HISTORY LESSON

Radford is in its 45th season as a varsity women's basketball program. RU has compiled a 666-531 record during that span.

Third-year head coach **Mike McGuire** is the program's seventh all-time head coach.

The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

Radford is down to nine available players after starting the season with 13.

Brittany Allen and **Claudia Quevedo** are out for the season with ACL tears.

Destinee Walker is on the mend after suffering a knee injury during the preseason.

Alexis Jackson is out indefinitely with a hand injury.

TEAM NOTES

SETTING THE STAGE

- Radford prepares to play Xavier for the first time in women's basketball Wednesday at 7 p.m. from the Cintas Center in Cincinnati, Ohio.
- Series: First meeting
- The Highlanders are looking to snap a six-game skid on the road. Their last win away from the Dedmon Center was at Charleston Southern on Feb. 14, 2015.
- RU is playing its fifth game in program history against a current BIG EAST member. Radford is 1-3 in those games.

SCOUTING XAVIER

- Record: 5-2
- The Musketeers had their four-game winning streak snapped on Dec. 6 in a 62-53 non-conference loss to Middle Tennessee State.
- Xavier is 5-1 inside the Cintas Center on the season, outscoring opponents 374-304.
- Ranking ninth in scoring offense in the BIG EAST with 61.1 ppg, the Musketeers make up on the defensive end, holding opponents to 56.6 ppg.
- A dominant rebounding team, Xavier has outrebounded opponents, 300-252. They are averaging 42.9 rpg, which rank second in the BIG EAST.
- Raeshawn Gaffney's 11.3 ppg lead the Musketeers. Following Gaffney, Briana Glover (9.9 ppg) and Aliyah Zantt (9.4 ppg) round out Xavier's top scorers.
- In the rebounding category, Leah Schaefer is tied for 11th in the BIG EAST with 6.0 rpg.
- Marquia Turner ranks third in the BIG EAST with a 2.7 assist-to-turnover ratio. Turner leads Xavier with 24 assists and only nine turnovers.
- Xavier's Tierra Floyd and Radford's Jayda Worthy were high school teammates at Notre Dame Academy in Toledo, Ohio. The duo led Notre Dame to three consecutive OHSAA Division I Final Four appearances from 2012-14.
- In their last four non-conference matchups with opponents from Virginia, the Musketeers are 2-2. Their last loss came in a 67-64 loss to Big South member Longwood on Nov. 21, 2013.

- Record: 3-3
- Radford is coming off a 71-66 loss at High Point on Dec. 5 in its Big South opener.
- Aisha Foy dialed up a season-high 20 points on 5 of 6 shooting from 3-point land to lead the Highlanders in the setback.
- In road games, Foy is averaging 14.0 ppg, while making 7 of 12 from 3-point land.
- Janayla White dominated the boards en route to 12 rebounds last time out, eight of which were on the offensive end, to go along with her 12 points. The double-double was the fifth of her career.
- Foy stands in 10th place among the Big South's scoring leaders at 12.8 ppg. She has reached double figures in four of RU's six contests on the season.
- Following Foy in the scoring column is White, who ranks 12th among Big South players with 12.0 ppg.
- Jayda Worthy remains the conference leader in field-goal percentage (.556) and ranks third in rebounding (8.8 rpg).
- In the loss to HPU, Lydia Rivers narrowly missed the first double-double of her freshman campaign, finishing with season highs in points (nine) and rebounds (10).
- Heading into their fourth road contest of the season, the Highlanders are averaging 57.0 ppg away from the Dedmon Center. Free throws have plagued Radford in those three games, only managing 54.2 percent from the charity stripe.

ADIÓS AYANA

- Radford will struggle to fill the void left by 2015 graduate Ayana Avery, who ranks 10th all-time in RU career scoring (1,198).
- Avery set the single-season (95) and career (261) records for 3-pointers made at Radford.
- Her 261 made 3-pointers rank fourth all-time in Big South history.
- She is the 21st member of the 1,000-point club in Radford women's basketball history.
- The Highlanders led the Big South in 3-point field goal percentage (.337) last season.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2015-16 roster features 13 players represent-

ing nine states and two countries.

- There are three players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by Claudia Quevedo.
- Radford has two seniors, one redshirt junior, five sophomores and five freshmen.
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

WHAT A TURNAROUND

- Radford tied for the sixth-best win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season.
- After the Highlanders only won seven games in 2013-14, RU exploded for 17 in 2014-15 (a 10-win improvement).
- Radford's 10-win improvement only trailed Ohio (18), East Tennessee State (12), Southern Illinois (12), Kennesaw State (11) and UC Riverside (11).

