Meet Notes: The Alabama cross country teams return to action Friday after a two-week break. The Crimson Tide men and women will travel to Wisconsin for the 2018 Nuttycombe Invitational, Sept. 28, at the University of Wisconsin's Zimmer Championship Course in Madison, Wis.

Considered one of the premier meets on the cross country circuit over the past decade, the 2018 Nuttycombe will once again feature a stacked field. The sixth-ranked Crimson Tide men is one of 18 top-30 men's teams scheduled to compete, including top-10 programs Northern Arizona (10), Portland (3), Iowa State (5), Colorado (7), Wisconsin (9) and Colorado State (10). The women's field features 15 top-30 programs, including top-10 New Mexico (1), Colorado (2), Boise State (5), North Carolina State (6), Wisconsin (7), Villanova (8) and Arkansas (9).

Meet Schedule: The Nuttycombe Invitational will feature a women's championship 6,000-meter race at 12:20 p.m. CT, followed by a men's championship 8,000-meter race at 1 p.m. CT. The day will open with "B" races at the same distances at 11 a.m. CT (women) and 11:40 a.m. CT (men).

Alabama Men No. 6 in Latest USTFCCCA Rankings

Alabama holds steady at No. 6 in the latest United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association (USTFCCCA) Men's Cross Country National Coaches' Poll, released Sept. 25. The Crimson Tide is the top-ranked Southeastern Conference team in the poll. SEC rivals Arkansas (No. 13), and Ole Miss (No. 20) are also ranked this week. Defending NCAA champion Northern Arizona is No. 1, followed by BYU, Portland, Stanford and Iowa State to round out the top five, while Alabama, Colorado, Syracuse, Wisconsin and Colorado State hold spots 6-10, respectively.

Tide Men Top South Region Rankings

The Alabama men's cross country team remained at No. 1 in the latest United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association South Region rankings released Sept. 24. The Tide men are joined by Ole Miss (2), Tennessee (5), Florida (11) and Georgia (13) as one of five Southeastern Conference schools in this week's regional top 15. The Crimson Tide women remain at No. 10 in the women's South Region rankings.

2018 MEET RECAPS

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE SEASON OPENER - AUG. 31

The Alabama men's and women's cross country teams opened the 2018 season with second and third place finishes, respectively, at the Mississippi College Season Opener in Clinton, Miss.

Junior Elliott Miller was the top finisher for the Alabama men, placing third in 15:15.84 over the 5,000-meter course at Choctaw Trails. Freshman Megan Patton led the Tide women with an eight-place finish in 19:06.07 in the women's 5,000-meter race.

Also scoring for the Crimson Tide men were sophomore Hayden Blalock, who finished seventh in 15:58.12; freshman Payton Ash, who finished ninth in 16:03.57; junior Oliver Rigg, who was 14th in 16:15.79 and junior Clay Austell, who finished 18th in 16:28.20.

Samford won the men's race with 27 points, followed by Alabama (48) and Mississippi College (57).

Other scorers for the Alabama women were freshman Riley Schelp, who covered the 5,000-meter course in 19:26.73 to finish 12th; junior Brittany Tolson, who finished 17th in 19:42.63; freshman Lauren Brackin, who was 21st in 19:48.77 and freshman Savannah Noethlich, who finished 22nd in 19:55.18.

Southern Miss won the women's race with 22 points, followed by Samford (39) and Alabama (75).

**SEC PREVIEW - SEPT. 7**

The Alabama women's and men's cross country teams got a first look at the course they will run on at the SEC Championships Friday as they turned in fourth- and fifth-place finishes, respectively, at the SEC Preview Meet at Indian Pines Golf Course in Auburn, Ala.

Senior Nicole Gardner was the top finisher for the Crimson Tide women, covering the 4,000-meter course in 13:55.1 to finish ninth in her first outing of the season. Senior Connor Ferrentino led the Crimson Tide men, finishing 18th in 18:56.1 in his season debut in the 6,000-meter race.
