HISTORY LESSON

Radford is in its 46th season as a varsity women's basketball program. RU has compiled a 687-542 record during that span.
Fourth-year head coach **Mike McGuire** is the program's seventh all-time head coach.
The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

POSTSEASON PLAY

RU qualified for the WNIT for the third time in program history last season, falling to East Carolina.
The Highlanders have a 2-3 WNIT record, picking up a pair of wins in the 1989 tournament.
Prior to 2015, Radford last appeared in the WNIT in 2008.
RU has made six postseason appearances in all (three WNITs and three NCAA Tournaments).

Give **Mike McGuire** his first win over an AP Top 25 team.
Even the all-time series between the two teams at 1-1.
Make **Mike McGuire** 2-8 against teams from Power 5 conferences.

TEAM NOTES

HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS

- Radford dons the longest winning streak in the Big South this season at seven games. The Highlanders put together two five-game winning streaks a season ago.
- The longest winning streak in program history is 11 games, coming in 1976-77, when Radford started the season 11-0.
- Radford swept the Big South Women's Basketball weekly awards for the first time since Dec. 17, 2007 as the league announced on Monday that **Janayla White** was named the Big South Player of the Week and **Khiana Johnson** the Come Ready Nutrition Freshman of the Week.
- The player of the week honor is the second of White's career, while the freshman of the week award is the first for Johnson. Radford has won player of the week awards in consecutive weeks.
- In the two games on the week, White scored 27 points and grabbed 22 rebounds. The junior also finished with four blocks and three assists. Increasing her field-goal percentage to .531, White went 10 for 15 from the field in 48 minutes of action. Her four blocks on the week give her 116 in her career, needing only three blocks to move into a three-way tie for third place in school history.
- Quickly adjusting to the college game, Johnson put together the two best games of her short collegiate career. The freshman finished with 28 points, seven assists and six rebounds in the two games. Johnson's back-to-back double-figure performances give her four on the season.
- The duo helped fuel Radford's 68-60 win over Wake Forest on Dec. 10. White played a season-high 31 minutes against Wake Forest and played a major role in the victory over the ACC foe. She collected her first double-double of the season and 16th career with an 18-point, 11-rebound effort. The 18 points came on a 7 for 12 effort from the field.
- Johnson provided Radford with a spark off the bench against Wake Forest, scoring 13 points to go along with her three assists. She added eight points in the second half, finishing 2 of 3 from 3-point land.
- No Highlander has filled out the box score like **Jayda Worthy** this season. Worthy is

averaging 10.6 points per game, 6.4 rebounds per game, 2.4 assists per game, 1.5 steals per game and 1.0 blocks per game.

- In the Big South; Worthy ranks third in blocks per game, 10th in steals per game and 12th in assists per game.
- Radford's defense has limited three opponents to 40 points or less this season, while allowing only two opponents to score more than 60 points. The Highlanders rank third in scoring defense in the Big South, allowing only 52.5 per contest.
- The Highlanders rank sixth in the country with a 31.6 field-goal percentage defense.
- In the last two games, Radford has shot over 40-percent from the field, marking the fifth time on the season.
- Radford ranks second in the league with a 42.3 field goal percentage.

SCOUTING KENTUCKY

- The Wildcats are coming off their second overtime loss in the last three games with a 73-71 loss to No. 23 Arizona State. Kentucky led for 28:03 minutes, while Arizona State only led for 7:05.
- The game saw 12 ties and seven lead changes, with six of the seven lead changes coming in the fourth quarter or overtime.
- Sophomore Maci Morris scored a career-high 29 points on 9 of 17 shooting from the floor, including a 9 for 9 effort from the free throw line. The 29-point effort is the first 20-point game of her career.
- Taylor Murray chipped in a career-high 16 points. The sophomore has scored 15-plus points in six of Kentucky's last seven games.
- The Wildcats leading scorer Makayla Epps (18.2 ppg) was held scoreless in the first half for the second time on the season. Epps finished with 14 points in the second half.
- Evelyn Akhator is the only Wildcat averaging a double-double and one of only three in the SEC. Akhator leads the team with 10.5 rebounds per game and ranks second with 13.9 points per contest.
- The 105 rebounds rank 14th in the country, while 10.5 rebounds per game is 22nd.
- Akhator ranks fifth nationally with six double-doubles on the season. She has grabbed

double-figure rebounds in seven games and has led the team in eight games.

- Makenzie Cann and Morris have combined for 34 of Kentucky's 51 made 3-pointers as the duo have made 17 each.
- Kentucky sports five players with a field-goal percentage above 40-percent. The Wildcats rank fourth in the SEC and 32nd in the country with a 45.7 field-goal percentage.
- Akhator (58.3 FG%) and Epps (50.0 FG%) are the best among SEC players; ranking third and ninth respectively.
- The Wildcats don't turn the ball over as their 11.9 turnovers per contest rank seventh in the country.

DYNAMIC DESTINEE

- Destinee Walker** continues her blistering start to the season, scoring double-figures in all but one game.
- The sophomore has taken smart shots in the first eight games, which is reflected in her league-best 54.9 field-goal percentage.
- Walker is 45 for 82 from the field, including 9 of 20 from 3-point land.
- Walker ranks second in the Big South in scoring (14.9) and rebounding (8.1).
- Walker scored double-digits in the first six games to start the season.
- Set a career mark with a 22-point effort in a Dec. 4 win over UNC Greensboro.
- Walker entered the season having scored 10-plus points in only one game.
- In win over Davidson on Nov. 19, Walker played a career-high 34 minutes, earning her first career start in the game.
- Collected three straight double-doubles, including back-to-back 20-point efforts (Nov. 26-Dec. 4).

CRUNCH TIME

- Radford played in seven games that were decided by three points or less since the 2015-16 campaign.
- The Highlanders have posted a 5-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach **Mike McGuire**, Radford is 15-8 in games decided by five points or less.



ADIÓS AISHA

- Radford will need to fill the void left by 2016 graduate **Aisha Foy**, a two-time Big South Conference honoree.
- A threat from behind the 3-point line, Foy made 129, ranking fifth all-time. Foy finished her career with a .351 3-point field goal percentage, ranking fifth in program history.
- She led the Highlanders in scoring during the 2015-16 season, averaging 12.2 points per game.
- Appearing in 113 games with earning 82 starts, Foy finished her career with 955 points.
- Named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want to be a Coach" program.
- Current graduate assistant at Southeast Missouri St.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2016-17 roster features 13 players representing eight states and two countries.
- There are four players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by **Claudia Quevedo**.
- Radford has one redshirt senior, three juniors, two redshirt sophomores, four sophomores, one redshirt freshman and two freshmen
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

WHAT A TURNAROUND

- Head coach **Mike McGuire**'s is 40-28 over the last three seasons after going 7-23 during his first season.
- In 2015-16, the Highlanders went 18-13, the most wins in a season since the 2007-08 season. Radford won 23 games that season

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

Despite a 2015-16 season ravaged by injuries, McGuire steered Radford to its most wins (18) since the 2007-08 season. The Highlanders, who tied for third in the Big South regular-season standings, advanced to the semifinals of the Big South tournament for the first time since 2013.

Defense was the cornerstone of Radford's success. The Highlanders concluded the season ranked fifth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense (.333), 14th in scoring defense (53.3) and 16th in blocks per game (5.6).

Individually, two Radford players (Janayla White and Aisha Foy) were named to the All-Big South first team for the first time since 1992-93.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade.

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best

turnaround in the nation.

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond where he helped lead the Spiders to five straight postseason berths and a 101-60 overall record. For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament

championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Riner with their daughters, Harper and Ellie.
