NOTEWORTHY

KEY STORYLINES

After prevailing in its home opener Wednesday night, Radford heads back out on the road for three straight games, the season's longest stretch away from home. The Highlanders are in the midst of a stretch of four games over six days and five within eight days. Game time and opponent for Saturday's contest will be based on Friday's outcomes.

BENCH PRODUCTION

The Highlander reserves sparked RU against Catawba, combining for 36 of the team's 68 points. Taj Owens, Ed Polite, Jr. and Darius Bolstad each notched career-high point totals. Polite, Jr. and Bolstad also shared team-high honors in rebounds. Sterling Christy, who came off the bench in the first two games, got his first career start and scored 7.

SERIES HISTORY

This will be the third time the teams have played in the last four seasons and fifth time overall. Radford picked up its lone victory last year at home, leading by nine at halftime in a 76-66 win. Siena won the first three all-time meetings, including an eight-point victory on its home floor in 2013.

TEAM NOTES

SCOUTING SIENA

- Siena has not played since a daunting pair of games on the season's opening weekend, facing both of last year's national championship game participants on the road. The Saints fell to reigning champion Duke 92-74 in the opener before losing a 92-65 decision at Wisconsin two days later.
- After winning the CBI title two years ago in head coach Jimmy Patsos' first season, Siena dropped to 11-20 last year due to injuries and suspensions.
- Junior guard Marquis Wright, a three-year captain, has led the Saints thus far with team-highs of 18.5 points and 4.5 assists per game. He scored 20 in the game against Duke and is shooting 51 percent from the field, including 4 for 8 on 3-pointers.
- Junior wing Lavon Long is second on the squad with 14.5 ppg, with 15 of 29 points coming at the free throw line.
- Freshman guard Nico Clareth tallied 21 points off the bench against Wisconsin after scoring just two in the opener.
- Redshirt junior forward Brett Bisping, who was MVP of the CBI in 2014, has returned after missing all but six games of last season. He averaged six points and a team-best 5.5 rebounds in the first two games.
- He is joined in the frontcourt by junior Javion Ogunyemi, who has contributed 8.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.
- Guard Ryan Oliver (5.0 ppg and 4.5 rpg) is the lone senior starter.
- Against Duke and Wisconsin, Siena shot a combined 41 percent from the floor and 31 percent from 3-point range. The Saints were outrebounded by 15.
- Patsos was an assistant at Maryland for 13 years under Gary Williams before serving as head coach at Loyola (Md.), for nine seasons. He led that to a school-record 24 wins in 2011-12 and its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 18 years.

RADFORD ROUNDUP

- Senior guard Taj Owens enjoyed a career night in Wednesday's win over Catawba. He set personal highs for points with 12, rebounds with five and assists with three.
- Despite an off night shooting against Catawba,

Rashun Davis continues to lead the team in scoring, now at 17.7 per game.

- The point guard is also averaging 6.3 assists per contest and now ranks seventh on the program's career assist list with 327. Roy Flynn stands sixth with 336.
- Davis has already set career game-highs this season for points, assists, made field goals and made FTs.
- Cameron Jones has connected on 8 of his 17 attempts from 3-point range and is second in scoring with 13.7 points per contest.
- The win against Catawba was the ninth under head coach Mike Jones in 53 games in which Radford shot under 40 percent. The Highlanders finished the contest at 37 percent, thanks to a 13 for 28 (46 percent) effort in the second half.

STRONG START

- The freshmen frontcourt trio of Ed Polite, Jr., Christian Lutete and Darius Bolstad have taken turns making an impact early in their RU careers.
- Coming off a season-best 10-point effort against Catawba, Polite, Jr. is fourth on the team in scoring with 7.3 per game and second in rebounding at 5.3 per contest. Polite, Jr. has had at least a share of team-high honors on the boards the last two games.
- Lutete scored 11 points on 4 for 4 shooting against VCU, including three 3-pointers. He is 4 for 8 from long range on the season and is averaging 4.7 points a game.
- Bolstad had his best game as a Highlander against Catawba, totaling seven points, seven rebounds, two assists and two blocks in 16 minutes. Almost all of the production came in the second half, helping Radford pull away.

DAVIS NABS A PAIR OF HONORS

- With his career performance in the season-opening win at Georgetown, Rashun Davis collected a pair of accolades on Monday.
- Davis was selected as the Lou Henson national Player of the Week, given to the top Division I mid-major player, as well as claiming Big South Player of the Week honors.
- Davis hit the game-winning 3-pointer with 1.5 sec-

onds left in double overtime to give the Highlanders the 82-80 win, and in the process set a career high with 28 points. He surpassed his previous best of 25, which came during his sophomore season against VMI.

