Alabama as Number-One Ranked Team

Alabama has compiled a 13-5 (.722) overall record as the nation's No. 1 ranked team. The Crimson Tide earned its first No. 1 ranking as the top seed in the 1996 College World Series. Alabama was also the No. 1 team and top seed at the 1997 CWS to become the first team in CWS history to be the top seed in back-to-back seasons.

Alabama vs. #1 Ranked Teams

The Crimson Tide has played 25 games against the nation's top ranked team, posting a 13-12 (.540) ledger. The Crimson Tide played back-to-back weekends against the No. 1 team during the 2006 season, beating Mississippi State (Mar. 31-April 2) and South Carolina (April 7-9) en route to a 4-2 record against the nation's top ranked team. In all, Alabama has won its last six regular-season series against the No. 1 ranked team, including series wins against Miami (1985), Mississippi State (1989), Auburn (1995), LSU (1997), Mississippi State (2006) and South Carolina (2006).

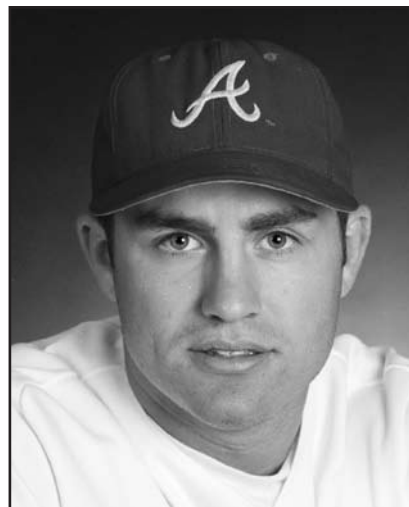

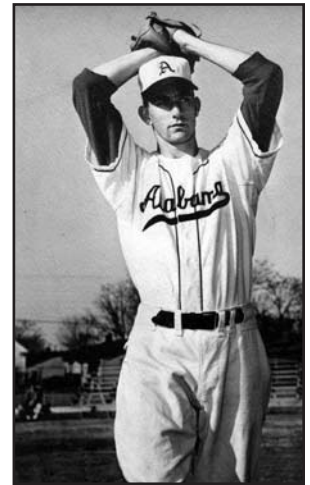
