## NO. 28/30 [5 SEED] ALABAMA *at* NCAA ATHENS REGIONAL

MAY 13-15, 2019 / ATHENS, GA.

UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA GOLF COURSE (PAR 71 / 7,253 YARDS)

The No. 28/30 (Listed as Golfstat/Golfweek national rankings released on May 5) Alabama men's golf team was selected to compete in the 2019 NCAA Men's Golf Athens Regional. The three-day, 54-hole regional will be held on May 13-15 in Athens, Ga., at the par 71, 7,253-yard University of Georgia Golf Course.

**Athens Regional Field:** This year's Athens Regional, which is hosted by The University of Georgia, features five teams from the Southeastern Conference, including No. 1 seed and fourth-ranked Vanderbilt, followed by the No. 2 seed and ninth-ranked Duke, No. 3 seed and 16th-ranked Georgia, No. 4 and 20th-ranked Liberty, with the Crimson Tide rounding out the top-five teams in the regional. The rest of the 13-team field includes: No. 6 and 33rd-ranked Tennessee, No. 7 Campbell, No. 8 Kentucky, No. 9 Nevada, No. 10 SMU, No. 11 Memphis, No. 12 UNC Wilmington and No. 13 Princeton.

**Regional Format:** The top five teams from each regional championship and low individual not on an advancing team will move on to the NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championships, which will be hosted by the University of Arkansas at the Blessings Golf Club, in Fayetteville, Ark. on May 24-29.

**Alabama at the NCAA Regionals:** With this year's selection, the Crimson Tide is participating in its 15th consecutive NCAA Regional under head coach Jay Seawell, and the 23rd appearance overall. Alabama has won an NCAA Regional four times, all of which came during a six-year stretch from 2009-14. The team claimed the 2009 NCAA Galloway (N.J.) Regional, the 2012 NCAA Athens (Ga.) Regional, the 2013 NCAA Baton Rouge (La.) Regional and the 2014 NCAA Auburn (Ala.) Regional. Last year, the Crimson Tide finished in a tie for third at the Washington Regional to earn a spot at the NCAA Championships. UA went on to finish national runners-up.

**ALABAMA EARNS 15TH CONSECUTIVE NCAA REGIONAL APPEARANCE**

With its selection to the NCAA Men's Golf Athens Regional, the Crimson Tide will make its 15th consecutive appearance in NCAA Regional play under head coach Jay Seawell, and the 23rd appearance overall. Alabama has won an NCAA Regional four times, three of which have come over the last seven years. The team claimed the 2009 NCAA Galloway (N.J.) Regional, the 2012 NCAA Athens (Ga.) Regional, the 2013 NCAA Baton Rouge (La.) Regional and the 2014 NCAA Auburn (Ala.) Regional. Last year, the Crimson Tide finished fourth at the NCAA Stockton (Ca.) Regional.

Five of the 13 teams competing in Athens are from the Southeastern Conference. In fact, a total of 13 SEC teams earned a regional spot in this year's event.

The top five teams from each regional championship and low individual not on an advancing team will move on to the NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championships, hosted by the University of Arkansas at the Blessings Golf Club, in Fayetteville, Ark. on May 24-29.

The Crimson Tide has advanced to nationals 11 times under head coach Jay Seawell, including seven of the last eight seasons. Alabama has won the national championship twice (2013 and 2014) and has finished runner up on two occasions (2012 and 2018).

**ALABAMA GOLF ON UNPRECEDENTED ROLL**

The Alabama men's golf team has been on quite an impressive roll over the past seven years. Following the national runner-up finish at the 2018 NCAA Men's Golf Championships, the Crimson Tide has played in the NCAA title match four times since 2012 – the most of any collegiate team since the current format came into play. Over the seven-year stretch, Alabama claimed the national championship twice (2013 and 2014) and finished runner-up twice (2012 and 2018).

