THIS WEEK: SEC CHAMPIONSHIPS

Meet Notes: The Alabama men's and women's cross country teams will begin postseason competition this week with the 2017 Southeastern Conference Cross Country Championships at the University of Georgia Cross Country Course on Friday, Oct. 27. The men's 8,000-meter race will begin at 9 a.m. CT, followed by the women's 6,000-meter race at 10 a.m.

Alabama at the SEC Championships: The Crimson Tide men have won three SEC team championships (1973, 2008, 2009) and nine individual championships, the most recent by Antibahs Kosgei in 2015. David Kimani (2000, 2001, 2002) is the Tide's lone three-time champion. The Alabama women won back-to-back SEC crowns in 1986 and 1987 and have won four individual SEC titles - Evelyn Adiru (1985, 1987), Carole Tremanier (1988) and Becki Wells (1993).

Next Meet: Alabama will host the 2017 NCAA South Regional at the Harry Pritchett Running Park in Tuscaloosa on Friday, Nov. 10.

Alabama to Host NCAA South Regional Nov. 13

Following the SEC Cross Country Championships at Georgia on Oct. 27, Alabama will host the NCAA South Regional on Friday Nov. 10 at Harry Pritchett Running Park in Tuscaloosa. The top two men's and women's team finishers will qualify for the NCAA Cross Country Championships along with the top four men's and women's individual finishers who are not members of the qualifying teams.

Kiprop Named SEC Runner of the Week

Alabama junior Vincent Kiprop was named the SEC co-Runner of the Week for his performance at the Crimson Classic on Oct. 13. Kiprop finished second overall at the meet and recorded the second-fastest 8,000-meter time ever at the Harry Pritchett Running Park.

The Alabama men's cross country team remains at No. 3 while the women are ranked No. 9, in the latest U.S. Track & Field Cross Country Coaches Association (USTFCCA) South Region rankings released Oct. 16.

2017 MEET RECAPS

STRUTS SEASON OPENER - SEPT. 1

The Alabama women's cross country team finished second while the men's team came in third in their season-opening meet at the Struts Season Opener in Oxford, Ala. Georgia Tech won both the men's and women's races.

In the women's 4,000-meter race, redshirt freshman Shannon Marsh was the Tide's first finisher, coming in fifth in 14:55.90. Freshman Margot Dooley finished seventh in 15:00.50. Sophomore Caroline Brooks finished 13th in 15:14.60. Junior Sarah Mohan finished 17th in 15:18.80 and sophomore Haley Wright finished 18th in 15:27.00 to round out the scoring for Alabama. Other runners for the Tide included sophomore Brittany Tolson, who finished 20th in 15:32.80, junior Brianna Koshy, who finished 26th in 15:50.20 and freshman Ameena Benselloum who finished 31st in 16:06.40.

In the men's 5,000-meter race, sophomore Oliver Rigg the Tide's top runner, finishing ninth in a time of 15:32.40. Freshman Hayden Blalock finished 18th in 15:38.90, one spot ahead of sophomore teammate Elliott Miller who finished in 15:40.60. Freshman Nathan Gamble finished 27th in 16:13.50 while fellow freshman Paul Selden rounded out the scoring for Alabama, finishing 43rd in 16:53.20. Also competing for the Tide on Friday were freshmen Jackson Reed (51st/17:18.80) and Colton Smith (53rd/17:22.30).



UC RIVERSIDE INVITATIONAL - SEPT. 16

Alabama juniors Vincent Kiprop, Gilbert Kigen and Alfred Chelanga finished 1-2-3 in their UA cross country debut to cap Alabama's day at UC Riverside Invitational in Riverside, Calif., on Sept. 16. Running in the men's open 8,000-meter race, the trio finished nearly simultaneously with Kiprop claiming first place and Kigen second in identical times of 24:23.0. Chelanga was third in 24:23.3.

