HISTORY LESSON

Radford is in its 46th season as a varsity women's basketball program. RU has compiled a 685-542 record during that span.
Fourth-year head coach **Mike McGuire** is the program's seventh all-time head coach.
The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

POSTSEASON PLAY

RU qualified for the WNIT for the third time in program history last season, falling to East Carolina.
The Highlanders have a 2-3 WNIT record, picking up a pair of wins in the 1989 tournament.
Prior to 2015, Radford last appeared in the WNIT in 2008.
RU has made six postseason appearances in all (three WNITs and three NCAA Tournaments).

A WIN WOULD...

Give the Highlanders three consecutive wins over the Catamounts.
Pull Radford within 7-4 of Western Carolina in the all-time series.
Make **Mike McGuire** 1-0 against Western Carolina during his career.
Give Radford its first 6-1 start to a season since the 1985-86 season, when the Highlanders started 7-1.

TEAM NOTES

HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS

- The Highlanders hot start to the season (5-1) is the best start to a season since 1985-86. Radford kicked off the 85-86 season with a 7-1 start.
- Radford's five-game winning streak has been highlighted by an 317-251 outscoring of opponents.
- After turning in back-to-back double-doubles on the road trip, giving her three in a row, **Destinee Walker** collected her first Big South Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week honor on Monday.
- Walker played a crucial role in Radford's two wins last week – averaging 21 points, 10.5 rebounds and one steal per game. The Florence, S.C. native connected on 60.7 percent (17-28) of her shots, finishing 3 for 6 from downtown.
- The sophomore has scored double-digits in the first six games to start the season. The last Highlander to start the season with double-figures in the first six games was **Da'Naria Erwin Spencer** in 2011-12. Erwin Spencer started the season with nine games of double-digit scoring.
- Walker's hot start to the season has led her to leading the Big South in scoring (16.2 ppg) and ranking second in rebounding (8.3 rpg).
- Joining Walker in double-figures on the week, **Jayda Worthy** tallied 12 points and four assists in a win over UNC Greensboro on Dec. 4. Worthy collected her seventh career double-double on Dec. 4 with a 14-point and 11-rebound effort against Appalachian State. The junior dished out four assists in the contest, bring her average to 2.5 assists per contest.
- Sydney Nunley** put together a career week-end, pouring in a career-high 10 points versus UNC Greensboro, while grabbing career best 13 rebounds on Sunday at Appalachian State.
- In the matchup against Appalachian State; Walker, Worthy and Nunley finished with double-digit rebounds. The first time this season and the first since Feb. 13, 2016.
- Radford averages 40.3 rebounds, grabbing a total of 242 to rank fourth in the Big South.
- The Highlanders are holding opponents to only 34.2 rebounds per contest.
- Only six games into the 2016-17 season, Rad-

ford already sports one of the best defenses in the country. The Highlanders rank 14th nationally in field goal percentage defense (32.6) and 22nd in scoring defense (53.5).

- Head coach **Mike McGuire** enters the contest 17-19 against teams from North Carolina.

SCOUTING WESTERN CAROLINA

- The Catamounts enter the game with a 2-3 record away from home and a 0-2 record against teams from the Big South (UNC Asheville, Campbell).
- Western Carolina will play six Big South all together with Gardner-Webb, High Point and Charleston Southern remaining on the docket.
- On Nov. 29, Western Carolina hosted their own Education Day, dropping a 50-48 overtime decision to Campbell.
- Entering the game as one of the best rebounding teams in the Southern Conference, Western Carolina has corralled 392 rebounds, which leads the conference and ranks 13th in the country.
- The Catamounts are averaging 39.2 rebounds per contest. Opponents hold a slight edge with 39.4 rebounds per game.
- Through 10 games, Western Carolina has pulled down 40-plus rebounds on five different occasions, including 48 in a 95-48 win over North Greenville on Nov. 20
- Sherae Bonner has been a rebounding machine through 10 games, totaling 109 rebounds, ranking second in the nation.
- Bonner stands in sixth place with 8.4 defensive rebounds per game and 14th with 10.9 rebounds per game.
- The junior is the only player averaging a double-double in the SoCon, chipping in 10.9 points per game.
- Raziyah Farrington paces the team with 11.5 points per contest, starting in only five games.
- Farrington is shooting a SoCon best 55.6 percent from behind the arch.
- Western Carolina is 137 of 181 from the free throw this season for a 75.7 free throw percentage.
- The Catamounts 137 made free throws ranks 11th nationally, while ranking 30th in free throw percentage.

DYNAMIC DESTINEE

- Destinee Walker** is off to a sensational start, averaging 16.2 points and 8.3 rebounds per game.
- Walker leads the Big South in scoring and ranks second in rebounding.
- Walker has scored double-digits in the first six games to start the season.
- Set a career mark with a 22-point effort in a Dec. 4 win over UNC Greensboro.
- Walker entered the season having scored 10-plus points in only one game.
- In win over Davidson on Nov. 19, Walker played a career-high 34 minutes, earning her first career start in the game.
- Has collected three straight double-doubles, including back-to-back 20-point efforts.
- Leads the Big South with a .590 field goal percentage.

ADIÓS AISHA

- Radford will need to fill the void left by 2016 graduate **Aisha Foy**, a two-time Big South Conference honoree.
- A threat from behind the 3-point line, Foy made 129, ranking fifth all-time.
- Foy finished her career with a .351 3-point field goal percentage, ranking fifth in program history.
- She led the Highlanders in scoring during the 2015-16 season, averaging 12.2 points per game.
- Appearing in 113 games with earning 82 starts, Foy finished her career with 955 points.
- Named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want to be a Coach" program.
- Current graduate assistant at Southeast Missouri St.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN



- RU's 2016-17 roster features 13 players representing eight states and two countries.
- There are four players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by **Claudia Quevedo**.
- Radford has one redshirt senior, three juniors, two redshirt sophomores, four sophomores, one redshirt freshman and two freshmen
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

WHAT A TURNAROUND

- Head coach **Mike McGuire**'s is 38-28 over the last two seasons after going 7-23 during his first season.
- In 2015-16, the Highlanders went 18-13, the most wins in a season since the 2007-08 season.
- That 2007-08 season saw Radford win 23 contests.

CRUNCH TIME

- Radford played in seven games that were decided by three points or less since the 2015-16 campaign.
- The Highlanders have posted a 5-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach **Mike McGuire**, Radford is 15-8 in games decided by five points or less.

BSC PRESEASON FIRST TEAM

- White earns preseason first team honors after finishing the 2015-16 season as the only Big South performer to average a double-double. The Virginia Beach, Va., product averaged 11.9 points and 10.0 rebounds per game a season ago, earning Big South first team honors in the process.
- White scored in double-figures in 19 games, while grabbing double-digit rebounds 14 times a season ago. In addition to averaging a double-double, White led the Big South in field-goal percentage (.571).

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

Despite a 2015-16 season ravaged by injuries, McGuire steered Radford to its most wins (18) since the 2007-08 season. The Highlanders, who tied for third in the Big South regular-season standings, advanced to the semifinals of the Big South tournament for the first time since 2013.

Defense was the cornerstone of Radford's success. The Highlanders concluded the season ranked fifth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense (.333), 14th in scoring defense (53.3) and 16th in blocks per game (5.6).

Individually, two Radford players (Janayla White and Aisha Foy) were named to the All-Big South first team for the first time since 1992-93.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade.

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best

turnaround in the nation.

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond where he helped lead the Spiders to five straight postseason berths and a 101-60 overall record. For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament

championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Riner with their daughters, Harper and Ellie.
