UCFACTS

SETTING THE SCENE

- Following a historic first season under head coach Johnny Dawkins in 2016-17, the Knights have returned to the court with new faces in season number two.
- With five new players in the way of transfers and freshmen making major contributions, UCF started the year 4-0 with key wins over Mercer and Nebraska.
- Unfortunately for the Knights, three straight losses have followed, dropping games at the AdvoCare Invitational to #20 West Virginia and St. John's, and then falling to Missouri at home Thursday night.

PLAYING SHORT-HANDED...AGAIN

- Last year the Knights had success with just seven scholarship players with a number of transfer players sitting out due to NCAA rules.
- In the first two games of the 2017-18 campaign, the Knights were without two key contributors (Aubrey Dawkins and Tacko Fall), who missed due to injury, and lost a third (all-conference point guard B.J. Taylor) to an injury in the second half of the season opener.
- Fall returned in game three, and has scored in double figures in four of his five games since hitting the court.

BUT DEPTH IS HERE, THANKFULLY

- Thankfully, the Knights have added plenty of depth, to make it easier when injuries happen.
- 11 Knights have scored in the 2017-18 season and eight have scored in double figures.
- Six have led the team in scoring and five are currently averaging more than nine points per game.

DAVIS DOMINATING

- Senior A.J. Davis has been dominant on the boards through four games of his final collegiate season, averaging a double-double with 10.9 points and 10.7 rebounds per game.
- Davis has recorded double figure rebounds in six of seven games this season.
- His 10.7 rebounds per game leads The American and ranks 14th in the nation.
- Davis is also second on the team among active players with 10.9 points per game and leads the way with 15 assists.

AIMING FOR FIRST WIN OVER ALABAMA

- UCF has played Alabama three times in men's basketball, losing in all three from 1987 to 1994.
- A win over the Crimson Tide would be UCF's second over an SEC opponent in the last two years, having defeated Mississippi State early last year.
- The Knights have three wins over the SEC, having defeated Auburn (2009) and Florida (2010).

UCF and Alabama have met three times in the history of the two programs. The Crimson Tide have won all three contests, which took place between 1987 and 1994.

The Knights played Alabama in a neutral site contest in the first ever meeting, falling 65-54 in the Red Lobster Classic back on Dec. 28, 1987.

Alabama then hosted UCF twice in 1988 and 1994, winning both times in Tuscaloosa.

KNIGHT NOTES

GOOD FOR GRIFFIN

- Dayon Griffin has scored 16, 12 and 10 points in the first three games of the season.
- He became the first UCF player to score in double figures in his first three games as a Knights since Joey Graham did in 2000-01.

VETERAN BIGS COME UP BIG AGAINST BULLDOGS

- A.J. Davis and Chad Brown stepped up in place of the injured Fall to lead UCF to the win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15.
- Davis recorded his seventh career double-double with 15 points, 10 rebounds and three blocks, marking the second straight game with double figure rebounds to start the season.
- Brown recorded career highs in both rebounds and blocks, finishing with 10 points, 10 boards and five swats for his first career double-double.

NICE JOB NEWCOMERS

- In their first games as Knights, Ceasar DeJesus and Dayon Griffin led the way with 16 points.
- DeJesus went 6-for-9 from the floor and grabbed three steals in the victory.
- Griffin knocked down 2-of-4 from beyond the arc and 6-of-9 from the free throw line.
- Sophomore Rokas Ulvydas (7 points, 4 rebounds), sophomore Terrell Allen (6 points, 3 steals) and freshman Myles Douglas (4 points, 3 rebounds) all made contributions in the win.

BEST SEASON IN OVER A DECADE

- The first season under head coach Johnny Dawkins was a serious success, as UCF went 24-12 overall, earning the most wins in a season in program history since 2004-05.
- In 2016-17, the Knights tied their second most single-season victories in the program's Division
 I era and were just two shy of the program record of 26 wins (set in Division II era, 1977-78).
- The Knights' 11-7 mark in league play was the team's most ever American Athletic Conference victories in a season (previous best was 6-12, 2015-16).

POSTSEASON PLAY

- For the first time in five years the UCF men's basketball team earned a postseason berth in 2016-17, participating in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.
- It marked just the second time the Knights have played in the NIT, but it was the first time the
 Knights had hosted an NIT game and the first time winning an NIT or NCAA Tournament game.
- The Knights defeated Colorado, Illinois State and Illinois to advance to the NIT Final Four, before falling to eventual champion TCU in the semifinals at Madison Square Garden in New York City.

EXPECTATIONS RUNNING HIGH

- Following a successful first season under Dawkins and a slew of new talent set to suit up, the 2017-18 season is one of most highly anticipated in the history of UCF Basketball.
- B.J. Taylor, Tacko Fall, A.J. Davis and Chad Brown return to lead, but transfers, freshmen and
 players returning from injury are ready to give UCF something it didn't have last year, depth.
- CBS Sports ranked the Knights as the 29th best team in the nation going into 2017-18, and UCF received votes in the AP Preseason Top 25 for the first time in program history.

