Slippery Rock owns a 58-24-3 advantage in the all-time series that dates back to 1910. The Rock have won each of the last six meetings, 12 of the last 13 games in the series and 23 of the last 26 meetings dating back to 1994. SRU is 12-1 in the series since the introduction of the "Milk Jug Trophy" in 2010. Clarion's lone win in the last 13 meetings was a 27-23 win at home in 2016. SRU has outscored Clarion 241-42 over the last six meetings in the series.

COACHING MATCHUP

Slippery Rock head coach **Shawn Lutz** is in his 29th overall year at The Rock and his ninth year (eighth season) as head coach, where he owns a 76-20 record with five PSAC West titles and five trips to the NCAA playoffs. Lutz was the PSAC West Coach of the Year in 2018, 2019 and 2023 and was the Don Hansen Football Gazette Division II National Coach of the Year in 2019. The 76 wins are the most among all PSAC head coaches since the 2016 season. Lutz was an assistant at SRU for 20 years before taking over the program in 2016. He has been a member of the coaching staff for 13 of SRU's 20 PSAC West titles. Lutz played tight end at West Virginia University, graduating in 1996, and earned a master's degree in sport management from SRU in 2003.

Raymond Monica, a 1990 North Alabama graduate, is in his third season at Clarion and has led the Golden Eagles to an 8-22 overall record during his tenure. Monica came back to the PSAC after serving as defensive coordinator at Southeastern Louisiana. Before that, he served five seasons as head coach at Arkansas Tech and was the head coach at Kutztown from 2006-12, where he went 45-34 and made two NCAA Playoff trips. In total, Monica is 87-90 in 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

Slippery Rock moved up one spot to No. 14 in the AFCA Division II national rankings this week. The Rock also moved up one place to No. 15 in the D2football.com media poll this week. Both national polls are available on page nine.

1,100TH RECORDED GAME IN PROGRAM HISTORY

This week's game will be the 1,100th recorded game in Slippery Rock program history. After an extensive research project that took years, we tracked down every record for a game we could find being played all the way back to 1898. We have results from 1,099 games in program history with Slippery Rock owning an all-time program record of 647-410-42 for a .608 winning percentage.

WE LOVE NIGHT GAMES

The Rock have won their last 33 consecutive games that started at 4 p.m. or later and have not lost an evening game at home or on the road since Sept. 29, 2012. SRU is 1-0 in night games this year with a victory over Edinboro back in week four.

ROAD NIGHT GAMES

This will mark the first road night game for Slippery Rock since SRU played its first two road games of the 2021 season at Wayne State and Seton Hill at 6 p.m. The Rock have won their last six road night games and have not lost on the road under the lights since Sept. 19, 2009 at Edinboro.

THURSDAY NIGHT GAMES

This will mark the first time SRU has played on a Thursday since opening the 2021 season on the road at Wayne State on a Thursday night. The Rock have played just four Thursday games since 2010 and have won all four with wins over Wayne State in 2021 and 2019, Seton Hill in 2012 and Merrimack in 2010. All four of those games were played in week one. The last time SRU played on a Thursday in the middle of the season was a week seven loss at Clarion on Oct. 8, 2007.

STREAKS SNAPPED AT CAL

The Rock's loss at Cal two weeks ago snapped multiple streaks, including a 16-game regular season winning streak that at the time was the second longest in Division II. It also snapped a 15-game PSAC West winning streak and was just the third PSAC West loss for SRU since October of 2017. The loss snapped a streak of six straight wins against Cal and was just the second regular season road loss for SRU since 2019 (21-2).

AFTER A LOSS

Slippery Rock has been tough to beat two weeks in a row. The Rock have not lost two games in a row since losing the PSAC title game and then losing in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs, both by one possession scores, in 2021. The last time SRU lost two regular season games in a row was all the way back in 2017 when SRU lost to IUP and Edinboro back-to-back. Since then, The Rock are 56-6 overall in the regular season, 38-3 in the PSAC West and have not lost more than one divisional game in any season.

BEST OF THE WEST FOR A LONG TIME

The Rock have lost just three divisional games since Oct. 21, 2017, going 38-3 against the Division since then, including 36-3 since the beginning of 2018 with five straight PSAC West titles. The Rock have won or at least shared nine of the 12 PSAC West titles dating back to 2011, easily leading all programs in the Division.