**ALABAMA WITHOUT TWO KEY STARTERS FROM FALL SEASON**

The Alabama Crimson Tide men's golf team will have a different look to its lineup than when the 2018-19 season began. UA played its entire fall season with two of its top players in every tournament – Davis Riley and Davis Shore.

Riley opted to turn professional following the completion of the fall season. At the time, he was ranked as one of the top amateur golfers in the world and ended the season ranked No. 10 in the nation, according to the Golfweek Player rankings. At the time, the Hattiesburg, Miss., native led the Tide with an average of 69.69 per round and a -1.38 per round stroke average. The two-time All-American would close his Alabama career with a 71.30 per round stroke average, which ranks third in program history, and a average vs. par of +0.07, which fourth-best in the program annals.

Meanwhile, Shore began the spring season battling a hip injury which eventually forced him to withdraw after one round at the Cabo Collegiate – the Tide's second tournament of the spring. The Knoxville, Tenn., native eventually had surgery to repair the injury that will force him to miss the remainder of the season. However, he is expected to make a full return and will be ready to get back into the lineup at the start of the 2019-20 campaign. At the time of his injury, Shore, who was ranked No. 60 in the Golfweek Individual Player Rankings, was second on the team in stroke average (72.35) and average vs. par (+1.12).

**FURR LEADS ALABAMA TO SHOAL CREEK TITLE**

Sophomore Wilson Furr claimed his first career collegiate medalist honor to lead the Alabama men's golf team to a dominant victory at the inaugural Shoal Creek Invitational, hosted by Auburn University on April 15-16. The Crimson Tide, who secured the team's only tournament championship of the 2019 spring season with the win, played solid golf from start to finish and was the only team to end play below par with a 54-hole total of 13-under 851 (285-281-285) – 19 shots better than the next closest team.

Alabama's 54-hole total was not only its lowest team score of the spring season, but the 13-under par was also the best relation to par of the spring and second-best of the entire campaign. LSU, ranked No. 12 in the nation, was the next closest finisher at 6-over par 870, while No. 15 North Florida was third with an 876. Kentucky (879), UAB (881) and Auburn (888) rounded out the top-six teams.

Furr led four Alabama golfers who finished among the top-10 individuals, as he claimed his first college individual crown with a season-low 54-hole total of 7-under par 209. After an opening round of even par 72, Furr carded rounds of 4-under 68 and 3-under 69 over the final 36 holes to capture a two-stroke win over North Florida's Cody Carroll (211). It was his second career top-five finish, besting the third-place result at the 2018 NCAA Stockton Regional, where he carded a career-best 9-under 207.

Furr finished the tournament with 14 birdies, which ranked second in the entire field, while his two eagles were tied for first among all individuals. The Jackson, Miss., native has now collected nine rounds in the 60s and 15 rounds of par or better this season, both of which lead the team.

Freshman Prescott Butler earned the best finish of the season and first-ever top-five result as he tied for fourth overall with a 2-under par 214 (70-73-71). The 54-hole total matched a season-best mark, which was set at the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate last fall.

Junior Josh Seden and freshman Frankie Capan III each collected their second top-10 result of the season, finishing in sixth and eighth place, respectively. Seden ended the event with a 1-under 215 (71-74-70) on his way to earning his second top-10 result over the Tide's last three tournaments. Capan carded an even par 216 (73-66-77) as he matched his season-best finish of eighth-place which was set in UA's first tournament of the year, the Carpet Capital Collegiate.

Sophomore Jake DeZoort rounded out the Alabama golfers as he tied for 31st with a 222 (72-75-75) on the par 72, 7,400-yard Shoal Creek Country Club course.

**UA DEFEATS TOP-RANKED OKLAHOMA STATE IN EAST LAKE CUP**

Alabama golfer Wilson Furr staged a dramatic come-from-behind victory to collect the match-clinching point and lift the then-No. 4-ranked men's golf team to a 3&2 victory over top-ranked Oklahoma State in the semifinals of the East Lake Cup. The Crimson Tide would eventually settle for a runner-up finish in the event, after falling to Auburn in the championship match.