B.J. BUCKETS

- B.J. Taylor earned Second Team All-Conference honors from The American last season and was selected as a Preseason First Team All-Conference selection this year.
- He is the first UCF player to ever earn First Team All-Conference honors from The American.
- Taylor led the Knights and ranked fourth in The American, scoring 17.4 points per game and was 10th in the league with 3.5 assists per game.
- Taylor's 126 free throws made on the season were the eighth most for a season in UCF history.

LOCK DOWN DEFENSE

- UCF's defense was very impressive in its first season under Dawkins, holding opponents to a nation's best 36.5 field goal percentage in 2016-17.
- The Knights finished sixth nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 61.2 ppg.
- UCF was strong defending the three-point line as well, leading the AAC and ranking 22nd in the country at 31.3 percent.
- Sports Illustrated ranked UCF as the second best defense in the nation heading into 2017-18.

DAWKINS AMONG TOP COACHES IN FIRST YEAR

- There were 52 coaches in NCAA Division I basketball in their first season as a head coach with their current team in 2016-17.
- Dawkins' 24-12 record ranked fifth among them.
- SMU's Tim Jankovich led all first year coaches with a record of 30-5.

KNIGHT NOTES

TACKO TIME

- Tacko Fall was named the 2016 American Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year and earned Preseason Second Team All-Conference honors in 2017.
- Fall has been named to the Preseason Watch List for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award after being named a finalist for the honor last season.
- Last year he also earned Lefty Driesell Defensive All-America honors.
- He led The American in field goal percentage (71.5) last year, the second best single season mark in UCF history.
- He was also second in the AAC in rebounding (9.5), which was the sixth best rebounding average for a single season in UCF history.
- Fall set a new UCF D1 era single season rebounding record with 343 boards on the year.
- His 94 blocked shots on the season were also a single-season record at UCF.
- Named AAC Player of the Week once, AAC Honor Roll twice, and earned a spot on the Charleston Classic All-Tournament Team.

FALL FACTS

- One of the 40 tallest living human beings in the world
- At 7-foot-6, he is the tallest player in NCAA Division I basketball.

DOMINATING DAVIS

- A.J. Davis returns for his third season on the court in Black and Gold, finally the veteran.
- The son of NBA All Star Antonio Davis, A.J. has excelled for the Knights as a jack-of-all trades.
- Davis was fourth on the team in scoring last season (8.3 ppg), second on the team and ninth in The American in rebounding (7.0 rpg), and even played some point guard when needed.
- With a knack of getting to the line, Davis needs just 49 free throws made to crack UCF's Top 10 for career free throws made.

BEATING THE BEARCATS

- UCF picked up its first signature win of the Johnny Dawkins era in defeating No. 15 Cincinnati 53-49 at CFE Arena on Feb. 26 of last season.
- It was just the fourth ever win over a nationally ranked team in program history and the first since 2011.
- The Knights held the Bearcats, who came in averaging 76.2 points per game and shooting 47
 percent from the field, to just 49 points and 29.6 percent.

ON THE GLASS

- UCF was fifth in the nation in rebounding at 40.8 boards per game last season.
- The Knights totaled 50 or more rebounds four times on the season, including 59 against Nicholls.
- UCF was also sixth in the nation in rebound margin with a mark of +8.2 and fourth in defensive rebounds per game at 30.0.

MAGIC NUMBER 70

- Solid defensively all season, hitting 70 points on offense was the key for a Knights win.
- UCF was 15-0 on the season when scoring 70 points or more.
- Conversely, the Knights were just 9-12 when failing to reach the 70-point plateau in 2016-17.

45 OR LESS

- UCF held opponents to 45 points or less four times last season.
- In the Knights' entire Division I history, which began in 1984-85, the team had held its opponent to 45 points or less just six times prior to 2016-17.
- Last year's team had four of the 10 best defensive outings in program history, including holding College of Charleston to just 40 points.



JOHNNY DAWKINS

HEAD COACH • SECOND SEASON • DUKE, 1986

Johnny Dawkins was named UCF's seventh head men's basketball coach on Mar. 23, 2016 and had immediate success in his first season with the Knights. Dawkins led the Black and Gold to a 24-12 overall record, doubling the team's win total from 2015-16, the sixth best turnaround in all of NCAA.

With just seven scholarship players, Dawkins' Knights earned their highest ever seed in the American Athletic Conference Tournament, and fourth seeded UCF advanced to The American Semifinals for the first time in program history.

