Radford has lost **nine** straight road games, dating back to last season. RU's last road win was on Feb. 14, 2015 at Charleston Southern.



The Highlanders have outrebounded **10** of their 12 opponents this season.

TEAM NOTES

SETTING THE STAGE

- Radford looks to collect its first road win of the season when the Highlanders travel to Presbyterian for Monday's Big South women's basketball contest.
 Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. inside the Templeton Center.
- Series: Radford leads, 14-4
- Last meeting: Radford 75, Presbyterian 68 (Feb. 7, 2015)
- Aisha Foy led the Highlanders in that game behind her game-high 23 points on 5 of 9 shooting, which included four 3-pointers. Foy went 9 for 10 from the charity stripe. Also finishing in double figures were
 Ayana Avery (13) and Janayla White (12).
- Radford went 27 for 34 from the free-throw line in the win. Cortney Storey paced Presbyterian with 18 points.
- The Highlanders are 6-2 against the Blue Hose inside the Templeton Center.

SCOUTING PRESBYTERIAN

- Record: 7-6, 3-1 Big South
- Presbyterian raced out to a 22-6 opening-quarter lead on its way to a 63-49 victory over Charleston Southern, Saturday afternoon on the road.
- In the victory, PC placed three scorers in double figures. Taylor Petty led the Blue Hose with a gamehigh 16 points. Cortney Storey followed with 15 points and Janie Miles added 10 points.
- The Blue Hose possesses one of the top defenses in the Big South, allowing only 57.2 ppg, ranking second behind Radford.
- Presbyterian averages 64.8 ppg, holding a +7.5 scoring margin over opponents.
- An early candidate for Big South Freshman of the Year, Taylor Petty averages 12.8 ppg off the bench, which lead all freshmen in the conference and rank ninth overall.
- In Big South contests, PC sports three of the league's Top-20 scorers. Petty ranks seventh (14.0 ppg), Aianna Kelly ranks 11th (12.8 ppg) and Storey ranks 19th (11.3 ppg).
- The Blue Hose relies on its 3-point shot, leading the league with 87, while averaging 6.7 per contest.
- Presbyterian takes advantage of free points, leading the league with a 73.4 free-throw percentage. The

- Blue Hose is 157 for 214 from the charity stripe.
- Storey has dished out 51 assists on the season, ranking second in the Big South with 3.9 apg.
- The Blue Hose leads the conference with a +3.23 turnover margin. Presbyterian has turned the ball over 201 times, compared to 243 opponent turnovers.
- PC is a difficult opponent to take down at the Templeton Center. The Blue Hose is 5-1 with its only loss coming against league-leading UNC Asheville.
 PC is averaging 79.0 ppg, while only allowing 56.3 ppg at home.
- Presbyterian has won five of its past six games, including its last three.

RADFORD ROUNDUP

- Record: 5-7, 1-2 Big South
- Radford had its 13-game home winning streak snapped in a 49-43 loss to Liberty on Saturday.
- In the loss, Lydia Rivers collected her first double-double with a 13-point, 12-rebound effort. Rivers' season-high 13 points came on 4 of 7 shooting, including a 5 for 6 clip from the free-throw line.
- Aisha Foy followed with 10 points and now has scored double digits in nine contests this season.
- The Highlanders' free-throw woes continue as Radford made just 14 of 26 in the loss to Liberty. Radford ranks 10th in the Big South with a 61.9 percentage (146-236).
- Radford owns the Big South's best defense, allowing only 681 points on the season and 56.0 ppg.
- Teams only manage a 34.3 shooting percentage (239-696) when facing the Highlander defense, which ranks first in the league.
- On offense, the Highlanders rank second in the Big South with a 43.2 field-goal percentage. Jayda Worthy leads the league, making 51.6 percent of her shots
- RU is a force in the paint, outscoring opponents, 414-272. on the season.
- Radford, which has only been outrebounded twice through its first 12 games, owns a +6.7 rebounding margin—ranking second in the Big South.
- Becoming a Windex machine for the Highlanders,
 Rivers cleans the glass for 8.3 rpg (fourth in the con-

- ference). In Big South play, Rivers leads the league with 10.3 rebounds per contest.
- In six games away from the Dedmon Center, Radford is averaging 56.2 ppg on the season. On the flip side, the Highlanders are allowing 63.5 ppg to opponents.

