TEAM NOTES

SETTING THE STAGE

- Radford will put its Big South two-game winning streak on the line Monday night when it hosts Campbell. Tipoff is scheduled for a 7 p.m. start inside the Dedmon Center.
- Series: Radford leads. 20-12
- Last meeting: Radford 67, Campbell 43 (2/21/15)
- In the last game between these two programs,
 Radford placed three players in double figures, led
 by Jordynn Gaymon's game-high 13 points.
- The RU win snapped Campbell's five-game winning streak in the head-to-head series.
- Radford is 13-4 all-time versus the Camels inside the Dedmon Center.

SCOUTING CAMPBELL

- Record: 7-7, 2-3 Big South
- Last time out, Campbell raced to an early 20-9 lead and coasted to a 73-56 win over Longwood, Saturday afternoon in Farmville, Va.
- The Camels placed four scorers in double figures.
 Amanda Coffer led Campbell with 18 points on 7 of 11 shooting. Bria Emanuel followed with 13 points and 10 rebounds. Providing a spark off the bench, Sarah Smith finished with 11 points.
- Campbell's offense is led by the duo of Coffer and RaeChaun Edwards. Coffer is averaging 11.8 ppg and Edwards averages 11.6 ppg. The duo ranks 11th and 12th, respectively, in the conference.
- One of the most accurate post players in the Big South, Coffer's 47.5 field-goal percentage paces the conference. The junior forward is 66 for 139 from the floor
- Coffer's success can be attributed to the vision of Edwards. The Camels' point guard leads the conference in assists with 65, dishing out 4.6 per contest.
- In Big South play, Edwards has 30 of Campbell's league-leading 70 assists.
- Edwards' vision shines on the defensive side of the ball as well, tallying 37 of Campbell's 111 steals on the year. The 37 steals rank second in the Big South.
- The Camels rank 11th in scoring offense, averaging 57.1 points per game.
- Campbell has only scored 60-plus points in five of its 14 games on the season.

- The Camels' two Big South wins of the season have come on the road where they are averaging 78.0 ppg.
- Since rejoining the Big South in 2011, Campbell holds a 5-3 head-to-head record versus Radford.

RADFORD ROUNDUP

- Record: 7-7, 3-2 Big South
- A decisive second quarter in which Radford outscored Winthrop, 20-7, highlighted the Highlanders' 66-44 win on Saturday.
- With its 3-2 Big South record, RU has climbed into a tie for fourth place in the league standings.
- Janayla White collected her third double-double of the season with an 18-point and 15-rebound effort against Winthrop. The 15 rebounds are a season high for White.
- Jayda Worthy and White are tied for fourth in the Big South with three double-doubles each.
- Radford outrebounded its 12th opponent of the season, controlling a 60-34 advantage on the glass.
 The 60 rebounds are a season high for RU, including a season-high 25 offensive rebounds.
- In the last seven games, Lydia Rivers has pulled down 71 of her 116 rebounds. Rivers ranks fifth in the Big South with 8.3 rpg.
- In Big South play, White and Rivers have been a force to reckon with on the glass. White leads the conference, averaging 10.2 rpg in league play. Rivers follows with 9.8 rpg for third overall.
- Radford ranks in the top three in 11 statistical categories in the Big South. RU has the top mark in seven of those categories.
- The Highlanders boast the best defense in the Big South and one of the best nationally. Opponents have only managed a 33.9 field-goal percentage, ranking 17th nationally. RU is allowing only 55.6 points per game, which rank 36th in the country.
- In four of their last five contests, the RU defense has held opponents under 50 points.
- Aisha Foy ranks second in the Big South and 17th nationally with 37.1 minutes played per contest. Foy is averaging 13.0 ppg, good enough for seventh in the conference.

ADIÓS AYANA

- Radford will struggle to fill the void left by 2015 graduate Ayana Avery, who ranks 10th all-time in RU career scoring (1,198).
- Avery set the single-season (95) and career (261) records for 3-pointers made at Radford.
- Her 261 made 3-pointers rank fourth all-time in Big South history.
- She is the 21st member of the 1,000-point club in Radford women's basketball history.
- The Highlanders led the Big South in 3-point field goal percentage (.337) last season.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2015-16 roster features 13 players representing nine states and two countries.
- There are three players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by Claudia Quevedo.
- Radford has two seniors, one redshirt junior, five sophomores and five freshmen.
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

WHAT A TURNAROUND

- Radford tied for the sixth-best win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season.
- After the Highlanders only won seven games in 2013-14, RU exploded for 17 in 2014-15 (a 10-win improvement).
- Radford's 10-win improvement only trailed Ohio (18),
 East Tennessee State (12), Southern Illinois (12),
 Kennesaw State (11) and UC Riverside (11).

CRUNCH TIME

- RU has played in nine games over the last two seasons that were decided by three points or less.
- The Highlanders have posted a 7-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach Mike McGuire, Radford is 10-6 in games decided by five points or less.

TRIO OUT FOR 15-16

- Sophomores Brittany Allen and Claudia Quevedo suffered season-ending injuries during Radford's preseason scrimmage against Furman.
- Both guards tore their ACL and will seek a medical redshirt for the 2015-16 season.
- Allen and Quevedo played in 29 and 30 games, respectively, as freshmen.
- Freshman point guard Jen Falconer tore her ACL in the Dec. 18 game at Wofford. She will miss the rest of the season and receive a medical redshirt.

BLOCK PARTY

- Radford racked up a season-high 10 blocks against Youngstown State, which were the most by the Highlanders since they tallied 11 on Jan. 24, 2015 vs. High Point.
- YSU had not been blocked that many times since West Virginia swatted 12 on Nov. 11, 2011.
- The last time YSU was blocked at least 10 times at home was against Detroit on Jan. 13, 2007.
- The Highlanders tied that 10-block mark at Presbyterian on Jan. 4.
- RU ranks first in the Big South in blocks (5.6 bpg).

MAKE THAT A DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Jayda Worthy made a splash in her trip home to Ohio, dropping in her first double-double of the season (10 points, 10 rebounds) against YSU.
- The sophomore from Toledo, Ohio, notched a double-double in three straight games, bringing her career total to five.

DEFENDING DEDMON

Radford had its 13-game winning streak inside the

- Dedmon Center snapped against Liberty on Jan. 2.
- RU won its final eight games at home last season and the first five games of the 2015-16 season.
- The Highlanders are 6-1 at home this season.

DISHING OUT DIMES

- Radford ranks second in the Big South in assists per game (13.0).
- The Highlanders have recorded at least 15 assists in six games this season, twice topping the 20-assist mark.

QUEENS OF THE REBOUND

- With the depth and athleticism of Radford's post players, the Highlanders rank first in the Big South in rebounding margin (+8.1).
- RU holds its opponents to 33.8 rebounds per game, which rank first in the conference.
- Through the Highlanders' first 14 games, they have only been outrebounded twice (at NC State, at Virginia Tech).

OH, OVERTIME?

- The season opener against George Mason was Radford's third overtime game under head coach Mike McGuire.
- The Highlanders are 2-1 in those games.
- In addition to the Radford women, the men's team also went into extra time on opening weekend, defeating Georgetown (82-80) in double overtime.
- It marked the first time in Radford's history both basketball programs went into overtime in their respective season openers.
- It was just the third time the Highlanders opened their season with an overtime game.

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade.

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best turnaround in the nation.

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant


