HISTORY LESSON

The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

TEAM NOTES

SETTING THE STAGE

- Radford looks to snap its seven-game road skid.
 The Highlanders have not won a true road matchup since Feb. 14, 2015 in a 64-57 win at Charleston Southern
- Series: Radford leads, 2-0.
- Last meeting: Radford 60, Wofford 59 (12/15/14)
- Ayana Avery sealed the Highlanders' comeback win with a clutch 3-pointer with 1:06 remaining in the second half
- This is Radford's first trip to Benjamin Johnson Arena. The first meeting between the two teams came on Dec. 10, 2011 as part of the SoCon/Big South Challenge in Asheville, N.C.

SCOUTING WOFFORD

- Record: 3-7
- Wofford is on a two game winning streak after defeating Bluefield (69-58) on Dec. 13 and NC Central (60-37) on Dec. 15.
- All three Terrier wins have come on their home court.
- Wofford ranks fifth in the SoCon in scoring offense (58.1 ppg), but ranks seventh in scoring defense (66.3 ppg).
- Kentra Washington leads the Terriers in scoring, averaging 10.7 ppg, ranking ninth in the SoCon.
- Behind Washington, Wofford sports four players averaging eight or more points per game.
- Ashton Fleming is Wofford's top rebounder, averaging 7.2 boards, ranking fifth in the SoCon.
- Opponents have outrebounded Wofford 437-368 this season.
- Chloe Wanink leads the conference in field-goal percentage at 50 percent. Wanink is 32 for 64 on the season.
- Wofford is one of the best free-throw shooting teams in the SoCon, making 120 of 164 attempts, good enough for second.
- The Terriers' success at the charity stripe can be attributed to Jordan Frazier. Frazier ranks second in the conference with an 85.2 free-throw percentage.
- Wofford is 0-3 versus Big South teams this season, dropping contests to UNC Asheville (70-63), Gardner-Webb (64-61) and Charleston Southern (74-64).

 After taking on Radford, the Terriers will travel to Coastal Carolina on Dec. 21 to face their fifth Big South team on the season.

RADFORD ROUNDUP

- Record: 4-4
- Radford is fresh off its 12th consecutive home victory with a 92-36 decision over Concord on Dec. 12.
- In the win, all eight Highlanders who played scored, including four in double figures.
- Leading the way for RU was an 18-point effort on 6 of 9 shooting from Jayda Worthy.
- Worthy continues to lead the conference in field-goal percentage at 52.2 percent. Worthy is 35 for 67 from the floor.
- Jen Falconer filled out the stat sheet in the win with 15 points, eight assists, five rebounds and two steals.
- Falconer is tied for the Big South lead in assists with 34 and ranks second in assists per game with 4.3.
 She also leads the conference in assist to turnover ratio at 2.4.
- Aisha Foy leads the Highlanders in scoring average, ranking ninth in the Big South with 12.6 ppg. Foy has totaled 101 points in eight contests.
- After grabbing a season-high 16 rebounds, Lydia Rivers now ranks ninth in the Big South in rebounds per game with 7.6.
- Gaby Gilmore is Radford's top perimeter defender ranking fourth in the Big South in steals (20) and steals per game (2.5).
- As a team, Radford possesses one of the best defenses in the Big South, holding opponents to 57.6 ppg.
- Adding to their strong defense, the Highlanders lead the Big South in rebounding, averaging 42.1 per game.

ADIÓS AYANA

- Radford will struggle to fill the void left by 2015 graduate Ayana Avery, who ranks 10th all-time in RU career scoring (1,198).
- Avery set the single-season (95) and career (261) records for 3-pointers made at Radford.
- Her 261 made 3-pointers rank fourth all-time in Big

South history.

- She is the 21st member of the 1,000-point club in Radford women's basketball history.
- The Highlanders led the Big South in 3-point field goal percentage (.337) last season.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2015-16 roster features 13 players representing nine states and two countries.
- There are three players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by Claudia Quevedo.
- Radford has two seniors, one redshirt junior, five sophomores and five freshmen.
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

WHAT A TURNAROUND

- Radford tied for the sixth-best win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season.
- After the Highlanders only won seven games in 2013-14, RU exploded for 17 in 2014-15 (a 10-win improvement).
- Radford's 10-win improvement only trailed Ohio (18),
 East Tennessee State (12), Southern Illinois (12),
 Kennesaw State (11) and UC Riverside (11).

CRUNCH TIME

- RU has played in nine games over the last two seasons that were decided by three points or less.
- The Highlanders have posted a 7-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach Mike McGuire, Radford is 10-6 in games decided by five points or less.

ALLEN, QUEVEDO OUT FOR 15-16

- Sophomores Brittany Allen and Claudia Quevedo suffered season-ending injuries during Radford's preseason scrimmage against Furman.
- Both guards tore their ACL and will seek a medical redshirt for the 2015-16 season.
- Allen and Quevedo played in 29 and 30 games, respectively, as freshmen.
- Allen scored a season-high eight points at Liberty, while Quevedo dialed up a season-high 19 points in a 67-65 come-from-behind win at UNC Asheville last season.

FOURTH QUARTER FURY

 Radford has outscored its opponents, 149-115, in the fourth quarter this season.

BLOCK PARTY

- Radford racked up a season-high 10 blocks against Youngstown State, which were the most by the Highlanders since they tallied 11 on Jan. 24, 2015 vs. High Point.
- YSU had not been blocked that many times since West Virginia swatted 12 on Nov. 11, 2011.
- The last time YSU was blocked at least 10 times at home was against Detroit on Jan. 13, 2007.
- RU ranks second in the Big South in blocks (4.6 bpg).

MAKE THAT A DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Jayda Worthy made a splash in her trip home to Ohio, dropping in her first double-double of the season (10 points, 10 rebounds) against YSU.
- The sophomore from Toledo, Ohio, notched a double-double in three straight games, bringing her

career total to five.

DEFENDING DEDMON

- Radford is currently on an 11-game winning streak inside the Dedmon Center.
- RU won its final eight games at home last season.
- The Highlanders' last loss at home was to West Virginia State, 58-52, on Dec. 18, 2014.

DISHING OUT DIMES

- Radford leads the Big South in assists per game (14.8).
- The Highlanders have recorded at least 15 assists in four games this season, twice topping the 20-assist mark.
- Jen Falconer ranks second among Big South
 players in assists per game (4.3). Her eight assists
 against Concord are tied for the most recorded by a
 Big South player in a single game this season.

QUEENS OF THE REBOUND

- With the depth and athleticism of Radford's post players, the Highlanders lead the Big South in rebounding margin (+9.0). That average ranks 37th in the nation.
- RU holds its opponents to a league-low 33.1 rebounds per game.
- Through the Highlanders' first eight games, they have only been outrebounded once (at NC State).

OH OVERTIME

- The season opener against George Mason was Radford's third overtime game under head coach Mike McGuire.
- The Highlanders are 2-1 in those games.

- In addition to the Radford women, the men's team also went into extra time on opening weekend, defeating Georgetown (82-80) in double overtime.
- It marked the first time in Radford's history both basketball programs went into overtime in their respective season openers.
- It was just the third time the Highlanders opened their season with an overtime game.

UP NEXT

- Radford remains on the road, traveling to Virginia
 Tech for a Dec. 21 matchup.

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade.

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best turnaround in the nation.

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant

For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Christiansburg with their daughter, Harper.
