## Crimson Tide Makes 19th NCAA Championship Appearance

The Alabama men's golf team is among the field for the 2017 NCAA Men's Golf National Championships, which marks the team's 19th appearance at Nationals and 27th NCAA showing overall in program history.

The 2017 NCAA Championship tees off on May 26 and runs through May 31 at the par 72, 7,300-yard Rich Harvest Farms course in Sugar Grove, Ill. There will be three rounds of stroke play for the 30-team field with a cut to 15 teams after 54 holes. Those 15 teams will be whittled down to eight teams after a fourth round of stroke play. The eight teams will then begin three rounds of match play for the national title (1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, 3 vs. 6, 4 vs. 5), which is slated to be held on May 30-31.

Alabama is making its sixth NCAA Championships appearance in the last seven years, which sets a school record for national championship appearances in a seven-year stretch.

## 2017 NCAA Men's Golf National Championships Information

The Tide received the No. 23 overall seed and will be paired with No. 22 seed North Carolina and No. 24 seed Lipscomb throughout the first two rounds of this year's event. The three teams will tee off at 7:40 a.m. CT on Friday off Hole No. 10 and 1 p.m. CT on Saturday off Hole No. 1. Sunday's tee time will be determined according to position following the first two rounds.

## Alabama in the NAAs

Alabama's berth in the NCAA Championship marks the 19th appearance at Nationals and the ninth in the last 11 years under the leadership of head coach Jay Seawell. The Tide is coming off one of the best stretches in modern collegiate golf. Alabama won back-to-back national titles in 2013 and 2014, becoming one of three teams to earn consecutive championships since 1984 (Houston in 1984 and 1985, Augusta State in 2010 and 2011). The Tide also finished runner-up to Jordan Spieth and Texas in 2012, falling on the last hole of match play by one shot.

Prior to the NCAA Tournament switching to regional format in 1991, the Crimson Tide made five NCAA Finals appearances in 1973-75, 1981 and 1983 under head coach Conrad Rehling. Alabama has 27 total appearances (regionals and finals) in the NCAA men's golf tournament. The 1975 team, which featured Crimson Tide legend Jerry Pate, earned UA's fourth-best finish in the NCAA Finals with a tie for third place. Following Rehling's last trip in 1983, Alabama didn't make its return to the NCAA Finals until 1992 when Dick Spybey's squad finished 11th. Following trips to the NCAA Finals in 1993 and again in 1996, UA would not return for another eight years until Seawell's 2005 team advanced out of the East Regional. Since then, the Tide has only missed a total of three championships in the last 13 years, missing out in 2006, 2010 and 2015.

## Alabama Advances to National Championship after Third-Place Tie at Washington Regional

Alabama shot a 2-under 282 in the final round and finished tied for third overall with a 54-hole score of 10-over 862 (293-297-282) at the NCAA Men's Golf Washington Regional, held in Sammamish, Wash.

Alabama reached this year's nationals on the strength of not only its best round of the regional, but the 282 was also lowest team score in the entire field in the last round of play. Three UAZ golfers shot below par in the final round, including Lee Hodges (3-under 68), Josh Seden (2-under 69) and Davis Riley (1-under 70).



## ALABAMA MEN'S GOLF NOTES

Hodges led the Crimson Tide, as he tied for eighth overall which marked his team-leading fifth top-10 finish of the season. The junior from Ardmore, Tenn., carded a 1-under par 212 (71-73-68) for the tournament.

Riley tied for 17th overall with a three-day total of 3-over par 216 (73-73-70) on the par 71, 6,885-yard Aldarra Golf Course. It was Riley's seventh top-25 finish in the eight tournaments he has played this year. Meanwhile, junior Steven Setterstrom tied for 22nd overall – his second-best finish in a tournament this season – carding a three-round total of 5-over par 218 (68-75-75) to give the Tide three golfers among the Regional's top-25 finishers.

Sedeno, a redshirt freshman, rebounded from a 9-over par 80 in Tuesday's second round with his 69 on Wednesday. He finished the event tied for 40th at 224 (75-80-69). Junior Jonathan Hardee rounded out the Crimson Tide golfers, as he tied for 47th with a 227 (71-76-80).

Top-ranked USC claimed the Washington Regional title with a 3-under par 849, finishing 12 strokes ahead of No. 12 Kent State (855). Alabama tied No. 24 Florida State for third, while Penn State (863) placed fifth to also earn a spot at nationals.

