KEY STORYLINES

Radford returns to action after a well-deserved six-day break.
The Highlanders play just their second home game of the

season, beginning a stretch of three contests inside the Dedmon Center over the next 10 days.

Coming off two straight wins, RU looks to continue its momentum heading into Thursday's Big South opener against Liberty.

POWERLESS

Last Tuesday's victory over Penn State was Radford's fourth over a power conference team during the last three seasons.

RU is 4-1 in its last five outings against those teams over a span of 42 total contests.

The Highlanders own wins over the ACC (Virginia Tech), Big 10 (Penn State), Big East (Georgetown) and Pac 12 (Oregon State).

SERIES HISTORY

James Madison leads the all-time series 10-2 and has won six consecutive meetings.

Radford is 1-4 on its homecourt against JMU.

The Highlanders' last win came was a 69-67 decision at home in 1999.

James Madison won last 74-71 on a 3-pointer with 3.5 seconds left.



Freshman Darius Bolstad has missed just one shot from the field in 13 attempts this season, for a .923 shooting percentage.



Senior guard YaYa Anderson is 9 points away from hitting 1,000 for his career. He would become the 28th Highlander to reach the mark.

TEAM NOTES

SCOUTING JAMES MADISON

- Like Radford, James Madison is coming off consecutive victories for the first time of the season, with the most recent an 89-75 win at Marshall on Friday.
- The Dukes opened the campaign with a 12-point win at Richmond before falling to West Virginia. They then split four straight home games before the game at Marshall.
- The Dukes return all five starters from last year's team that went 19-14 and earned a share of the CAA regular-season title. They were picked second to Hofstra in this year's preseason poll.
- Ron Curry, a second-team All-CAA pick last season and first-team preseason pick this year, leads the way, averaging 13.6 points per game. He also has a team-best 27 assists (3.9 per game).
- Junior college transfer Shakir Brown had made an immediate impact, ranking second with 13.3 points per game, including 20, 21 and 25 against Richmond, West Virginia and Marshall, repectively. He also leads the team in rebounding at 7.4 per contest.
- 6-foot-10 forward Dimitrije Cabarkapa has come off the bench to average 12.4 points per contest.
 He scored 27 two games ago against Eastern Mennonite.
- Yohanny Dalembert, an All-CAA third team and all-defensive team member last year is at 12.2 points and 6.6 rebounds this season.
- As a team, James Madison is averaging 79.7 points per game, while giving up 74.7 per contest. The Dukesare shooting 48 percent from the field, including 40 percent on 3-pointers. They have outrebounded their opponents by 3.7 per contest.

RADFORD ROUNDUP

- Despite a well-earned five-day break for the holiday, Radford looks to carry over the momentum from last Tuesday's win over Penn State, the program's first-ever over a Big 10 team.
- The Highlanders will be playing just their second home game of the season after opening the campaign with five out of six away from the Dedmon Center.
- Rashun Davis ranks first in the Big South with 6.5 assists, while leading RU in scoring at 15.2 points

- per game (seventh in the conference).
- Cameron Jones is coming off a 23-point performance in the win over Penn State, which included a career-best five 3-pointers. Jones upped his scoring average for the year to 12.7 and his shooting 42 precent from long range.
- Freshman Ed Polite, Jr. has scored in double figures in fourth consecutive games and ranks third on team with 9.7 per contest.
- With its season-best 56 percent shooting night against Penn State, RU is now at 44 percent for the season. The Highlanders are averaging 7.3 made 3-pointers per game.
- The 12 made 3-pointers against Penn State were the most for the Highlanders since hitting 13 against Liberty on Jan. 24.

MILESTONE WATCH

- With his season-high 14 point outing in the win over Penn State, YaYa Anderson is now on the verge of reaching the 1,000-point mark for his career.
- The senior now has 991 points and is just nine away from becoming the third Highlander in three seasons
 and 28th all-time - to hit the scoring milestone.
- Anderson also hit four 3-pointers in the Penn State game to move into seventh place alone in program history with 197. He is now three away from tying Leslie Ballard for sixth.

HELPING HAND

- Rashun Davis dished out nine assists against Penn State, giving him 39 on the season and 347 for his career
- He now ranks sixth in program history and is just 22 away from equaling former teammate R.J. Price for fifth on the list.

NOT POLITE TO THE OPPOSITION

- Ed Polite, Jr. is on a streak of four consecutive games of scoring in double figures while also being a rebounding force, particularly on the offensive end.
- The freshman of Lanham, Md. has alternated 10-point performances with career-high 13-point outings over the last four contests. He now stands third on the team at 9.7 per game.

 Polite also shares the team-lead with 5.5 rebounds per game. The 6-foot-5 forward has grabbed a total of 33 boards on the season, with 20 of them coming on the offensive end, tied for most in the conference.

