## AROUND #SUNBELTFB

- The Sun Belt Conference will conduct its inaugural Football Championship Game on December 1, 2018 and the game will air on ABC, ESPN, or ESPN2. The game will feature the winners of the Sun Belt's two divisions and will take place at the home site of the Divisional Champion with the best overall conference winning percentage.

- During the last two seasons, the Sun Belt tied its record for wins in the postseason with four wins in both 2016 and 2017. The Sun Belt finished second in bowl winning percentage among all 10 FBS conferences in each of those years while also finishing fourth in 2015.
- Reaching back to the 2014 season, no conference has a better total bowl winning percentage (.611) than the Sun Belt Conference. Further, the Sun Belt has won more games during that four year period (11) than its peers: the American Athletic Conference (10) and the Mid-American Conference (6). That fact is staggering when considering the Sun Belt has reached its win mark despite those conferences having more opportunities to win games (AAC – 27, MAC – 23, Sun Belt – 17).

SUN BELT CONFERENCE FOOTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE



JUSTICE HANSEN, ARKANSAS STATE (SR., QB, EDMOND, OKLA.)

Senior quarterback Justice Hansen completed a school-record six touchdown passes and recorded 454 yards total offense to help lead Arkansas State to 48-21 victory over Southeast Missouri State. Not only did Hansen's six passing touchdowns break the A-State record, they also tied the second most in Sun Belt Conference history and tied the most this season by any player in the nation. Hansen's total offense output tied the third most ever by an Arkansas State player and was the fourth most in the country this year as he led the Red Wolves to 685 yards total offense as a team, which ranked as the third most in school history. He completed 26-of-36 passing attempts for 423 yards that now stand as the fifth most in the A-State record books. All of his six passing touchdowns went to a different wide receiver and four of them covered at least 26 yards. Hansen is now responsible for five of the top seven single-game school records for passing yards.

DEFENSE



TOMARCIO REESE, GEORGIA SOUTHERN (SR., LB, MOULTRIE, GA.)

Tomarcio Reese led the Georgia Southern defense with 10 tackles and recorded his first interception in a 37-6 win over South Carolina State on Saturday at Paulson Stadium. The defense allowed just 151 yards of total offense and shut out the Bulldogs in the first half.

SPECIAL TEAMS



DARRYNTON EVANS, APPALACHIAN STATE (SO., RB, OAK HILL, FLA.)

After missing all of 2017 due to injury, Evans made his dynamic presence felt immediately with a first-quarter kickoff return of 100 yards to answer No. 10 Penn State's initial touchdown drive and tie the score at 7-7. - It was the second 100-yard kickoff in program history. Keith Nash had a 100-yard return against Lenoir-Ryne in 1968. - It was App. State's first kickoff return for a TD since Evans himself had a 94-yard return in the 2016 Camellia Bowl. It marked two touchdowns in a span of three returns for Evans, as he had a 14-yard return after his 94-yard return in the bowl game. - Evans piled up a game-high 149 all-purpose yards (9 rushing, 10 receiving, 130 kick return).

**Sun Belt Conference Bowl Partners**

The 2018 season will conclude with the Sun Belt being guaranteed a minimum of five spots in postseason bowl games. The Sun Belt maintains partnerships with the R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl, the Dollar General Bowl, the Raycom Media Camellia Bowl, the AutoNation Cure Bowl, and the NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl. Additionally, the College Football Playoff guarantees that a spot among the premier bowl games in college football will be given to the highest-ranked champion from the "Group of Five" conferences: the Sun Belt Conference, American Athletic Conference, Mountain West Conference, Mid-American Conference and Conference USA.