Furr trailed by three holes after four holes played and didn't take draw even until the 15th hole. The Jackson, Miss., native took his first lead of the match with birdie on 17 before collecting another birdie on the 18th hole to seal the win for the Tide. Senior Davis Riley defeated Zach Bauchou 4&3 and freshman Prescott Butler defeated Haywood Butler, 3&2, to record the Tide's three points in the match. Sophomore Davis Shore fell to Matthew Wolff, 4&3, and freshman Frankie Capan III fell to Viktor Hovland, 2&1.

**ALEX GREEN RECEIVES TOM COUSINS AWARD**

Alabama men's golfer Alex Green was the recipient of the fourth annual Tom Cousins Award, which was presented to him on Oct. 30 in conjunction with the East Lake Cup. The honor recognizes a collegiate golfer best representing the values of the award: excelling in academics and engagement in the community.

A junior majoring in finance (minor in economics), Green is a member of the University's honors college and has been among the Southeastern Conference Academic Honor Roll for the duration of his collegiate career. The Fairhope, Ala., native is also a two-time member of the Southeastern Conference Community Service team. His long list of community involvement includes volunteering at the University of Alabama Special Olympics and serving as the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee campus collaboration chairman. Green also was presented with the Alabama Men's Golf Scholastic Achievement Award earlier this year.

The Tom Cousins Award is named after developer and philanthropist Tom Cousins, who laid out an aspirational blueprint to revitalize the East Lake community of Atlanta by providing cradle-to-college education, mixed-income housing and community wellness to break the cycle of poverty to create a holistic environment. East Lake now acts as a national model for community redevelopment through Purpose Built Communities for transforming a struggling community into a thriving neighborhood.

### GOLF CHANNEL'S "DRIVEN" FEATURING ALABAMA AND OTHERS

The Alabama men's golf team will be featured in the Golf Channel's "Driven" – a four-part documentary series that gives fans a behind-the-scenes look at three of the country's top collegiate golf programs.

The 30-minute program will go in-depth throughout the 2018-19 season and highlight the competitive journey of the Alabama men's golf team and its rivalry with Auburn. In addition to the May 6 premier, the series will continue the following two Mondays (May 13 and 20) on the Golf Channel. The series will conclude when the final episode premieres on NBC on Saturday, June 29, at 1 p.m. CT (2 p.m. ET) following the 2019 NCAA Men's Golf Championship, which will be played May 24-29 at The Blessings Golf Club in Fayetteville, Ark.

PGA Tour superstar and former Alabama men's golfer Justin Thomas, a member of the 2013 Alabama Crimson Tide national championship team, partnered with Rickie Fowler as co-executive producer. In addition to the Crimson Tide, the program will also highlight defending NCAA champion Oklahoma State and Auburn.

### THREE NEWCOMERS SET TO JOIN CRIMSON TIDE IN 2019-20

University of Alabama men's golf head coach Jay Seawell announced the addition of three standout prep golfers who have signed National Letters of Intent to join the Crimson Tide for the 2019-20 season. The trio of Tyler Lipscomb (Carrollton, Ga.), Thomas Ponder (Dothan, Ala.) and Simms Abney (Madison, Miss.) will become the newest members of the Alabama men's golf program next season.

### TYLER LIPSCOMB | 6-3 | CARROLLTON, GA. | BREMEN HIGH SCHOOL

Lipscomb was named a 2018 Rolex Junior All-American who is currently ranked as the No. 39 junior golfer in the nation ... was named a three-time All-State honoree ... earned back-to-back Georgia state individual champion, winning AA classification as a freshman and AAA his sophomore season ... also finished state runner up as a junior ... captured medalist honors at the 2018 w Junior with a 241 (69-71-71) ... won the Central Lion medalist honor that included a tournament record single round of 65 ... also claimed medalist honors at the AAA Georgia High School Region Championship and the Gordon Lee High School Invitational ... was the 2017 and 2018 Carrollton Cup Georgia PGA Club Junior Championship ... recorded a low tournament round of 59 which he shot during the Callaway Gardens Pro/Junior Championship ... has recorded a hole-in-one on five separate occasions.