### Tide Getting Hot At The Right Time

After a slow start to the 2016-17 season, Alabama is playing some of its best golf at the right time of year. Over the last six tournaments this spring, the Crimson Tide has finished outside the top five only once. That occasion came when it placed sixth at the SEC Championships. However, Alabama advanced to match play with the result and reached the semifinals before falling to No. 3 seed and 15th-ranked Texas A&M.

After averaging a team total of 876.0 over the first four stroke play tournaments of the year, the Tide has lowered that more than 21 strokes in the six tournaments since. Over the stretch, Alabama's team average has dropped to 854.7 per tournament.

### Breaking Down The Alabama Fivesome

The Crimson Tide lineup for the 2017 NCAA National Championships will be the same as each of the last four tournaments in which UA has competed.

Playing in the top slot for the Tide will be second team All-SEC performer and 2016 honorable mention All-American **Davis Riley**. The sophomore from Hattiesburg, Miss., could not play in the team's first two tournaments this spring due to an injury, but enters NCAA play as one of the hottest golfers on the team. Riley tops the Tide with a 71.29 per round stroke average and a 0.21 average vs. par to rank 43rd nationally in the latest Golfweek/Sagarin Performance Index. He comes into this week's event having finished among the top-20 individuals in five consecutive tournaments, while 23 of his 24 rounds (.958) played this year have counted toward the team total. At the SEC Championships, Riley set a new season low with a 66 – the lowest round by a Tide golfer this season – in the first round of stroke play. Prior to that, Riley shot a career-low 207 (71-68-68) and finished ninth at the Mason Rudolph Championship. He also finished tied for 17th at the Washington Regional with a 216 (73-73-70).

Playing in the No. 2 slot is junior **Lee Hodges**, who is the only Crimson Tide golfer to make the starting lineup in all 10 tournaments this season. Hodges, who transferred from UAB to Alabama last summer, ranks second on the team

in stroke average (71.47) and has seen 28 of his 30 rounds (.933) count toward the team total. Hodges is currently ranked No. 56 nationally by the Golfweek/Sagarin Index Player Performance Rankings. Earlier this spring, he won the Desert Mountain Intercollegiate with a 10-under 206 (69-68-69) on his way to being named the SEC Men's Golfer of the Week (March 8). The Ardmore, Tenn., native has shot in the 60s in 10 of his last 18 rounds to give him a team-leading 13 rounds in the 60s this season. Additionally, he has scored par or better in 19 of his last 24 rounds heading into play at the NCAA Championships.

**Jonathan Hardee** will be at the three spot for the Tide this week. Hardee, who missed the entire fall season while recovering from offseason surgery, has been one of the top players for Alabama this spring. He is currently ranked No. 158 nationally in the Golfweek/Sagarin performance index. The Greer, S.C., native ranks third on the team in both stroke average (72.24 average) and average vs. par (0.81 per round). He has four top-20 finishes in his seven tournaments played this spring.

Rounding out the Crimson Tide lineup will be redshirt freshman **Josh Sedeno** at the four position and junior **Steven Setterstrom** at the five spot. Sedeno has seen action in eight events during his rookie season. He was named SEC Freshman Men's Golfer of the Week (April 5) after he carded a tournament total of 9-under par 204 on the strength of three consecutive rounds of 3-under par 68 – all career-best numbers – on his way to a second-place finish at the Mason Rudolph Championship. Meanwhile, Setterstrom ranks second on the team with nine tournaments played this season. He collected a season-best finish tying for 20th at the Clemson Invitational with a 6-over 222 (75-73-74). Setterstrom played impressively at the NCAA Washington Regionals where he placed 22nd overall with a three round total of 5-over par 218 (68-75-75).

### Davis Riley Earns Second Team All-SEC Honors

Alabama sophomore Davis Riley was named to the 2017 Southeastern Conference Second Team, the league office announced on May 3.

Coming off a freshman season in 2015-16 in which he was tabbed an honorable mention All-American, Riley earns his second consecutive nod to the league's all-conference team in as many years (named to second team and all-freshman team a year ago).

Riley enters the NCAA National Championships play ranked No. 43 in the nation according to the latest Golfweek/Sagarin Player Performance Ratings. Despite battling injuries which forced him to miss the Tide's first two tournaments this spring, Riley leads Alabama with a 71.29 stroke average and has a team-best total of 5-over par for the year for a 0.21 average vs. par, which also tops the Tide.