**Sun Belt and ESPN Reach Long-Term Agreement**

This past March, the league announced a continuation of its relationship with ESPN that is the most significant and extensive multimedia rights agreement in conference history. This new agreement includes enhancements in the current agreement, which runs through 2019-20, most notably an increase of men's and women's basketball games on ESPN platforms. The number of men's basketball contests available will jump to a minimum of 100 games in 2018-19 and 150 games in the 2019-20 season. Beginning with 2020-21, the Sun Belt's agreement includes the following on an ESPN platform: A minimum of 500 events per year, all football, men's basketball and women's basketball games, a minimum of 10 football games per year on a combination of ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, all live coverage of regular-season competition across all sports each year, all live coverage of conference championship events each year.

**Sun Belt Officiating Program**

The Sun Belt Conference officiating program will use a collaborative replay system for the second consecutive year. The system allows officials in a central location to review replays and assist officials at each game. The Sun Belt is one of only five FBS conferences to use collaborative replay and the only 'Group of Five' conference to use the system. Others with collaborative replay - ACC, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC.

**Sun Belt Athletes Are Student-Athletes**

During the recent 2017-18 academic year, Sun Belt member institutions awarded over \$50 million in scholarships to more than 3,100 student-athletes, while also providing life experiences such as team building, domestic and foreign travel, community service, mentoring and recognition through honors and awards. The commitment to education recently led to over 2,000 Sun Belt Conference student-athletes being named to the 2017-18 Commissioner's List and Academic Honor Roll. The list is comprised of 1,036 student-athletes on the Commissioner's List (3.5 grade point average or better) and 987 student-athletes on the Academic Honor Roll (GPA between 3.0 and 3.49).

Sun Belt in the Polls

The preseason Amway Coaches/USA Today Poll gave the Sun Belt several new records. It marked the first time the Sun Belt had three different teams receive votes. Troy and Arkansas State now also tie for the highest amount of points in a preseason poll as well as tying for the highest position in a preseason poll. Appalachian State joined Troy and A-State in the poll.

New Faces

Three new head coaches hit the Sun Belt sidelines this season with Chad Lunsford (Georgia Southern), Billy Napier (Louisiana) and Steve Campbell (South Alabama) all made their debuts. Notably though, Lunsford served as interim head coach at the end of 2017, coaching a total of six games.

Welcome Back

Coastal Carolina coach Joe Moglia missed the entire 2017 season dealing with medical conditions that popped up last summer, and didn't return to the program until January. "It was a difficult decision, but it was the smart decision, one that will have a positive impact on my health for the next 20 years. I just had to give up a few months," he reflected. Moglia, who also serves as acting chairman of the board and is the former CEO of TD Ameritrade, one of the world's largest online discount brokerage firms, had to watch from a distance as Coastal played in its second year of transition to the FBS ranks.

The Sun Belt has three head coaches that all graduated from Appalachian State – Scott Satterfield - 1996 (Appalachian State), Shawn Elliott - 1996 (Georgia State), and Everett Withers - 1985 (Texas State). Withers was a standout defensive back and captain for the Mountaineers from 1981-85 and played one season under legendary head coach Mack Brown. Satterfield and Elliott played together under another coaching legend in Jerry Moore. Both were All-Conference selections in 1995, Satterfield at quarterback and Elliott at defensive end.

**Hart Among Nation's Best**

Georgia State feature's one of the nation's most prolific receivers in junior Penny Hart, a Preseason All-American who led the Sun Belt Conference in 2017 with a school-record 74 receptions for 1,121 yards and eight touchdowns. Hart, who had a 3-yard touchdown catch against Kennesaw State in the Panthers' season opener, ranks first among all active FBS receivers in career receptions per game (5.64 ) and receiving yards per game (83.1). He ranks second in receiving yards (2,327), fifth in receptions (158) and third in TD receptions (18), all in 28 games.

**App State Youngsters**

Appalachian State has the second-youngest team in the country based on the percentage of underclassmen on its roster. The Mountaineers had six players start for the first time at Penn State and 12 players make their Appalachian debuts.

