Homecoming

The Game

This marks Rowan's first road game of the year. Last season, the Profs were 3-2 away from home.

60 Years in the Making

This marks the 60th year of football at Rowan as the program got its start in 1947, when the school was named Glassboro State. The program was discontinued from 1951 to 1962, and then returned as a junior varsity team in 1963, before the varsity program returned in 1964. The school's all-time record is 364-221-8 (counting this season).

The Series (Rowan leads 2-0)

This is the third meeting between the schools but the first in regular-season play. The teams previously met in the 2004 NCAA Second Round and the 2006 First Round, with Rowan winning both games at home. The Profs scored a 45-14 win in 2004 and posted a 20-18 victory in 2006.

Accorsi at the Helm

Head coach **Jay Accorsi** is in his 18th season as the head coach of the Profs, and his 27th overall, and is the longest-tenured coach in program history. Accorsi owns the most wins (125) and most games coached (183) while the Profs have posted a record of .500 or better in all but two seasons under his guidance.

About the Profs

Rowan fell to 0-2 with the 35-14 loss to #12 Linfield College at home last Saturday. The Profs are on the road for two straight and return for the "Homecoming" game on October 5 vs. Kean in the NJAC opener.

About Hobart

The Statesman are 0-2 with wins over #13 Brockport (33-7, and at Morrisville State, 38-24. Hobart is coached by Kevin Dewall, who is in his fifth year. QB Ryan Hofmann has thrown for seven touchdowns this year.

Last Time Out

A pair of touchdowns within a three-minute span in the third quarter helped give 12th-ranked Linfield College a 35-14 win over host Rowan.

Rowan trailed 28-14 and was putting together a five-minute drive in the fourth quarter, but Linfield came up with an interception in the end zone to stop the Profs. It was the third interception of the Profs, and their fourth turnover of the game. The Wildcats then put it out of reach after recovering a Rowan fumble and scoring in three plays.

Linfield jumped out to a 14-0 lead but All-American **Elijah Rehm** scored his first touchdown of the season when he took a 2-yard pass from **Mike Husni** to cut Linfield's lead to 14-7 as time expired in the first half.

The Profs tied it in the third quarter, 14-14, with a drive that included a 21-yard completion to **Nick Grosso** and a 16-yarder to Rehm. The drive culminated on a 30-yard touchdown run by **Messiah Divine** for his first of the season.

Linfield answered immediately on the next drive with an 11-yard pass to go up 21-14. The Wildcats then capitalized on the Profs' four-and-out on the next possession, driving 60 yards in four plays to go up 28-14, with a 48-yard pass play.

Rowan and the NJAC

Rowan has won the New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC) Championship 19 times, with 14 outright and five shared titles. The Profs captured the conference title in 2006, 2005, 2004, 2002, 2001, 1997, 1995, 1993, 1992, 1991, 1977, 1976, 1975 and 1974. Rowan shared the NJAC Championship in 2014, 2013, 2010, 1983 and 1972.

Captaining the Profs

The Profs are led by four captains this season – **David Gajderowicz** (DE), **Nick Grosso** (WR), **Anthony LaRosa** (LB) and **Elijah Rehm** (WR). Grosso and LaRosa were both high school teammates at Washington Township High School.

Under Center

Sophomores **Mike Husni** and **Nick Cuozzi** battled all preseason at the quarterback position and Husni earned the starting nod. Husni, who transferred to Rowan from Marist, passed for 280 yards and three TDs in the loss to Widener. Cuozzi is in his first year with the Profs after transferring from Pace University.

Divine's Day

Messiah Divine ran for a season-best 95 yards against Linfield and scored his first rushing touchdown of the year, a 30-yarder in the third quarter. The junior is averaging 86.5 yards per game and 3.8 yards per carry this season.

No Whistles

The Profs rank 28th in the nation in fewest penalties with 4.0 per game and lead the NJAC. Rowan committed just two penalties in the Widener game for a total of 26 yards and then had six vs. Linfield. Last season, Rowan averaged eight penalties per contest.

The Stoppers

Mike Mascioli leads the Profs in tackles this season with 16, while **David Gajderowicz** has 14, including a team-high eight solos. Gajderowicz has a sack this year as do **Sunny Tapp** and **Luke Genise**.

On the Offensive

The Profs posted 380 yards of total offense against Widener, led by 280 passing yards from **Mike Husni**. **Messiah Divine** ran for 78 yards to lead Rowan and **Elijah Rehm** had five catches for 27 yards.

Early Honors

Senior WR/KR **Elijah Rehm** was selected to the D3football.com Preseason All-America offense first team as a return specialist while DE **David Gajderowicz** was named to the Preseason All-America defense second team. In 2018, Rehm was chosen to the D3football.com All-America second team as a return specialist, was selected to the NJAC All-Conference first team for special teams and was on the second team offense at wide receiver. Gajderowicz was a member of the 2018 NJAC All-Conference defense first team and the D3football.com All-East Region second team.

Topping the Profs

Messiah Divine was the leading returning rusher for the Profs, as he averaged 34.9 yards last season. **Elijah Rehm** topped the team in receiving (50.8 yds) and in kick returns, with an average of 29.4. Rehm was also the squad's leader in all-purpose yards with an average of 156.0.

Tough Tests

The Profs are facing a challenging schedule this year with three opponents in the D3football.com Top 25 (Linfield, Wesley, Salisbury) and one receiving votes (Hobart).