Riley has had five consecutive top-20 finishes entering championships play, including an 11th-place finish at the 2017 SEC Championships and a 17th-place result at the NCAA Washington Regional. His opening round of 66 at the SECs marked a career-best 18-hole total and was the lowest round shot by an Alabama golfer this year. Earlier this year, the Hattiesburg, Miss., native shot a career-best 54-hole tournament total of 207 to finish ninth overall at the Mason Rudolph Championship.

Riley has had 57 of his 60 (.950) career rounds count towards the team total, including a team-leading 23 of 24 (.958) this season.

### Alex Green Named to SEC Community Service Team

In addition to Davis Riley's All-SEC award, redshirt freshman Alex Green earned a spot on the conference's Community Service Team. Green, who served as the men's golf representative on the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC), led all Crimson Tide men's golfers in total hours served in the community. Included in his community service projects were volunteering his time at the Halloween Extravaganza and working with the local Child Abuse Prevention Services.

### Alabama Reaches Semifinals of 2017 SEC Championship

After finishing sixth in stroke play, the Alabama Crimson Tide reached match play where it eventually fell in the semifinals at the 2017 Southeastern Conference Men's Golf Championships. This year's event featured a new format that included 54 holes of stroke play over the first two days, followed by the top eight teams advancing to match play over the final two days.

The Crimson Tide finished in sixth place following stroke play with a team total of 11-over par 851 (275-288-288) to advance to the match play portion. Alabama defeated No. 3 seed and seventh-ranked LSU, 3-1-1, during the opening round of match play before falling to second-seeded Texas A&M, 3-2, later that same afternoon. Top seed and No. 1 Vanderbilt went on to defeat the Aggies, 3-2, to claim the SEC crown.

### Lee Hodges Named SEC Golfer of the Week

Alabama junior Lee Hodges was named the Southeastern Conference Men's Golfer of the Week for the week of March 8.

Hodges earned the weekly honor when he claimed victory at the Desert Mountain Intercollegiate. Hodges finished the two-day, 54-hole tournament with a 10-under par 206. His 10-under par marks the best tournament mark of his career in terms of vs. par, while his 206 is second only to the 203 he carded last fall in the Jerry Pate Intercollegiate (finished third).

The Ardmore, Tenn., native carded three consecutive sub-70 rounds for the first time as a collegiate golfer on his way to winning the second tournament title of his career (also won the 2015 Shoal Creek Intercollegiate while at UAB).

Hodges began the event by carding a 3-under par 69 in Saturday's opening 18 holes and followed that with a 4-under 68 to finish the day with a career-best 36-hole score of 7-under par 137. Hodges capped the stellar weekend with another 69 on Sunday to become the Tide's first individual medalist of the season.

### Josh Sedenio Earns SEC Freshman of the Week Honors

Alabama redshirt freshman Josh Sedenio was named the Southeastern Conference Freshman Golfer of the Week, the league office announced on April 5. Sedenio earned the award as he collected his first top-five finish and best result of his young career with a second-place finish at the Mason Rudolph Championship earlier that same week.

Sedenio, who was the No. 4 golfer in the UA lineup, carded a tournament total of 9-under par 204 on the strength of three consecutive rounds of 3-under par 68 – all career-best numbers. He shared the lead entering Sunday's final 18 holes and was vying for medalist honors throughout the day until a bogey on the 17th hole dropped him out of the lead. Sedenio would narrowly fall to Florida's Sam Horsfield (202), who earned SEC Golfer of the Week honors, by two strokes for the individual title.

Sedenio did the majority of his damage on the par 5 holes, as he ranked third with an average of 4.42 (-7) during tournament action. Meanwhile, his 14 birdies throughout the event tied for fourth-most among all golfers.

Thanks in large part to his performance, Alabama, who was one of nine teams in the 14-team field ranked among the top 60 in the nation, carded a team total of 29-under par 823 (278-272-273) and finished one shot behind No. 6 Florida for the tournament title. The 54-hole score of 823 is seventh-best in program history, while the 29-under par ranks as the ninth-lowest total vs. par by an Alabama team. The Tide finished ahead of No. 3 Vanderbilt, No. 21 Duke and No. 26 Missouri among other teams.

### Alabama Has Season-Best Showing at 2017 Mason Rudolph Championship

Three golfers placed among the top 10 to lift the Alabama men's golf team to a runner-up finish at the 2017 Mason Rudolph Championship with a season-best team total of 29-under par 823 (278-272-273). The 54-hole score of 823 is seventh-best in program history, while the 29-under par ranks as the ninth-lowest total vs. par by an Alabama team. It was the Tide's lowest tournament score and its best finish of the 2016-17 campaign.