SIX-PEAT UNLIKELY NOW

Slippery Rock opened this year trying to win an unprecedented sixth straight PSAC West title. The Rock's loss at Cal and the Vulcans' overtime win over IUP last week means SRU cannot play for the PSAC title this year. There is still an outside chance at sharing the regular season division title, but SRU would need to beat Clarion and Seton Hill and Cal would need to lose to Edinboro next week. Even if all that were to happen, the Vulcans will host the PSAC title game via the head-to-head tiebreaker.

REGIONAL RANKINGS

SRU was listed in the top 10 of the Super Region One rankings this week when the NCAA Committee unveiled the alphabetized first set of rankings. The committee will rank the teams in numerical order beginning next Monday. The teams in consideration entering this week are: Ashland, Assumption, California (Pa.), Charleston, East Stroudsburg, Findlay, Kutztown, New Haven, Slippery Rock and Tiffin. The Rock own the fourth-highest performance indicator score in the region behind Charleston, Kutztown and Cal and are one of only four teams in the region with at least three wins over teams above .500 (Charleston, Assumption, Kutztown).

LONG NAMED FINALIST FOR CAMPBELL TROPHY

During the bye week last week, SRU QB **Brayden Long** was named as one of 16 national finalists from all levels of college football for the 2024 William V. Campbell Trophy, which is the premier scholar-athlete award in collegiate football. Long is the only Division II player to be a finalist for this year's award. He will be recognized on stage at the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame Annual Awards Dinner Dec. 10 in Las Vegas. He will also receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the 2024 NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class.

SRU NOW 2ND IN DII IN CAMPBELL TROPHY FINALISTS

Brayden Long becomes the third Campbell Trophy finalist from SRU since 2017, joining **Marcus Martin** (2017) and **Henry Litwin** (2021). The Rock are the only school in the PSAC to ever have a finalist and now rank second among all active Division II programs for the most finalists, trailing only the four for Colorado School of Mines.

SRU IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

SRU has been ranked in every national poll since the final poll of the 2018 season was released. This week's game will be the 61st straight game SRU plays as a ranked team. The Rock have appeared in the top 10 in the national rankings for at least one week in each of the last five seasons and have earned a top 10 ranking in seven of the last eight complete seasons.

REGULAR SEASON ROAD WARRIORS

The Rock have lost only two regular season road games in the last four plus seasons dating back to the beginning of the 2019 season. That losses came in week five of the 2022 season at Indiana (Pa.) and two weeks ago at California (Pa.). Other than that, SRU's only road losses in the last five years have either been in the PSAC Championship game or the NCAA Playoffs. The Rock are 21-2 on the road in weeks 1-10 dating back to 2019.

LAST MEETING WITH CLARION – OCT. 28, 2023

No. 6 Slippery Rock jumped out to a 35-0 lead and cruised to a 42-14 win over Clarion in week nine at home last year. The Rock put up a 510-267 advantage in total offense with 394 passing yards and 116 rushing yards while limiting Clarion to 183 passing yards and 84 rushing yards. **Brayden Long** threw for 363 yards with four TD and no INT while also rushing for a TD to lead SRU. **Kyle Sheets** (106 yds, 2 TD) and **Cohen Russell** (135 yds) both had more than 100 receiving yards and **Logan Ramper** and **Kam Kruzelyak** each caught a TD pass. Clarion QB **Anthony Guercio** was 18-of-24 for 183 yards with two TD and two INT while also rushing for 28 yards.

LAST WEEK FOR CLARION

Clarion led 13-7 at halftime on the road at Seton Hill last week before the Griffins went on a 24-3 run in the second half to pull away for a 31-16 victory in a game that featured 991 yards of offense. Clarion played without its starting QB and still put up 445 yards of offense with 245 passing yards and 200 rushing yards. Seton Hill managed 546 yards of offense with 325 passing yards and 221 rushing yards. **Ty Hurst** completed 16-of-36 attempts for 245 yards with one TD and one INT. **Logan Kent** ran for 98 yards on 14 carries and **Trevon Tate** caught five passes for 101 yards and one TD.