Rowan and the NCAA's

Since 1991, Rowan has made 16 appearances in the NCAA Championship tournament, owning a 31-16 mark. Rowan has played in the championship game, the Amos Alonzo Stagg Bowl, five times (1999-98-96-95-93). Rowan reached the semifinals of the national championship in 2005, 2004, 2001, 1997 and 1992.

Rowan Head Coach/Special Teams Coordinator
18th Season

The program's all-time leader in victories with 125, **Jay Accorsi** is in his 18th season as the head coach of the Rowan University football team, which makes him the longest-tenured coach in school history. The seventh coach in school history, he also serves as the special teams coordinator.

Accorsi took over as head coach in 2002 after nine years as an assistant coach. He has guided Rowan to seven appearances in the NCAA Division III Championship Tournament, two trips to the national semifinals and seven New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC) championships. His coaching record stands at 125-57.

The 2018 saw the Profs get back on the winning track with 6-4 record and go 5-4 in the NJAC. Elijah Rehm was named to the D3football.com All-America Second Team as he set numerous Rowan marks for returns.

In 2016, the Profs were 6-4 overall and 5-4 in the NJAC with seven players earning All-Conference honors, including first teamers Ryan Brenner and Bobby Barbieri.

In 2015, Rowan finished with a 6-4 record (5-4 NJAC), while 14 Profs were named to the All-Conference team, including Sam Mills Defensive Player of the Year Darren Dungee. Dungee also received ECAC South Defensive Player of the Year and D3football.com All-America honors. In 2014, the Profs posted a 7-4 record and went 6-1 in the NJAC to earn a share of the conference championship and receive an automatic bid to the NCAA Championship Tournament. Accorsi was chosen the NJAC Co-Coach of the Year and 15 players earned All-Conference honors. Linebacker Tyler Jenkins was selected to the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) All-America team while running back Withler Marcelin received D3football.com All-America honorable mention.

Rowan compiled a 9-3 overall record and a 6-1 conference mark in 2013 while taking a share of the NJAC title. The Profs received the league's automatic bid to the national tournament and defeated Endicott College, 24-0, in the first round. In 2012, Accorsi guided the Profs to a 7-3 season, and second place in the NJAC with a 6-1 mark. That earned Rowan an at-large bid into the NCAA Championships.

In 2010, the Profs were 9-1 overall and 8-1 in the conference to earn a share of the NJAC title with Montclair State and SUNY Cortland. Rowan posted a 7-3 record in 2009 and an 8-2 mark in 2008. In 2006, the Profs went 9-3 and won their third consecutive NJAC Championship, and fifth in six years. Accorsi's squad also advanced to the quarterfinals of the national tournament.

The 2005 season was a stellar one for Rowan and Accorsi. The Profs went 11-2, won the NJAC Championship and reached the semifinals of the NCAA Division III Championship Tournament for the second consecutive season. Accorsi was selected as the NJAC Coach of the Year and received the Maxwell Football Club Tri-State Coach of the Year Award. That followed a 10-3 campaign in 2004 which saw Rowan reach the semifinals of the national tournament, and after achieving a 7-3 record in 2003.

In his first year as head coach in 2002, Accorsi guided the Profs to a 10-1 record, the conference title and their 10th appearance in the NCAA Division III Championship Tournament. That effort led him being named the NJAC Coach of the Year.

Prior to coming to Rowan as a graduate assistant in 1993, Accorsi was an assistant football and baseball coach at his alma mater, Nichols College in Dudley, MA, from 1989-93.

The native of Somers, CT, graduated from Nichols in 1985 with a bachelor's degree in business administration. He earned a master's in sports science from the U.S. Sports Academy (Daphne, AL) in 1992 and a master's in business administration from Rowan in 1997.

He is a member of the AFCA, Maxwell Football Club and the New Jersey Football Coaches Association and is on the South Jersey Chapter of the National Football Foundation committee. Accorsi served as a NCAA representative during the 2007 NCAA Division III Championship Tournament. He is on the Adam Taliaferro Foundation Advisory Committee and previously served on the NCAA Division III East Region Advisory Committee as well as the AFCA Program and Rules & Exhibits Committees. Accorsi is a voting member of the AFCA Division III Coaches Poll and the chair of the AFCA Division III All-America Team Selection Committee.

At Rowan, Accorsi has been an advisor for Delta Phi Epsilon sorority and served on the Campus Aesthetics and Environmental Concerns Committee. He has been involved with the Peer Referral Orientation and Staff (PROS) program and has represented the athletic department at freshman and transfer orientations. He has initiated and participated in several service programs at the University, including: Coach to Cure MD, Campus Clean and Green, Adopt-A-Family Thanksgiving Basket Program through the Aids Coalition of Southern New Jersey, Get in the Game. Save A Life. Bone Marrow Registry, Gloucester County Clean Communities Program, Town of Glassboro Clean Up Day and adopting the DeFillipo family through the Friends of Jaclyn Foundation.

Accorsi continually attends various high school and youth organization clinics and is a common presenter for a wide variety of clinics and organizations. He has been the guest speaker for the Dr. Warren J. McClain Memorial Touchdown Club of Southern New Jersey and the Brooks-Irvine Memorial Football Club. In addition, Accorsi has been a speaker at the South Jersey Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame/Adam Taliaferro Foundation All-Star Banquet.

Accorsi resides in Mullica Hill, NJ, with his wife Nancy and daughters, Gabrielle and Rachel and son, Jack.
