### KEY STORYLINES

#### HISTORY LESSON

Radford is in its 46th season as a varsity women's basketball program. RU has compiled a 682-542 record during that span.  
Fourth-year head coach **Mike McGuire** is the program's seventh all-time head coach.  
The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

#### POSTSEASON PLAY

RU qualified for the WNIT for the third time in program history last season, falling to East Carolina.  
The Highlanders have a 2-3 WNIT record, picking up a pair of wins in the 1989 tournament.  
Prior to 2015, Radford last appeared in the WNIT in 2008.  
RU has made six postseason appearances in all (three WNITs and three NCAA Tournaments).

Give Radford their first win against Tennessee Tech in the head-to-head series  
Give Radford its first 2-1 start to the season since 2013-14  
Make **Mike McGuire** 1-0 against Tennessee Tech during his career.

## TEAM NOTES

### HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS

- Radford picked up its first win of the season on Nov. 19, holding off a late second half charge by Davidson for a 44-40 victory.
- The win marks the seventh consecutive season that Radford has collected at least one win in their first two games of the season, dating back to the 2010-11 season. Radford improves to 4-3 in the all-time series, versus Davidson riding a two-game winning streak.
- Jayda Worthy** finished with a game-high 14 points, marking the 23rd time she has scored at least 10 points in her career and the 11th time she had led Radford in points.
- Worthy finished with two blocks, giving her sixth through the first two games and 45 in her career.
- Through two games, Worthy leads the Big South in blocks.
- Destinee Walker** followed with her second straight game of 12 points. Walker made 5 of 7 field goals for a new career high, including a career-high two made 3-pointers.
- Lydia Rivers**, Worthy and Walker combined for 23 of Radford's 39 rebounds.
- The Highlander defense has allowed 110 points through games, ranking second in the Big South with 55.0 points allowed per game.
- In addition, opponents are shooting only 31.6 percent against the Radford defense, which ranks second in the conference. Opposing teams are 37 for 117 from the floor with only six baskets coming as 3-pointers.
- Radford last matchup against an opponent from the Volunteer State came on Dec. 2, 2008 in a 78-41 loss at Vanderbilt. The Highlanders last win against the state of Tennessee came in a 73-67 win over ETSU on Dec. 20, 2007.

### SCOUTING TENNESSEE TECH

- The Golden Eagles are currently on a two-game skid since their first win of the season on Nov. 14 in a 54-41 win over NAIA foe Tennessee Wesleyan.
- Tennessee Tech's only player averaging

double-figures is Yaktavia Hickson, who is averaging 15.5 points per game, ranking sixth in the Ohio Valley.

- Hickson has poured in double-digits in all four games on the season, including season-high 17 points twice.
- The junior is shooting 46 percent (23-50) from the field and 75 percent (12-16) from the charity stripe.
- Tennessee Tech has five players averaging five-plus points on the season.
- Hannah Goolsby is the Golden Eagles leading rebounder with 20 rebounds through four games, averaging 5.0 per game.
- Point guard Akia Harris is the Golden Eagles leading offensive rebounding, corralling 11 offensive boards.
- Harris turned in strong performance in her fourth collegiate game as Tennessee Tech dropped a 73-62 decision to Middle Tennessee State. The freshman dished out a season-high 12 dimes. She is averaging 3.8 assists per game, ranking seventh in the OVC.
- The matchup against the Highlanders is the first of three contests against Big South foes. Tennessee Tech will travel to UNC Asheville for a Nov. 25 matchup and Winthrop on Nov. 29.

### ADIÓS AISHA

- Radford will need to fill the void left by 2016 graduate **Aisha Foy**, a two-time Big South Conference honoree.
- A threat from behind the 3-point line, Foy made 129, ranking fifth all-time.
- Foy finished her career with a .351 3-point field goal percentage, ranking fifth in program history.
- She led the Highlanders in scoring during the 2015-16 season, averaging 12.2 points per game.
- Appearing in 113 games with earning 82 starts, Foy finished her career with 955 points.
- Named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want to be a Coach" program.

- Current graduate assistant at Southeast Missouri St.

### ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2016-17 roster features 13 players representing eight states and two countries.
- There are four players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by **Claudia Quevedo**.
- Radford has one redshirt senior, three juniors, two redshirt sophomores, four sophomores, one redshirt freshman and two freshmen
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

### DYNAMIC DESTINEE

- Destinee Walker** is off to a sensational start to her sophomore season, averaging 12 points and 6.5 rebounds per game.
- Walker has scored 12 points in back-to-back games to start the season.
- Her career high in points in 13.
- Walker entered the season having scored 10-plus points in only one game.
- In a 44-40 win over Davidson on Nov. 19, Walker played a career-high 34 minutes, earning her first career start in the game.
- She also set career highs in made field goals (5) and 3-pointers made (2).

### WHAT A TURNAROUND

- Head coach **Mike McGuire**'s is 35-28 over the last two seasons after going 7-23 during his first season.
- In 2015-16, the Highlanders went 18-13, the most wins in a season since the 2007-08 season.
- That 2007-08 season saw Radford win 23 contests.



## CRUNCH TIME

- Radford played in six games that were decided by three points or less during the 2015-16 campaign.
- The Highlanders posted a 4-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach **Mike McGuire**, Radford is 13-8 in games decided by five points or less.

# MIKE MCGUIRE

HEAD COACH :: FOURTH SEASON AT RADFORD

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

Despite a 2015-16 season ravaged by injuries, McGuire steered Radford to its most wins (18) since the 2007-08 season. The Highlanders, who tied for third in the Big South regular-season standings, advanced to the semifinals of the Big South tournament for the first time since 2013.

Defense was the cornerstone of Radford's success. The Highlanders concluded the season ranked fifth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense (.333), 14th in scoring defense (53.3) and 16th in blocks per game (5.6).

Individually, two Radford players (Janayla White and Aisha Foy) were named to the All-Big South first team for the first time since 1992-93.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade.

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond where he helped lead the Spiders to five straight postseason berths and a 101-60 overall record. For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament

championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

### LAST TIME OUT

**DAVIDSON, N.C.** – Radford collected its first win at Davidson in program history as **Jayda Worthy** poured in a game-high 14 points on 7 of 10 shooting as the Highlanders held off a late Wildcat charge for a 44-40 victory.

Despite only scoring seven points in the opening quarter led by six off the hot hand of Worthy, Radford outscored Davidson 14-7 in the second quarter. The second quarter started with back-to-back layups by **Khiana Johnson** and Worthy to give the Highlanders a 11-4 lead, two minutes into the second quarter.

After building up the lead to seven points, **Destinee Walker** caught fire for the Highlanders, hitting two consecutive 3-pointers from the left corner on a pair assists by **Claudia Quevedo** and **Janayla White**. The two Walker 3-pointers extended the Radford lead to 17-7 with 4:42 remaining in the first half.

Davidson cut the lead to six (17-11) on a Mackenzie Latt jumper at the 2:16 mark. Following a White free throw, Johnson found a wide open Quevedo at the top of the arch for a 3-pointer, sending the Highlanders into the locker room with a 21-11 advantage.

Davidson scored the first three points of the third quarter, before the Worthy show took over. The Toledo, Ohio native scored three consecutive baskets over a four-minute span, extending the Highlander lead to 27-14 with 4:40 left in the quarter.

Having already hit two 3-pointers of her own, Walker found a wide-open **Alexis Jackson** on the left side for a 3-pointer at the 1:55 mark. Walker capped off the Radford 13-8 run in the third quarter with a jumper as the Highlanders went into the final quarter with a commanding 34-23 lead.

The Wildcats saved their fight for the fourth quarter as Davidson opened the quarter on a 6-2 run off of four points by Latt, cutting the deficit to seven (36-29) with 7:13 remaining in regulation. Johnson ended the streak on a Radford defensive stop in which Worthy found Johnson off the rebound, finishing with a strong layup.

A three-minute scoreless streak by both squads was ended as **Jen Falconer** sunk two free throws at the 3:05 mark to give Radford a nine-point lead. Davidson made quick work of the nine-point deficit as a 6-1 run cut the Highlander lead to 41-37 on a Justine Lyon jumper with 40 seconds left.

With four points in the quarter, Chloe Johnson hit a clutch 3-pointer with just under 15 seconds remaining to pull within 42-40 of the Highlanders as neither team had any timeouts to call.

Khiana Johnson made two key free throws down the stretch as Radford held on for a 44-40 win, despite being outscored 17-10 in the final quarter.