ALMOST PERFECT

- Freshman Darius Bolstad is making the most of his scoring opportunities so far in his Highlander career.
- Bolstad has made 12 of his 13 field-goal attempts for a remarkable .923 shooting percentage.
- He has made his last 10 shots since his only miss of the season early in the second half against Catawba.
- For the season, Bolstad is averaging 5.3 points and 4.0 rebounds per game.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- Radford's reserves continue to make a huge impact in games as they posted their fifth straight performance of over 30 points in Tuesday's victory over Penn State.
- The Highlanders have gotten 174 points off the bench in those five contests for an average of just under 35 per game.

BLOCK PARTY

- Senior center Brandon Holcomb recorded a season-high three blocks in last Tuesday's win at Penn State and now has 122 in his career.
- With two more, Holcomb will equal Eric Parker for third in Radford program history.

DAVIS NABS A PAIR OF HONORS

- With his career performance in the season-opening win at Georgetown, Rashun Davis collected a pair of accolades for the first week of the season.
- Davis was selected as the Lou Henson national Player of the Week, given to the top Division I mid-major player, as well as claiming Big South Player of the Week honors.
- Davis hit the game-winning 3-pointer with 1.5 seconds left in double overtime to give the Highlanders the 82-80 win, and in the process set a career high with 28 points.
- The Big South Player of the Week honor is the first of his career. He was named conference Freshman of the Week in March of 2013.

SUCCESSFUL RETURN

- After missing last season with a shoulder injury, redshirt sophomore Justin Cousin has gotten off to a good start in his return.
- Getting the starts in all six games so far, Cousin is fourth on the team with 5.2 points per game. He had a career-best nine against VCU.

BUSY BEGINNING

- Radford finally wrapped up its hectic early season schedule as it played six games in a span of 11 days.
- Five of the games were played outside of the Dedmon Center, with the Highlanders visiting three states other than Virginia, along with the District of Columbia.
- The three-game roadtrip that concluded with the victory at Penn State was Radford's longest of the season. RU plays consecutive road games only once more the rest of the way when they pay visits to Longwood and Winthrop in late January.

TRENDING UP

- Head coach Mike Jones looks to continue the progress the Highlanders' program has made during his tenure.
- Following the six-win campaign in his debut year, Jones has guided Radford to 57 victories over the last three seasons and a tie for third place in the Big South Conference in 2014-15.
- The 57 wins are tied for the second-most in program history over a three-year span.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

The Highlanders are having to replace the program's

most accomplished players in **Javonte Green** and **R.J. Price**. Green is the program's all-time leading rebounder and second-leading scorer, along with ranking first in steals. Price ranks fifth on the career scoring list and second in made 3-point shots.

A MIX OF EXPERIENCE & YOUTH

- With seven seniors and five true freshmen among their 14 players, the 2015-16 Highlanders are a dynamic blend of experience and youth. RU has six players who have been with the program for at least four years and seven who are in their first or second seasons.
- Two of the five newcomers guard Caleb Tanner and forward Christian Lutete - played post-graduate seasons last year after finishing high school in 2014. They are joined by guard Devin Cooper, forward Ed Polite, Jr. and center Darius Bolstad.

RU VOTED FOURTH IN BIG SOUTH

- Radford was picked fourth in the Big South Conference's preseason poll comprised of votes from head coaches and media members.
- High Point was tabbed as the favorite, followed by Coastal Carolina and Winthrop.
- The Highlanders tied for third place during last year's regular season with a 12-6 conference mark.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2015-16 roster features 14 players representing four different states.
- Virginia is home to half (7) of the members of this year's squad. The remaining half is comprised of three from both North Carolina and Maryland and one from California - Brandon Holcomb.

RADFORD SPORTS NETWORK

- Each RU men's basketball game can be heard live in the New River Valley on the RU Sports Radio Network on the campus flagship, WRVU 89.9-FM and on the commericial affiliate, Supersports 101.7-FM.
- Rick Watson handles the play-by-play for the Highlanders.
- The live stream can also be heard world-wide on www.radfordathletics.com.

PLENTY OF AIR TIME

- A total of seven Highlanders' games this season are scheduled for national or regional TV broadcasts.
- RU's game at Penn State aired on the Big Ten Network and the Big South opener vs. Liberty on Dec. 3 is scheduled for CSN-MA.
- American Sports Network will show the home matchups against Coastal Carolina (Feb. 6) and Winthrop (Feb. 13). The Highlanders' visit to Rock Hill, S.C. to face the Eagles on Jan. 30 has been slated for ESPN3.

UP NEXT

- Radford's next two games against Big South opponents beginning with Thursday night's conference opener agains Liberty.
- Tipoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. inside the Dedmon Center.
- The Highlanders will then travel to defending Big South Tournament champion Coastal Carolina on Sunday before returning to the New River Valley to host Virginia Tech on Wednesday, Dec. 9.

