Washington, D.C.), the FedExForum (Memphis, Tenn.), Rupp Arena (Lexington, Ky.), the Palace at Auburn Hills (Detroit, Mich.), the Prudential Center (Newark, N.J.), Savage Arena (Toledo, Ohio), the Wolstein Center (Cleveland, Ohio), the Bryce Jordan Center (State College, Pa.) and A.J. Palumbo Center (Pittsburgh, Pa.).


Who Was Robert Morris?

Robert Morris, Jr. (January 20, 1734 – May 8, 1806) was a Liverpool-born American merchant and signer of the Declaration of Independence, the Articles of Confederation and the United States Constitution. He was elected to the Pennsylvania Assembly, became the Chairman of the Pennsylvania Committee of Safety and was chosen as a delegate to the Second Continental Congress, where he served as chairman of the "Secret Committee of Trade" and as a member of the Committee of Correspondence. From 1781 to 1784, he served as the powerful Superintendent of Finance, managing the economy of the fledgling United States. As the central civilian in the government, Morris was, next to General George Washington, "the most powerful man in America." His successful administration led to the sobriquet, "Financier of the Revolution." He was one of Pennsylvania's original pair of U.S. senators, serving from 1789 to 1795. A look at his legacy:

- A portrait of Morris appeared on U.S. \$1000 notes from 1862 to 1863
- Morris and Roger Sherman were the only two people to sign all three significant founding documents of the United States, the Declaration of Independence, the Articles of Confederation, and the U.S. Constitution.
- The dollar sign ("\$") was in common use among private merchants during the middle of the 18th century. It referred to the two columns draped with scrolls on the Spanish milled dollar, which predated the U.S. Dollar. Morris was the first to use that symbol in official documents.



The UPMC Events Center



Robert Morris University announced Thursday, Jan. 19, 2017, the construction of the UPMC Events Center, a 140,000-square foot complex for the Colonials NCAA Division I basketball and volleyball teams, which will play in Peoples Court. The UPMC Events Center is the main part of a \$50 million project that also includes a student recreation and fitness center on RMU's Moon Township campus.

The project is funded largely through individual donations and corporate sponsorships, including sponsorships from UPMC, Peoples, Eat'n Park Hospitality Group, PJ Dick and PNC. The project also has received a grant through the Pennsylvania Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program.

In addition to the 4,000-plus-seat Peoples Court, a practice court, locker rooms, a strength and conditioning center, offices for athletics, concessions and a souvenir shop, the UPMC Events Center will feature 11,000 square feet of conference and meeting space for campus events and outside organizations. Plans call for the center to open in 2019.

"With a new venue of this quality and size, RMU cements its status as a university on the rise," said RMU President Chris Howard. "Not only is it a significant regional asset, it's a facility worthy of the success for our athletics programs and reflective of our status as a nationally ranked university. This is a great day for the Colonial Nation."

"UPMC is thrilled to be a leading partner with Robert Morris University in this exciting endeavor that will provide long-lasting health and wellness benefits to not only the RMU community but also to people and businesses in this entire region. We applaud and share RMU's commitment to provide our communities with nothing less than world-class care and facilities," said Jeffrey Romoff, president and CEO of UPMC.

As part of a broader strategic collaboration with RMU, UPMC became the exclusive provider of sports medicine to the university's 16 NCAA Division I sports programs, and the UPMC Health Plan will administer the university's employees' health insurance benefits. UPMC already provides health care to RMU students at UPMC MyHealth@School, an on-campus health and wellness center that opened in the fall of 2016.

"With this partnership, UPMC supports RMU's leading role in the continued development of the Airport Corridor and this region. We look forward to making the UPMC Events Center a crown jewel for RMU and for Pittsburgh and western Pennsylvania," said Romoff.

The UPMC Events Center will bring the Airport Corridor an attractive new venue for public speakers, conventions, expos, concerts, graduation ceremonies and other family entertainment options. It also will host the university's annual convocation and commencement ceremonies, which have outgrown their current location.

All three teams that will play at Peoples Court - men's and women's basketball and women's volleyball - have won the Northeast Conference title and advanced to the NCAA tournament within the last four years.

"RMU is a special place that for a lot folks in this region, including many alumni who attended the old downtown campus without ever setting foot on this beautiful campus in Moon," said Morgan O'Brien '82 M'85, president and CEO of Peoples and a member of the RMU Board of Trustees. "This events center will create reasons for people from all over the region to see just how special this campus is. And this collaboration with UPMC will make RMU a place students from all over will want to attend."

The university's plans call for the UPMC Events Center to replace the Charles L. Sewall Center, a venue more than 30 years old. While construction is underway, the men's basketball team will play its home games at PPG Paints Arena in downtown Pittsburgh as well as the A.J. Palumbo Center on the campus of Duquesne University.

RMU has constructed a two-story student recreation and fitness center at the North Athletic Complex, which opened in the fall of 2017. The center features two indoor intramural basketball courts, a fully-equipped weight room and cardio room, two additional rooms for Pilates and other exercise training, plus men's and women's locker rooms, all for general student use.

"The new UPMC Events Center, together with the student recreation and fitness center, will literally be a 'game-changer' for not only the athletic department but for the university as a whole," said former RMU Director of Athletics Director Craig Coleman, M.D. "It will be a clear sign to the intercollegiate athletics world that RMU does indeed mean business."

The UPMC Events Center is the latest initiative to provide students with a living and learning environment worthy of their expectations and of RMU's growing stature as a national, doctoral-level university. Scaife Hall, formally dedicated last spring for the School of Nursing and Health Sciences, is the third new academic building opened on campus in the last five years.