LAST TIME OUT FOR SLIPPERY ROCK

California (Pa.) hit a 65-yard TD pass on the first play from scrimmage and Slippery Rock never got back into the game on the way to a 28-7 loss on the road at Cal two weeks ago. The Rock struggled offensively, going 0-for-2 in the red zone and 0-for-8 on third down on the way to finishing with 292 total yards with 282 passing yards and a season-low 10 rushing yards. Cal found success on the ground and in the air to put up 405 total yards with 250 passing yards and 155 rushing yards. The Vulcans also did not turn the ball over, which marked the first time this season SRU failed to force at least one turnover. **Brayden Long** was 24-of-38 for 282 yards with one TD and one INT. **Idris Lawrence** racked up 103 total yards with 33 rushing yards on five carries and 70 receiving yards on five catches.

OFFENSE LIMITING NEGATIVE PLAYS

Slippery Rock enters this week ranked No. 1 in the PSAC and No. 6 in Division II in both fewest sacks allowed and fewest turnovers lost. The Rock have turned it over just six total times this year, which includes a PSAC-low two interceptions and four lost fumbles. The two INT thrown is the fifth lowest total in the country. SRU has allowed only four total sacks with two each against Shippensburg and Cal and none in the other five games. The Rock also rank No. 8 in Division II in fewest tackles for loss allowed with opponents averaging just 3.7 TFL per game.

OFFENSIVE LINE GETTING THE JOB DONE

The new-look offensive line was the biggest question mark entering this year with four new starters and only LT **Joe Cooper** returning from 2023. That group, which includes Cooper (LT) and new starters **Marshall Futrell** (LG), **Cade Cameron** (C), **Luke Pugliese** (RG) and **Nathan Waltman** (RT) has answered the call in a big way, allowing just four total sacks through seven games.

THIRD DOWN DEFENSE

Slippery Rock enters this week ranked No. 1 in the PSAC and No. 18 in Division II in third down defense with opponents converting on just 29.4 percent of third downs. Three weeks ago SRU was No. 2 in Division II in the same category. Over the last two games, opponents have gone 15-of-29 on third down (51.7%).

KICKING GAME PROBLEMS

Slippery Rock has gone four straight weeks without a made field goal after opening the year 3-for-3 on the first three attempts. The Rock missed their only FG attempt at Cal. Since opening the year 3-for-3, The Rock have gone 1-for-5 over the last five weeks in field goal attempts and have not made a field goal since a 23-yard make at Shippensburg in week three. SRU may elect to go with its third placekicker this year and could send **Mason Yohn** out to handle placekicking in addition to punting this week.

10+ TACKLES THREE WEEKS IN A ROW FOR GREGORY

Redshirt freshman LB **Teddy Gregory Jr.** had 12 tackles at Cal and has now put together three straight games with at least 10 stops. In just his first season of collegiate football, Gregory finds himself leading SRU in total tackles (55) and solo tackles (25).

MUNCHIE MOVING UP SRU LISTS

DT **Munchie Johnson** started his 46th straight game at Cal and tallied 1.5 tackles for loss, moving him up to sole possession of No. 13 all-time at SRU with 36.5 career tackles for loss.

JOHNSON CLOSING IN ON 50 STARTS

Munchie Johnson's 46 starts are the most by any player currently playing in the PSAC. Johnson ranks 10th among all active players in Division II in career games played and ranks second among all active defensive linemen in Division II for the most career games played, trailing only the 49 by Lenoir-Rhyne defensive tackle **Andre Jefferson**.

HILL RANKED SECOND IN PSAC

DE **Todd Hill** enters this week ranked second in the PSAC in tackles for loss (11.0) and tackles for loss per game (1.57) while also ranking second in the PSAC in sacks (5.5) and sacks per game (0.79.). He trails Clarion's **Jake Tarburton** in both categories as Tarburton has 13.0 TFL and 7.0 sacks.

INSIDE-OUTSIDE COMBO ON DEFENSIVE LINE

The duo of DE **Todd Hill** and DT **Munchie Johnson** have combined for 81 tackles, 20.0 TFL, 8.5 sacks and 11 QB hurries through six games. Hill and Johnson rank No. 2 and No. 3 in the PSAC in tackles for loss per game at 1.57 and 1.29 per game, respectively.

