ALABAMA **AII** EAST LAKE CUP

OCT. 29-31, 2018 / ATLANTA, GA.
EAST LAKE CLUB GOLF COURSE (PAR 72 / 7,460 YARDS)

The No. 4/5 (Listed as Golfweek Coaches Poll/Golfstat) Alabama men's golf team will close out the 2018 fall season at the prestigious East Lake Cup. The three day event will take place on Oct. 29-31 and will be televised live on the Golf Channel. Modeled after the NCAA Golf Championships, the format for the East Lake Cup consists of an opening round of stroke play to crown an individual male and female champion and determine seeding for the following two days of match play competition.

THE EAST LAKE CUP FIELD: The 2018 East Lake Cup will feature the eight semifinalists from the 2018 NCAA Division I men's and women's golf national championships earlier this year. The women's division will feature reigning national champion Arizona, 2018 runner-up University of Alabama, as well as Stanford University and the University of Southern California (USC). The men's division will include the reigning NCAA national champions Oklahoma State University; 2018 runner-up University of Alabama in addition to Auburn University and Duke University.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION: The East Lake Cup will be contested over three days, following the format from the final three days of the NCAA men's and women's golf national championships. On Oct. 29, the eight teams will compete in individual stroke play competition to determine the individual champion and to seed for two days of match-play competition. On Oct. 30-31, two match-play tournaments will be hosted simultaneously for the men's and women's divisions, with the semifinals taking place on Tuesday and the finals and consolation matches on Wednesday. Teams for the East Lake Cup will compete on the championship golf course at East Lake Golf Club, home of the TOUR Championship, which was the seasonending event of the PGA TOUR's FedExCup Playoffs.

The East Lake Cup benefits the East Lake Foundation, a charitable organization dedicated to helping families build better lives and children reach their highest potential through its holistic approach to community revitalization incorporating mixed-income housing, cradle-to-college education and community wellness. The East Lake Cup has raised nearly \$1.5 million for the East Lake Foundation since its inception in 2015. Mercedes-Benz, CSX and Bridgestone Golf are sponsors for the East Lake Cup in 2018.

MAKING HISTORY

The Alabama Crimson Tide men's and women's golf teams will participate in the 2018 edition of the East Lake Cup, a three-day tournament that features eight of the top teams (four semifinalists from both the men's and women's national championship) in collegiate golf. Alabama is the first program to send its men's and women's teams to the event in the same year, as both finished national runner-up at their respective NCAA Championships last May.

FALL TOURNAMENT RECAPS

Below is a look at the Crimson Tide's fall tournament schedule and how Alabama fared in each:

CARPET CAPITAL COLLEGIATE | SEPT. 7-9 | DALTON, GA.

RESULT: 3rd of 15 (-19, 845)

TOP FINISHER: Davis Riley, t2nd overall (-9, 207)

RECAP: Alabama carded a 54-hole team total of 19-under par 845 (288-270-287) to finish in third overall at the 2018 Carpet Capital Collegiate. The Crimson Tide was led by two-time All-American Davis Riley, who finished tied for second overall 9-under par 207 (68-69-70). Freshman Frankie Capan III, playing in his first career collegiate tournament, also finished among the top-10 individuals, closing play tied for eighth place with a 3-under par 213 (74-66-73). Sophomore Wilson Furr gave UA three golfers among the top 20, as he tied for 16th overall with an even par 216 (71-68-77) on the par 72, 7,178-yard Farm Golf Club layout. Sophomore Davis Shore (78-67-74) and junior Josh Sedeno (75-74-70) rounded out the Alabama golfers as they tied for 27th with both carding a 3-over 219. Freshman Prescott Butler, playing as an individual this weekend, ended the tournament tied for 65th with a 225 (75-76-76).

OFCC/FIGHTING ILLINI INV. | SEPT. 14-16 | OLYMPIA FIELDS, ILL.

