2013. The 2009 SEC Championship Game earned an 11.8 rating and a 24 share, marking the highest-rated SEC Championship Game in history. The game matched the No. 1 Florida Gators (12-0) vs. the No. 2 Alabama Crimson Tide (12-0).

THE TEAMS: Alabama (12-0, 8-0 SEC) is the Western Division Champion and the visiting team. Georgia (11-1, 7-1 SEC) is the Eastern Division Champion and the home team.

NATIONAL RANKINGS: Alabama comes into the game as the No. 1-ranked team in the nation in the Associated Press and USA Today polls. Georgia is the No. 4-ranked team in the nation. This is the first top five matchup in the SEC Championship Game since 2013.

SEC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME: The game, which started in 1992, is in its 27th year. It was a result of conference expansion, which saw Arkansas and South Carolina become the first members added in SEC history. Over 1.8 million fans have witnessed the pageantry of the game first-hand, with 24 sellouts in its history, including the last 22 consecutive contests. (Only 1993 and 1995 were not). The first two games were played at Legion Field in Birmingham and the game was played at the Georgia Dome from 1994-2016. This will mark the second SEC Championship Game played at Mercedes-Benz Stadium.

SEC CHAMPIONS: Georgia will be vying for its 14th SEC Championship and second consecutive. Alabama is aiming for its 27th SEC Championship and first since 2016.

TELEVISION: CBS Sports will televise the game nationally for the 18th straight year (BRAD NESSLER, Play-by-Play; GARY DANIELSON, Analyst; JAMIE ERDAHL, Sidelines; CRAIG SILVER, Producer). CBS has aired the game nationally since 2001. ABC Sports televised the game from 1992-2000.

TV RATINGS: Last season's SEC Championship Game between Georgia and Auburn was the highest-rated college football game nationally of the regular season. The game earned an 8.0 rating and 13.5 million viewers on CBS, up 21% in ratings and viewership from the previous year (6.6, 11.1M) and up 3% and 6% respectively from 2015 (7.8, 12.8M). It was the highest rated and most-watched SEC Championship since

RADIO: Managed by IMG College, the SEC Radio Network will broadcast the game to the 11-state SEC region and around the nation on SiriusXM. (SEC Radio Network: DAVE NEAL, Play-by-Play; DAVE ARCHER, Analyst; STEPHEN HARTZELL, Sidelines). The broadcast can be heard on Sirius 127, XM 191. The Georgia Radio Network is on Sirius 146, XM 190 and the Alabama Radio Network is on Sirius 84, XM 84.

IN THE SEC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME: This will be the second meeting between Alabama and Georgia in the SEC Championship Game, with the other occurring in 2012. It is widely considered one of the greatest SEC Championship Games in history as the contest came down to the final play.