- The Charlotte, N.C., native shot 12 for 19 from the field in the game, both also career highs, and was 3 of 7 from 3-point range. Davis made all six of his attempt from the floor for 13 points in the opening half and finished the game with a team-high five assists, while grabbing four rebounds and collecting one steal.
- The Big South Player of the Week honor is the first of his career. He was named conference Freshman of the Week in March of 2013.

BLOCK PARTY

- Senior center Brandon Holcomb had two blocks against Catawba to move past Art Parakhouski for fourth place alone in program history. He now has 117 in his career.
- Parakhouski established his total in just two seasons as a Highlander.
- Holcomb is now eight away from equaling Eric Parker for third place.

SUCCESSFUL RETURN

- After missing last season with a shoulder injury, redshirt sophomore Justin Cousin has gotten off to a good start in his return.
- Getting the starts in all three games so far, Cousin is third on the team with 7.7 points per game. He tallied a career-best nine points Monday against VCU.

2K CLASSIC

- Friday and Saturday's games, hosted by Bryant, are a sub-regional of the 2K Classic benefiting Wounded Warrior Project.
- Radford's first two opponents, Georgetown and VCU will be a part of the championship round, which is being held Friday and Sunday at Madison Square Garden in New York.
- The mission of Wounded Warrior Project is to honor and empower wounded warriors and to raise awareness and enlist the public's aid for the needs of injured service members.

MILESTONE WATCH

- **YaYa Anderson** needs 34 points to become the third Highlander in two seasons - and 28th all-time - to hit the 1,000 plateau.
- All of Anderson's points this season have come on 3-pointers now has 191 for his career, to rank eighth in program history. He is two away from tying for seventh.

BUSY BEGINNING

- Radford is in the middle of a hectic schedule to begin the season with six games in a span of 11 days.
- Five of the games will be played outside of the Dedmon Center, with the Highlanders visiting three states other than Virginia, along with the District of Columbia.
- The three-game roadtrip that begins with these two 2K Classic games is the longest of the season. RU plays consecutive road games only once more the rest of the way.

TRENDING UP

- Head coach **Mike Jones** looks to continue the progress the Highlanders' program has made during his tenure.
- Following the six-win campaign in his debut year, Jones has guided Radford to 57 victories over the last three seasons and a tie for third place in the Big South Conference in 2014-15.
- The 57 wins are tied for the second-most in program history over a three-year span.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

- The Highlanders are having to replace the program's most accomplished players in **Javonte Green** and

R.J. Price. Green is the program's all-time leading rebounder and second-leading scorer, along with ranking first in steals. Price ranks fifth on the career scoring list and second in made 3-point shots.

A MIX OF EXPERIENCE & YOUTH

- With seven seniors and five true freshmen among their 14 players, the 2015-16 Highlanders are a dynamic blend of experience and youth. RU has six players who have been with the program for at least four years and seven who are in their first or second seasons.
- Two of the five newcomers - guard **Caleb Tanner** and forward **Christian Lutete** - played post-graduate seasons last year after finishing high school in 2014. They are joined by guard **Devin Cooper**, forward **Ed Polite, Jr.** and center **Darius Bolstad**.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- In his first season as a Highlander, **Cameron Jones** was fourth on the team in scoring, averaging 8.5 points per game off the bench. He led RU in 3-point shooting, hitting over 43 percent from behind the arc, and was the team's top scorer in six games.

RU VOTED FOURTH IN BIG SOUTH

- Radford was picked fourth in the Big South Conference's preseason poll comprised of votes from head coaches and media members.
- High Point was tabbed as the favorite, followed by Coastal Carolina and Winthrop.
- The Highlanders tied for third place during last year's regular season with a 12-6 conference mark.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2015-16 roster features 14 players representing four different states.
- Virginia is home to half (7) of the members of this year's squad. The remaining half is comprised of three from both North Carolina and Maryland and one from California - Brandon Holcomb.

RADFORD SPORTS NETWORK

- Each RU men's basketball game can be heard live in the New River Valley on the RU Sports Radio Network on the campus flagship, WRVU 89.9-FM and on the commercial affiliate, Supersports 101.7-FM.
- Rick Watson handles the play-by-play for the Highlanders.
- The live stream can also be heard world-wide on www.radfordathletics.com.

PLENTY OF AIR TIME

- A total of seven Highlanders' games this season are scheduled for national or regional TV broadcasts.
- RU's game at Penn State on Nov. 24 will be on the Big Ten Network and the Big South opener vs. Liberty on Dec. 3 is scheduled for CSN-MA.
- American Sports Network will show the home matchups against Coastal Carolina (Feb. 6) and Winthrop (Feb. 13). The Highlanders' visit to Rock Hill, S.C. to face the Eagles on Jan. 30 has been slated for ESPN3.