ADIÓS AYANA

- Radford will struggle to fill the void left by 2015 graduate Ayana Avery, who ranks 10th all-time in RU career scoring (1,198).
- Avery set the single-season (95) and career (261) records for 3-pointers made at Radford.
- Her 261 made 3-pointers rank fourth all-time in Big South history.
- She is the 21st member of the 1,000-point club in Radford women's basketball history.
- The Highlanders led the Big South in 3-point field goal percentage (.337) last season.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2015-16 roster features 13 players representing nine states and two countries.
- There are three players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by Claudia Quevedo.
- Radford has two seniors, one redshirt junior, five sophomores and five freshmen.
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

WHAT A TURNAROUND

- Radford tied for the sixth-best win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season.
- After the Highlanders only won seven games in 2013-14, RU exploded for 17 in 2014-15 (a 10-win improvement).
- Radford's 10-win improvement only trailed Ohio (18),
 East Tennessee State (12), Southern Illinois (12),
 Kennesaw State (11) and UC Riverside (11).

CRUNCH TIME

- RU has played in nine games over the last two seasons that were decided by three points or less.
- The Highlanders have posted a 7-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach Mike McGuire, Radford is 10-6 in games decided by five points or less.

TRIO OUT FOR 15-16

- Sophomores Brittany Allen and Claudia Quevedo suffered season-ending injuries during Radford's preseason scrimmage against Furman.
- Both guards tore their ACL and will seek a medical redshirt for the 2015-16 season.
- Allen and Quevedo played in 29 and 30 games, respectively, as freshmen.
- Freshman point guard Jen Falconer tore her ACL in the Dec. 18 game at Wofford. She will miss the rest of the season and receive a medical redshirt.

BLOCK PARTY

- Radford racked up a season-high 10 blocks against Youngstown State, which were the most by the Highlanders since they tallied 11 on Jan. 24, 2015 vs. High Point.
- YSU had not been blocked that many times since West Virginia swatted 12 on Nov. 11, 2011.
- The last time YSU was blocked at least 10 times at home was against Detroit on Jan. 13, 2007.
- RU ranks first in the Big South in blocks (5.1 bpg).

MAKE THAT A DOUBLE-DOUBLE

 Jayda Worthy made a splash in her trip home to Ohio, dropping in her first double-double of the season (10 points, 10 rebounds) against YSU. The sophomore from Toledo, Ohio, notched a double-double in three straight games, bringing her career total to five

DEFENDING DEDMON

- Radford had its 13-game winning streak inside the Dedmon Center snapped against Liberty on Jan. 2.
- RU won its final eight games at home last season and the first five games of the 2015-16 season.

DISHING OUT DIMES

- Radford ranks third in the Big South in assists per game (13.0).
- The Highlanders have recorded at least 15 assists in five games this season, twice topping the 20-assist mark.

QUEENS OF THE REBOUND

- With the depth and athleticism of Radford's post players, the Highlanders are second in the Big South in rebounding margin (+6.7).
- RU holds its opponents to 34.1 rebounds per game, which rank second in the conference.
- Through the Highlanders' first 12 games, they have only been outrebounded twice (at NC State, at Virginia Tech).

OH, OVERTIME?

- The season opener against George Mason was Radford's third overtime game under head coach Mike McGuire.
- The Highlanders are 2-1 in those games.
- In addition to the Radford women, the men's team also went into extra time on opening weekend, defeating Georgetown (82-80) in double overtime.

- It marked the first time in Radford's history both basketball programs went into overtime in their respective season openers.
- It was just the third time the Highlanders opened their season with an overtime game.

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade.

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best turnaround in the nation.

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant

For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Christiansburg with their daughter, Harper.