Redshirt freshman Josh Sedenio (2nd), junior Lee Hodges (T-3rd) and sophomore Davis Riley (9th) all placed among the top-10 individuals over the three-day tournament that featured nine of the 14 teams ranked among the top-60 in the nation. Meanwhile, junior Jonathan Hardee ended the event tied for 12th to give the Tide four golfers among the top 15.

### Alabama Head Coach Jay Seawell Inducted into GCAA Hall of Fame

Current Alabama men's golf coach Jay Seawell and former Alabama men's and women's golf coach Dick Spybey were two of six individuals who were inducted into the Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA) 2016 Hall of Fame class. The ceremony was held in mid-December in Las Vegas at the annual Hall of Fame Reception and Awards Banquet.

Four others were inducted alongside Seawell and Spybey, including former Alabama assistant coach and current Baylor coach Mike McGraw, Vince Clark, Tim Poe and Mike Small.

Named Alabama's head men's golf coach on July 26, 2002, Seawell led the Crimson Tide to back-to-back national championships in 2013 and 2014, while his teams have captured a total of four Southeastern Conference championships. Seawell has led Alabama to 13 NCAA Tournament appearances and nine NCAA Championship berths. Seawell has coached Alabama to 46 team tournament championships with 34 individual medalists. He received the Dave Williams National Coach of the Year Award in 2013.

Seawell has coached 31 PING All-Americans during his coaching career. His golfers at Alabama have been nominated for the sport's highest national awards, including the Ben Hogan, the Jack Nicklaus, the Fred Haskins, the Phil Mickelson and the Byron Nelson Awards. Justin Thomas won the Nicklaus, Haskins and Mickelson awards in 2012 and Robby Shelton was named the Mickelson Award winner in 2014.

Alabama has put 77 student-athletes on the SEC Academic Honor Roll in the last 14 years during Seawell's tenure and has seen eight student-athletes (16 honors) earn Cleveland Golf All-America Scholar accolades. Joseph Sykora was voted by the league golf coaches as the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year an SEC-record three times. In 2008, Sykora won the SEC's H. Boyd McWhorter Scholar-Athlete Award (all sports, all males in the league) and Alabama's Bryant Award, as the top male student-athlete from any sport. Cory Whitsett received the 2012 and 2013 NCAA Elite 89 Award, presented annually to the golfer at the NCAA Championships with the highest GPA. He also was named 2013 and 2014 SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year while winning the H. Boyd McWhorter Scholar-Athlete Award and the Bryant Award in 2014.

### Crimson Tide under Jay Seawell

Head Coach Jay Seawell transformed Alabama in to perennial contender in his 15 years at the Capstone. He solidified that with the program's first NCAA Championship in 2013 and followed with the 2014 title to make it back-to-back championships. He has won four SEC Coach of the Year honors and has guided the Tide to four SEC titles during his tenure. This year marked the 14th regional appearance in 15 years, including 12 straight. With the berth to this year's championships, Seawell has now guided Alabama to 10 NCAA Championships appearances (2005, 07-09, 11-14, 16-17), including nine appearances over the last 11 years.

Seawell not only rekindled the proud tradition of the Alabama Crimson Tide men's golf program, he has entrenched the Crimson Tide into the forefront of the nation's elite teams, as Seawell guided Alabama to the sport's pinnacle in 2013 and returned the Tide there again in 2014. Furthermore, his 2012 team finished runner-up to Texas at the 2012 NCAA Championships. The Tide also finished first in the stroke-play portion of the NAAs in 2012, eventually finishing runners-up to Texas as the Tide fell on the final hole of match play. His teams have won 46 tournament titles over the last 15 years, including 33 wins in the last eight seasons (90 events). UA won a then-school-record eight times in 2012-13 and upped the ante in 2013-14 with nine wins in 12 events. The Crimson Tide also set the school record with 11 straight wins before finishing second at the SMU Querencia Cabo Collegiate.

