KEY STORYLINES

HISTORY LESSON

Radford is in its 46th season as a varsity women's basketball program. RU has compiled a 683-542 record during that span. Fourth-year head coach Mike McGuire is the program's seventh all-time head coach.

The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

POSTSEASON PLAY

RU qualified for the WNIT for the third time in program history last season, falling to East Carolina. The Highlanders have a 2-3 WNIT record, picking up a pair of wins in the 1989 tournament.

Prior to 2015, Radford last appeared in the WNIT in 2008. RU has made six postseason appearances in all (three WNITs and three NCAA Tournaments).

A WIN WOULD...

Give Radford their second win against Davis & Elkins in the head-to-head series.

Make Mike McGuire 1-0 against Davis & Elkins during his career. Ensure Radford's first 3-1 start to a season since the 2012-13 campaign. After a season opening loss to Marshall, Radford picked up wins over UNC Greensboro, Bluefield and Southern Illinois.

Head coach Mike McGuire. the 2014-15 Big South Coach of the Year, enters his fourth season at the helm of the Highlanders.

TEAM NOTES

HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS

- After only scoring a combined 100 points in the first two games to start the 2016-17 season, Radford's offense exploded for 79 points in a 79-46 home opening win over Tennessee
- The 79 points are the sixth most points scored by a Big South team this season.
- The win also marked the Highlanders first win over an opponent from the Volunteer State since a 73-67 victory over ETSU on Dec. 20,
- Ten different Highlanders scored in the win, while eight grabbed at least one rebound.
- Destinee Walker has scored double-figures in the first three games to start the season.
- Walker's 16-point effort breaks her career-high mark of 13 set Feb. 23, 2016 at Winthrop. The sophomore finished 5 of 9 from the floor, including two 3-pointers.
- Averaging 13.3 points per game, Walker ranks sixth in the Big South.
- Janayla White collected her first start of the 2016-17 season, tallying 16 points to lead the Highlanders in scoring for the 16th time in her
- After pulling down a season-high 12 rebounds last time out, Lydia Rivers now ranks third in the conference with 7.7 boards per game.
- Rivers career average is 8.0 per game, while leading the Highlanders in rebounds in 16 career games.
- Radford shot 48.1 percent in the contest, going 26 for 54 from the field, their highest mark since shooting 48.5 percent in an 80-64 win over Longwood on Feb. 20, 2016.
- After making 23 of 38 attempts from the charity stripe, The Highlanders made 21 of 24 free throw attempts, including 18 of 20 in the second half in the win over Tennessee Tech.
- Radford's defense is off to another strong start. holding opponents to 52.0 points per game, leading the Big South.

SCOUTING DAVIS & ELKINS

- Davis & Elkins are coming off a 110-55 win over Bluefield State on Nov. 21. The Senators scored over 30 points in two of the four quarters.
- Through five games, Davis & Elkins is averaging 83.4 points per game, while opponents are scoring 70.6.
- The Senators are shooting 45 percent from the floor. Of their 152 made field goals, 63 have come from behind the 3-point line.
- Stephanie Wooten paces the Senators with 21.8 points per game clip, while Sydney Turner follows with 16.6 points per contest.
- Turner is shooting a blistering 25 for 50 from the 3-point line. Only three of Turner's made field goals have not been of the 3-point variety.
- Wooten is 39 of 95 from the floor for a 41.1 field goal percentage.
- In addition to scoring the rock, Wooten paces the team with 8.2 assists per game, tallying 41 on the season.
- As a team, the Senators have collected 107 assists, averaging 21.4 per game.
- Davis & Elkins sports five players averaging five or more points per game.
- The Senators are counting the contest as an exhibition, their second in a row. Davis & Elkins will travel to Bowling Green on Nov. 30 for their final contest against an NCAA Division I opponent.