RESULT: 4th of 14 (+18, 858)

TOP FINISHER: Davis Riley, 13th overall (+2, 212)

RECAP: Alabama had three golfers finish among the top-20 individuals to lead the team to a fourth-place finish at the 2018 Olympia Fields/ Fighting Illini Invitational. The Crimson Tide, one of 10 squads in the 15-team field ranked among the top-25 in the nation entering the event, closed the three-day 54-hole tournament with an 18-over par 858 (284-283-291). Alabama was led by senior Davis Riley who finished the tournament in 13th overall with a 2-over par 212 (68-73-71). Sophomore Davis Shore tied for 14th with a 3-over par 213 (73-68-72) on the par 70, 7,281-yard Olympia Fields Country Club North Course layout. Freshman Frankie Capan III tied for 20th overall after carding a 5-over 215 (70-72-73). Sophomore Wilson Furr tied for 38th with a three-day total of 220 (73-70-77), while junior Josh Sedeno rounded out the UA lineup as he tied for 42nd with a 221 (73-72-76).

JERRY PATE NATIONAL INTER. | OCT. 8-9 | VESTAVIA HILLS, ALA.

RESULT: 1st of 12 (-12, 828)

TOP FINISHER: Davis Riley, 2nd overall (-9, 201)

RECAP: For the sixth time in the last seven years and the 10th time overall, the Alabama men's golf team claimed the championship at the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate. The third-ranked Crimson Tide did so this year in dramatic fashion, securing the win on the final putt of Tuesday's third round to finish with a team total of 12-under par 828 (277-277-274) and defeat No. 19 Arkansas (-11, 829) by one stroke. Alabama was clinging to a one-stroke lead as senior Davis Riley, who was paired in the final group, was approaching the 18th green. Arkansas' Julian Perico, who claimed medalist honors with 13-under par 197, missed his birdie putt that would've forced a tie. Riley then calmly drained his par putt to ensure the team title. Riley finished the event in second overall after carding a 9-under par 201 (66-68-67) over the two-day, 54-hole event. It was the second-best 54-hole total and score vs. par in the senior's four-year collegiate career. Sophomore Davis Shore ended the tournament with a 1-under par 209 (70-70-69) which tied him for sixth overall. Sophomore Wilson Furr gave the Crimson Tide three golfers among the top 15, as he tied for 14th place with a 2-over par 212 (69-72-71). After an opening round of 80, freshman Prescott Butler responded with back-to-back rounds of 3-under 67 to close play in 22nd with a 54hole score of 4-over par 214. Sophomore Ben Fuller, playing in his first collegiate event, rounded out the Alabama golfers as he tied for 42nd overall with a 222 (72-73-77) on the par 70, 7,204 yard Old Overton Club.

U.S. COLLEGIATE CHAMPIONSHIPS | OCT. 19-21 | ALPHARETTA, GA. RESULT: 5th of 14 (-15, 849)

TOP FINISHERS: Davis Riley, Wilson Furr, Davis Shore T-10th overall (-4, 212)

RECAP: Three Alabama golfers finished among the top-10 individuals to lead the fourth-ranked Crimson Tide men's golf team to a fifth-place result at the Golf Club of Georgia Collegiate Invitational (GCOGCI). Alabama, one of 11 teams in the 14-team field that are nationally-ranked - seven of which are ranked among the top-15 teams in the nation finished the three-day, 54-hole event with a team total of 15-under par 849 (286-278-285). Sophomores Wilson Furr (75-69-68) and Davis Shore (70-71-71), along with senior Davis Riley (74-66-72), each carded a 54hole total of 4-under par 212 as the trio tied for 10th overall. It marked the first time in four tournaments played this season that Alabama had three individual finishers among the top-10. The last time it occurred came at the 2017 Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate when Lee Hodges (3rd), Riley (6th) and Shore (t-9th) each recorded a top-10 finish. Freshman Prescott Butler closed play with a 2-over par 218 (72-72-74) as he tied for 33rd overall on the par 72, 7,017-yard Golf Club of Georgia layout. Freshman Frankie Capan III rounded out the Alabama golfers, finishing tied for 51st at 222 (70-75-77).