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS NEWS AND NOTES

Overall vs. Charlotte: First Meeting

Appalachian State and Charlotte, two of the three FBS programs in North Carolina that play in a Group of Five conference, will meet for the first time Saturday. Charlotte, which is less than two hours from Boone, is in its sixth year of football.

App State sophomore quarterback Zac Thomas threw for 270 yards, rushed for 43 yards and accounted for three touchdowns in his starting debut at Penn State. Thomas and backup quarterback Peyton Derrick, who filled in for one play, went a combined 10 of 16 passing for 175 yards in the fourth quarter, and App State had 91 rushing yards in that quarter.

App State scored 28 fourth-quarter points at Penn State, going from 31-17 down with less than eight minutes left to 38-31 ahead thanks to three touchdowns in a span of 5 minutes, 53 seconds.

App State sophomore Darrynton Evans' 100-yard kickoff return against Penn State was only the second one of that maximum length in program history. Keith Nash had a 100-yard return against Lenoir-Ryne in 1968. It was App State's first kickoff return for a TD since Evans had a 94-yard return in the 2016 Camellia Bowl, and he redshirted in 2017, so he's had a kickoff return for a touchdown in each of his last two games as an active player.

Overall vs. Alabama: Third Meeting - Alabama leads, 2-0  
 Last Meeting: Nov. 1, 2008 (L, 0-35) – Tuscaloosa, Ala.

Set to play Alabama in the second week of the season, Arkansas State is will play a defending national champion for the first time since the 2004 season when it played then-ranked No. 4 LSU following its 2003 title season.

Alabama holds a 2-0 lead in the all-time series, which dates back to 1982. The last meeting between the two programs came in 2008.

A-State won its season opener for the first time since the 2014 season, but claimed its 14th victory over its last 15 home openers.

Senior quarterback Justice Hansen broke the school record for passing touchdowns with six in the Red Wolves' season opener, helping lead A-State to a 48-21 win over Ohio Valley Conference member Southeast Missouri State.

A-State had seven different players catch a touchdown pass in the game and finished with 685 yards total offense, which was the third most in school history.



GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES NEWS AND NOTES

Overall vs. UMass: Fourth Meeting - UMass leads, 2-1  
 Last Meeting: Oct. 21, 2017 (L, 20-55) – Amherst, Mass.

This will be the fourth meeting between the Eagles and the Minutemen with UMass leading 2-1. The two teams played last season in Amherst with the Minutemen winning 55-20. In the 1999 I-AA quarterfinals, the Eagles won 38-21 behind five touchdowns and 333 yards rushing from Adrian Peterson at Paulson Stadium en route to a national title. The Minutemen beat GS 55-43 in the 1998 national championship game in Chattanooga.

In the modern era, Georgia Southern is 3-2 all-time against teams from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Eagles are 1-2 against UMass and 2-0 against Northeastern.

GS has won 21 straight games at home against non-conference opponents (including vacated wins and FCS Playoff games) dating back to a Nov. 18, 2006 overtime loss to end the season against Central Arkansas.

The 670 yards of total offense allowed to UMass last year are the most given up by the Eagles since joining the FBS in 2014.

Overall vs. North Carolina State: First Meeting

After a thrilling 24-20 win over Kennesaw State in its season opener, Georgia State (1-0) hits the road to face Atlantic Coast Conference foe NC State (1-0) Saturday in Raleigh, N.C.

In his first Division I game, quarterback Dan Ellington threw three touchdown passes, including the 8-yard game-winner to Diondre Champaigne with 41 seconds left. The junior college transfer was 20-for-28 for 187 yards while rushing for 77 yards on 18 attempts.

The winning drive covered 73 yards on nine plays as the Panther defense held on fourth down to give GSU the ball with 2:01 left and no timeouts. Ellington also rallied from a 14-0 first-half deficit with two touchdown passes in the final minute of the first half.

Georgia State has won eight of its last 11 games.

The Panthers have won five straight road contests and six straight games away from home with the 2017 AutoNation Cure Bowl victory over Western Kentucky.