A season full of firsts, UCF hosted its first NIT game in 2016-17, defeating Colorado for the program's first ever win in an NIT or NCAA Tournament game. The Knights went on to defeat top seeded Illinois State on the road, before coming home to the first ever sell-out crowd at CFE Arena and winning 68-58 over Illinois to earn a spot in the NIT Final Four.

Under Dawkins' leadership, UCF led all of NCAA Division I in defensive field goal percentage, holding opponents to just 36.5 percent from the floor. The Knights were also sixth in the nation, allowing only 61.2 points per game, and gave up 45 or less points in four games over the course of the year.

Dawkins came to Orlando after an eight-year stint at Stanford, where he led the Cardinal to five postseason appearances, including a trip to the NCAA Sweet Sixteen in 2014, and four 20-win seasons.

Prior to his stint in Palo Alto, Calif., Dawkins coached for 10 years under the legendary Mike Krzyzewski at his alma mater, Duke. He played for the Blue Devils from 1982-86, where he was named the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year and helped lead Duke to three NCAA Tournament berths, including an NCAA National Championship Game appearance in 1986.

FIRST YEAR HONORS

In his first season with the Knights, Dawkins earned accolades as one of the top coaches in the nation. He was named a finalist for both the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year and the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year awards.

STANFORD STINT

Stanford put together four 20-win seasons in Dawkins' tenure as head coach. He is only the second coach in Stanford history with at least four 20-win seasons. Stanford's success on the court came against some of the toughest schedules in the nation. During the 2015-16 season, the Cardinal faced the sixth-most difficult slate in the country. A nation-leading 17 of Stanford's 30 games came against RPI Top 50 squads. Stanford's strength of schedule was rated in the top 50 each of the past four seasons, including two in the top 20, with an average rank of 27.75.

The Cardinal basketball program also excelled in the classroom during Dawkins' tenure, earning at least three Pac-12 All-Academic selections for five consecutive seasons and producing back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year recipients (2014, 2015). Stanford also received annual national academic recognition, with three players earning National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court status in 2015. The Cardinal was one of 20 NCAA Division I teams to earn an NABC Team Academic Excellence Award last season.

In 2012, Dawkins mentored Chasson Randle to become the consummate student-athlete. Randle finished that season as Stanford's all-time leading scorer and earned the program's first Academic All-America First Team selection since 2006. Under Dawkins, Stanford recorded back-to-back perfect Academic Progress Rate scores of 1000 in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 reports, the two most recent to be released by the NCAA.

Player development was also markedly improved at Stanford under Dawkins' tutelage. Four Cardinal players were selected in the NBA Draft following their collegiate careers.

LEARNING FROM A LEGEND

The Washington, D.C. native coached for 10 years under the legendary Mike Krzyzewski at Duke. During Dawkins' decade as a coach at Duke, the Blue Devils won a national championship (2001), tallied six ACC regular season championships, recorded seven ACC Tournament titles and posted a 330-60 record. In four consecutive seasons from 1999-2002, Duke finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both national polls, a first in college basketball history. Duke reached a No. 1 national ranking in seven of the 10 seasons with Dawkins on the coaching staff.

While at Duke, he also served as the Player Personnel Director for the USA Basketball Senior National Team from 2006-08.





DECORATED DUKIE

Following a prolific high school career at Mackin Catholic in Washington, D.C., Dawkins made his way to Duke, where he would become one of the most decorated players to step foot in Durham, North Carolina.

He played for the Blue Devils from 1983-86, earning Consensus All-America honors twice (1985, 1986). Dawkins was also voted as the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year and named a Freshman All-American in 1983. During his collegiate career, he helped lead Duke to three NCAA Tournament berths, including an NCAA National Championship Game appearance in 1986. He was listed as an All-ACC honoree in all four seasons as a Blue Devil.

Dawkins finished his career as the school's all-time leading scorer and held that honor until 2006 when J.J. Redick surpassed his mark of 2,556 points. He recorded double-figure point totals in 129-of-133 collegiate games. Dawkins led the Blue Devils in scoring all four years, recording the fourth-highest season point total in school history with 809 in 1986. Dawkins remains Duke's career record-holder in field goals (1,026) and field goals attempted (2,019) while also owning the school's best single-season mark for field goals (331) during the 1986 campaign.

Dawkins was inducted into the Duke Sports Hall of Fame in September 1996. His jersey number 24 was retired by the school.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

A 1986 first-round draft pick (10th overall) by San Antonio, Dawkins saw action in nine NBA seasons with the Spurs, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. He averaged 11.1 points and 5.5 assists over 541 career NBA games.

GIVING BACK TO THE GAME

Dawkins has served as a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches Board of Directors since 2012. He also currently serves on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition, an independent committee of current and former coaches, charged with promoting ethical conduct through leadership, education and mentoring opportunities, while identifying key issues challenging the coaching community.


