## HISTORY LESSON

Radford is in its 46th season as a varsity women's basketball program. RU has compiled a 687-544 record during that span. Fourth-year head coach Mike McGuire is the program's seventh all-time head coach.

The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

## POSTSEASON PLAY

RU qualified for the WNIT for the third time in program history last season, falling to East Carolina. The Highlanders have a 2-3 WNIT record, picking up a pair of wins in the 1989 tournament.

Prior to 2015, Radford last appeared in the WNIT in 2008. RU has made six postseason appearances in all (three WNITs and three NCAA Tournaments).

Nine underclassmen are set to don the Red and White in 2016-17, Radford ranks fourth in youngest rosters in the Big

Radford leads the Big South and ranks seventh nationally in field-goal percentage defense, holding opponents to only 32.36 shooting from the floor.



Radford's ranks 30th in the country in scoring defense, holding opponents to a mere 55.0 points per game.

# TEAM NOTES

#### **HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS**

- Radford is coming off a stretch of three games against Power 5 opponents, going 1-2 with a 68-60 win over Wake Forest on Dec. 10. In the two losses to Kentucky and Virginia Tech, Radford was outscored 130-88.
- During the last two games, Radford has been held to single-digits in five out of the last eight quarters.
- Individually, Destinee Walker has led the Highlanders in scoring seven times on the season. She has scored double-figures in eight of Radford's 10 contests, including five with 15-plus points.
- Walker ranks tied for second in the league with 14.3 points per game and third in rebounds with 7.7 per game.
- The sophomore leads the Big South with a .529 field goal percentage, making 55 of 104 attempts. The .529 field goal percentage ranks 67th in the country.
- She is the only Highlander averaging double-figures. Janayla White and Jayda Worthy follow with 9.0 points per game.
- Last time out. White had her three-game streak of 11 rebounds snapped, corralling only seven rebounds in the loss to Virginia Tech.
- Despite only playing in seven games, White has grabbed 58 rebounds for 8.3 per game, leading the Big South.
- Foul trouble has plagued Worthy in the last two contests as the Toledo, Ohio native has only managed five points in 23 minutes of action.
- Radford has been one of the best teams in the Big South and the country on the defensive side of the basketball. The Highlanders rank seventh nationally with a 32.6 field goal percentage defense and 30th in scoring defense, limiting opponents to only 55 points.
- In the last two games, Radford's defense limited Kentucky (36.9) and Virginia Tech (35.3) to their season lows in field goal percentage.
- The Highlanders have held seven opponents to under 35-percent shooting.
- Dominating the defensive glass, Radford leads the conference and ranks 22th in the nation with 30.1 defensive rebounds per contest.
- Radford has collected nine more blocks than the next closest Big South team, totaling a league best 43 and 4.3 per game. The 4.3 per

- contest is 76th in the country.
- White collected three blocks against Virginia Tech, moving her into sole possession of third place in program history with 120 career blocks.
- The Highlanders look to close out the 2016 portion of their home schedule with a perfect record at 4-0. A season ago, Radford closed out the 2015 slate with a 5-0 record.

#### **SCOUTING CONCORD**

- Concord has not played in 20 days with the last game coming on Dec. 11 against Winston-Salem State. The Mountain Lions dropped the decision 65-61 for their fifth loss in a row.
- During the five-game skid, Concord has been outscored 425-355.
- The Mountain Lions are averaging 68.8 points per game, only scoring less than 60 points in three games. Opponents are averaging 78.8, crossing the century mark twice on the season.
- Alexis Lowery paces the Mountain Lion offensive attack with 15.4 points per game. The senior also leads the squad with 2.7 assists per game and 2.0 steals per game.
- Joining Lowery in double-figures, Heather Chapman averages 10.0 points per game. Chapman leads the way with 5.6 rebounds per game.
- Concord is shooting 41.6 percent from the field, including a 30.7 clip from the 3-point line. Of the 512 shots attempted by the Mountain Lions on the season, 127 have come from behind the arc.
- The Mountain Lions share the wealth on the floor, averaging 14.9 assists per contest.
- In eight games, Concord has turned the ball over 169 times for 21.1 per game.
- Radford is the second NCAA Division I opponent the Mountain Lions have faced this season. Concord traveled to West Virginia for an exhibition on Nov. 1. Lowery led all scorers in the game, finishing with 19 points on five 3-pointers.

#### **DYNAMIC DESTINEE**

- Destinee Walker continues her blistering start to the season, scoring double-figures in all but
- Ranking tied for second in the Big South with 14.3 points per game, she has tallied 143 points in 10 games which is second most in the league.
- Walker leads the conference with a 52.9 fieldgoal percentage, ranking 67th in the country. The next closest player to Walker in field-goal percentage in the Big South is Charleston Southern's Ke'Asia Jackson with a 42.1 shooting clip.
- Walker is 55 for 104 from the field, including 10 of 25 from 3-point land.
- In addition to scoring, Walker ranks third in rebounding with 7.7 per game.
- Walker scored double-digits in the first six games to start the season.
- Set a career mark with a 22-point effort in a Dec. 4 win over UNC Greensboro.
- Walker entered the season having scored 10plus points in only one game.
- In win over Davidson on Nov. 19, Walker played a career-high 34 minutes, earning her first career start in the game.
- Collected three straight double-doubles, including back-to-back 20-point efforts (Nov. 26-Dec. 4).

#### **CRUNCH TIME**

- Radford played in seven games that were decided by three points or less since the 2015-16 campaign.
- The Highlanders have posted a 5-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach Mike McGuire. Radford is 15-8 in games decided by five points or less.

#### **ADIÓS AISHA**

- Radford will need to fill the void left by 2016 graduate Aisha Foy, a two-time Big South Conference honoree.
- A threat from behind the 3-point line, Foy made 129, ranking fifth all-time. Foy finished her career with a .351 3-point field goal percentage, ranking fifth in program history.
- She led the Highlanders in scoring during the 2015-16 season, averaging 12.2 points per game.
- Appearing in 113 games with earning 82 starts,
   Foy finished her career with 955 points.
- Named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want to be a Coach" program.
- Current graduate assistant at Southeast Missouri St.

#### **ROSTER BREAKDOWN**

- RU's 2016-17 roster features 13 players representing eight states and two countries.
- There are four players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by Claudia Quevedo.
- Radford has one redshirt senior, three juniors, two redshirt sophomores, four sophomores, one redshirt freshman and two freshmen
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

#### **WHAT A TURNAROUND**

- Head coach Mike McGuire's is 40-29 over the last three seasons after going 7-23 during his first season.
- In 2015-16, the Highlanders went 18-13, the most wins in a season since the 2007-08 season. Radford won 23 games that season

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

Despite a 2015-16 season ravaged by injuries, McGuire steered Radford to its most wins (18) since the 2007-08 season. The Highlanders, who tied for third in the Big South regular-season standings, advanced to the semifinals of the Big South tournament for the first time since 2013.

Defense was the cornerstone of Radford's success. The Highlanders concluded the season ranked fifth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense (.333), 14th in scoring defense (53.3) and 16th in blocks per game (5.6).

Individually, two Radford players (Janayla White and Aisha Foy) were named to the All-Big South first team for the first time since 1992-93.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond where he helped lead the Spiders to five straight postseason berths and a 101-60 overall record. For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Riner with their daughters, Harper and Ellie.