UP NEXT

- After the two games this weekend, Radford concludes its road trip Tuesday night at Penn State in the Highlanders' final game before Thanksgiving.

On June 14, 2011, Radford University officials announced the hiring of former VCU assistant coach Mike Jones as the Highlanders' seventh head men's basketball coach.

After taking over a program with just one win in the season prior to him arriving on campus, Jones has Radford competing again as a championship contender in the Big South Conference. The Highlanders have won 22 games and have advanced to the CBI postseason tournament in each of the past two seasons (a first in program history).

Radford's recent success can be attributed to the foundation laid in year one with Big South all-freshman selections Javonte Green and R.J. Price. Green, who was Jones' first All-Big South performer, and Price spearheaded the Highlanders' resurgence to the top of the league.

Under Jones' tutelage, Green developed into one of the all-time greats in Radford men's basketball history. The Petersburg, Va., native finished his career second in scoring, first in rebounding, first in steals, second in free throws made, second in field goals made and first in games played. Price left RU ranked fourth all-time in scoring.

Jones spent the 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons at VCU, which included a magical run to the 2011 Final Four with wins over USC, Georgetown, Purdue, Florida State and Kansas. While on Shaka Smart's staff, the Rams posted 55 wins over the final two seasons Jones was on the staff, the highest total over any two-year span in program history. Prior to his second coaching stop in Virginia at VCU, Jones served a six-year stint on Dennis Felton's bench at Georgia from 2003-09. In 2008, Georgia advanced to the NCAA Tournament when the

sixth-seeded Bulldogs won four games in three days to complete the most improbable SEC Championship run in conference history, which included a tornado striking the Georgia Dome and the tournament being moved to the Georgia Tech campus.

While at Georgia, Jones made a name for himself when Rivals.com selected him as one of the nation's Top-25 recruiters in 2005. Jones also previously worked under John Beilein at Richmond from 2000-02 and during the early stages of Beilein's rebuilding project at West Virginia in 2002-03.

Jones' father, Jimmy, was a star guard in the ABA from 1967-74. In 1974, Jimmy Jones signed with the Washington Bullets in the NBA, where he remained until 1977.

Jones was a four-year standout at Howard, where he forged a connection with fellow Howard alumnus, Felton ('85), who he calls the biggest influence on his coaching career. Once Jones graduated in 1990, he began his coaching career as a high school coach at Sidwell Friends School in Washington, D.C. before moving to the collegiate ranks at his alma mater in 1994.

RADFORD, Va. - The Radford men's basketball team used a strong last 12 minutes to pull away for a 68-60 victory over Catawba Wednesday night at the Dedmon Center, extending its streak of home-opening wins to 13 straight.

- The Highlanders outscored their pesky visitors 30-19 over the final 11:31 to claim their 32nd consecutive win over a non-Division I opponent.
- Trailing 41-38, Radford put together an 11-2 run to take control as YaYa Anderson and Cameron Jones hit 3-pointers, Jones followed with a fast-break dunk and another trey by Taj Owens made it 49-41.
- Catawba got as close as 53-50 with 4:48 to play, but the Highlanders scored the next seven points on a dunk by Darius Bolstad, a three-point play by Owens and a fast-break layup by Rashun Davis following a steal. That gave RU its biggest lead of the game at 60-50.

INSIDE THE BOX SCORE

- Owens, Ed Polite, Jr. and Bolstad each posted career-highs in scoring and were part of a huge effort by the Highlander bench. The trio combined to shoot 11 of 18 from the field for 29 points.
- Owens scored 10 of his 12 points in the second half, surpassing his previous high of 11 against Howard last season. He was 4 for 8 from the field in the game and also grabbed five rebounds.
- Polite, Jr. finished with 10 points and also set a career-high with seven rebounds, tying for team-high honors.
- Bolstad also had his best game as a Highlander, totaling seven points, seven rebounds, two assists and two blocks. All of that production except for two of the points and one of the rebounds came during his 14 minutes of action in the second half.
- In all, Radford got 36 points in the game from its non-starters, compared to just 14 for Catawba.
- A total of seven Highlanders scored at least seven points as Jones finished with nine, Justin Cousin had eight and Davis and Sterling Christy each chipped in a career-high seven in his first RU start.
- After struggling from the field in the first half, Radford hit on 46 percent (13 for 28) of its attempts from the field in the second half to finish at 38 percent for the game.
- Brandon Holcomb recorded two blocks to move into fourth place alone on the program's all-time list, now has 117.
- Freshman Christian Lutete hit his first shot of the game off the bench, giving him five made attempts in a row going back to the VCU game, with four of them 3-pointers.
- Catawba outscored Radford 38-26 in the paint and 25-17 on second-chance points to stay with the Highlanders for most of the way. Malik Constantine scored a game-high 18 points for the Indians.