ROCK VS. 2024 OPPONENTS

Slippery Rock has an overall combined record of 295-186-17 (.609) all-time against its 2024 scheduled opponents. The largest current win streak in a series belongs to SRU over Gannon at 10 straight wins. SRU has a winning record all-time against eight of its 10 opponents and has won the most recent meeting against nine of its 10 opponents.

STOKES CLIMBING PASSES DEFENDED LIST

CB **Josh Stokes** enters this week ranked fifth in the PSAC in passes defended with eight. All eight of those are pass breakups as Stokes has yet to grab an interception this year. He enters this week with 28 career passes defended, needing three more to crack the all-time top 10 at SRU.

CAREER-HIGH FOR HENWOOD

Safety **Michael Henwood** is coming off a career-high 10 tackles at Cal two weeks ago. Henwood is having a breakout season in his first year as a starter and comes into this week ranked third on the team in tackles with 37 stops while leading the team with two interceptions and ranking second on the squad with six passes defended.

FAULKNER IV STUFFING THE BOX SCORE

All-American safety **Eddie Faulkner IV** has put up stats in nearly every defensive category this year with 27 total tackles, 5.0 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks, two forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries and three pass breakups.

MOST ACCURATE PASSER IN SRU HISTORY

QB **Brayden Long** ranks first in SRU program history in completion percentage at 67.6 percent, completing 484-of-716 passes for 5,629 yards with 49 TD and just eight INT. He also ranks No. 2 among every current active QB in Division II with only 2023 Harlon Hill Trophy winner **Zach Zebrowski** from Central Missouri owning a higher career completion percentage, by four-tenths of a percent (68.0%).

LONG AS A STARTER

Brayden Long is 18-4 as the SRU starting QB with three of those losses coming in week 11 or later. His only loss in PSAC West play during his career came two weeks ago at Cal.

LONG'S CAREER RANKS

Brayden Long ranks No. 1 at SRU in completion percentage (67.6%), No. 4 in completions (484), No. 4 in passing TD (49), No. 4 in passing yards (5,629), No. 4 in passing attempts (716) and No. 5 in total offense (5,629).

SOLOMON SECOND IN PSAC WEST IN TD GRABS

WR **Mike Solomon** enters this weekend ranked second in the PSAC West with five TD catches on the year. Solomon has 16 total catches for 227 yards, giving him a TD grab on 31 percent of all his catches. He is coming off SRU career-highs of four catches for 64 yards at Cal two weeks ago.

FEATURED EVENTS LEFT ON THE SCHEDULE

SRU will celebrate its seniors and host its Salute to Military and First Responders Game Nov. 9 against Seton Hill before closing the regular season Nov. 16 against Bloomsburg with the 50th anniversary celebration of the 1972-74 PSAC champion teams.

RUNNING BACK TANDEM

Slippery Rock's running back duo of **Chris D'Or** and **Idris Lawrence** have combined for 910 rushing yards and 265 receiving yards through the first seven games, accounting for 167.9 yards of offense per game. Lawrence is averaging 5.9 yards per carry on 76 touches with D'Or averaging 5.1 yards per carry on 86 touches. They both rank in the top 10 in the PSAC in total rushing yards this year and they rank No. 1 and No. 2 in the PSAC West in average yards per carry with Lawrence ranked first and D'Or second. They have combined for 5,800 career rushing yards at the Division II level.

LAWRENCE FIFTH AMONG ALL D2 BACKS

RB **Idris Lawrence** enters this game with 3,503 career rushing yards, which ranks fifth among all active players in Division II and first among all active players in the PSAC. Lawrence is averaging 94.7 rushing yards per game over 37 career games, which ranks seventh among all players in Division II. His 5.8 yards per carry over 602 rushes ranks 10th best in Division II.

D'OR CLOSING IN ON 2,500/3,500 CLUB

RB **Chris D'Or** comes into this week with 2,297 rushing yards and 3,459 career all-purpose yards. He needs 374 more rushing yards to crack the all-time top 10 at SRU and 218 more all-purpose yards to crack the top 10 in that category. D'Or can become the eighth player in SRU history with 2,500 rushing yards and 3,500 all-purpose yards with 203 more rushing yards and 41 more all-purpose yards.