ADIÓS AISHA

- Radford will need to fill the void left by 2016 graduate Aisha Foy, a two-time Big South Conference honoree.
- A threat from behind the 3-point line, Foy made 129, ranking fifth all-time.
- Foy finished her career with a .351 3-point field goal percentage, ranking fifth in program
- She led the Highlanders in scoring during the 2015-16 season, averaging 12.2 points per
- Appearing in 113 games with earning 82 starts,

- Foy finished her career with 955 points.
- Named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want to be a Coach" program.
- Current graduate assistant at Southeast Missouri St.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2016-17 roster features 13 players representing eight states and two countries.
- There are four players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by Claudia Quevedo.
- Radford has one redshirt senior, three juniors, two redshirt sophomores, four sophomores, one redshirt freshman and two freshmen
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

DYNAMIC DESTINEE

- Destinee Walker is off to a sensational start, averaging 13.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per
- Walker has scored double-digits in the first three games to start the season.
- Set a career mark with a 16-point effort in Wednesday's win over Tennessee Tech.
- Walker entered the season having scored 10plus points in only one game.
- In win over Davidson on Nov. 19, Walker played a career-high 34 minutes, earning her first career start in the game.

WHAT A TURNAROUND

- Head coach Mike McGuire's is 36-28 over the last two seasons after going 7-23 during his first season.
- In 2015-16, the Highlanders went 18-13, the most wins in a season since the 2007-08 season.
- That 2007-08 season saw Radford win 23 contests.



CRUNCH TIME

- Radford played in six games that were decided by three points or less during the 2015-16 campaign.
- The Highlanders posted a 4-2 mark in those
- Under head coach Mike McGuire, Radford is 13-8 in games decided by five points or less.

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

Despite a 2015-16 season ravaged by injuries, McGuire steered Radford to its most wins (18) since the 2007-08 season. The Highlanders, who tied for third in the Big South regular-season standings, advanced to the semifinals of the Big South tournament for the first time since 2013.

Defense was the cornerstone of Radford's success. The Highlanders concluded the season ranked fifth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense (.333), 14th in scoring defense (53.3) and 16th in blocks per game (5.6).

Individually, two Radford players (Janayla White and Aisha Foy) were named to the All-Big South first team for the first time since 1992-93.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best

turnaround in the nation.

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond where he helped lead the Spiders to five straight postseason berths and a 101-60 overall record. For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Riner with their daughters, Harper and Ellie.

LAST TIME OUT

RADFORD, Va. - After only scoring a combined 100 points in the first two games to start the 2016-17 season, Radford's offense exploded for 79 points in a 79-46 home opening win over Tennessee Tech as the Highlanders placed three scorers in double-figures, Tuesday afternoon in the Dedmon Center.

Radford 33-point win is its largest since a 92-36 victory over Concord on Dec. 12, 2015. Destinee Walker and Janayla White turned in game-high 16-point efforts. Jayda Worthy added 10 points off the bench.

Tennessee Tech commanded a 9-8 lead with 3:52 remaining in the opening quarter, before Radford went on a 12-0 run to close out the guarter with a 20-12 lead. The run saw eight points by Walker, including two 3-pointers that sparked the run. Sydney Nunley and White contributed layups. Radford shot a blistering 60-percent from the floor to start the contest, making 9 of 15 attempts.

Keeping their hot shooting alive, Brittany Allen opened the second quarter with a 3-pointer off an inside-out pass from Lydia Rivers. Trailing 23-12, Tennessee Tech received a deep 3-pointer from Hannah Goolsby and layup by Anacia Wilkinson to cut the deficit to 24-18 with 6:21 remaining in the first half.

Six points would be as close as the Golden Eagles would come within the Highlanders as Radford rattled off eight straight points to take a 32-18 lead off of transition layups from Alexis Jackson and Khiana Johnson.

Radford went into the locker room with 34-24 lead on 15 of 30 shooting in the first half. Walker lead all scorers with 10 points, while Johnson chipped in six points.

The Highlanders blew the game wide open in the third quarter as White scored the first five points of the quarter as Radford outscored Tennessee 28-10.

The third quarter turned into a free throw contest as the Highlanders went 15 for 16 from the charity stripe. including a 5 of 5 effort from White and a 4 of 4 showing by Worthy. Allen hit a running 3-pointer at the buzzer to give Radford a 64-34 advantage after three quarters.

Radford ran clock for most of the fourth quarter as the Highlanders cruised to a 79-46 victory.


