Bernard Clark, Jr., is in his eighth season as the head coach of the Robert Morris University football program in 2025. A native of Tampa, Florida, he was named the third head coach in program history on December 19, 2017.

Clark led the Colonials back into the Northeast Conference (NEC) in 2024, where they had a successful campaign with a 7-5 overall record and a 4-2 mark in conference play. The team won their last six home games and was undefeated at 3-0 against NEC teams at Joe Walton Stadium. Nine student-athletes were named to the All-NEC teams, and 15 were selected for Phil Steele's All-NEC Team. Individually, Luke Beltavski was named the NEC Football Fall Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was selected to both the Football Championship Subdivision Athletics Directors Association (FCS ADA) 27th Annual Academic All-Star Team and the College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-District Team.

This return to the NEC marked a notable turnaround for the program, reminiscent of their 2019 season, the last time they played in the conference. That year, Clark presided over one of the best seasons in program history. The Colonials won seven of their final nine games to achieve their first winning season since 2010, finishing 7-5 overall and 6-1 in NEC play, which secured the program's highest league finish in nine seasons.

For his efforts, Clark was named the 2019 NEC Co-Coach of the Year and was also a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award, given annually to the NCAA FCS Coach of the Year. The team also received the 2019 NEC Sportsmanship Award, a first in program history. A total of eight Colonials earned All-NEC honors under Clark's leadership in 2019, the most since nine were honored in 2013, and a significant increase from the three All-NEC selections in his first year.

Among the talent he coached was Matthew Gonzalez, who became the first player in program history to earn consecutive NCAA FCS All-American accolades, being named to the 2019 STATS FCS All-American Third Team after a 2018 Associated Press FCS All-American Second Team selection.

During their time in the Big South Conference, Clark continued to make an impact. Over four seasons, nine student-athletes earned All-Big South honors. Under his leadership, the team also received the 2021 Big South Team Sportsmanship Award. In 2022, former defensive back Tavin Harville became the eighth Colonial to sign an NFL deal and the first under Clark when he signed a free agent contract with the Pittsburgh Steelers.

Before joining Robert Morris, Clark spent four years at the University at Albany (2014-17). He began as the assistant head coach and linebackers coach and was promoted to associate head coach, defensive coordinator, and linebackers coach in 2015. While there, his defense ranked ninth in the NCAA FCS and was in the top 20 in eight different categories in 2017. In his first season, Clark's defense led the nation in turnover margin (+1.25) and fumble recoveries (20).

Clark's collegiate coaching career began in 1998 at James Madison, where he coached defensive ends for two seasons. He then spent four years at Liberty (2000-03), coaching linebackers and special teams.

In 2004, Clark had his first of two stints at Florida International (FIU), serving as defensive coordinator for two seasons. He then joined the South Florida coaching staff in 2006, where he coached the defensive line.

Clark returned to FIU as a defensive assistant from 2007-08 and later served as defensive coordinator at Hampton University in 2009 and linebackers coach at Pitt in 2010. While with the Panthers, Clark helped the defense finish in the top 10 of the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS). He also coached linebackers at Colorado State in 2011 before returning to Hampton in 2013 as the defensive line coach and then defensive coordinator/linebackers coach in 2014.

As a player, Clark was a key linebacker for the University of Miami, contributing to their national championships in 1987 and 1989. As a sophomore, he was named the MVP of the 1988 Orange Bowl after a 20-14 victory over Oklahoma that secured the national title. Clark finished the game with 14 tackles, including 12 solo. Notably, that game featured opposing head coaches Jimmy Johnson (Miami) and Barry Switzer (Oklahoma), both of whom later won the Super Bowl with the Dallas Cowboys.

A third-round pick by the Cincinnati Bengals in the 1990 NFL Draft, Clark played two seasons with the Bengals and one with the Seattle Seahawks. He also spent time in the Arena Football League (AFL) with the Orlando Predators.

In 2022, Clark was inducted into the Orange Bowl Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2022. That same year, his first book, *Ascension: A Coach's Guide to Becoming a Better Man, Father, and Husband*, was published.

