Bernard Clark, Jr., enters his seventh season as head coach of the Robert Morris Football program in 2024. Clark, a native of Tampa, Fla., was named the third head coach in program history on Dec. 19, 2017.

Clark leads the Colonials as they rejoin the Northeast Conference ahead of the 2024 season. In his second season leading RMU in 2019 as member of the NEC, Clark presided over one of the best turnarounds in program history. The Colonials won seven of its final nine games of the year to record their first winning season since 2010 with an overall mark of 7-5. Included in that record was a ledger of 6-1 in NEC play as RMU was second in the league standings, their highest finish in nine seasons.

For those efforts, Clark was tabbed the 2019 NEC Co-Coach of the Year and was also a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award, one of the STATS NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) legacy awards and given annually to the NCAA FCS Coach of the Year.

RMU also claimed the 2019 NEC Sportsmanship Award for the first time in program history. The award is designed to acknowledge the team in each conference sport that, in the opinion of its peers, most closely demonstrates good sportsmanship based on the NEC Principles of Sportsmanship and Standards of Conduct.

A total of eight Colonials earned All-NEC honors in 2019 under Clark's tutelage, the most since nine Colonials were honored in 2013. This was up from three in his first year on the sidelines.

Among the talent coached by Clark is Matthew Gonzalez, who was named to the 2019 STATS FCS All-American Third Team, a year after being tabbed to the 2018 Associated Press FCS All-American Second Team. He became the first student-athlete in program history to earn NCAA FCS All-American accolades in consecutive years.

Clark was a steady presence in RMU's time in the Big South Conference. Over four seasons, a total of nine student-athletes have earned All-Big South honors. RMU was also awarded the 2021 Big South Team Sportsmanship Award under Clark's leadership, which is voted on by Big South student-athletes and awarded at the end of each competition seasons.

Former defensive back Tavin Harville, became the eighth member of the Colonials to sign an NFL deal and the first under Clark when he signed a free agent contract with the Pittsburgh Steelers in April of 2022.

Prior to RMU, Clark spent four years at the Albany (2014-17), where he served as the assistant head coach and linebackers coach for the Great

Danes before being promoted to associate head coach, defensive coordinator and linebackers coach in 2015. While at Albany, Clark's defense ranked ninth and finished in the top 20 in eight different categories the NCAA FCS in 2017. In his first season at Albany, Clark's defense led the nation in turnover margin (+1.25) and fumble recoveries (20).

Clark began his collegiate coaching career at James Madison in 1998. He spent two seasons with the Dukes coaching the defensive ends before moving to Liberty, where he spent four years with the Flames from 2000-03, tutoring the linebackers and special teams.

In 2004, Clark began the first of two stints with Florida International. He served as the defensive coordinator for the 2004 and 2005 seasons before joining the coaching staff at the South Florida in 2006, coaching the defensive line. Clark returned to FIU as a defensive assistant in 2007 and 2008 and also served as defensive coordinator for Hampton University in 2009 and linebackers coach at Pitt in 2010. While an assistant with the Panthers, Clark helped the defense finish in the top 10 of the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS). In 2011, Clark coached the linebackers at Colorado State before returning to Hampton to serve as defensive coordinator in 2012 and 2013.

As a player, Clark was a key contributor at linebacker for the University of Miami as they claimed national championships in 1987 and 1989.

As a sophomore, Clark was named the MVP of the 1988 Orange Bowl after helping lead Miami to a 20-14 victory over Oklahoma and the national title. Clark finished with 14 tackles against the Sooners, including 12 solo takedowns. That game featured Jimmy Johnson as head coach of the Hurricanes and Barry Switzer as the head coach of the Sooners. The contest marked the only time opposing head coaches from a college national championship game each later served as head coach of the same professional football team. Both Johnson and Switzer won the Super Bowl with the Dallas Cowboys.

A third-round pick by Cincinnati in the 1990 NFL Draft, Clark played two seasons with the Bengals as well as one year with the Seattle Seahawks. He also spent time in the Arena Football League (AFL) with the Orlando Predators.

Clark was inducted into the Orange Bowl Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2022, joining Dewey Selmon (Oklahoma) and Grant Wistrom (Nebraska). Inductees exemplify the tradition of the Orange Bowl, which has been played annually since January 1, 1935, and has nine decades of historical impact on the college football landscape.

Clark and his wife, Tammy, reside in Clinton, Pa.

SATURDAY SET-UP

First place is on the line Saturday afternoon when RMU (6-3, 3-0 NEC) travels to crosstown rival No. 25/24 Duquesne (6-2, 3-0 NEC) at Rooney Field Kickoff is at noon.

RMU LATELY

The Colonials have won four straight games, their longest since 2019. They are coming off back-to-back shutouts of Saint Francis U (17-0) and Merrimack (6-0) and were named the Stats Perform FCS National Team of the Week. RMU has received votes in the last three AFCA FCS Coaches Poll, presented by Hudl.

