

SEC MATCH PLAY

HOSTED BY JERRY PATE

Sept. 25-27 // Vestavia Hills, Ala. (Old Overton Club)

After 35 seasons (1986-2020), the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate will make the transition to a first-of-its-kind SEC Match Play hosted by Jerry Pate. It will be the Crimson Tide's lone home tournament of the season. Head coach Jay Seawell worked closely alongside the tournament's namesake Mr. Pate to put together the unique three-day tournament, which will be held Sunday through Tuesday, September 25-27 at the beautiful par 70, 7,204-yard Old Overton Club course in Vestavia Hills, Ala. All 14 SEC schools will compete in 54 holes of stroke play – 36 holes Sunday followed by 18 Monday – with match play coming on Tuesday. The top two finishers from stroke play will square off in the final groupings of the day, while the 12 other teams will square off in East vs. West Match Play format.

ABOUT JERRY PATE

Host and tournament namesake Jerry Pate is the one of the most successful professional golfers to have worn the crimson and white. The former Tide golfer and current Champions Tour player proudly lends his name and plays an active role each year, including presenting the tournament trophy. Pate was a mere 22 years old when he won the United States Open in 1976, and that wasn't even the first time he'd made major national headlines. He did that in 1974 when he won the United States Amateur – only weeks before he started his senior season on The University of Alabama's golf team. Pate would go on to win eight PGA Tournaments including the 1976 U.S. Open as a rookie on the tour. That year, Pate was named the PGA Rookie of the Year and Co-Player of the Year. He was also a member of the victorious 1981 Ryder Cup team and was inducted into the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame in 1994.