KRUZELYAK PASS CATCHING STREAK

TE **Kam Kruzelyak** has caught at least one pass in 19 straight games and has multiple catches in 17 straight games. He ranked third on the team in catches with 46 grabs for 465 yards in 2023 and is second on the team with 27 catches for 236 yards and two scores this year.

WILSON LEADS TEAM IN ALL-PURPOSE YARDS

Despite being just seven games into his sophomore season, WR **Kylon Wilson** is already up to No. 4 all-time in SRU history with 1,268 career kickoff return yards. He is also finding his groove as a pass catcher and now leads The Rock with 30 catches for 353 yards and two scores. He has 290 receiving yards and two scores in the last four games and leads all SRU players with 828 all-purpose yards (118.3 yards per game).

FASTEST MAN IN THE PSAC

DB **Kanye Thompson** has stepped into the punt return role and given SRU a spark with a pair of returns over 30 yards. Thompson is in his first season with an increased role on the football roster. He was dominant on the track in 2024 when he won PSAC titles indoor in the 60-meter dash and outdoor in the 100-meter dash, setting a new SRU record with a time of 10.27 seconds in the 100m. That time is the second-fastest 100m time in PSAC history and the fastest time run by a PSAC athlete in nearly three decades.

FRESHMAN DEBUT THIS WEEK

Slippery Rock assigned No. 55 to freshman tight end **Lou Swartz** this week and Swartz will dress for the first time in his collegiate career Thursday night. If he sees action, Swartz is likely to be involved with the special teams units. True freshmen can play in three games without using a season of eligibility at the Division II level. So far this year, **Kwalil Shepperson** and **Sincere Shannon** are the only SRU true freshmen to play in a game.

LONG DRIVES AND POSSESSION

SRU has put together 11 drives that lasted more than five minutes and seven drives that lasted longer than six minutes so far in 2024, including two drives of 8:59 or longer and two TD drives that went 99 yards.

WE'VE PLAYED A LOT OF FOOTBALL

Slippery Rock has played 74 games since the beginning of the 2018 season, which is the most games played among all Super Region One schools. The Rock are averaging an impressive 11.0 wins per year over the last five full seasons.

CAPTAINS

SRU has named six captains for the 2024 season with two on offense, three on defense and one on special teams. The offensive captains are QB **Brayden Long** and TE **Kam Kruzelyak**. The defensive captains are DT **Munchie Johnson**, DB **Eddie Faulkner IV** and DB **Josh Stokes**. The special teams captain is LS **Josh George**. Long, Kruzelyak and Johnson are all two-time captains after serving as captains in 2022 as well.

PLAYOFF STAPLES

Slippery Rock has reached the NCAA Division II Playoffs in each of the last five seasons and has made a playoff appearance in eight of the last 10 seasons. The Rock reached the NCAA quarterfinals in 2018, made the national semifinals in 2019, reached the first round in 2021, made the second round in 2022 and reached the quarterfinals in 2023. Slippery Rock's current streak of five straight trips to the playoffs is tied with Colorado School of Mines for the second-longest active streak among all Division II programs, trailing only Ferris State (9) for the longest active playoff streak in the country.

WINNING SEASONS STREAK

Slippery Rock has put together a winning season in each of the last 14 years, which ranks ninth among all Division II programs for the longest active winning seasons streak in the country. The only other program in the PSAC with more consecutive winning seasons currently is California (Pa.), which has strung together 19 winning seasons entering 2024. The Rock are already guaranteed to extend that streak.

UP NEXT

Slippery Rock returns home for back-to-back weeks to close the regular season. The Rock will host Seton Hill at 1 p.m. Nov. 9 before hosting Bloomsburg at 1 p.m. Nov. 16.

HEAD COACH SHAWN LUTZ - BRIEF BIO

Shawn Lutz was named the 16th head coach in SRU football history on Dec. 18, 2015 after spending 20 years as an assistant coach at The Rock. In the seven plus seasons SRU has played since he was named head coach, Lutz has guided the program to five PSAC West titles, five trips to the NCAA Division II Playoffs and an overall record of 76-20, the most wins in the PSAC over that stretch. He is the fastest coach in SRU history to 75 wins

Lutz is a three-time PSAC West Coach of the Year and was named the 2019 Don Hansen Football Gazette Division II National Coach of the Year after leading The Rock to the NCAA Division II semifinals and posting the best record in program history at 13-1.