GSU features one of the nation's most prolific receivers in junior Penny Hart, a Preseason All-American who led the Sun Belt in 2017 with a school-record 74 receptions for 1,121 yards and eight touchdowns.

LOUISIANA RAGIN' CAJUNS NEWS AND NOTES

This Week: Bye Week

Louisiana's 49-17 win over Grambling improved its record in the last 10 home openers to 9-1.

The Ragin' Cajuns are now 8-4 against schools from the state of Louisiana over the last four seasons.

It was the first meeting all-time between Grambling and Louisiana and the Cajuns are now 1-0 against Grambling and 3-0 all-time against the Southwestern Athletic Conference.

Head coach Billy Napier won his first game of his head coaching career. Among the seven head coaches across the FBS who coached their first game at the helm of their respective programs, only four out of the seven won and Napier was among that four. Napier became the 12th head coach in Louisiana history to win his first game as head coach of the Ragin' Cajuns and the first since Sam Robertson won his first game against New Mexico State on Sept. 6, 1980.

Senior quarterback Andre Nunez, who got the start on Saturday, finished 19 for 22 with 184 yards and three touchdowns (two passing, one rushing) finishing with a completion percentage of 86.4 percent. That number breaks a 21-year old school record for completion percentage in a single game with at least 20 attempts that was set by Lance Domec on Oct. 4, 1997 against Arkansas State when Domec went 17 for 20 to finish with a 85.0 percentage completion.

Junior Caleb Evans accounted for 408 yards total offense and three touchdowns to lead ULM to a 34-31 season-opening victory over Southeastern Louisiana. Evans capped off a seven-play, 63-yard drive with the game-winning 11-yard TD run with 37 seconds left. He also added a two-point run on the conversion to provide the final margin. Evans set career highs for pass completions (35) and attempts (53) against Southeastern, including scoring tosses of 3 and 79 yards to Marcus Green. He completed throws to 10 different receivers. Evans rushed 13 times for 62 yards and one score.

Junior R.J. Turner blocked Jonathan Tatum’s potential game-tying field-goal attempt from 37 yard out as time expired to preserve ULM’s 34-31 season-opening victory over Southeastern Louisiana. In addition, Turner matched his career high with seven receptions for 95 yards against the Lions.

Fifth-year senior Derrick Gore carried 21 times for a career-best 104 yards, including a 2-yard touchdown run to open the scoring, in ULM’s 34-31 season-opening win over Southeastern Louisiana. It marked Gore’s second career 100-yard rushing game.

In his first career start, junior defensive end Sam Miller recorded four tackles against Southeastern Louisiana, including two sacks for 13 yards.

In their first game under new head coach Steve Campbell, the Jaguars dropped a 30-26 decision to Louisiana Tech Saturday on the opening weekend of the season. It marked the first time South has dropped the season opener in consecutive years since 2012 and '13.

Texas State plays its first home game of the 2018 season when the Bobcats host Texas Southern on Saturday, Sept. 8. This is the 37th season that Texas State is playing its home games in Bobcat Stadium after the stadium opened in 1981. The Bobcats enter the Texas Southern game with an all-time record of 122-96.

Texas State ranks third nationally in team interceptions with three against Rutgers and in turnovers gained after forcing four against the Scarlet Knights. It was the first time since Sept. 21, 2013 that the Bobcats intercepted three passes in a game (at Texas Tech).

Freshman Jarron Morris recorded an interception in the end zone during the second quarter for Texas State’s first interception since the Bobcats played at Louisiana on Oct. 22, 2016.

Kordell Rodgers had two interceptions in the Rutgers game to become the first Bobcat to intercept two passes in a game since Texas State’s game against Georgia State on Nov. 14, 2015. Rodgers also returned his second interception for a touchdown, marking the first time the Bobcats have returned an interception for a TD since they played at ULM on Oct. 15, 2016.


