## HISTORY LESSON

Radford is in its 46th season as a varsity women's basketball program. RU has compiled a 685-542 record during that span.
Fourth-year head coach **Mike McGuire** is the program's seventh all-time head coach.

The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

## POSTSEASON PLAY

RU qualified for the WNIT for the third time in program history last season, falling to East Carolina.
The Highlanders have a 2-3 WNIT record, picking up a pair of wins in the 1989 tournament.

Prior to 2015, Radford last appeared in the WNIT in 2008. RU has made six postseason appearances in all (three WNITs and three NCAA Tournaments).

## A WIN WOULD...

Give the Highlanders three consecutive wins over the Mountaineers in Boone.

Pull Radford within 11-9 of Appalachian State in the all-time series. Make **Mike McGuire** 2-1 against Appalachian State during his career.

Give Radford its first 5-1 start to a season since the 1985-86 season, when the Highlanders started 7-1.

# TEAM NOTES

#### **HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS**

- Radford is currently on a four-game winning streak, outscoring opponents 260-197.
- The hot start to the season has been fueled by the play of **Destinee Walker**. The sophomore is averaging 15.0 points per game and 7.8 rebounds per game.
- Walker ranks second in the Big South in scoring and rebounds.
- Last time out, Walker finished with her second career double-double, finishing with a career-high 20 points and 10 rebounds in a 70-54 win over UNC Greensboro on Friday night. Walker poured in 12 points in the second half on 6 of 7 shooting to finish the night 8 for 12.
- Walker joins redshirt senior Rachael Ross as the only two Highlanders on the current roster to score 20 points in a game. Ross poured in 21 points at Longwood Feb. 22, 2014.
- Radford placed four players in double figures for the first time since the Big South Tournament on March 11, 2016.
- Jayda Worthy (12), Sydney Nunley (10) and Khiana Johnson (10) rounded out the Highlanders in double-digits.
- Nunley's career high in points came on 4 of 8 shooting, while finishing with seven rebounds in a career-high 29 minutes of action.
- During the four-game winning streak, Radford has held opponents under 60 points, while only giving up 53.4 points per game on the season.
- In the win over UNC Greensboro, Radford shot a blistering 49.1 percent from the field, making 26 of 53 from the floor. The Highlanders missed shooting 50 percent from the first time since Dec. 12, 2015.
- Radford is one of only three Big South schools with a field goal percentage above 40-percent.
- The Highlanders are 113 for 264 from the field for a 42.8 field goal percentage.
- On the opposite end, opposing teams are only shooting 33.1 percent against the Radford defense, ranking 18th nationally.
- Radford has only committed 78 fouls on the season, which leads the Big South and ranks 10th in the country in fewest fouls committed.

#### SCOUTING APPALACHIAN STATE

The Mountaineers will be playing their third consecutive home game, holding a 1-1 record

- in the Holmes Center.
- Appalachian State is 2-0 against the Big South this season, defeating Gardner-Webb 72-67 on Nov. 12 in the Maggie Dixon Classic and Liberty 66-57 on Nov. 17. The Mountaineers will host UNC Asheville on Dec. 21.
- Coming off a 71-58 win over North Carolina A&T on Nov. 30, Madi Story turned in a 31-point performance on 12 of 20 shooting from the floor. Story is second on the squad with 11.6 points per game.
- Joi Jones paces the Mountaineers with 16.4 points per game, scoring double-figures in five of seven games on the season.
- Jones has gone over the 20-point mark twice on the season.
- Appalachian State has fared better in the second half than the first half this season. In the first half, the Mountaineers have been outscored 244-180. However, in the second half Appalachian State has outscored opponents 266-223.
- The Mountaineers have scored almost half of their points in the paint, tallying 212 of their 446 points down low.
- Appalachian State's defense has forced 149 turnovers (21.3 per contest). They are averaging 19.7 points off turnovers on the season.

#### **ADIÓS AISHA**

- Radford will need to fill the void left by 2016 graduate Aisha Foy, a two-time Big South Conference honoree.
- A threat from behind the 3-point line, Foy made 129, ranking fifth all-time.
- Foy finished her career with a .351 3-point field goal percentage, ranking fifth in program
- She led the Highlanders in scoring during the 2015-16 season, averaging 12.2 points per
- Appearing in 113 games with earning 82 starts, Foy finished her career with 955 points.
- Named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want to be a Coach" program.
- Current graduate assistant at Southeast Missouri St.