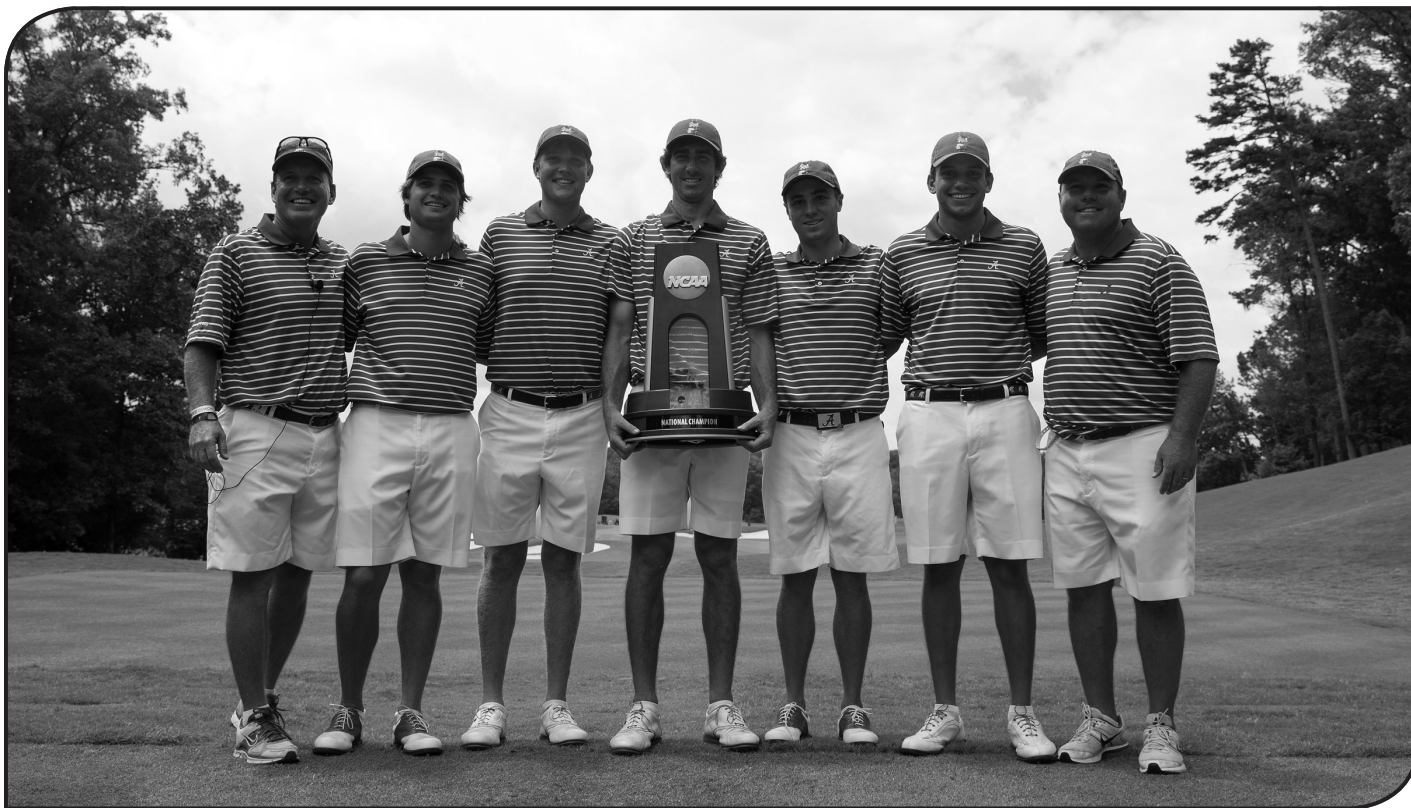

# 2013 NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

The Alabama men's golf team reached the pinnacle of collegiate golf in 2013, capturing the program's first NCAA Championship title. The Crimson Tide also won the Southeastern Conference title and the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional on the way to the NCAA title at the Capital City Club's Crabapple Course just outside of Atlanta. The Tide set a school record for team victories in a season with eight (out of 12 events) while winning the final six tournaments of the year and seven of eight on the spring schedule. Alabama's national championship squad featured five All-Americans, including three first-team honorees in Bobby Wyatt, Cory Whitsett and Justin Thomas while Trey Mullinax and Scott Strohmeier earned honorable mention accolades. Whitsett was the SEC Player of the Year and shared SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year honors. Senior captain Scott Strohmeier finished his Alabama career by winning the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional title and then delivering a 2-0-1 record in match play at the NCAA Championships. Head coach Jay Seawell capped off his 11th year at the Capstone with his first national championship and SEC Coach of the Year honors.