DUQUESNE LATELY

The Dukes cracked both national FCS Top-25 Polls this week, coming in 24th in the AFCA Coaches Poll, presented by Hudl, and 25th in the Stats Perform Poll. Duquesne has won its last six contests and is one of five undefeated teams in FCS play (Montana State, North Dakota State, Southeast Missouri, Rhode Island and UC Davis).

THE SERIES

Saturday marks the 22nd installment of the series. Duquesne leads 13-8 overall, 8-4 in NEC play and 9-2 at Rooney Field. This will be the first matchup between the Colonials and Dukes since November 9, 2019 when RMU defeated Duquesne 41-21 at Joe Walton Stadium. The series began in RMU's inaugural season in 1994 with games in 1995, 1996 and 1998. The teams played 17 straight seasons from 2003 until 2019.

THE LAST TIME OUT

RMU used a 20-point first half en route to a 41-21 victory at Joe Walton Stadium on November 9, 2019.

BIG MOMENTS AGAINST DUQUESNE

- November 23, 1996 - Robert Morris won the ECAC Bowl with a 28-26 victory at Rooney Field ending the Dukes' 19-game winning streak, which dated back to a 38-20 loss to RMU in 1995
- November 15, 2003 - In the program's 100th game, quarterback Rich Demaio, gets the only start of his collegiate career, establishes single-game school records for completions (33) and passing yards (444)
- October 11, 2008 - Myles Russ establishes an RMU single-game record for rushing attempts with 37, compiling 246 yards and a pair of touchdowns in a 34-27 win
- October 30, 2010 - Russ scores on a six-yard touchdown run early in the fourth quarter to become the program's all-time leading rusher in a 34-11 win passing Sam Dorsett

SHUTTING THEM DOWN

RMU's has gone eight straight quarters (133 minutes in total) without

allowing a point, blanking Saint Francis U (10.26) and Merrimack (11.2). This marks first time since 1996 RMU has recorded back-to-back shutouts. Last week's clean sheet against Merrimack also marked the second time the Colonials have recorded three shutouts in a season, also in 1996.

THE PICK HEARD ROUND THE WORLD

Robert Carter Jr.'s amazing interception to end the 1st half was a viral sensation. The video was number one on ESPN's Top 10, the Pop Tarts Play of the Week, was featured on Good Morning America, Overtime, JomBoy, Bleacher Report, Barstool and was viewed over 55 million times on social media platforms X, TikTok and Instagram. Earlier this week, Carter received a pair of autographed gloves from Randy Moss for being the top play on the ESPN's Sunday NFL Countdown "You Got Mossed".

31-YEAR LETTERWINNER

"The Voice of the Colonials" Chris Shovlin enters his 31st year as the play-by-play man for RMU Football. He had been behind the mic for nearly every football game since that sport's inception in 1994. He has served as the Colonials' play-by-play announcer for the men's basketball team since 1987. Shovlin was inducted into the Pennsylvania Association of Broadcasters Hall of Fame earlier this year.

THE SIX DEGREES OF COACHING

RMU head coach Bernard Clark, Jr. can be connected to Duquesne head coach Jerry Schmitt, based on the "six degrees of separation" in a variety of ways.

1. Schmitt played at Keystone Oaks High School with coach Jerry Mancini (1977)
2. Mancini served as Keystone Oaks Drivers Education teacher and taught RMU Assitant AD for Media Relations Ryan Gavatorta (1991)
3. Gavatorta currently serves as Clark's SID at Robert Morris (2023-24)

LOOKING AHEAD

RMU remains on the road at Central Connecticut State on November 16 before returning to Joe Walton Stadium to face Stonehill on November 23 to close out the regular season for Senior Day.

HELLO OLD FRIEND

On November 28, 2023, Robert Morris University announced that its football program has accepted an invitation from the NEC Council of Presidents to rejoin the conference as a football associate member in 2024. The Colonials will be immediately eligible to secure the league's automatic bid to the NCAA FCS Playoffs.

A RICH NEC HISTORY

RMU helped launch NEC football in 1996 and claimed six conference championships. While under the leadership of Hall of Fame Coach Joe Walton, the Colonials boasted a 26-2 conference record in their first five seasons in the NEC. During its initial run in the NEC, RMU had three postseason berths winning the ECAC Football Classic in 1996 and 1997 as well as representing the NEC in the FCS Playoffs in 2010.

In its 24 years as an NEC football member, RMU has three NEC Offensive Player of the Year winners, four NEC Defensive Player of the Year honorees and Walton was a four-time NEC Coach of the Year. Hank Fraley, a center who competed for the Colonials from 1996-99, enjoyed an 11-year NFL career and was inducted into the NEC Hall of Fame as part of its 2010 inaugural class.

WHERE WE HAVE BEEN?

RMU spent the 2023 season in the Big South-DVC Football Association and the previous three years (2020-22) as a Big South Conference associate football member.

THE CONFERENCE SLATE

The NEC schedule consists of six games. The conference champion receives an automatic bid into the NCAA FCS Playoffs. Because Mercyhurst is not playing a full league schedule this year, games against them will not be counted as a league matchup.