### THOMAS PONDER | 5-6 | DOTHAN, ALA. | PROVIDENCE CHRISTIAN

Ranked No. 86 in the Rolex AJGA Junior Rankings ... a two-time AHSAA Class 3A individual state champion (2017 and 2018) who is the fourth-ranked junior in the state of Alabama ... ended this past season at Providence Christian as he carded a two-day total of 139 (69-70) with just one bogey while winning the AHSAA Class 3A state title for the second straight year ... behind his efforts, Providence finished as the 2018 Class 3A state runner-up behind city rival Houston Academy ... named the Dothan Eagle Golfer of the Year for three consecutive seasons (2016-18) ... a quarterfinalist at the United States Golf Association Junior Amateur Championship ... finished ninth at the 2018 Future Masters ... owned a 71.06 stroke average for the

season, but shot a blistering 67.5 average in the postseason, highlighted by an AHSAA state-tying record 62 at the Class 3A South Sectionals ... had an even par or under par score in 13 of his 19 rounds, including under par in all four postseason rounds.

### SIMMS ABNEY | 5-11 | MADISON, MISS. | JACKSON PREP

Ranked No. 79 golfer in the nation and the No. 1 player in the state of Mississippi by the Junior Golf by the Rolex AJGA Junior Rankings ... helped lead Jackson Prep to four state championships, including three consecutive (2014, 2016-18) and a runner-up finish in 2015 ... a four-time all-state performer, earning first team honors in each of the last two years (2017 and 2018) ... named the Clarion Ledger Mississippi boys golf Player of the Year in 2018 ... won six individual high school tournaments in his career ... claimed medalist honors at the 2018 Mississippi Junior Amateur Championship in which he set the 54-hole record for scoring and largest margin of victory, finishing the event tournament score of 16-under 200 (71-64-65), winning by 10 strokes over the field ... secured the individual title at the E-Z-Go Vaughn Taylor Championship with a 9-under par 207 (73-68-66) ... won the Hampton Cove Junior Classic with a 143 – one of three top-five finishes on the Southeastern Junior Golf Tour ... set the 54-hole record when he won the 2017 AJGA David Toms championship ... also earned a spot on the academic honor roll in each of his three years in high school (2016-18).

### 2018 NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP RECAP

Alabama placed sixth overall in stroke play at the 2018 NCAA Men's Golf Championships, closing with a 72-hole total of 16-over par 1,168 (294-279-301-294), which earned the Crimson Tide the No. 6 seed in match play. It marked the first time since 2014 the Tide advanced to the match play portion of the championships.

On a day in which it played two matches, the Tide survived No. 3 seed Texas Tech, 3-2, in the morning quarterfinal round and followed that with an dominant 5-0 defeat over No. 2 seed Duke on the afternoon semifinals. That set up a rematch of the 2013 NCAA golf championship match between Alabama and Oklahoma State (which UA won, 4-1). Playing on the Cowboys home Karsten Creek course in front an estimated crowd of nearly 5,000 spectators, most of which were clad in orange and black, Oklahoma State was too much and overpowered Alabama, 5-0, to claim the national championship.

The Crimson Tide earned a spot at the NCAA Nationals with a fourth-place finish at the NCAA Stockton Regional. Alabama closed play with a three-day, 54-hole total of 15-under par 849 (282-280-287) to seal its 20th appearance at nationals and 11th in 16 seasons under head coach Jay Seawell. Wilson Furr led the Crimson Tide behind a NCAA Regional-best 16 total birdies on his way to finishing tied for third overall with a 9-under par 207. It was his best result and tournament total last season.