#### **ROSTER BREAKDOWN**

- RU's 2016-17 roster features 13 players representing eight states and two countries.
- There are four players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by Claudia Quevedo.
- Radford has one redshirt senior, three juniors, two redshirt sophomores, four sophomores, one redshirt freshman and two freshmen
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller

#### **DYNAMIC DESTINEE**

- Destinee Walker is off to a sensational start, averaging 15.0 points and 7.8 rebounds per game.
- Walker ranks second in the Big South in scoring and rebounds.
- Walker has scored double-digits in the first five games to start the season.
- Set a career mark with a 20-point effort in a Dec.2 win over UNC Greensboro
- Walker entered the season having scored 10plus points in only one game.
- In win over Davidson on Nov. 19, Walker played a career-high 34 minutes, earning her first career start in the game.
- Last time out, Walker collected her second conseutive and career double-double, finishing with 20 points and 10 rebounds.

#### **WHAT A TURNAROUND**

- Head coach Mike McGuire's is 37-28 over the last two seasons after going 7-23 during his first season.
- In 2015-16, the Highlanders went 18-13, the most wins in a season since the 2007-08 season.
- That 2007-08 season saw Radford win 23 contests.



#### **CRUNCH TIME**

- Radford played in six games that were decided by three points or less during the 2015-16 campaign.
- The Highlanders posted a 4-2 mark in those
- Under head coach Mike McGuire, Radford is 13-8 in games decided by five points or less.

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

Despite a 2015-16 season ravaged by injuries, McGuire steered Radford to its most wins (18) since the 2007-08 season. The Highlanders, who tied for third in the Big South regular-season standings, advanced to the semifinals of the Big South tournament for the first time since 2013.

Defense was the cornerstone of Radford's success. The Highlanders concluded the season ranked fifth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense (.333), 14th in scoring defense (53.3) and 16th in blocks per game (5.6).

Individually, two Radford players (Janayla White and Aisha Foy) were named to the All-Big South first team for the first time since 1992-93.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond where he helped lead the Spiders to five straight postseason berths and a 101-60 overall record. For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Riner with their daughters, Harper and Ellie.

#### **AST TIME OUT**

GREENSBORO, N.C. – Radford placed four players in double-figures, while Destinee Walker poured in a career-high 20 points to go along with 10 rebounds for her second double-double on the season as the Highlanders cruised to their four-straight win with a 70-54 decision over UNC Greensboro.

Radford jumped out to an early 9-2 on three straight 3-pointers by **Claudia Quevedo** and Walker. Walker's first 3-pointer came at the 8:21 mark, while **Jen Falconer** found Walker on the left side of the perimeter at the 6:04 mark.

Almost one minute later, Falconer pushed the ball up the right side of the court, finding Quevedo for a transition 3-pointer to give the Highlanders a sev 5:16 remaining in the opening quarter. -pointer to give the Highlanders a seven-point lead with

The Highlanders closed out the first guarter with a strong showing as Quevedo and the Radford defense forced a turnover, leading Jayda Worthy to a transition threepoint play. After sinking the free throw, Worthy collected a second chance basket on Radford's next offensive possession, giving the junior five straight points as the Highlanders ended the quarter with a 16-7 edge.

In the second quarter, **Sydney Nunley** (6) and Worthy (7) combined for Radford's first 13 points. Nunley outscored UNCG 6-2 in a 2:10 span in the quarter, knocking down back-to-back jumpers to give the Highlanders a 24-10 lead with 6:37 remaining in the first half.

Worthy added five points and Walker contributed two free throws as the Highlanders went into the locker room with a commanding 31-16 halftime lead.

Radford built its lead to 19 in the third quarter as Falconer found a wide open Quevedo in the corner for her second 3-pointer, giving the Highlanders a 38-19 lead early in the second half

UNCG slowly chipped into the Radford lead, ending the third quarter on a 9-5 run, trailing 51-37. Khiana Johnson prevented the Spartans from making a run to end the quarter with five of her 10 second half points.

The Spartans opened the final quarter with five straight points, cutting the Highlander lead to 51-42 as the Highlanders would go on an 8-2 run.

The 8-2 run was highlighted by two 3-pointers from Falconer and Quevedo, while Walker finished off an offensive rebound putback.

Radford demised what comeback attempt UNCG mustered as the Highlanders finished the fourth quarter with three 3-pointers and four straight free throws from Falconer to collect their fourth consecutive win with a 70-54 decision.