In the women's 6,000-meter race, sophomore McKenzie Yanek led the Tide across the finish line, placing 18th (15th collegiate finisher) in 20:37.3. Fellow sophomores Elisabeth Danis and Rebecca Buteau finished 20th (16th) and 25th (18th), respectively. Danis finished in 20:39.1 while Buteau clocked a time of 20:47.0. Junior Jessica Gray finished 43rd (33rd) in 21:16.9. Junior Nicole Gardner rounded out the scoring for UA, finished 44th (34th) in 21:17.0. In the women's open 5,000-meter race, freshman Maddie Dearborn finished seventh overall (sixth collegian) in 17:45.5 to lead the Tide. Redshirt freshman Shannon Marsh finished 13th (12th) in 17:57.7. Senior Alison Ringle was 34th (26th) in 18:31.6. Sophomore Caroline Brooks was the Tide's fourth finisher, running 18:40.7 to come in 52nd (40th). Freshman Margot Dooley was 61st (46th) in 18:51.0 in her collegiate debut.

In the men's invitational 8,000-meter race, sophomore J.P. Brinyark was the Tide's top runner, finishing 46th (38th collegian) in 25:02. Senior Garrett Bull finished 62nd (53rd) in 25:16.5, followed by freshman Chase Buckelew, who placed 72nd (61st) in 25:20.9 in his collegiate debut; sophomore Elliott Miller, 86th (71st) in 25:30.4 and sophomore Clay Austell, 93rd (77th) in 25:35.5.



JOE PIANE NOTRE DAME INVITATIONAL - SEPT. 29

Alabama juniors Gilbert Kigen, Vincent Kiprop and Alfred Chelanga finished 1-2-3, respectively, in the men's 5-mile race to highlight Alabama cross country's day at the Joe Piane Notre Dame Invitational on Sept. 29.

Running at Notre Dame's Burke Golf Course, Kigen crossed the finish line first for the Crimson Tide, covering the men's 5-mile course in 23:23.7, just ahead of Kiprop (23:24.2) and Chelanga (23:26.9) to win his first individual title with the Tide. Friday's finish marks the second time in two meets that the trio has swept the top three spots. Junior Josh Short (24:55.3) and senior Garrett Bull (25:45.9) were the Tide's fourth and fifth runners as Alabama finished eighth in the 21-team field.

Alabama finished 18th in the women's 5,000-meter race with senior Caroline Barlow (17:47.4), sophomore Rebecca Buteau (17:51.9), junior Nicole Gardner (18:00.2), junior Jessica Gray (18:03.0) and freshman Maddie Dearborn (18:06.7) finishing as the scoring runners for the Tide.

Southern Utah won the men's race while Colorado took home the women's crown.



CRIMSON CLASSIC - OCT. 13

The Alabama and Middle Tennessee men's cross country teams lived up to their South Region rankings, as the two teams tied for first at the 2017 Crimson Classic at the Harry Pritchett Running Park on Oct. 13. The top-ranked Blue Raiders took home team honors based on the meet tie-breaker over the third-ranked Crimson Tide. Middle Tennessee and Alabama each scored 110 points to take the top spots in the team competition. Georgia Tech finished third with 124 points, followed by Auburn (134) and Belmont (138).

Alabama junior Vincent Kiprop finished second on Friday, completing the 8,000-meter course in 23:26.4. Junior Gilbert Kigen was third in 23:34.7, while fellow junior Alfred Chelanga was fourth in 23:42.0. Middle Tennessee's Jacob Choge took individual honors in 23:22.3. The times by Choge, Kiprop and Kigen are the three fastest ever run on the 8,000-meter course at UA's Harry Pritchett Running Park. Chelanga's time ranks No. 5 in course history. Also scoring for the Tide were sophomore J.P. Brinyark, who finished 52nd in 25:37.1 and senior Andrew Bull, who placed 53rd in 25:38.1.

The Crimson Tide women were led by senior Nicole Gardner, who finished 18th in 21:13.8. Sophomores Rebecca Buteau (21:15.3) and McKenzie Yanek (21:20.5) finished 20th and 24th, respectively. Freshman Maddie Dearborn finished 30th in 21:39.9 and senior Jessica Gray finished 45th in 21:46.8 to round out the scoring for Alabama.