CRUNCH TIME

- RU has played in nine games over the last two seasons that were decided by three points or less.
- The Highlanders have posted a 7-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach Mike McGuire, Radford is 10-6 in games decided by five points or less.

ALLEN, QUEVEDO OUT FOR 15-16

- Sophomores Brittany Allen and Claudia Quevedo suffered season-ending injuries during Radford's preseason scrimmage against Furman.
- Both guards tore their ACL and will seek a medical redshirt for the 2015-16 season.
- Allen and Quevedo played in 29 and 30 games, respectively, as freshmen.
- Allen scored a season-high eight points at Liberty, while Quevedo dialed up a season-high 19 points in a 67-65 come-from-behind win at UNC Asheville last season.

FOURTH QUARTER FURY

- Radford has outscored its opponents, 116-88, in the fourth quarter this season.

RADFORD ROUNDUP

BLOCK PARTY

- Radford racked up a season-high 10 blocks against Youngstown State, which were the most by the Highlanders since they tallied 11 on Jan. 24, 2015 vs. High Point.
- YSU had not been blocked that many times since West Virginia swatted 12 on Nov. 11, 2011.
- The last time YSU was blocked at least 10 times at home was against Detroit on Jan. 13, 2007.
- RU ranks second in the Big South in blocks (5.0 bpg).

MAKE THAT A DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Jayda Worthy** made a splash in her trip home to Ohio, dropping in her first double-double of the season (10 points, 10 rebounds) against YSU.
- The sophomore from Toledo, Ohio, has notched a double-double in three straight games, bringing her career total to five.

DEFENDING DEDMON

- Radford is currently on an 11-game winning streak inside the Dedmon Center.
- RU won its final eight games at home last season.
- The Highlanders' last loss at home was to West Virginia State, 58-52, on Dec. 18, 2014.

BIG EAST BASH

- RU is meeting Xavier for the first time in program history.
- Wednesday's game is just the fifth time Radford faces a current member of the BIG EAST.
- The Highlanders have a 1-3 record against BIG EAST competition, with the lone win coming against DePaul (91-83) in the 1989 WNIT in Amarillo, Texas.

LAST TIME OUT

- Senior guard **Aisha Foy** dialed up a season-high 20 points, but Radford could not overcome an 8 for 18 performance from the free-throw line as the Highlanders dropped their Big South opener, 71-66, at High Point Saturday afternoon.
- Tied at 53 with 6:14 remaining in the fourth quarter, High Point scored six straight points over the next three minutes to take a 59-53 lead.
- RU held its largest lead of the contest in the third quarter at 43-36 on back-to-back baskets by **Jen Falconer** and **Janayla White**.
- The Highlanders came out of the break fired up as an offensive rebound and putback by White gave RU the lead at 35-34.
- Radford closed out the first half on consecutive 3-pointers by **Gaby Gilmore** and Foy to close its deficit to 34-31 at the break.
- High Point came out on fire in the second quarter as the Highlanders struggled to get their offense going. Haleigh Hatfield gave the Panthers a 32-23 lead at the 2:44 mark, highlighting a 14-5 run.
- Foy led two Highlanders in double figures, offensively, behind a 5 of 6 performance from 3-point range. The five 3-pointers are a career high for Foy.
- White picked up her fifth career double-double with a 12-point, 12-rebound effort. Of White's 12 rebounds, eight came on the offensive glass. White also tied a career high of four blocks.
- Lydia Rivers** narrowly missed the first double-double of her freshman campaign, finishing with season highs in points (nine) and rebounds (10).
- Radford outrebounded High Point, 46-36, including an impressive 19 on the offensive glass.
- The Highlanders went 8 for 18 from the charity

stripe, for a season-low 44.4 percent.

- On the other hand, HPU converted 16 of its 19 free-throw opportunities (84.2 percent).
- Turnovers cost the Highlanders in the end as High Point forced a season-high 19 RU turnovers.
- Radford did a commendable job on limiting Kaylah Keys, the Big South's scoring leader. She was held to 2 of 10 from the floor, including 1 of 7 from downtown. Eight of her 13 points came at the charity stripe.

OH OVERTIME

- The season opener against George Mason was Radford's third overtime game under head coach **Mike McGuire**.
- The Highlanders are 2-1 in those games.
- In addition to the Radford women, the men's team also went into extra time on opening weekend, defeating Georgetown (82-80) in double overtime.
- It marked the first time in Radford's history both basketball programs went into overtime in their respective season openers.
- It was just the third time the Highlanders opened their season with an overtime game.

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade.

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best turnaround in the nation.

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant

coach at the University of Richmond where he helped lead the Spiders to five straight postseason berths and a 101-60 overall record. For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Christiansburg with their daughter, Harper.