FURR HAS A BUSY 10-DAY STRETCH

When sophomore Wilson Furr begins play at the East Lake Cup on Oct. 29, it will mark the final stretch in what was a busy week for the Jackson, Miss., native. After competing at the U.S. Collegiate Championships on Oct. 19-21, Furr then travelled to his home town of Jackson, Miss., where he played at the Sanderson Farms Championship PGA Tour event, which began on Oct. 25. Furr automatically qualified for the tournament after winning the Mississippi State Amateur at the end of June. Furr played the tournament on his home course, the Country Club of Jackson, during the four day, 72-hole event. From there, Furr will make the trek to Atlanta to compete at this year's East Lake Cup to conclude his fall season.

CRIMSON TIDE RANKED AMONG TOP-5 TEAMS NATIONALLY

The Alabama men's golf team has been ranked among the top-5 teams in the nation throughout the fall season. Entering the East Lake Cup, the Tide checks in at No. 4 in the nation according to the Bushnell Golfweek Coaches Poll, while Golfstat.com ranked UA at No. 5. The Tide began the season ranked No. 2 in the nation by the coaches.

RILEY COMING OFF AN IMPRESSIVE SUMMER

Alabama men's golfer Davis Riley had a summer to remember prior to his senior season with the Crimson Tide. The Hattiesburg, Miss., native finished runner-up at the Western Amateur Championship in early-August and followed that with an appearance in the quarterfinals at the U.S. Amateur Championship in mid-August.

Riley nearly pulled off a dramatic comeback in the finals of the 116th Western Amateur at Sunset Ridge Country Club on Saturday, but ultimately fell to Texas golfer Cole Hamel, 1-up, on Aug. 6. Riley reached the finals of the prestigious event for the second time in three years after he won two matches in convincing fashion on Friday afternoon, defeating Min Woo Lee, of Perth, Australia, 4 and 3 in the round of 16 before taking down Hayden Springer, of Trophy Club, Texas, 5 and 3 in the quarterfinals. He then advanced to the finals with a 4 and 2 win over Georgia Tech's Tyler Stafaci.

At the 118th U.S. Amateur Championship, Riley dropped a back-and-forth match to Devon Bling of UCLA in the quarterfinals. The duo was all square as they walked to the tee box at Hole No. 18, but Riley missed a par putt, while Bling drained a six-footer to win the match and advance to the semifinals. Riley's run to the quarterfinals began with a 2&1 victory over Ryan Burnett in the round of 64. He followed that with a pair of wins on the same day, defeating No.1-seed Daniel Hillier, 5-and-4, followed by capturing a victory on the 21st hole over Arkansas' Mason Overstreet.

Last season, Riley earned All-America third team honors for the second time in his career (2016) after helping lead the Crimson Tide to a runner-up finish at the 2018 NCAA Championships last May.

ALABAMA GOLF ON UNPRECEDENTED ROLL

The Alabama men's golf team has been on quite an impressive roll over the past seven years. Following the national runner-up finish at the 2018 NCAA Men's Golf Championships, the Crimson Tide has played in the NCAA title match four times since 2012 — the most of any collegiate team since the current format came into play. Over the seven-year stretch, Alabama claimed the national championship twice (2013 and 2014) and finished runner-up twice (2012 and 2018).

2018 NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP RECAP

Alabama placed sixth overall in stroke play at the 2018 NCAA Men's Golf Championships, closing with a 72-hole total of 16-over par 1,168 (294-279-301-294), which earned the Crimson Tide the No. 6 seed in match play. It marked the first time since 2014 the Tide advanced to the match play portion of the championships.

On a day in which it played two matches, the Tide survived No. 3 seed Texas Tech, 3-2, in the morning quarterfinal round and followed that with an dominant 5-0 defeat over No. 2 seed Duke on the afternoon semifinals. That set up a rematch of the 2013 NCAA golf championship match between Alabama and Oklahoma State (which UA won, 4-1). Playing on the Cowboys home Karsten Creek course in front an estimated crowd of nearly 5,000 spectators, most of which were clad in orange and black, Oklahoma State was too much and overpowered Alabama, 5-0, to claim the national championship.