On June 14, 2011, Radford University officials announced the hiring of former VCU assistant coach Mike Jones as the Highlanders' seventh head men's basketball coach.

After taking over a program with just one win in the season prior to him arriving on campus, Jones has Radford competing again as a championship contender in the Big South Conference. The Highlanders have won 22 games and have advanced to the CBI postseason tournament in each of the past two seasons (a first in program history).

Radford's recent success can be attributed to the foundation laid in year one with Big South all-freshman selections Javonte Green and R.J. Price. Green, who was Jones' first All-Big South performer, and Price spearheaded the Highlanders' resurgence to the top of the league.

Under Jones' tutelage, Green developed into one of the all-time greats in Radford men's basketball history. The Petersburg, Va., native finished his career second in scoring, first in rebounding, first in steals, second in free throws made, second in field goals made and first in games played. Price left RU ranked fourth all-time in scoring

Jones spent the 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons at VCU, which included a magical run to the 2011 Final Four with wins over USC, Georgetown, Purdue, Florida State and Kansas. While on Shaka Smart's staff, the Rams posted 55 wins over the final two seasons Jones was on the staff, the highest total over any two-year span in program history. Prior to his second coaching stop in Virginia at VCU, Jones served a six-year stint on Dennis Felton's bench at Georgia from 2003-09. In 2008, Georgia advanced to the NCAA Tournament when the

sixth-seeded Bulldogs won four games in three days to complete the most improbable SEC Championship run in conference history, which included a tornado striking the Georgia Dome and the tournament being moved to the Georgia Tech campus.

While at Georgia, Jones made a name for himself when Rivals.com selected him as one of the nation's Top-25 recruiters in 2005. Jones also previously worked under John Beilein at Richmond from 2000-02 and during the early stages of Beilein's rebuilding project at West Virginia in 2002-03.

Jones' father, Jimmy, was a star guard in the ABA from 1967-74. In 1974, Jimmy Jones signed with the Washington Bullets in the NBA, where he remained until 1977.

Jones was a four-year standout at Howard, where he forged a connection with fellow Howard alumnus, Felton ('85), who he calls the biggest influence on his coaching career. Once Jones graduated in 1990, he began his coaching career as a high school coach at Sidwell Friends School in Washington, D.C. before moving to the collegiate ranks at his alma mater in 1994.

UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa. - The Radford men's basketball team shot a season-high 56 percent, including 62 percent in the second half, to claim an 86-74 victory over host Penn State Tuesday night at the Bryce Jordan Center.

- It was the program's first-ever win over a Big Ten opponent and the Highlanders' second road victory over a power conference team this season.
- Radford hit a season-high 12 3-pointers on 22 attempts (55 percent) in the game, making five of seven in the second 20 minutes as they pulled away over the final 12 minutes.
- RU used a 14-3 run over a three and a half minute period to build a 70-59 cushion with 8:08 to play.
- Penn State made a run to get within six with 3:36 left, but Rashun Davis hit the team's final trey with a hand in his face, quieting the crowd and the Highlanders coasted from there.

INSIDE THE BOX SCORE

- Cameron Jones led five RU players in double figures with a game-high 23 points, one shy of his career-high. He did set a new personal best with five 3-pointers on seven attempts. He was 8 for 11 from the field overall.
- Davis finished with 18 points on 7 of 10 shooting, while dishing out nine assists.
- YaYa Anderson posted a season-best 14 points, hitting 4 of 6 from beyond the arc. The four 3-pointers give him 197 for his career, ranking sixth on the program's alltime list
- Brandon Holcomb recorded his second career double-double, totaling 10 points and a team-best 11 rebounds, along with a season-best three blocks.
- Ed Polite, Jr. chipped in 13 points for his fourth straight double-digit scoring performance.
- Radford's final shooting percentage was made more impressive by the fact it started the game 1 for 8 from the field.
- However, the Highlanders made 12 of their last 18 shots of the opening half, including a stretch of four out of six 3-pointers to build a 22-11 lead.
- RU scored the final five points of the half on Jones' fourth 3-pointer and a jumper by Davis to lead 37-34.
- The Nittany Lions started the second half with a 9-3 run, but Radford answered, getting baskets by Kion Brown, Jones, Davis and Polite and a 3-pointer by Anderson to lead 51-50 before going on the game-clinching run.
- After Jones made a 3-pointer on RU's second shot of the game, the Highlanders missed their next six attempts before Davis converted a layup and Anderson hit his first two 3-pointers to get the team going.
- While the starters had their best performance since the season opener, RU's bench continued to contribute, scoring over 30 points for the fifth straight game – 33 in this one.
- Penn State shot 46 percent in the game and outscored RU 42-34 in the paint. However, the Nittany Lions made just 6 of 22 3-pointers and the Highlanders had a 15-2 edge in fast-break points.