Clark and his wife, Tammy, reside in Clinton, Pa.

SATURDAY SETUP

Robert Morris (3-8, 2-4 NEC) wraps up the 2025 season on Saturday when they face cross-town rival Duquesne (6-5, 4-2 NEC). Kickoff at Joe Walton Stadium is 2 p.m. The game will air on SportsNet Pittsburgh and is available to stream on NEC Front Row and ESPN+.

DUQUESNE LATELY

Duquesne defeated Central Connecticut State in a 38-33 shootout last Saturday, powered by running back Taj Butts' career-high 254 yards and three touchdowns. The victory was sealed when defensive back Antonio Epps made an interception in the end zone in the final seconds

THE SERIES

Saturday marks the 23rd installment of the series. Duquesne leads 14-8 overall, 9-4 in NEC play and 9-2 at Rooney Field. The series began in RMU's inaugural season in 1994 with games in 1995, 1996 and 1998. The teams played 17 straight seasons from 2003 until 2019.

LAST TIME OUT

Duquesne scored the game's first 24 points in its 31-6 victory over RMU on November 9, 2024.

BIG MOMENTS AGAINST DUQUESNE

- November 23, 1996 - Robert Morris won the ECAC Bowl with a 28-26 victory at Rooney Field ending the Dukes' 19-game winning streak, which dated back to a 38-20 loss to RMU in 1995
- November 15, 2003 - In the program's 100th game, quarterback Rich Demaio gets the only start of his collegiate career, establishes single-game school records for completions (33) and passing yards (444)
- October 11, 2008 - Myles Russ establishes an RMU single-game record for rushing attempts with 37, compiling 246 yards and a pair of touchdowns in a 34-27 win
- October 30, 2010 - Russ scores on a six-yard touchdown run early in the fourth quarter to become the program's all-time leading rusher in a 34-11 win passing Sam Dorsett

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JUST KICKING IT

In his first career game as a punter, Jayson Jenkins averaged 41.2 yards per kick and placed five balls inside the 20 at West Virginia. He also added a 36-yard field goal. For his efforts, he was named NEC Special Teams Co-Player of the Week on September 1. The following week, he again was named NEC Special Teams Player of the Week after booting a career-best 46-yard field goal and averaging 42.2 yards per punt at Youngstown State.

His 78-yard punt at LIU was the longest in program history, one yard longer than Chris Longo's 77-yarder in 1997. It is tied for the third longest punt in the FCS this season with Zach Wieder from Arkansas-Pine Bluff. The longest this season is 82 yards from Gilbert Brown of Charleston Southern and Mark Shenouda from Tennessee State.

PATRICK PERSISTENCE

Patrick McDonnell was named a Week I NEC Prime Performer. The linebacker recorded a game-high 12 tackles with a fumble recovery at WVU. He followed that with a Week II NEC Prime Performer honor after a career-high 18 stops.

SHINE ON

Ethan Shine set a career-best with 133 yards and a touchdown on 20 carries against West Liberty on September 20. For his efforts, he was named a Week 3 NEC Prime Performer. He earned his second NEC Prime Performer honor in Week 7 after leading RMU with 143 all-purpose yards, catching eight passes for a team-high 119 yards including a 66-yard touchdown at LIU. After rushing for 123 yards at Saint Francis, he became a Prime Performer for the third time. Shine recorded his second consecutive 100-yard game at Stonehill with a 122-yard effort, which earned him his first-ever NEC Offensive Player of the Week.

THE MIDDLE MAN

Chaz Middleton had a career afternoon against Central Connecticut, hauling in nine passes for 186 yards and a touchdown. He was named a Week 6 NEC Prime Performer.

CARTER CELEBRATION

Jaqai Carter, who entered Week 10 with 163 receiving yards on the year, pulled in seven receptions for 141 yards, including a 7-yard touchdown score to earn the NEC Rookie of the Week award. The 141 receiving yards ties Saint Francis' DJ Maultsby for the most by an NEC rookie in a game this season.