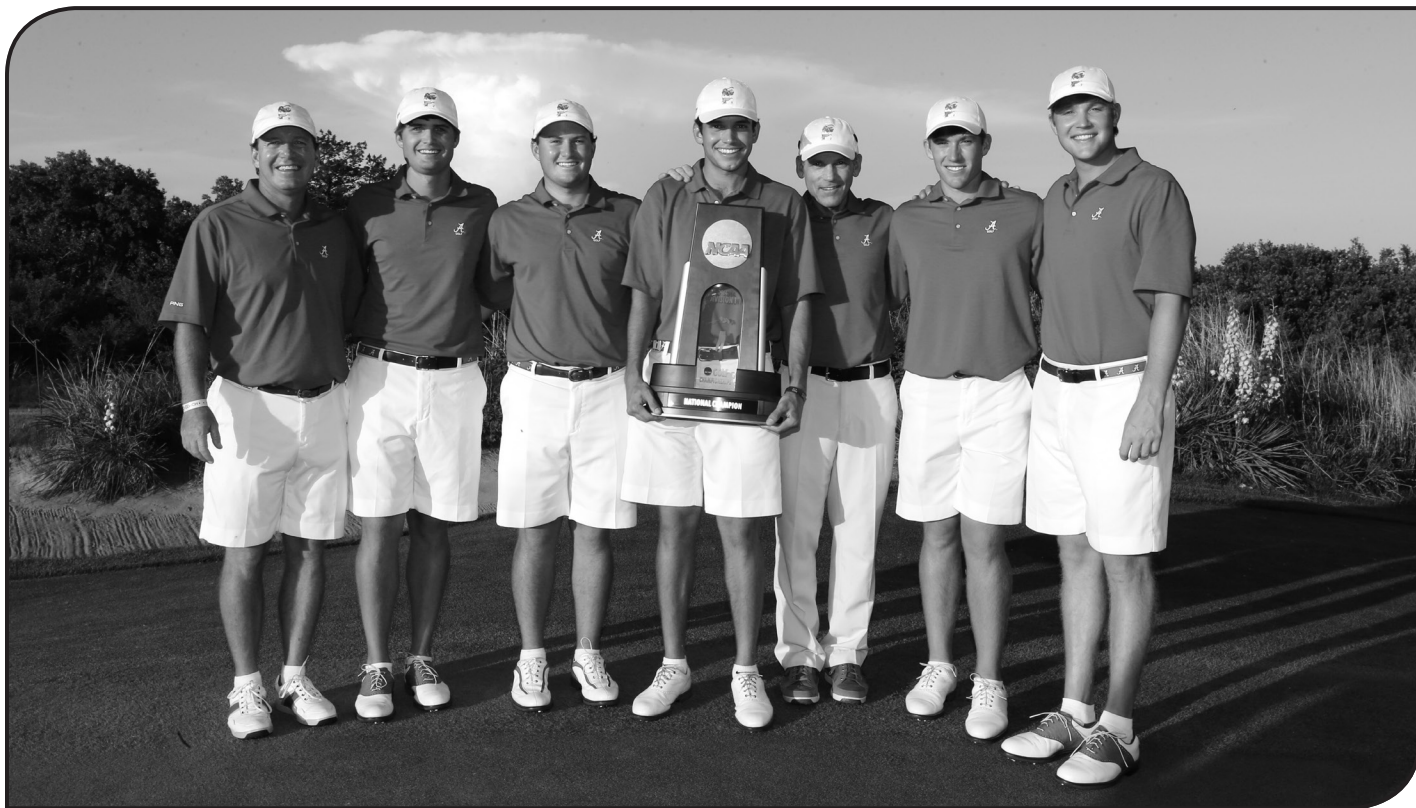

# 2014 NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

The Alabama men's golf team became the second team since the mid-1980s to win back-to-back NCAA Men's Golf Championships with a 4-1 win over second-ranked Oklahoma State in the NCAA Match Play Finals. The Crimson Tide also captured its third straight SEC Championship and third consecutive NCAA Regional, winning the Auburn site in 2014. Alabama broke the year-old school record with nine team wins in 12 events, including the first five events of the season to set a NCAA record with 11 straight tournament victories. The Tide also won the last four events in 2014 to give the senior class of Cory Whitsett, Bobby Wyatt and Trey Mullinax 27 wins in their four years at the Capstone. Alabama had four players garner All-America honors with freshman Robby Shelton and Wyatt named to the first team. Shelton captured SEC Player and Freshman of the Year en route to being named the Phil Mickelson Award winner as the National Freshman of the Year. The Tide finished tied for second in NCAA Championships stroke play and then defeated SMU (3-2) and LSU (4-1) to reach the NCAA Match Play Finals for the third straight year.
